RIGHT BRIGHTLY hopped on the break then ducked in at the gap while allowed to gather herself seeing the field along the backside, saved ground throughout the turn starting to pick up runners inside at the three eighths marker, skimmed the fence gathering more speed at the top of the lane, darted through the rail opening at the sixteenth pole and determinedly dug in to hold for the three way photo win. BRAZILIAN LEGACY battled up top going head-to-head inside down the back straight, continued to have company outside while maintaining a slim advantage on the fence around the bend, disposed of the early pace rivals when spurting clear in upper stretch in the two path, dueled stubbornly between to new foes in deep stretch but just missed at the wire in a close finish for the top three spots. DAISYCREST had a good spot nestled on the rail keeping a close eye on the embattled threesome at the half, elected to take the overland route shifting out at the quarter pole, closed in to loom menacingly in the five path straightening out for home, battled up front outside with an eighth of a mile to run with the left cheek piece dropping down noticeably in the stretch drive and was outkicked by the inside two rivals in deep stretch. ALMASTY'S LUST was brushed outside on the break tracking three deep in the beginning, moved in prompting the pace by the half, dueled three wide for the front around the oval, still was in the mix at the top of the stretch for a piece of the prize but evened out in the final furlong to settle on the fringes in the end. D'S KANDY travelled in midfield between horses watching the front pair in the early going, was scrubbed on outside another but could not keep up to rivals by the five sixteenths pole, shifted out staying on the incorrect lead down the lane and had little to offer in the stretch drive. RING BIT was on the outside contesting the pace along the backstretch, vied up top with challengers on either side through the turn, was the first of the lead trio to give way by the quarter pole and wilted between rivals by the furlong marker. HEBRIDEAN MISS broke out on the start, settled near the rear in a stalking role ahead of only the eventual winner down the backside, was unable to progress around the turn, shifted out four wide for the drive but could not factor in the late stretch running.

ADDENDUM assumed command while well in hand just off the rail down the backside, quickened the tempo still unchallenged around the turn, opened up at will turning for home and cruised in easily for the win while being geared down coming to the finish line. APRIL DE VELP stalked three deep near the rear along the backside, shifted out three wide at the quarter pole starting to pick up the bit, battled four wide in the mix for a placing in upper stretch and with a good late charge bested the rest at the finish line for the distant runners up share. GIZMO'S B F F pulled the rider on the rail to press the issue inside at the five eighths pole, was reined back conceding the fence at the half to the leader, took the short way around the bend being scrubbed on for more with a quarter mile to go, closed in to fight for the place share on the rail by mid-stretch but could not find more late and settled for the show money at the wire. KAVALA was unhurried trailing down the backside, started to pick up horses outside at the three eighths pole, angled out five wide at the top of the lane and finished up willing to just win the close picture for the minor share in the end. CEFALO settled inside rivals on the rail in the middle of the pack, was urged for more but was backing away midway on the turn, swung out widest in the seven path for the drive to the wire and finished up gradually on the outside of runners barely missing getting up late to be a fringe player at the wire. SHAMRA prompted the pace on the outside in the beginning, chased the winner in vain around the turn making no headway and faltered in the two path in the last sixteenth of a mile. LADY MOONSHINE stalked close to the back of the pack between horses down the back straight, had the outside position in mid-division watching the front two runners around the turn, shifted out three wide for the drive but folded between rivals in the last furlong.

GENIUS OF LOVE broke a step slow to begin, was isolated watching the top two runners with the field spread out at the half, rallied smartly on the rail at the quarter pole gaining position in upper stretch, could not match strides with the winner late but did run on well enough to secure the place share inside rivals in deep stretch. STERLING HEIGHTS settled in the middle of the pack on the outside, continued in midfield well behind the pacesetter with three furlongs still left to run, closed the gap in the three path at the top of the lane, switched back to the incorrect lead stalling while in the hunt at the three sixteenths marker, still kept on trying to the end and picked up the weary early frontrunner late to capture the show money in the end. MADAM GWEN was unhurried seeing the field on the fence on the first turn, shifted just off the fence splitting rivals at the half, began to uncork a run four wide around horses having a quick turn of foot midway on the last bend, swung out six wide with a full head of steam turning for home, stormed on past for

the lead leaving the eighth pole and was unchallenged at the finish line for the win. PAT'S HOLIDAY was inside a runner in the two path sitting in the middle of the pack on the first bend, rated kindly on the rail in the third flight down the backside, sat just behind the lead trio on the fence well in range with three furlongs from home, could not make a move on hold looking for room through the far turn, shifted out to be five wide finally getting clear in mid-stretch and surged in the late stages but could not get to the winner who got the jump on her at the top of the lane. DANISH COOKIE had a good spot tucked in on the fence drafting behind the pacesetter, sat all alone watching the engaged duo along the backside, moved in to bid three wide at the three-furlong pole, took over control in the four path turning for home, was clinging onto the lead at the furlong marker inside the winner, gave way up top with a sixteenth to run and just was picked up late on the outside for the place share nearing the wire. RELOAD EH was inside runners close to the back in the beginning, closed the gap but had little change in position when the field bunched up at the three eighths marker, was in tight with five sixteenths to go unable to lengthen her stride, angled out five wide in upper stretch and finished with good energy outside rivals late settling on the fringes in the end. UNDER AGREEMENT (FR) settled on the outside in mid-division, improved slightly keeping a close eye on the lead three at the half, moved in on the leaders at the quarter pole, shifted out five wide having a chance for a piece of the prize at the top of the stretch but finished up evenly in the late running to just miss holding for a minor share in the end. ECLIPTICAL LADYBUG prompted the pace on the outside in the beginning, continued to sit off the leaders outside flank down the back straight, moved in to seize command but for a fleeting moment at the five sixteenth pole, relinquished the front inside rivals at the top of the stretch and tired while losing a few placings to the outside foes who were making a rally in the final furlong. BLACK GODDESS had an outside stalking role near the rear in the early stages, moved in closer four deep improving outside horses at the half, could not sustain the rally in the three path between horses by the midpoint of the far turn, angled out six wide for the stretch drive but could not get involved. BLACK DAGGER was hard held near the rear while going four wide outside foes on the initial bend, could see the field by the half mile marker, lagged well behind the group on the last bend but did mange to pass the weary early leader inside in the final sixteenth of a mile. ONE MORE DOLL had the lead in hand inside going into the first turn, set the pace while hounded outside along the backside, was collared outside by two rivals offering little resistance on the fence at the three furlong pole, regressed through the far turn and folded inside by the furlong marker.
