RAPTURE BAY assumed command setting a pedestrian pace up top with little pressure applied from the outside foe, continued to dictate the soft pace along the backside, was briefly challenged outside at the three-furlong marker, quickly spurted clear once again under a well rationed ride and won comfortably at the finish having plenty left in the stretch drive. MEHLEK settled on the rail part of the back trio in the beginning, co-trailed inside another along the backside, started to uncork a rally three wide between rivals with three furlongs still to run, angled out four wide finding his best stride late and closed in steadily down the lane to get the place share but could not threaten the winner who had the race all his own way. CHANCEL was content to track the pacesetter outside in the early going, moved in to duel outside on the far turn at the three eighths marker, was unable to quicken at the top of the stretch chasing the winner in vain and just got caught for the runners up share by the oncoming foe outside just before the wire. ROYAL HUDSON stalked three wide between horses near the rear in the beginning, ranged up three deep outside foes down the backside, was under a ride but could not accelerate with the front two runners at the five sixteenths pole and evened out late to settle on the fringes in the end. HELL BENT was at the back of the pack just off the fence with runners on either side going into the first of two turns, improved to be in mid-division between rivals down the backside, was hard ridden but was being passed by another foe outside making a run midway on the second bend and failed to menace in the two path down the lane. MISTER MESEEKS travelled four wide on the outside in the first bend at the rear, could see the field while outside another down the back straight, had not rally going four wide on the last turn and could not get involved in the drive to the finish line continuing on with the four wide trip. BREAK THE SPELL was hard held on the rail watching the lead two in the first turn, rated kindly on the rail in midfield along the backstretch, was roused for more inside foes at the three-furlong pole but

offered little response, backed away through the far turn and could not factor inside foes in the stretch running.

U S ARMY CORPS was nestled on the fence in the middle of the pack, shifted out beginning to reach for more ground four wide at the quarter pole, had a full head of steam outside in the five path in upper stretch and got up under a well-timed stretch rally to get his head down right at the finish line for the victory. COMPUTER HACKER broke in at the start, seized command just off the rail along the backside, shook loose up top at the three eighths marker, was comfortably in control up front in mid-stretch but could not find more late and was just caught by the surging winner outside right at the wire. MIDNIGHT ARKLE was part of the back group in the two path with rivals on each side, had a sharp turn of foot rallying at the quarter pole, skimmed the fence having

run, shifted out three wide between foes with a sixteenth from home and finished up with good energy to be a clear third while not that far off the front two at the wire as well. WHISKEY ROW prompted the pace on the outside down the back straight, made no gain outside another chasing the frontrunner in vain through the bend, still was in the hunt for a share at the top of the stretch, switched leads late but faded inside to settle for a minor share in the end. ORPHAN HALLIE settled between foes in the middle of the pack, edged up three wide at the five sixteenths pole to be four wide in the mix in upper stretch, could not find another gear down the lane and stalled by the furlong pole. MT LOGAN was in the four path in the back quintet in the early stages, offered a mild run when roused at the three furlong marker splitting foes midway on the turn, swung out widest in the six path straightening for home and finished up gradually outside foes to the wire. CELENTANO travelled three deep in midfield along the backside, made little impression while hard ridden around the bend, angled five wide turning for home but had little presence in the stretch drive. MIDNIGHT TEMPESTA had the rail while inside the group of five at the back of the pack, took the short way around the bend making little progress, angled out to the three path for the drive but had no finish to offer in the stretch running. JO DADDY moved up on the rail along the backside to press the issue inside at the half, was scrubbed on for more midway on the turn trying to hold position by the quarter pole, shifted out three wide for the drive but faltered between horses at the furlong marker. MO TOURIST stalked near the rear between rivals while in the three path in the early going, could see the field by the half and could not factor in the stretch running. GENDRAGON was brushed inside on the break, stalked five deep near the rear down the backside, began to bear out four wide midway on the turn, was eased up at the quarter pole, cantered across the finish

SAILOR'S PASSION was unhurried co-trailing on the inside along the backstretch, waited behind the embattled twosome at the five sixteenths pole, rallied in the two path with a quarter mile from home, under a well timed move burst to the front splitting foes with a sixteenth to go and just withstood the late surge from the fast closing rival outside at the wire. BACHELOR PAD co-trailed on the outside settling into stride down the backstretch, continued at the rear just off the fence throughout the turn, swung out widest having a clear run seven wide turning for home, charging outside rivals in mid-stretch and just missed at the wire with one final late surge. JUSTINTIMEFORWINE had the rail position in midfield down the backside, was under a snug hold waiting for the cue to move on the fence around the turn, shifted out posing a threat four wide in upper stretch, got his head in front for a brief moment at the sixteenth pole but could not fend off the late rallying rivals on both sides in deep stretch. WALTER ME LAD prompted the issue on the outside in the backstretch, moved in to battle outside going head-to-head around the oval, stubbornly dug in three wide between foes dueling down the lane and faded ever so slightly in deep stretch to settle on the fringes while not beaten that far for the win. TAZMAN was away alertly having the lead along the backside, dueled up top having company to his outside through the turn, bobbed heads fighting on the front end while traveling on the fence down the stretch, could not keep up late and weakened at the sixteenth pole. MAD DOG N JOE settled in the middle of the field going four deep down the back straight, stalked in the third flight outside

making little movement around the bend, shifted three wide at the quarter marker and lacked a rally on the rail in the final furlong. SECRET STORM travelled in mid-division between foes in the two path in the early stages, moved out to the five path for the stretch running, had little to give and failed to fire in the last eighth of a mile. NINETYFOUR EXPOS tracked the front pair while going three deep along the back straight, continue the three wide journey still keeping a close eye on the lead duo around the bend, angled out six wide for the drive to the wire, had little to offer down the lane and yielded by the three sixteenths pole.

STRATUS settled at the rear shifting in a bit, moved out and advanced outside rivals late up the backstretch and on the far turn going five to seven wide, struck the lead in mid-stretch, kicked clear and held sway. JUST JACOBO was positioned mid-pack four to five wide early, settled mid-pack for the run up the backstretch, was encouraged along past the five-sixteenths, fanned seven to nine wide coming into upper stretch, finished strongly to secure the place. FUN FELLA exchanged light brushing with rivals at the start, settled toward the back from outside, bided time into the far turn, moved out five wide later on that bend to commence and advance while forced out further, came into upper stretch eight to ten wide, fought on outside a rival but was unable to get past that one for the place. HOLIDAY SNOOZE was very lightly brushed at the start, tucked in to the rail entering the first turn saving ground while mid-pack, gained a bit two to three wide on the far turn finding room in upper stretch, kept on evenly. SPIRITUAL MAN settled in behind tracking inside saving ground, found room at the rail to bid at the top of the stretch, took a brief lead, lacked the needed late kick. LET'S GO LIAM was lightly brushed at the start, settled at the back tucking in, saved ground both turns, found room up the rail in the stretch, ran on evenly. RHUMBABA broke outwardly lightly brushing a rival, settled near but off the fence and off the pace, faced traffic in behind four wide coming past the quarter pole and bumping a rival, angled nine wide in upper stretch, finished willingly. MICHAELS GIFT was lightly brushed at the start, caught three to four wide through the first turn racing just off the leaders, went four to five deep on the far turn, flattened out in the stretch. SPRINGER was prominent between runners heading to the first turn but in tight and taken back while fighting the restraint, tipped out then keenly moved forward again chasing the pace from between runners and still headstrong, dropped back and faded. TEMPLE HALL moved to the lead to set the pace near but off the rail, was headed outside the half-mile marker, retook the lead a furlong or so later, faltered and faded. WOODGLEN COURT stalked not too far off the pace two to three wide, began to weaken between runners late on the far turn, was bumped and steadied at the top of the stretch, faded thereafter. NYCELY moved forward outside, pressed the early pace, took a narrow lead from about the nine-sixteenths till past the three-eighths, gave way.

UNCAPTURED MOMENT pressed the pace on the rail at the start, patiently drafted behind the leader at the half, waited to move having the rail midway on the turn, shifted out four wide looming the main threat in upper stretch, split foes to take control at the furlong pole and held safe for the win from the oncoming outside rival at the finish line. ASK IN MY NAME broke inwards on the start, had the fence while stalking only ahead of a couple of horses in the

early going, waited behind a wall of three runners on the turn, shifted out having a clear lane six wide between foes straightening out for home, stormed past runners staying on the incorrect lead down the lane and finished up smartly nonetheless to be second best at the wire. CANYOUHEARMERUNNIN had the outside tracking position sitting three deep at the half keeping close tabs on the pacesetter, kept pace with the frontrunner while in the second flight outside on the bend, was brushed inside by the eventual winner turning for home, could not match strides at the furlong pole conceding the front but still did fight on to the wire to be a clear third in the end. BRINGER OF RAIN settled in mid-division between horses, made little impact just off the rail in the two path around the bend and still remaining two wide for the drive to the wire finished up willingly in the last eighth of a mile between foes capturing a minor placing in the end. MID DAY IMAGE vied up top with runners on either side early in the backstretch, tracked the frontrunner at the half, was shuffled back slightly at the three eighths marker to sit in the third flight inside with five sixteenths still to run, had a chance for a small share three wide turning for home but evened out being one paced in the final furlong. MILITARY FORCE had a poor start to begin, recovered to sit in midfield three deep with a half mile remaining to run, settled in the third flight outside another rival through the turn, shifted out five wide in the mix for a small share at the top of the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. VALLEY VICTORY was jostled between foes on the break, recovered to sit in the middle of the pack on the fence midway down the backside, saved ground inside two others making little headway through the turn and had no finish to give inside horses running on the fence through the stretch. EMBRACE MY UNCLE was unhurried seeing the field along the backside, still was at the rear going three wide through the turn and found a little interest down the stretch to pass a couple of weary foes, picking up the one straggler right at the wire. JIMMIES BIG DAY prompted the pace on the outside at the start, edged away for a clear lead in hand at the half, quickened the pace loose up top around the bend, was collared outside in the two path at the furlong pole offering no resistance to the winner, was engulfed by rivals outside with a sixteenth to run and was not persevered with in the final seventy yards. C C'S KINGDOM had a stalking role travelling four deep on the outside ahead of only one runner down the back straight, offered a brief move picking up the bit mildly outside horses three wide in midturn, swung out widest in the seven path at the top of the lane but was empty in the stretch drive.

FLYING BLACK broke a step slow on the start, was allowed to settle into stride seeing the field in the early parts of the race, cruised around a rival getting into gear three wide at the quarter pole, shifted to the four path at the top of the stretch, switched leads finding more to surge between horses taking control at he sixteenth pole and was kept to the task late to fend off a stubborn outside foe who would not give in until the very end. SPEEDY FREEZE had a slow start on the break, stalked ahead of only the other poor starter in the early stages, made a quick move mounting a rally at the three furlong pole to circle rivals four wide on the last bend, had all the momentum outside five wide turning for home, could not match strides with the winner inside at the sixteenth pole, did try to come on again late at the wire but settled for the runners up share at the finish line. KITTEN'S ROMANCE prompted the issue outside in the first turn, tracked the new leader making an early bid at the half, was forced to move in the two path between horses at the three eighths marker, duelled with rivals on both sides on the last turn, moved clear in front two wide in mid-stretch, had no answer though when the top pair drove past at the sixteenth pole outside but did find a little bit more late to save for the show money at the wire. ZISISIT (IRE) was nestled on the rail in a good spot sitting just behind the pacesetter on the initial bend, continued the short way around on the rail in midfield along the backside, waited between foes watching the contesting trio up front around the final turn, had a clear path three wide briefly in upper stretch, was then stymied unable to make a rally behind the tiring leader at the furlong marker, finally got a seam on the fence with seventy yards remaining but could not get the show award under only mild urging in deep stretch. VOICE FROM ABOVE traveled three wide in mid-pack, moved in three wide angling in at the three furlong pole going for the lead outside horses, battled outside up top throughout the far turn but had little in reserve for the stretch run and faded between foes the last sixteenth of a mile. DESTINY RO travelled five wide on the first of two turns circling around runners, seized control continuing the run midway down the backstretch, was headed outside by two rivals at the three eighths pole, dueled inside trying to hold inside position on the last bend and gave way on the fence in the final furlong. KATHERINE'S GEM had the lead on the rail in the first turn, relinquished the front midway along the backstretch, was shuffled back in tight conceding the fence at the three-furlong pole, saved ground through the turn but was near the rear at the top of the stretch, lacked running room on the rail at the furlong pole, shifted

outside but had no finish to give.

LASTING SILENCE veered out on the break, moved to the rail from the outer post saving ground trailing down the backside, pulled the rider improving between horses at the half, patiently waited in the clustered group through the turn, shifted out seven wide at the top of the stretch gaining steadily outside foes through the lane, dueled for the lead outside while laying in at the sixteenth pole and edged away keeping a straight path under left handed encouragement in the final seventy yards. BIG BABY HENRY bobbled slightly soon after the break, moved up positions while going three wide travelling smartly between horses in midturn, loomed six wide at the quarter pole, closed in to get his head in front for a moment inside the eighth pole but could not continue on late with the winner getting the better of the battle in the final few jumps before the wire. GOLDEN TEST was loose on the lead down the back straight, rattled on up top unopposed throughout the turn, had a host of runners bearing down on him while in the two path clinging up top turning for home, gave way grudgingly to the top two rivals outside with a sixteenth from the finish but did stay on to easily best the rest for the show money. DADDY SEND MONEY had the rail position while watching the lead trio down the backside, edged up taking closer order saving all the ground around the bend, was right on the leaders heels two wide at the top of the stretch, shifted out for clear run three wide at the eighth pole and finished up evenly to be a fringe player in the end. MAGIC SLIPS travelled with runners on either side just off the fence in mid-division, was shuffled back a few spots in midturn with the field tightly bunched, could not find room to run five wide at the top of the lane and when clear in the last eighth of mile failed to fire in the late stages. FIELD HOCKEY tracked the pacesetter outside in the three path, sat just outside off the leader around the oval, bid four wide straightening out for the drive, dug in determinedly fighting to the wire but had enough and faded in the three path in the last sixteenth of a mile. MONDAY MORNING had the rail ahead of a couple of runners in the beginning, co-trailed on the inside around the bend, skimmed the fence narrowing the margin in upper stretch, shifted out in the three path with a furlong remaining but lacked a rally in deep stretch. LUMBERYARD travelled four deep in mid-pack, kept pace when roused with five sixteenths to go but was doing so while four wide on the turn, swung out widest in the nine path two furlongs from the prize but could not get into contention in the stretch drive. ARAMI'S SPEIGHSTER tracked the leader between foes early on, held position when nudged on for more with three eighths to go, was hard ridden three wide between runners with the field spread across at the quarter pole and wilted having little left at the furlong marker. RAISE A PROFIT settled near the rear outside in the beginning, co-trailed outside another going four wide at the half, shifted in three wide at the top of the lane, swung out again to the nine path with three sixteenths to go having a lane but came up empty in the late stretch running.
