## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

SOUPER ZONDA pressed the early pace for a quarter, stalked the leader as that one moved clear, came into upper stretch three wide, was put to urging past the quarter pole, by mid-stretch was moving well and took charge, powered just clear then was eased up late. TEXAS HOLIDAY got away alertly, set the pace from off the rail facing outside pressure early, moved clear after the opening quarter, was urged by upper stretch, overtaken past the furlong marker and no match for the winner. BRUTALLY HONEST got away awkwardly and slowly, moved forward about three wide between foes up the backstretch, was mid-pack two to three deep through the turn into upper stretch, came out five wide in mid-stretch, ran along for show without threatening the top pair. NANTUCKETS DAY was outpaced early, began to advance late on the turn, came out six wide in upper stretch, finished up mildly. WORKOUT AFFAIR moved forward inside tracking the pace, loomed a threat up the rail in upper stretch but soon faltered and faded. MY GIRL DELLA lacked early speed despite some encouragement up the backstretch, swung five wide turning for home moving out a couple paths soon after, was never near enough to threaten. SPEAK UP chased from inside, was encouraged a bit on the turn but was outrun. CRYSTALAIRE (GB) stalked outside mostly three wide early and a path wider in upper stretch, dropped back and faded. STREET PRINCESS settled outside three wide into the turn, moved out four to five wide for the drive, faded.
