IMPERIAL GOLD dictated the soft pace up front along the back straight, quickened the tempo still in hand opening up easily on the field around the bend and cruised home for the frontrunning score under very mild urging. SOUPER ZONDA pressed the early pace for a quarter, stalked the leader as that one moved clear, came into upper stretch three wide, was put to urging past the quarter pole, by mid-stretch was moving well and took charge, powered just clear then was eased up late. TEXAS HOLIDAY got away alertly, set the pace from off the rail facing outside pressure early, moved clear after the opening quarter, was urged by upper stretch, overtaken past the furlong marker and no match for the winner. BRUTALLY HONEST got away awkwardly and slowly, moved forward about three wide between foes up the backstretch, was mid-pack two to three deep through the turn into upper stretch, came out five wide in mid-stretch, ran along for show without threatening the top pair. NANTUCKETS DAY was outpaced early, began to advance late on the turn, came out six wide in upper stretch, finished up mildly. SIPPING HISTORY was quite content isolated watching the lone speed along the backstretch, measured the leader on the turn while starting to close the gap with five sixteenths to go, pounced three wide in upper stretch, opened up quickly by the furlong marker and comfortably crossed the finish line for the win. SUPERFLY CHICK was away slowly to see the field on the fence down the back straight, started to reach for more ground midway on the turn, passed a rival inside rallying at the quarter pole, angled out in the six path gathering speed at the top of the stretch and with a solid late run got up to be a non-threatening runner up showing grit after the poor start. CAPTAIN CLUTCH had the rail position in midfield down the backside, continued to save ground on the turn while scrubbed on for more at the five sixteenths pole trying to get to the front pair, rallied in the two path in upper stretch spurting away from others, could not get to the winner who was long gone, did fight on for the place share inside late but just missed holding for second money a few strides before the finish line. LAPIN DE PLAGE was in the third flight three deep on the outside down the backstretch, continued the three wide journey around the turn but was making little headway on the top two runners, shifted out five wide in the mix for a piece of the prize, was one paced in the final furlong but did pick up the leg weary frontrunner at the wire for a minor share. SOUPER SPORTY was hustled on the rail to be loose up top along the backside setting a brisk pace, continued to roll along up top on the bend but by a diminishing margin at the quarter pole, was collared outside by the winner straightening out for the drive, offered no resistance and wilted on the fence in the final seventy yards. FLEURY had runners on both sides while in the third flight in the early stages, tried to hold position between foes but was in tight leaving the quarter pole, was bumped outside in the four path turning for home and weakened on the fence with a sixteenth still to run. SPUN AROUND stalked close up from outside three wide, bid past the quarter pole, was put to urging at the top of the stretch, found a resilient competitor inside but edged away late. MCKENZIE ROAD got away alertly, set the pace inside on or just off the rail, was shadowed by a foe up the backstretch then received further pressure, was overtaken by the top of the stretch, fought on till late then yielded grudgingly but just saved the place. STARSHIP SERENITY tucked in settling toward the rear inside early, switched out up the backstretch, was relegated to the rear heading into the far turn, went three then four wide on that bend coming out a bit further for the drive, navigated traffic in the stretch moving in then out to gain show and just missed the place. TOP OF D MOUNTAIN shifted in early, was forwardly-positioned saving ground tracking inside, moved out midway on the far turn coming into upper stretch six to

seven deep, needed more. SERENADING KITTEN gained early forward position outside, stalked three to four wide, advanced starting from the three-eighths, was closer coming past the quarter pole, lacked the needed late kick ni the stretch. MIA MITOLE settled off the pace mid-division inside saving ground, was under urging three furlongs out, began to shift out shortly after, came to the quarter pole five wide, was carried seven to eight wide into upper stretch and ran on without threatening. NICKI IS A BREEZE settled between foes three wide early, switched out up the backstretch racing wide four to five deep and toward the back, failed to rally. MISS BOUJEE broke awkwardly and was taken up soon after, settled off the pace, made a mild advance inside coming into upper stretch, moved out a bit at that juncture but was soon forced in near mid-stretch, flattened out thereafter. SERIOUS LADY moved to mid-pack, stalked two to three wide, faded. TALLAWAH stumbled at the start, was caught four wide through the first turn, shifted in a bit on the far turn, failed to menace.

HIGHWAYTOTHEMOON prompted the pace outside in the beginning, moved in to poke his head in front between horses with three furlongs still to run, battled with challengers on both sides narrowly up front around the bend, continued to be hounded by a stubborn outside rival down the stretch but had plenty in reserve late to pull away in the final sixteenth. DUCKDUCK improved steadily on the outside down the backstretch, contested outside for the lead going three wide at the three eighths marker, continued to fight on outside up top around the turn, dug in determinedly going head to head for the win in upper stretch but gave way to the winner in the final sixteenth while easily beating the rest for the runners up placing. SPÉIĞHTS WILL travelled three deep near the rear, rallied three wide circling foes at the three eighths pole, shifted out widest in the five path for the drive to the wire and finished up with intent on the outside of rivals to capture the show money in deep stretch. KING RONIN was on the outside tracking the front trio at the half, kept pace chasing the lead threesome through the turn, angled out three wide with a chance for a small share turning for home and finished up willingly between horses in the final eighth of a mile to garner a minor role in the end. SILENT MORT took this field down the backside while up front on the rail, dueled inside two others for the top spot around the oval, could not quicken with the front duo by the quarter pole, battled inside for a minor share down the stretch but faded in the final seventy yards. MAKING HIS MARK broke in at the start, was throttled down to be shuffled back to last coming up to the half mile marker, made little impression taking the short way around the turn, shifted to the three path at the top of the stretch and passed tired ones down the lane. QUADZILLA was brushed inside at the start, settled near the rear between foes at the half, was asked for run with five sixteenths to go, closed the gap mildly making a move at the quarter pole but yielded between foes shortening stride staying on the incorrect lead at the furlong pole. DRI SADDLE pressed the issue early on, was reined back to draft behind the lead trio at the seven sixteenths pole, was nudged for more with three eighths from home making little headway on the fence through the turn and was in tight inside foes at the furlong pole having little to give in the late running.

OUJDA (FR) was up close tracking in behind and inside saving ground, came out five wide in upper stretch, took aim, took over past the furlong pole, moved clear and held sway. READY TO JAM brushed lightly with a foe at the start, stalked from between runners mid-pack about two to three wide, shifted seven wide in upper stretch, kicked on well but could make no headway on the winner late while clear of the rest. TICKER TAPE HOME brushed a rival just

lightly at the start, settled off the pace near the inside saving ground on the turn, came out in upper stretch then altered back to the rail in mid- to late-stretch finishing up strongly inside but was not enough. WAR COURT had an ideal set up isolated rating kindly under a snug hold behind the contesting pair in the early going, cruised up three wide at the three eighths pole, pounced three wide at the quarter pole, battled determinedly outside down the entire stretch and just prevailed from a stubborn frontrunner in a photo at the wire. SWIFT DELIVERY broke inwards brushing the gate at the start, was allowed to gather himself on the rail close to the back in the early going, made a savvy move for position splitting foes at the seven sixteenths pole, confidently cruised around horses three wide on the final bend, was set down four wide in upper stretch and drove past the leader pulling away at the furlong marker to prevail comfortably at the finish for the eye catching win. DRESDEN ROW rated kindly under a tight hold sitting just behind the leader in the first of two turns, was all alone watching the engaged trio at the half, dropped back lacking room unable to make a run at the three furlong pole while the outside runners were swooping around him on the far turn, picked up the bit when urged to go at the quarter pole three wide between horses, shifted out six wide full of run at the top of the stretch but could not get to the winner who got the jump on him turning for home. PARAMOUNT PRINCE dictated the soft pace up front taking the group into the first turn, was relegated to a tracking role at the half with another challenger making an early move outside midway down the backstretch, settled on the fence waiting for room to move while shuffled back slightly at the five sixteenths pole, angled out finding a seam four wide in mid-stretch, came with late energy at the sixteenth pole but had to settle for the third place prize at the wire. CLASSIC MO TOWN was unhurried trailing the field in the early stages on the rail, took the short way around the last turn closing the gap smartly by the quarter pole, skimmed the fence mounting a rally inside runners having a chance for a minor share by mid-stretch and finished up mildly to the wire to settle on the fringes in the end. ESSEX SERPENT shadowed the pacesetter on the outside in the beginning, tracked the new frontrunner outside another rival in the two path with a half mile remaining, edged up two wide at the five sixteenths pole, was in tight losing momentum between foes at the guarter marker, shifted out five wide with runners on each side but had to be checked slightly losing his path as well as switching back to the incorrect lead at the furlong marker but showed grit trying to come back on again when crossing the finish line. BAIL US OUT travelled in the two path in midfield on the first turn, stalked in the third flight down the backside outside the eventual winner at the half, was hard ridden making a brief move three wide at the three furlong marker to angle out widest in the seven path turning for home, drifted inwards at the eighth pole and lacked a rally in the three path in deep stretch. LAC MACAZA travelled three wide near the rear into the first turn, continued three wide circling around rivals in the initial bend, sensing the slow pace made an early move pulling the rider three deep outside foes to assume command with a half mile left to run, had the lead up top on the rail only by a diminishing advantage at the quarter pole, was collared outside by the winner straightening out for home and fought on inside until the sixteenth pole before giving way in deep stretch.

CLEARWATER BEACH stalked on the fence close to the back of the pack down the backside, inched up in the two path between foes with the field tightly bunched at the three furlong marker, made a quick move surging for a seam in the three path at the five sixteenths marker, angled out four wide in upper stretch making a bid for the lead outside with three sixteenths still left to run, dueled outside with a stubborn rival in the final furlong and edged clear for the win in the final few strides. NORTH YORK broke inwards on the start, settled in the second flight on the rail keeping a close eye on the lead pair down the backside, held her own when nudged along saving ground through the turn, was in the thick of things in the two path at the top of the lane, poked her head in front for a brief moment at the furlong marker inside rivals, did not switch leads down the stretch, gave way to the surging winner outside late and was checked on the fence at the wire to be second best on this day. WONDERLAND broke out on the start, seized command inside down the backstretch, was unopposed setting a brisk pace still in hand though around the turn, remained in control three wide entering the stretch, gave way to the swarming rivals on either side at the furlong marker but did fight on to save the show money at the finish line. ORIENT BEACH was under a snug hold in the middle of the pack having the rail, patiently waited for the cue to move on the fence behind runners through the turn, shifted to the two path for the drive to the wire, drifted out under left-handed encouragement at the furlong marker and finished with interest between horses to settle on the fringes in the end. AFLEET FLATTER was in the second flight on the outside of another while tracking the leader in the early stages, was urged for more making a rally at the five sixteenths pole to be in the mix five wide in upper stretch, could not find another gear down the lane and finished up one paced losing the duel for a minor share outside. QUALITY PRESENCE settled near the back of the field between horses in the early stages, came under a vigorous ride at the three furlong marker to rally in the two path closing the gap smartly turning for home, could not sustain the run down the stretch and stalled on the fence at the furlong pole. PRINCESS JADE travelled in midfield in the two path with runners on each side, was nudged along narrowing the margin on the leader by the three eighths pole, was checked in tight quarters going for the same seam with eventual winner at the five sixteenths pole, angled out six wide at the top of the stretch and finished up mildly unable to threaten in the late stages. BELLA CLASSICA stalked close to the back of the pack in the three path between runners in the beginning, made little progress three wide outside rivals under a ride around the bend, shifted to the four path at the top of the lane but failed to menace in the drive to the wire. RESORT FEE was forced out being bumped inside on the break to co-trail on the inside down the backstretch, took the short way around the turn making little movement, stayed inside on the rail at the top of the lane but could not get into contention in the final furlong. TAP MY DESIRE travelled in mid-pack three deep, kept pace with rivals still three wide with challengers on either side on the bend, was checked losing her path when pushed out eight wide by the inside rival straightening out for home and could not get involved in the late running. VIVECA had a stalking role outside four deep down the back straight, had one rival beaten making little impact around the oval, shifted three wide at the quarter pole but made little presence in the drive to the wire. LADY IONA was pinballed between horses on the break to co-trail on the outside with the other troubled starter, could see the field on the turn, had a brief move trying to rally three wide outside rivals at the three eighths pole, swung out widest in the ten path for the drive but could not factor in the stretch running. SUNLIT pressed the issue on the outside down the backstretch, chased the frontrunner that was setting an even but fast tempo around the turn, was hard ridden in the four path between foes at the top of the stretch, drifted out getting leg weary with three sixteenths still left to run and folded in the final eighth of a mile. ONEHOTMESS rated in mid-division going four deep outside foes along the back straight, travelled four wide on the turn unable to keep up to runners by the three furlong pole, shifted out eight wide with a quarter mile from home but had nothing to offer in the stretch drive.
