PERFECT SPARKLE pressed the pace outside along the back straight, moved in to bid outside with two furlongs from the line, poked her head in front straightening out for the drive, battled outside determinedly through the lane and inched away for the win in the final seventy yards. NAKEDINTHEFOREST was away alertly for the lead on the break, remained up front inside by a narrow margin with a guarter mile to go, relinquished the lead inside turning for home, fought on bobbing heads to the wire and just missed inside the winner at the finish line. TOAST THE GHOST had an ideal spot isolated watching the embattled duo down the backside, waited to move behind the contesting twosome on the fence around the bend, shifted out by the quarter pole, took aim in the four path at the top of the lane but could only finish up mildly to be a non-threatening third at the finish line. SANS DANCER hopped on the break, had a stalking role ahead of another poor starter down the backside, closed the gap on the leaders around the bend, had a chance for a piece of the prize just off the rail into the stretch and dug in down the stretch on the rail late to save for a minor placing at the finish line. JAPONKA broke outwards on the start, improved on the inside to sit in mid-pack on the fence by half, was scrubbed on at the five sixteenths pole making no progression saving the ground through the turn, dropped back on the fence in upper stretch, switched outside at the furlong marker and had a late run between horses dueling for the minors in the end. I THINK I CAN (IRE) tracked the front pair outside down the back straight, took closer order picking up the bit two wide outside a rival midway on the turn, was fanned out to the five path at the top of the stretch and could not offer a finish outside rivals in the late running. WUNHAPPY WABBIT broke a touch slow on the start, trailed along the backside, lagged behind through the turn, made a brief move closing the gap smartly by the quarter pole, angled out six wide for the drive, could not sustain the run and stalled outside by the furlong marker.

CITY OF OSCARS settled near the back off the inside, began to advance late on the turn, came out seven wide in upper stretch, got into stride and gained steadily driving past late. GLASWEIGIAN set a pressured pace, dueled inside a rival, was headed in upper stretch, dug in to re-take the lead from the dueling partner but was no match for the winner. WAGNER was coaxed forward between foes after the start, forced the pace, dueled outside, took a narrow lead in upper stretch, flattened out. JAGGERSGOTAGUN was well-placed stalking the leading pair from outside, was encouraged a bit passing the half, failed to rally in the lane. PRIME PLUS ONE was bumped at the start, chased from inside just off the fence, ran evenly. A LITTLE FRISKY was content to hound the pace outside down the back straight, moved in when forced to go with an outside rivals prompting three wide at the three eighths pole, vied between foes around the bend, poked her head in front with determined challengers on either side through the stretch and found just a bit more to edge away for the win nearing the wire. PROMISING settled three deep in the middle of the pack in the early going, closed in at the half, bid three wide midway on the turn, was in the thick of things outside, four wide at the top of the lane, dueled to the wire outside but just weakened slightly in the shadow of the wire to settle for the runners up share instead at the finish line. LITERATE was unhurried sharing the rear outside in the early stages, galloped along finding her stride down the backstretch, began to reach for more ground taking the shortest way around the turn, darted up the rail at the top of the lane, shifted out in the two path never losing momentum with an eighth of mile to run with aim on the leader and surged three wide on the outside in the final seventy yards while being bumped by the inside rival coming out nearing the wire to still get up for the well timed late rally. CAITLINHERGRTNESS rated kindly on the second flight with the field paired up in three tiers on the first turn, ranged up in the three path outside foes along the back straight, moved in comfortably three wide on the last turn, cruised around the leading pair at the quarter pole, pounced four wide when asked for more in upper stretch to take command by the furlong marker, drifted in slightly in mid-stretch then drifted back out under left handed urging coming to the finish line but could not find more late to fend off the outside charge by the winner. FASHIONABLY FAB was nestled on the rail watching the lead duo on the first turn, settled in mid-pack still on the fence along the backside, edged closer to the contesting trio when roused at the five sixteenths pole, veered out sharply for a moment with a quarter mile to run, quickly was straightened out five wide turning for home and recovered smartly by the furlong pole closing in smartly late but just could not get to the front two at the finish line. FOR FLYING (BRZ) was nudged up top having a narrow advantage inside another around the initial bend under a modest pace, reined back to draft behind the pacesetter along the backside, moved in to bid in the two path between foes at the three eighths marker, fought on still in the mix of things three wide in upper stretch, had little left for the final furlong and faded between horses to settle on the fringes in the end. VEERY broke a step slow on the start, then was checked soon afterwards, was hustled to prompt the pace outside around the first of two turns, quickened the tempo shaking clear for the lead down the backside, still maintained a slim advantage on the rail at the three furlong pole, was urged for more but could not maintain position with a quarter mile to run, had little left at the top of the lane and wilted in the two path by mid-stretch. ECSTASY broke slow and outwards to co-trail on the outside in the early going, improved slightly along the backstretch ahead of only the eventual winner, came under a ride with five sixteenths to go but could not quicken with others and had little to offer in the stretch running.

BILES (IRE) was hustled to seize command from the start, dictated the pace having a narrow lead while in hand by the half, edged away putting away the other early speed foe by the quarter pole, had the rail opening up on the rivals turning for home and was kept to the task in deep stretch to hold safe for the gate to wire victory. GINGER ZIP rated kindly tracking the top threesome while between horses down the backside, was in tight dropping back on the fence at the three eighths marker, re-rallied when urged right-handed at the quarter pole regaining her stride and with a solid late charge on the rail closed in smartly in the final furlong to best the rest for the runners up share. SEEKINGTITLEREADY settled in mid-division on the rail down the backside, shifted out in the two path with runners on either side commencing a run midway on the turn, burst between foes three wide at the quarter pole with a quick turn of foot to had a full head of steam in the six path in upper stretch and closed in late outside horses to capture the show award. LUDICROUS had the rail position keeping a close eye of the lead three down the backside, took closer order drafting right behind the leader while under a snug hold by the rider at the half, waited to move on the fence through the turn, shifted out three wide between runners posing the main opposition turning for home, chased the winner in upper stretch but stalled with a sixteenth left to run and settled for a minor placing in the end. FOURFIFTYFOUR rated kindly while nestled on the rail in the second flight while staying in contact with the embattled trio down the backside, took closer order to be by oneself poised on the fence on hold waiting to move behind the contesting threesome around the bend, shifted out beginning to lengthen stride leaving the quarter pole to be three wide posing the only threat in upper stretch and drove on past in the final seventy yards holding for the win at the finish line. GO GIFFEN co-trailed on the outside after the start, sat alone at the back of the pack by the half, made a strong move at the quarter pole shifting off the fence, found a seam three wide full of run straightening out for home and closed in smartly for the runners up share in deep stretch. WHISKEY NICE dueled on the rail in the beginning, edged away for a clear lead by the half, increased the advantage on the turn disposing of the other two early speed foes with a quarter mile from home, spurted away briefly from the new challenge by the eventual winner turning for home but faded on the fence in the final seventy yards being softened up from his early efforts to get the lead and still held on for the show money at the wire. BEDAZZLE ME co-trailed on the inside in the early going, stalked near the rear ahead of one other by the half, had little to give on the turn relegated to the rear by the quarter pole, shifted five wide at the top of the lane, shifted inwards avoiding a weary drifting out rival at the eighth [pole and passed a couple of horses in the late running. MISS PIERRE settled in the second flight on the outside early on watching the lead trio battle up top, settled in mid-pack by the half, was scrubbed on at the three eighths pole for more but was backing away through the turn, swung out widest in the seven path for the drive to the wire and pass some tired horses in the final sixteenth of a mile. PRIMA bid for the early lead between foes in the beginning, kept a close eye on the leader inside another by the half, chased the pacesetter in van through the turn unable to keep up by the quarter pole, angled to the four between foes shortening stride the stretch drive and wilted at the furlong marker. EXECUTIVE SUCCESS prompted the pace three deep along the backside, tracked the leader outside at the half, was trying to hold position three wide on the turn in touch with the frontrunner at the quarter pole, shifted out to the six-path turning for home, had little left for the drive and folded in the final furlong.

SCAT GIRL settled nicely with runners on either side in the third flight down the backside, was nudged for more improving smartly between foes in midturn, had a clear lane moving out five wide for the drive, powered past to take control at the furlong pole and was drawing away at the wire for the win. MO ARGENTO had a good spot tucked in behind the contesting three down the backside, waited patiently just off the fence still keeping a close eye on the front threesome still continuing to battle for the lead around the bend, darted to the fence having clear run in upper stretch, moved in to bid inside foes by the furlong pole and fought on determinedly to the wire but was no match for the winner in the final seventy yards. MOBULA had an outside spot in the second tier watching the dueling trio along the backside, travelled three wide outside of trouble waiting for the cue to move around the oval, was fanned out eight wide at the quarter pole and grinded away steadily down the lane to get up in the late stages between rivals to capture the show money at the finish line. SYMPATICO was hustled on the fence having a slim lead down the backside, continued saving ground with a narrow advantage up front through the turn still hounded by a couple of rivals, dug in just off the rail in upper stretch and gave way grudgingly in the final furlong saving for a minor share all the while not beaten that much for the place and show money as well. ABINO BAY moved through the backstretch to get to the rail from the outer post while in a stalking spot ahead of a couple of rivals going into the turn, mildly narrowed the margin on the lead trio on the turn, angled out seven wide straightening out for the drive, shifted out further to be nine wide at the furlong pole and under a left handed crop had good late energy to finish with intent closing in smartly at the wire. CALL ME KAYKAY stalked inside runners while having a few rivals beaten along the backside, closed the gap between foes but could not gain position around the bend, shifted to the four path at the quarter pole, was one paced wandering slightly down the late and could not get involved by the time they hit the finish line. CLOUD RIDER settled close to the back of the pack in the early going, made little impression taking the short way around the turn, angled out five wide with the field bunching up at the top of the lane, was allowed to drift inwards trying find a clear lane driving down the stretch but could not factor in the late running when finishing up on the fence at the wire. NAUGHTY DESTINY travelled three deep in the third flight down the back straight, held her own moving comfortably four wide outside on the bend, swung out widest in the nine path turning for home, had a chance for a piece of the prize by the furlong pole but stalled in the final seventy yards between horses. MY EMMY advanced five deep outside foes to sit in midfield along the backstretch, kept pace with the lead threesome while going three wide outside horses on the turn, shifted out in the six-path having no room to go in upper stretch, angled to be eight wide with three sixteenths from the wire but failed to fire in the late running, BEACH CRICKET settled in the third flight on the rail with the field already string out midway down the backstretch, travelled in mid-pack on the turn coming under a ride to hold position at the half, shifted just outside two wide for the stretch run but had little to give and tired on the fence at the eighth pole. MONTY'S INN prompted the issue three deep down the back straight, continued the three wide journey outside shadowing the two other foes dueling for the lead on the bend, swung out to the six path for the drive and gave way with three sixteenths still left to run. TANZANITE LILY vied between runners in the early stages of the race, shifted out to the three path between foes turning for home, had little left to offer in the lane and faltered by the furlong pole. LOVE TO DREAM stalked outside foes ahead of only one runner down the backside going into the turn, still remained well behind horses around the oval, galloped through the stretch playing no role in the in the late stages and was far back when coming across the finish line. REMARKABLY HUMAN was void of early speed to see the field along the backside, lagged at the back by many losing touch with the group around the turn, was not persevered with cantering down the lane and eventually crossed the wire in the end.
