SLOANS SKY broke a touch slow on the start to stalk near the back ahead of only a couple of runners, kept pace with the pack on the fence on the turn, shifted out starting to mount a run three at the quarter pole responding to right handed urging, had a full head of steam five wide at the top of the stretch, drifted inwards staying on the incorrect lead at the furlong pole closing in on the leader and with a good late charge edged away for the win in deep stretch. ALA TURKA broke a step slow to share the rear outside down the back straight, closed the gap smartly between horses in the two path midway around the bend, waited patiently behind the engaged duo with a quarter mile from home, looked for a seem just off the fence behind the leader in upper stretch, burst between runners with a sixteenth to go, could not match strides with the outside winner late but did surge at the right time to just get the nod for the runners up share at the wire. IMA BEAST was away alertly for the early lead, gave way up top to the inside rival with four furlongs still to run, regained the lead outside by the three eighths marker pulling the rider to the front, increased the advantage in the two path by mid-stretch, could not fend of the winner in the final seventy yards then just missed saving the place share in a tight photo at the finish line. NO WHAMMIE tracked three deep keeping a close eye on the pacesetter in the beginning, settled into a rhythm outside in mid-pack by the half, narrowed the gap moving on the outside with another rival three wide midway on the bend, was in the mix in the four path straightening out for home, had to be checked in tight between horses with an eighth of mile to go losing momentum and could not recover in time to pose a threat late. CRIMSON NIGHTS had a good position under a good hold tracking the contesting pair at the half, moved in three wide at the three eighths pole to force the pace outside on the turn, was in the hunt in the three path between rivals turning for home but stalled with rivals on each side at the furlong marker. MISS BOBBIT hesitated then veered out on the break to co-trail inside along the backstretch, could not keep up with others throughout the turn, shifted out four wide at the top of the lane and could only pass a straggler by mid-stretch. SILENT TRIBUTE was hustled on the rail to get the lead by the half mile marker, relinquished the top spot dropping back quickly by the five sixteenths pole and emptied out just off the fence in upper stretch.

SUNDAY'S WELL hopped slightly on the break, quickly moved in the fence still in hand to easily get the front by the five eighths pole, rambled on loose on the lead moving well and rapidly through the turn, had another gear to open up at the top of the lane and won as pleased in dominant fashion at the finish line. BIG SCREEN BOSS travelled in mid-division on the outside three deep by the half, stalked in the third flight still outside runners on the turn, narrowed the margin on the chasing rivals four wide by the quarter pole and closed in belatedly with the winner long gone and got up late to best the rest for the runners up share in the end. STIRLING CASTLE kept a close eye on the frontrunner down the back straight inside rivals while just off the fence, lost momentum for a stride or two between rivals with three eighths remaining, kept pace on the rail throughout the turn, moved in to the second position midway down the stretch having the rail, needed more late fading between foes in deep stretch but did at least save the show money in a tight picture at the wire. BEE ME settled on the fence keeping tabs on the lead three down the backside, shifted outside making a mild run inside another with five sixteenths to go and finished up willingly on the fence just missing getting up for the third place share in a photo at the finish line. CAPTIVATING NAME lacked early foot seeing the field down the back straight, began to make a rally passing a rival outside at the three furlong pole, shifted out four wide for the drive to the wire but lacked a rally down the stretch. MAY AND JUNE broke in on the start, had a good spot watching the front two in the early going, moved closer to the leader three wide midway on the oval, chased in vain in the three path straightening for home and folded between horses in the final eighth of a mile. DEVIL'S TONGUE was brushed outside then bobbled on the break, settled on the rail stalking down the backside having one rival beaten along the backside, retreated while saving all the ground around the turn and could no factor in the stretch running on the fence down the stretch.

BOTTA SWING appeared to brush a rival ever so lightly after the start, stalked from outside, advanced willingly four to five wide on the turn, drew up to the leaders flank near mid-stretch, made a steady bid finally wresting control near the seventy yard marker and edged away late under steady handling. BACKROADSBILLY had the lead for the opening furlong under moderate encouragement, was overtaken by an inside foe, re-engaged that one to duel into and on the turn, put that rival away in upper- to mid-stretch while coming out four to five wide but was then joined by the aforementioned winner outside, fought on for a while then yielded grudgingly. BLAZING BUCCHERO settled at the back off the inside racing three to four deep into and on the turn, came out six wide in upper stretch, rallied solidly while altering inwards in late stretch but ultimately needed more. SO DELICIOUS stalked the dueling pair three to four wide, was encouraged along past the three-eighths, shifted in past the five-sixteenths cutting the corner into upper stretch before being guided back out a bit, ran on evenly. KOKOMO bumped with a rival at the start, was urged forward taking a narrow lead after the opening furlong, dueled inside a foe, gave way in the stretch. WAR OF DESTINY bumped with a rival at the start, raced off the pace inside and was never near enough to threaten.

CRIMINAL INTENT was roused three deep having a slim advantage down the backside, shook clear up top for a brief moment into the turn, relinquished the lead on the fence midturn with a couple of outside rivals making an early bid, was calmly nudged for more skimming the fence at the top of the lane to reclaim the lead in upper stretch, had more to open up with a sixteenth to go and under a well rated ride held safe for basically a gate to wire score. ROAR OF THE CROWD travelled on the outside in midfield down the backside, was forced to go with an outside rival trying to swoop the field four wide at the three eighths pole, poked his head in front between horses with a quarter mile to run, could not keep up to the winner inside who had something left for the drove in the final eighth of a mile but still ran on gamely to clearly be second best. SPEEDY BEAR pressed the pace on the rail in the beginning, was shuffled on the fence when outside rivals were making a move early on in the running around the bend, started to get back into stride three wide at the top of the stretch and found another gear with a furlong remaining to close in smartly to capture the show award. FOUR STRONG WINDS broke sharp with the leaders at the start, dropped back through the back straight to be at the rear on the fence by the half, had a sharp move advancing on the rail midway on the turn, shifted just outside two wide turning for home and finished with good late energy to be a fringe player in the end. BUCYK was brushed on the outside

on the start, settled three deep watching the frontrunner down the back straight, could not quicken with the lead trio while between rivals at the three eighths marker, had a chance for a piece of the prize a little behind the winner in the two path turning for home but faded on the fence in the final seventy yards. TIERNAN was in the mix early on between challengers, tracked the leader when reined in at the half, made little headway just off the fence outside another through the oval, shifted out four wide at the top of the lane but was one paced in the stretch. MAGIC POWER trailed the field in the early stages, made a premature early move four deep at the half starting to make a run outside rivals, quickly moved in four wide outside runners to bid for the lead outside with five sixteenths from home, was in the thick of things four wide at the top of the lane, could not sustain the long rally and folded between horses in the three path in the final furlong. RIDE FOR THE PURSE stalked close to the back in the three path between horses at the half, made no progression four wide outside through the turn, shifted inwards to the two path turning for home and passed a weary rival inside down the lane. DONTGOBACKONURWORD was brushed inside on the break, settled near the rear between rivals along the backside, made little impression going three wide around the bend, angled out widest in the five path turning for home and had little to show in the stretch running.

GIANT TEDDY was quick to take the lead, set the pace from off the rail shadowed by a rival into the turn, kicked clear turning into upper stretch, was encouraged along at that juncture then put to strong urging nearing the furlong grounds, had enough in reserve to hold well despite shortening stride late. HANLAN was lightly bumped after the start, pursued from between runners early then was in a bit tight and altered outside a rival leaving the backstretch, went mostly four wide on the turn chasing outside, came out a bit turning for home, gained steadily under urging to get the place but could not reel in the winner. PINE KNOLL tracked from inside in behind the leaders, saved ground, kept on inside but was outfinished for place. SPLIT STRIKE had incidental contact just after the start, settled off the pace and off the inside going in the four to five path into the turn, came six wide into upper stretch, was best of the

READY FOR SHIRL was allowed to settle between runners galloping along near the rear in the early stages, began to reach for more ground when urged three wide at the five sixteenths pole, angled out gathering momentum in the five path between horses turning for home and with a busy ride had relentless pursuit on the frontrunner in the final furlong to get up for the win in the shadow of the wire. GIMME A NOTHER (SAF) had the front setting a snail's pace along the backside, continued up top dictating an even tempo hounded outside around the bend, got a breather in the third split still quite in control at the top of the stretch, dug in tenaciously holding on down the lane but just could not fend off the late charge by the winner in the final few jumps. LIFE'S AN AUDIBLE was content to sit of the outside flank of the pacesetter along the back straight, continued to have a shadowing role outside throughout the turn keeping a close eye on the leader, was nudged for more three eighths out making no gain on the frontrunner and in the two path between rivals had little to offer in the late stretch run yielding at the furlong pole.

CRUDEN BAY tucked in settling last but one racing in the two to three path heading up the backstretch into the turn, bided time then tipped out six to seven

wide in upper stretch and was put to urging once a clear path was available, promptly responded and swept to the lead in mid-stretch and drove clear. NORTHERN INVADER was forwardly-placed tracking inside, attempted to get through between runners in upper stretch seeking a seam between the weakening leader and an outside rival, appeared to brush the latter near the furlong marker now with clear sailing but was outkicked by the winner while second best. PIPER'S FACTOR bumped a rival at the start, settled mid-pack off the rail in the two to three path, moved out late on the turn beginning to advance four then five wide, kept on in the stretch but needed more. KEHOE BEACH soon led, set the pace shadowed by foes racing on or just off the rail, was patiently handled racing in hand till upper stretch, was encouraged at the quarter pole then received stronger urging at the three-sixteenths, was overtaken just past the eighth pole and continued to weaken but held on for the minor award. LUCKY SCORE lacked early speed then settled at the back, brought up the rear near the inside well back of the leader heading into the turn, angled eight wide leaving that bend and was asked for run, kept on in the lane gaining mildly but steadily and just missed the super. TWIN CITY was bumped at the start, settled outside foes in the back half of the field racing three to four deep, swung six wide turning for home, shifted in a bit through upper- to mid-stretch and ran on while improving position. CRUMLIN LAD chased the pacesetter pressing that one from between runners two to three wide heading into the turn, was encouraged to keep up while starting to weaken at the five-eighths, had no response and faded in the stretch. SKY'S NOT FALLING was between foes off the pace into the turn, came out seven wide in upper stretch, failed to rally. SHARDS chased from inside, dropped back and faded.

SEDBURYS GHOST travelled in mid-division on the fence in the beginning, was all alone near the back of the pack rating kindly ahead of only a few runners by the half, began to edge up three wide between rivals at the three furlong pole still in hand, moved in quickly when roused having a burst of speed at the quarter marker, pounced outside leaving the eighth pole, seized control with a sixteenth left to run and held safe from the oncoming runner up. NOTORIOUS GANGSTER was unhurried trailing early on, settled at the rear with challengers on both sides at the half, lacked running room while having horse at the seven sixteenths pole, was urged four wide inside another making a move two furlongs from the wire, shifted out to the five path finding his best stride late and rallied strongly to get the runners up share as well as gaining on the winner when coming up to the finish line. SCORCHING was away alertly

to have the lead after the start, let the early speed rival go on with it into the turn to contently track outside, vied between runners up front down the back straight, assumed command still in hand when the early leader gave way at the three furlong pole inside, was moving well in control in the two path inside at the top of the stretch, had no answer when collared outside by the winner at the sixteenth pole and gave way to the front pair while easily holding for the show award in the end. WATSONVILLE RED was allowed the settle near the back of the pack inside rivals on the first of two turns, co-trailed inside at the half, shifted outside for clear run when in last midway on the second bend, mounted a good rally five wide with a quarter mile from the finish line, shifted out in the six path gathering more speed in upper stretch and finished up with intent to garner a minor share in the end. FORTY N FIVE stalked near the rear going three wide into the first turn, co-trailed three deep outside two others with a half mile still to go, tried to circle around rivals four wide at the three eighths marker, bid for the lead outside with a quarter mile left to run, was unable to sustain the rally just off the fence at the top of the lane and weakened inside foes at the furlong pole. DEWOLF had an outside spot in the middle of the pack in the early stages of the race, kept in range with the engaged duo while under a snug hold between runners at the half, waited for the cue to go having no room to move at the five sixteenths pole, was shuffled back at the quarter pole still looking for a seam, angled out five wide straightening out for the drive and finished up mildly in the late running. CALL ME SUE was nestled on the rail keeping a close eye on the lead pair in the early going, settled on the fence in midfield along the backside, was relegated to last when the field was bunching up with a quarter mile remaining, angled out in the four path for the stretch drive and could only manage to pass tired foes outside in the last furlong. UNBRIDLED WEATHER bobbed on the break, recovered to seize command just off the fence into the initial bend setting a brisk pace, had a slim advantage inside slowing the tempo down along the backside, lost the lead on the fence at the three eighths pole, backed away through the field inside around the last turn and emptied out on the fence by the final furlong. AUTOBAHN ACE tracked outside into the first turn, travelled three deep watching the front two down the backstretch at the half, could not hold position three wide between rivals at the quarter pole and had little left to offer in the four path down the lane.

NO TIME settled outside a rival in the second flight three to four wide into the first turn, continued stalking up the backstretch, began to inch closer four deep

late on the far turn, took command at the eighth pole and drew clear under moderate urging. SHIFTY got away well and had forward position stalking between foes early, continued from the inside as a rival dropped back, saved ground on the far turn taking closer order and put to urging past the quarter pole, bid inside near the eighth pole, was no match for the winner but second best. WINTERBERRY unseated her rider behind the gate, broke well and was intent on the lead moving to the fore and shifting in, set the pace from off the rail, was challenged by foes inside and out coming to the top of the stretch, yielded to those but kept on well enough to hold show honors. D'AURUM unhurriedly brought up the rear off the inside, advanced past a couple at the back, was still far off while swinging five wide turning for home, had to shift out further in upper stretch for room, rallied outside for a minor award but was far too late to threaten the top trio. NATA TROUBLE bumped a rival at the start, was under a hold rating in behind the leading group racing off the rail and inside the eventual winner, continued tracking close up saving some ground on the far turn, got through along the rail in upper stretch, tipped out in mid- to late-stretch but could only kick on evenly. REVELER'S ROW shifted in heading into the first turn settling in the back half, switched out for the run up the backstretch three to four wide, came out six wide in the stretch, ran on with some late interest. ARISTELLA settled outside off the pace three to four wide early, steadily crept closer up the backstretch, made a swift five wide move from the five-sixteenths to the top of the stretch reaching striking distance but could not sustain the effort, was carried out a bit at that point and was not persevered with very late. INNISFREE ISLE shifted in to the two to three path entering the first turn, raced about mid-pack two to three wide throughout and was one-paced. CRYSTAL VISIONS bobbled at the start then moved forward stalking outside three wide, dropped back late on the far turn and faded. WAR SIGNAL was up close tracking inside briefly, steadily retreated. ELLA IT IS was bumped at the break, urged but lacking speed, checked and altered out entering the first turn bumping a rival in the process, was never near enough to threaten. R CANADIAN APPLE was bumped outward and bothered entering the first turn, settled after still far back from the leaders, was not a threat.

GAS ME UP had the rail position in mid-division along the backside, waited just off the fence for running room at the three eighths pole, continued to look for a seam in the two path straightening out for the stretch drive, shifted out four wide finally having a clear lane to run, drove past on the outside leaving the furlong marker and won going away smartly when crossing the finish line. FOUND MY BALL watched the frontrunner while outside another down the backstretch, took closer order to be all alone in the second position keeping an eye on the leader through the turn, shifted out three wide in the thick of things between rivals with a quarter mile left to run, could not quicken late with the outside winner in deep stretch but did fight on to just get the nod outside for the place share at the wire. BABBO spurted clear taking this field along the backside, was loose on the lead through the turn setting an even pace, still maintained control in the two path entering the stretch, was clinging onto a diminishing lead at the furlong marker, conceded the front while drifting inwards to the rail under a right-handed crop nearing the sixteenth pole and just missed saving the place share in a tight photo at the finish line. NIAGARA SKYLINE tracked on the fence in the beginning, was checked briefly while watching the front duo on the rail midway on the bend at the seven sixteenths marker, moved closer scraping the paint to be in range of the pacesetter with a quarter mile to run, had a clear lane for a moment to dart through at the furlong pole but lost his path shortly thereafter, had to be checked again with a sixteenth of a mile remaining losing all his run, switched out late but could not recover to threaten in time and still managed to settle on the fringes in the end. IRONSTONE settled close to the back on the rail in the early stages, was on hold behind runners taking the short way around the oval, had a clear path on the fence at the top of the lane and finished up with purpose with horses on each side dueling for a minor role coming to the wire. GILT EDGE rated in mid-pack four deep outside runners, made little advancement going four wide through the bend outside rivals, shifted to the seven path between foes turning for home and finished up one paced battling for a minor share in deep stretch. RAPID GREY settled on the outside in the third flight down the backstretch, edged up taking closer order on the lead duo while outside a rival at the three eighths pole, had a chance four wide for a piece of the prize in upper stretch but stalled between horses by the sixteenth pole. ARABIAN PRINCE stalked four deep near the rear down the backside, narrowed the gap taking the outside route going three to five wide through the turn, was floated out widest in the eighth path straightening out for home but could not find more to factor in the final furlong outside of rivals. ROI SOLEIL settled in midfield between horses in the early going, made little improvement around the oval, shifted out four wide behind the lead group at the top of the stretch but lacked a finish in the final furlong. PAINTTHTOWN SILVER stalked with rivals on either side along the back straight, made little impact just off the fence through the turn, angled outside between foes in the seven path for the drive to the wire but had no rally to offer in the stretch running. STEWARDS INQUIRY AND TRAINERS CLAIM OF FOUL #1 NIAGARA SKYLINE AGAINST #4 BABBO AT THE SIXTEENTH POLE RESULTED IN #4 BABBO BEING DISQUALIFIED AND PLACE FOURTH FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH
