EL ALACRAN sat alone down the backstretch watching the front two rivals, inched up running just off the rail around the oval, shifted out three wide at the five sixteenths marker, loomed menacingly in the five path full of run at the eighth pole and edged away on the outside in the late running for the win. INDY ONE pressed the early pace inside, was then reined back to let the leader go by the eleven sixteenths marker down the backside, chased just off the fence making no headway on the pacesetter around the turn, shifted out to the three path starting to rally closing in by the eighth pole, poked his head in front for a moment with a sixteenth of a mile from the wire but was no match for the outside winner in deep stretch. CAUGHT SPEEDING had the rail inside another while stalking near the rear in the early going, patiently saved ground while dropping back positions through the turn but was closing the gap on the leader nonetheless, rallied smartly on the rail in upper stretch and closed in belatedly to be a non-threatening third at the finish line. FRAC RIGHT was hustled from the outer post intent on getting the lead, moved comfortably loose on the lead around the bend, had a quickly diminishing lead inside while just clinging up top at the furlong pole, offered no answer when the front two swept past with a sixteenth to run and faded late to settle for a minor role in the end. SECRET THREAT had a stalking trip on the outside down the back straight, was part of the back trio with runners on either side through the turn, began to lengthen stride at the five sixteenth pole, shifted out five wide in upper stretch having a chance for piece of the prize but could not find more late and stalled at the furlong marker. RY PIE popped up breaking outside on the start to trail in the beginning, was checked slightly on the fence with three eighths to go, shifted just off the rail at the top of the lane and managed to pass a tired rival inside at the furlong marker. SOONER LUNAR co-trailed on the outside midway down the backstretch, made a brief run going four wide around rivals at the three-furlong marker, swung out widest in the six-path turning for home, could not sustain the outside rally and folded by the three sixteenths marker down the stretch.

IRON PYRITE shifted out getting off the fence to be three wide going around the first turn, sat in mid-pack tucked in on the fence watching the engaged threesome at the half, made a quick move darting up the rail at the quarter pole, angled just outside off the leader gathering speed at the top of the lane and determinedly wore down a stubborn pacesetter in the final sixteenth for the win. I'M TENACIOUS assumed the lead on the rail in the early going, had company to her outside into the backstretch, relinquished the lead at the half for a moment, came back on the edge away up front again from the early speed foes by the five sixteenths marker, gamely tried to dig in finding something in reserve to repel the outside challenge by the winner in deep stretch but could not fend off the winner late and settled for asecond money in the end. I HAVE AN IDEA was pushed out from the inside rival on the first of two turns, had a stalking trip ahead of a couple on horses along the backside, closed the gap smartly between foes midway on the last turn and burst through a seam in the three path down the stretch to capture the show award in the late running. MAGIC TOKEN was unhurried at the rear in the beginning, made no movement co-trailing inside at the half, was roused on the far turn making little impression on the outside, shifted out to the four path at the top of the lane and finished with interest between horses dueling for a minor role at the wire. ANITA MARGARITA was quick to take the early lead then taken back and put to rating tactics tracking in behind the leader near but off the fence, was encouraged by upper stretch, came out a bit in mid-stretch and surged past late under steady handling. JOURNEYMAN tracked the pacesetter three deep into the first turn, took closer order on the outside to hound the leader by the half, was repelled while scrubbed on to keep up at the five sixteenths pole by the frontrunner, never wavered three wide between foes with his relentless pursuit down the stretch and got up in the final few strides while being pushed out coming to the finish line. SOCIETY'S THUNDER assumed command going into the first turn, was hounded outside by the eventual winner at the half, pulled away for a clear advantage again at the five sixteenths pole, had control moving well in the two path turning for home, heard hoof steps bearing down outside with an eighth to run, drifted out under left handed encouragement late but could not fend off the tenacious winner at the wire. WYOMING BILL was allowed to settle into stride seeing the field in the early parts of this two turn race, began to reach for more ground mounting a rally going by a runner outside at the quarter pole, was in full flight six wide having a clear path at the top of the stretch, was moving the quickest down the lane but just could not get to the front pair by the time they crossed the finish line. TIZ ROMANTIC was nestled on the rail just behind the leader on the first bend, settled into a good rhythm in the second flight having the rail along the backside, was asked for more inside foes at the quarter pole to be in the conversation on the fence straightening out for home but was one paced inside horses in the final furlong to settle on the fringes in

the end. LOST ARK travelled five wide entering the first turn, improved outside to sit in mid-pack at the half, had little movement in the third pairing around the last bend, shifted out five wide between horses for the drive and ran on mildly in the last eighth of a mile making little impact at the wire. EVER DANGEROUS tracked the leader with runners on both sides in the early going, watched the front pair while outside another foe down the back straight, moved in closer shifting out three wide at the quarter marker to loom a threat outside in the four path in upper stretch, could not kick on with others and wilted by the furlong pole. COZY CURLIN KITTEN stalked close to the back of the pack in the initial turn, made no progression ahead of only one rival along the backside, was passed outside to be at the rear with a quarter mile from home and failed to fire in the three path between horses in upper stretch. OCEAN ATLANTIQUE settled near the rear in the two path inside another in the early stages, travelled on the fence in mid-division along the backside, was scrubbed on the rail but could not get involved running around the far turn and emptied out in the two path by the sixteenth pole.

JUST PRAY broke out bumping the outside runner on the break, seized control dictating the pace along the backside, quickened the tempo unopposed through the turn, shifted just off the fence in command at the top of the stretch, kept finding more when urged down the lane and just held on from the late charging rivals outside for the win at the wire. MIRAMICHI tracked the leader on the rail down the back straight, moved comfortably inside another having the fence just behind the pacesetter waiting for the cue to go on the turn, tried to shift out from behind the frontrunner down the lane but could not do so with another challenger outside holding firm battling for the lead as well, finally got a clear run with seven yards to go and surged late but missed with the late burst at the finish line between foes. I GOT MURPHED was content to track the leader outside in the early stages, had aim on the frontrunner three wide outside a rival straightening out for the drive, dueled stubbornly holding her own down the stretch gaining gradually with a furlong to go but could not get there in time narrowly losing the three way photo for the top two placings at the wire. SIL'S GAMBLE had the rail position part of the rear threesome down the backside, moved in closer taking the short way around the turn still waiting for the rider to give the signal to go, angled out three wide looking for a seam in upper stretch but was shuffled back losing position, shifted back to the fence by the eighth pole having a clear run inside for the final furlong and finished with interest to get up to win the battle for the minors in the end. TABEI stalked between horses in the back trio in the beginning, edged up well in hand between foes in the two path at the three eighths pole, shifted out five with two furlongs from home and ran on mildly losing the duel for a minor placing in

deep stretch. UNHEARD was bumped on the inside on the start trailing three deep in the beginning, improved slightly in the three path between horses by midturn, shifted out to the six path in the mix for a piece of the prize in mid-stretch by had little left late when fading outside runners in the final sixteenth of a mile. GOOD AS GONE was in midfield going four deep along the backside, kept pace outside others but was doing so going five wide around rivals through the bend, swung out widest in the seven path at the quarter pole but had nothing to offer using up too much energy taking the overland route on the turn. MY CASH FACTOR travelled in the middle of the pack in the three path between foes down the backside, watched the front three rivals while four wide still with challengers on either side in the turn running, was urged for more but was backing up at the five sixteenths pole and had no finish to give four wide down the lane.

RADIO GOO GOO was steadied sharply in the two path between horses going into the first of two turns, advanced smartly inside runners along the backstretch to sit in the third flight on the rail by the three eighths pole, waited for the cue to go on the far turn, was asked for run with a quarter mile from home having a quick turn of foot electing to go up the fence at the top of the lane and drove past rivals inside under a very savvy ride to kick on in the final seventy yards for the victory. CHERVONARUTA had a good spot drafting behind the pacesetter on the first turn, continued to sit behind the frontrunner with company on each side at the three eighths pole, was poised measuring the leader in the last bend, shifted out to make his run three wide turning for home, quickened at the furlong marker to seize command briefly with a sixteenth to run but was denied in deep stretch when slightly outkicked by the winner inside a few jumps before the finish line. ADORABLE ANGEL took this field up front going into the first turn, slowed the tempo down considerably dictating the pace along the backside, moved well in control through the far turn, was collared on both sides offering little resistance to the battling lead pair at the sixteenth pole but did fight on late to hold for the show money at the finish line. RYO AMAZING settled on the rail in the third flight on the first bend, edged up inside runners down the backside to sit behind the leader at the seven sixteenths pole, dropped back on the fence not able to hold inside position at the three eighths marker, shifted out trying to re-rally three wide at the quarter pole, angled out further with some momentum in the five path driving to the wire and finished up willingly to settle on the fringes in the end. BERTHA travelled in the three path in the middle of the pack early on, inched up on the leader along the backside, regressed at the three eighths pole, began to pick up the bit inside foes under a vigorous ride midway on the last turn, shifted just out two wide for the drive and found his best stride late coming up on the fence in the final sixteenth of a mile trying to close in for the show award at the finish line. VRANA (IRE) shadowed the leader outside in the early stages, chased the pacesetter outside another rival unable to gain through the far turn, shifted out four wide dueling for a minor share in upper stretch but faded between foes in the last sixteenth of a mile. SCAT HUMOR was second to last in the beginning having only the troubled starter beaten, made no movement inside foes along the backside, tried to start a run but had to be throttled down inside rivals at the five sixteenths pole, shifted outside in the two path turning for home looking for room, angled back to the fence by the furlong marker but lacked a rally when urged inside runners in the final furlong. FROGINAPOND stalked near the rear just off the rail, travelled outside only ahead of one runner down the back straight, regressed while going three wide on the last bend but did show some run down the stretch to pass a few weary foes in mid-stretch. DANCIN MARY MARIE had a good spot behind the leader in the two path in the first bend, pulled the rider closer three deep on the outside under a snug hold with the pace slowing down along the backside, was nudged on for more at the three eighths marker but could not hold position outside through the far turn, shortened stride four wide at the top of the lane and never switched leads to the wire. WHAT A COMPLEX travelled widest in the eight path heading into the first turn, moved up four wide around the bend, was shuffled back unable to hold position outside four deep at the half, made little headway three wide on the last turn and failed to menace in the four path in the stretch running. BUTTERFLY BILLIE stalked in midfield going seven wide between horses into the bend, was three deep having the eventual winner to his inside midway along the backstretch, dropped back between rivals on the far turn, offered a brief spurt four wide outside foes at the quarter pole, angled out seven wide again turning for home and was empty in the drive to the wire. OUT OF POVERTY was away slowly trail the group into the first of two turns, still could see the field making no progression along the back straight, could not close the gap on rivals on the last bend and galloped down the lane across the finish line never factoring at any point of the race.
