LAUGHING OUT LOUD was under a snug hold going five wide outside foes on the first bend, improved position to sit in mid-pack three deep outside down the backstraight moving well in hand, began to move in when nudged for more at the five sixteenths pole, loomed the main threat four wide in upper stretch and edged clear for the win in the last sixteenth. GREAT KATE assumed command setting a soft pace into the first oval, maintained a slim lead while hounded outside along the backstretch, was still in the mix just behind the new leader while inside rivals turning for home, stubbornly fought back to regain the lead through the stretch but was no match for the winner in the final sixteenth of a mile. DADDY'S DAISY co-trailed on the outside to begin, stalked still close to the back going three deep outside rivals down the backstretch, ranged up three wide midpoint on the far bend, shifted just out further in the four path for the stretch drive reaching for more ground and finished up willingly in deep stretch to just miss getting the place share at the wire. MAKAYLA tracked the pacesetter outside in the early going, took closer order to shadow the frontrunner outside down the backstretch, moved in to bid for the lead at the quarter pole, briefly had her head in front in the three path straightening out for home, could not accelerate with the two rivals on either side with a furlong left to run and faded slightly more in the late running to settle on the fringes in the end. GHOSTLY PERFECTION co-trailed on the inside in the early going, could see the field down the back straight, made little impression when scrubbed for more shifting out three wide at the quarter pole, swung out widest in the six path turning for home and did show some interest late to pass a couple of tired foes in the final sixteenth of a mile. KEY STROKE stalked close to the back in the three path between horses in the beginning, made no progression down the backside, was under a ride making little headway midway on the final turn inside runners and had no finish to offer just off the fence in the stretch running. CARDIO PRINCESS (JPN) had good rail position drafting behind the pacesetter into the first of two turns, continued to sit behind the leaders on the fence waiting for the cue to go along the backside, was finally roused for more at the five sixteenths pole, offered little response around the last bend, emptied out on the rail in upper stretch and was not persevered with late.

SO CALLED VACATION had the lead inside in the beginning, remained up front by a narrow margin while shadowed outside down the backstretch, relinquished the lead on the rail with three furlongs still to run, was urged right-handed coming back on by the quarter pole, bid inside in the three path at the top of the lane, was resilient in the stretch resurging to regain the front at the furlong pole, drifted out in the late running but was clear of rivals at the wire. SMART ALMASTY travelled three wide tracking the lead twosome in the beginning, under a tight hold pulled the rider to the leaders three deep on the outside by the half, bid three wide outside through the last bend, angled out five wide dueling outside for the front in upper stretch but was outkicked by the re-rallying winner in the last sixteenth of a mile. PET SOUNDS settled in the two path keeping a close eye on the lead duo, rated kindly in the second flight between horses along the backside, crept closer on the far turn when roused for more between foes at the three eighths pole, shifted out six wide for the stretch drive, was no threat to the front pair in the lane but finished up well to be a clear third at the wire. ISAAC LEO took control right from the break, was loose up top moving comfortably along the backside, continued to have no pressure early on the turn, had company to his outside at the quarter pole, had more when called upon to spurt away at the top of the stretch and under a well rationed out ride just had enough saved up late to withstand the late charge by an inside rival in deep stretch. SCUDERIA was in the second flight outside watching the lead two along the backside, co-trailed on the outside when shuffled back in midturn still not that far off from the leader though, rallied at the quarter pole looking for a seam behind the winner, angled inwards to the two path in upper stretch full of run and closed in smartly late inside but could not get up in time for the win. EL DIABLITO broke out on the start, prompted the pace leaving the chute, was then reined back to track the leader outside down the backside, moved in outside through the turn to bid for the lead at the quarter pole, angled out five wide for the drive to the wire still posing a threat, could not keep up to top pair by the furlong pole and was one paced late to hold for a clear third at the wire. AUDI'S WORLD was squeezed on the start to be at the rear leaving the chute, took closer order to the compact bunch at the half, inched up in the two path between foes with a quarter mile from home, switched out three wide at the eighth pole losing his path in mid-stretch and finished up mildly to be a fringe player in the end. SOUPER EFFECT broke in at the start, settled near the rear outside horses down the back straight, made a brief rally going four wide trying to swoop around rivals from the three eighths pole until the two furlong marker, swung out widest in the six path at the top of the lane and stalled with a furlong remaining never switching leads to the finish line. PROFESSOR RELOAD had a stalking role in the beginning, improved down the backstretch on the rail to sit just behind the frontrunner at the half, could not quicken on the fence with others making a move outside when urged on at the quarter pole and having little left for the stretch run, yielding inside rivals in the final furlong.

TRUE SHOT angled in after the start settling toward the rear off the inside about three wide, advanced steadily entering the far turn, moved between foes midway on that bend, angled six wide coming into upper stretch, drove to the lead outside the sixteenth pole and edged past willingly late. ITS IN THE CARDS bobbled just slightly at the start, was forced inward in the early going, settled not too far off the leaders inside saving ground, was encouraged leaving the far turn, angled four wide at the top of the stretch, kept on and edged past for the place. NIGHT STRIKER was forced in early, moved forward

and stalked the leading pair having shifted inside, moved out and advanced four wide on the far turn taking a narrow lead at the five-sixteenths, engaged with the inside rival dueling while drifting in a bit in upper stretch and putting that one away, was overtaken by others late but was best of the rest. GLORIOUS REVENGE sped and clear and shifted in, set the pace in the clear, was challenged on the far turn, fought on till the stretch, lacked the needed late kick. UPHILL ROAD broke in a bit, clipped heels early, settled well back of the pace, saved ground inside through both turns, improved inside in the stretch. AUDAX MINOR broke out just a bit, was in a hair tight and altered outside a rival two to three wide heading to the first turn, settled, continued two to three deep on the far turn, was one-paced. FEELS LIKE A KYLLA moved forward outside stalking from just past mid-pack about three wide, took a bit closer order outside foes five wide on the far turn, was under urging past the three-eighths, failed to rally in the stretch. MIAH SAID bobbled ever so slightly at the start, moved forward outside, stalked the pacesetter two to three wide in the clear, continued close up in behind late on the far turn, weakened in the stretch and came out late. SMALL TALK co-trailed on the outside along the backstretch, stalked while only ahead of one runner on the turn, started to mount a rally four wide at the five sixteenths pole circling rivals, gathered more speed in the six path with a quarter mile from the wire, had a strong sustained run down the lane, drifted in late taking command outside at the sixteenth pole and edged away for the win at the finish line. LEGAL ATTACK (GB) drifted outwards on the break having a slim advantage in the beginning, was taken a hold of on the fence into the turn to sit in the third flight keeping pace on the rail around the bend, edged up inside with five sixteenths to go, shifted out off the leader in the two path with three sixteenths from the wire, dueled determinedly between foes with a furlong to go and drifted in slightly nearing the wire when capturing the runners up share in the end. GUILDSMAN (FR) was checked ever so slightly after the break to co-trail on the inside down the backside, took the short way around the bend, narrowed the gap scraping paint at the quarter pole just behind the leader, kept looking for a seam in the stretch drive unable to extend his stride, finally angled out in the four path having clear run but with seventy yards remaining finished up well but could not get to the winner in time. PEJA DU moved clear and shifted in, dictated pace on or just off the rail slowing things down a bit midway up the backstretch, kicked clear when roused turning into upper stretch, held sway. LOBBY BAR was bumped into a rival at the start, reserved at the rear racing off the rail, was kept wide up the backstretch, began to advance foes on the far turn five to six deep coming into upper stretch six to seven wide, finished well to gain the place while no threat to the winner. THIS DUDE A BREEZE stalked from outside three to four wide, was within range coming to the top of the stretch, could make no headway on the winner and lost place late. WELLER GREEN was allowed to settle in last finding his stride in the early stages, began to pick up the bit catching up to a rival outside at the half, moved well in hand circling runners four wide at the five sixteenths pole, had a clear lane full of run outside in the six path at the top of the stretch, drove on by the leader leaving the furlong pole taking command and won going away at the finish line. MAGNA TIME narrowly dictated the pace outside down the backstretch, edged away up front by the midpoint of the turn, drifted out holding on up top at the three sixteenths marker, had no answer for the winner outside when switching back to the incorrect lead inside the eighth pole and dug in late getting back to the proper lead to clearly best the rest for the runners up share when crossing the finish. HIGHLY POTENT travelled four deep in the middle of the pack along the backside, moved in three wide outside at the half to flank the leader by the three eighths pole, angled out five wide in the thick of things turning for home between horses, was no match for the top pair who had it to themselves in the last eighth of a mile but did fight on outside to secure the show money at the wire. ROYAL ENTRY settled near the rear after the break, closed the gap in mid-backstretch, was relegated to the back midway around the bend, shifted to the two path straightening out for the drive and was one paced to the wire dueling for the show award inside but had to settle on the fringes in the end. CONN SMYTHE (GB) prompted the issue outside in the half, shifted out four wide in upper stretch but lacked a rally in the last eighth of a mile. EMPOWER pressed the pace inside down the backstretch, came under a ride trying to hold position on the rail at the half, retreated on the fence by the five sixteenths pole and had nothing more to offer on the fence while drifting out by the furlong marker.

ADMIRAL NELSON seized control fight from the start setting the pace down the backstretch, was unchallenged going at an even rate stringing out the field through the running around the bend, had a commanding lead at the top of the stretch and won by a diminishing margin late but under a hand ride. BIG LEW travelled on the outside in midfield at the half, began to rally midway on the bend just off the rail following another rival who was making the same move, angled out six wide finding his best stride late, won the duel for the runners up share by the furlong pole and finished up smartly closing the gap on the winner considerably in deep stretch all the while staying on the wrong lead never wavering to the wire. SWITCHIN' TO GLIDE settled three deep on the outside watching the front three runners down the backside, rallied three wide passing another foe outside midway on the turn to be in the mix for share four wide turning for home, dueled inside for the runners up share with the winner long gone by the furlong marker and finished up a clear third at the wire. HALCON NEGRO was brushed outside on the start, settled in mid-division on the rail along the backside, kept pace taking the short way around the turn, started to rally between foes at the quarter pole in the two path, swung out six wide for the stretch drive and finished up with intent to garner a minor placing in the end. ASHWOOD stalked down the backstretch having a couple of runners beaten in the early going, was scrubbed on foe more with five sixteenths from home, offered a mild rally shifting out in the two path by the quarter pole, weaved between horses four wide at the top of the stretch and kept on trying to the wire. TOP BEAR settled close to the back of the pack down the back straight, made little progression through the turn, shifted three wide at the top of the lane and passed a few tired runners on the outside in the stretch drive. Z HUB travelled between foes in midfield along the backside, was roused for more at the five sixteenths but was going the wrong way being passed by outside rivals making a move by the guarter pole and faded inside runners by upper stretch. JO JAGR broke out on the break, improved along the backside to track the pacesetter outside at the half, was roused midway on the turn trying to hold position in third, shifted out three wide at the top of the stretch but had little left and wilted with a furlong left to run. HAPI EKATI broke inwards on the start, tracked behind the pacesetter along the backside, chased the leader to no avail losing ground on the turn by the quarter pole, began to get leg weary on the fence in upper stretch and folded inside foes by the furlong marker. HIGHLAND ROCKY was unhurried seeing the field along the backside, could not make any progression saving ground on the turn and did not factor in the stretch running. KAIROS MOMENT was bumped inside at the start, clipped heels shortly thereafter, stumbled unseating the rider in the chute and walked off. STEWARDS GENERAL INQUIRY AFTER THE START RESULTED IN NO CHANGE
