BANK ON BIG WINNER broke on top at the break, was pressed outside for a brief moment into the backstretch, spurted clear again by the half mile marker, rolled along comfortably along the bend and pulled away by the furlong marker to coast in for the front-end score. TIME ZAPPER tracked the leader outside three deep down the backside in the beginning, ranged up three wide closing the gap on the turn to be in the mix at the quarter pole, could not get to the winner who had something left in mid-stretch but did show some grit to capture the secondary battle nearing the finish line. DEPUTY GHOST brushed the inner part of the gate breaking a step slow compared to others on the start, moved up quickly between horses to press the issue early in the backstretch, took back to track the frontrunner inside another rival by the half, shifted out at the quarter pole trying to close the gap on the leader, was no match for the winner while between horses in upper stretch and just missed out for the place share dueling inside in the late stages. BALBONI'S CREW travelled in midfield between foes down the backside, dropped back to be at the rear outside at the three furlong marker, made a mild run circling some rivals three wide in midturn, shifted slightly inwards at the top of the lane and finished up one paced to settle on the fringes. FOG D'ORO lacked early foot to be at the back after the start, improved on the rail midway down the backside, was scrubbed on for more but could not keep up to the lead threesome around the turn, shifted to the three-path turning for home but had little to offer in the stretch running. DARK SCREEN had a tracking spot on the rail in the early going, was taken a deep hold of by the rider while drafting behind the pacesetter through the turn, shifted out to loom menacingly four wide at the top of the lane, was gaining steadily down the stretch to get his head in front at the sixteenth pole and stubbornly dug in nearing the wire to fend off the inside rival at the finish line. KEKOA broke with the field but dropped back while being nudged on to stay interested soon after the start, became eager pulling the rider closer on the rail into the turn, rated kindly advancing smartly on the fence in midturn, skimmed the rail to be in the thick of things inside in upper stretch, battled determinedly to the wire but just could not kick on late with the winner outside. GO KART MOZART dictated the pace down the backside, continued up top only by a slim margin inside around the bend while nudged for more at the three furlong marker, shifted just out to the two path clinging onto the lead in mid-stretch but had little left in the final sixteenth of a mile unable to battle on with the closing in runners on either side in deep stretch. PHILIP BANKS tracked between rivals in the beginning, was headstrong fighting the rider getting out briefly around the five eighths marker, settled into stride three wide in the second flight around the bend, angled out to the five path straightening out for home and finished up mildly outside winning a minor share in the end. AWESOME RAINBOW galloped along three deep stalking near the rear, had to be checked slightly at the five eighths pole to be shuffled back to last, moved well three wide through the turn keeping pace with the field, shifted out to the four path but lacked running room in upper stretch, switched outside for a clear lane at the eighth pole but continued to lay in under a left handed crop unable to fire in the late running. LITTLE RED DOMI prompted the pace three deep along the backside, took even closer order to hound the frontrunner outside around the bend, was still in the hunt three wide at the top of the lane, could not continue on with others in mid-stretch and wilted between horses at the furlong marker.

TABLOID MATERIAL was content to let the pacesetter go on with it patiently tracking on the outside down the back straight, kept pace measuring the leader through the turn, began to whittle away on the frontrunner in the two path at the top of the lane, closed in smartly with a furlong from the prize and while being pushed out nearing the wire by the leader got up in the last few jumps for the victory. SUPER SICILY broke in at the start, seized command right from the get-go unchallenged down the backside, maintained a comfortable lead while quickening the pace through the turn, still was well in control on the fence in upper stretch, could hear the runner coming at the eighth pole, drifted out under left handed encouragement in the late stages but was caught in the final few strides being denied the victory. WICKED MERCURY settled on the rail in the middle of the field in the early going, ran on evenly making little headway on the lead two around the oval, angled out three wide for the stretch run but finished up one paced unable to threaten the top two finishers while coming in under the wire for a clear third in the end. CRUMLIN BEAST was pushed in on the break, could see the field while three deep along the backside, was roused for more but made little impact outside foes still going three wide around the bend, shifted to the four path straightening for home and passed a rival outside by the furlong marker. VERI GIZMO had a stalking role between rivals in the two path, made no movement around the turn and while continuing to stay just off the fence down the lane failed to menace in the late running inside rivals.

AWESOME CONNECTION forced the pace from outside, moved clear past the four- and one-half, dictated terms from off the rail, was challenged in upperto mid-stretch, dug in gamely and just got the nod. DYNA stalked from just off the leading pair outside, began to advance late on the turn shifting out, came
into upper stretch five wide and in contention, was lightly bumped repeatedly by an inside rival while commencing a bid, was even with the leader through
late stretch but just lost the nod. THUNDERMAKER was prominent inside in the early going, ceded the lead and switched out coming to the half stalking

SHAMATEUR assumed command utilizing the inside post entering the first turn, remained up top while pressured outside by the half, comfortably continued on saving all the ground up top through the last turn, had company outside at the top of the stretch, threw it all down inside to the wire, lost the lead for a moment on the head bob at the sixteenth pole but came right back on to stick his neck out at the wire for the resilient frontrunning win. CONACHER was in the second flight on the outside rating kindly in the early going, moved in closer by the half, bid for the lead three wide at the quarter pole, dueled outside for the lead in mid-stretch, poked his head in front for a fleeting moment with a sixteenth from home but was denied by a game winner digging in late. SOL DE VERANO had a good spot nestled on the rail just behind the leader down the backside, still remained on the fence waiting for the cue to go throughout the far turn, moved in scraping paint at the top of the stretch, could not find more to threaten the front duo who had it to themselves at the furlong pole but did show grit to fight on inside to capture the show money late. GLINTINDADDYSEYE had an outside position close to the back of the pack early on, settled in the third flight down the backside, made a sharp move three wide at the three-furlong pole circling rivals, was in the hunt four wide turning for home, could

not sustain the rally to catch the top pair but did finish up well enough just missing out on the battle for third place share in deep stretch. YOU'RE SO LUCKY was part of the rear pairing inside another runner early on, started to make a move on the fence in the far bend at the three furlong pole, shifted out with five sixteenths from home, angled to the four path straightening out to the wire and finished up mildly down the lane. PIPERS REIGN was allowed to settle near the back of the field having only two rivals beaten along the backside, took the short way around the bend saving all the ground, made a savvy move skimming the fence while the field was fanning out ten abreast turning for home, closed in sharply in the two path by mid-stretch figuring which path to take when coming up to the leaders and darted inside up the rail to drive past at the sixteenth pole for the stretch running score. LOVER BOY MO was part of the fray up front having the rail on the start, settled into stride on the fence at the half in the second flight watching the contesting trio on the turn, moved in two wide to sit just behind the embattled duo entering the stretch, shifted out posing a threat in the four path with clear run at the three sixteenths pole, veered in behind a weakening rival when asked right handed shying from the crop at the eight pole losing his momentum, got going again on the incorrect lead back outside in deep stretch and kept trying to the finish line just getting up for the place share right on the wire. RED WEAVER was hustled on the fence taking this field down the backside, continued inside with initially two other rivals forcing the issue outside into the turn, still remained in front narrowly in midturn with only one close pursuer to his outside, was headed outside at the top of the stretch, found another gear continuing to fend off the early foe who did not appear to want to go away, conceded the lead to the winner who was making a late charge on the fence with a sixteenth from home and just missed saving the runners up share in a tight finish at the wire. TOTAL SENSATION pressed the issue up front going three deep along the backside, dueled outside the leader when the other front end rival dropped back at the seven sixteenths marker, shifted three wide for the stretch drive battling determinedly to the sixteenth pole getting a little leg weary late and faded in deep stretch just saving for a minor placing at the wire. PARADISE PERFECT co-trailed on the outside, still remained near the rear outside another foe around the bend, closed the gap swinging out widest in the eleven path at the top of the lane, had a very good sustained rally down the stretch gaining with every stride and almost got up for a minor role in a tight finish at the wire. VELOCIRAPTOR had the rail position in midfield, continued to save ground while in the third grouping midway on the turn, was in the mix of things in the three path straightening out for home, shifted out five wide running greenly weaving in when switching back to the incorrect lead under right-handed encouragement at the furlong pole and could not offer a finish in deep stretch. TORONTO CITY had rivals on either side while sitting in midfield down the backstretch, still remained between foes midpoint around the bend in the third tier, shifted out to the six-path finding a seam at the top of the lane and finished with interest even though not gaining position at the wire but closing the gap on the leaders in the end. COUNTRYBOYSURVIVE travelled between horses in the second flight in the early stages, made a brief run three wide at the three eighths marker, angled out eight wide in upper stretch but lacked a rally down the lane to the finish line. SILENT KNIGHT settled in the middle of the pack going four deep on the outside along the backstretch, travelled in the third flight of runners three wide at the three eighths pole, made a quick move ten wide closing the gap at the quarter pole but could only finish up one paced between rivals down the lane. PAYNES SPIRIT vied between runners down the back straight, continued up top with challengers on either side in the early part of the turn, was checked backing up abruptly at the seven sixteenths pole, recovered in the five path with a quarter mile to go having a chance for a small share of the prize but yielded on the fence by the furlong marker. FINE STYLE travelled three deep in the second flight along the backside, was scrubbed for more run at the three eighths pole, offered little response regressing with five sixteenths from home, was in tight losing his path shifting out to the ten-path straightening out for the drive and could not factor in the late stages. TANIST co-trailed on the inside, lagged well behind the field on the turn, shifted out eight wide turning for home and could not get involved in the stretch running moving in to four path by the furlong marker.
