QUIET VISTA had the inside route tracking the front duo in the early going, improved slightly to sit on the fence in mid-pack along the backside, was moving comfortably edging up the rail in hand through the far turn, shifted out three wide gathering speed in upper stretch and grinded away in the final furlong to get up for the win just before the wire. MOTION GRANTED was intent on getting the front being encouraged right-handed a couple of times setting a brisk pace on the lead into the first bend, slowed the pace down considerably bunching up the compact field at the half, was under a vigorous ride holding the diminishing lead around the last turn, kept on finding more inside by mid-stretch clinging up top but was just caught in the last few jumps for the win. ETHNIC SOUL was unhurried lagging behind the field in the beginning, narrowed the margin on the frontrunner but could not improve position with the second split slowing down considerably down the backstretch, was hard ridden on the final bend to start to make a rally at the quarter pole, split foes four wide at the top of the stretch finding his best stride late and closed in right at the wire to capture the show money. CATCH A TIGER was content to sit just back and outside the frontrunner who was sent for the lead in the first turn, settled into stride outside measuring the pacesetter along the backstretch, ranged up closing in smartly on the leader through the far turn, loomed three menacingly three wide in upper stretch, could not get by the stubborn rival still digging in up front at the furlong marker and faded in the final seventy yards losing a couple of placings late to settle for a minor role in the end. COMPTON was on the outside in the second flight with the field strung out going into the first turn, stalked near the rear three deep along the backside, made little headway outside of horses on the last turn, angled out widest in the five path turning for home but had had no finish outside rivals in the stretch drive.

HEY CUE broke sharp having the lead inside in the beginning, was reined back letting the pacesetter go while shifting outside into the backstretch, began to move in at the three eighths pole, glided right past the leader seizing total control at the quarter pole and coasted home for the win uncontested through the lane. MANNIX (IRE) was allowed to settle outside of horses in midfield down the backside, inched up on the outside of a rival in the second flight around the bend, swung out widest in the five path posing a threat briefly in upper stretch, chased the winner in vain by the furlong marker and bested the rest late winning the battle for the runners up position in the final seventy yads. WILBERFORCE was under a good hold watching the lead pair down the back straight, edged up just off the fence trying to get to the lead duo at the quarter pole, shifted out three wide in the hunt turning for home, was no match for the winner by the furlong pole, dueled inside for the secondary share in deep stretch but was denied in the final seventy yards. WINSTON BLUE clipped the inside rivals heels stumbling on the start to co-trail inside another down the backside, closed the gap at the half while on the rail, made little progression when roused on the turn, shifted out to the two path and finished up mildly between horses to settle on the fringes in the end. KID FORESTER was bumped on the inside from the troubled starter on the break to co-trail outside of that one down the backstretch, could see the field at the half, offered a mild rally when asked right-handed picking up the bit at the quarter pole, angled out to the four path at the top of the lane but could not get involved in the stretch running. CLASSIC DANCER broke outwards on the start, dictated terms on the fence along the backside, continued up front but by a diminishing margin halfway around the bend, surrendered the lead on the fence offering no resistance at the quarter pole and folded inside rival by the furlong marker.

POSTURING broke a step slow at the start, improved going three wide around the first of two bends, settled outside three deep in mid-division moving well, was nudged to go three wide at the five sixteenths pole starting to reach for more ground, loomed boldly outside four wide in upper stretch and won going away when crossing the finish line. ADAPTED became antsy in the stall prior to the start, was hustled right from the break to take this field inside going into the first turn, continued up top down the backside with little pressure while setting a soft pace, was collared outside relinquishing the lead on the fence by the quarter pole, dug in stubbornly on the inside of challengers straightening out for home, could not quicken with the winner in mid-stretch but did fight on to easily be second best on this day at the wire. PROUD RONIN tracked the pacesetter outside in the first turn, rated kindly keeping a close eye on the leader outside down the backstretch, moved in to bid on the turn poking his head in front with a quarter mile remaining, battled with rivals on each side while three wide straightening out home but was unable to match strides late holding for the show award at the finish. BRAVO KATE was nestled on the rail behind the frontrunner in the early going, travelled well in hand on the fence in mid-pack down the backside, kept pace while inside in the second flight through the far turn, shifted out four wide for the drive but could not keep up to the front trio in upper stretch and finished up mildly to hold for a minor role in the end. JAY BIRD was unhurried on the rail at the rear in the early stages, co-trailed on the inside at the half, was scrubbed on the fence making little impact around the final bend, shifted out four wide in upper stretch and showed late interest dueling outside for a minor share. DREAMS AND SCHEMES travelled between horses in midfield on the initial turn, had company inside while at the back of the pack down the backstretch, made little impression outside another foe around the last turn and could not offer a finish angling out five wide in the stretch run.

JUST A GEM assumed command setting a pokey pace on the first turn, continued loose on the lead rationing out the speed or lack thereof down the backside, still remained up top narrowly on the rail through the far turn, shifted out two wide clinging to the lead with a couple of challengers bearing down in upper stretch, kept finding more down the lane, drifted out late under left handed encouragement but tenaciously prevailed at the finish line. ENGLISH JUBILEE was content to sit just off the leader in the early going, hounded the pace outside down the back straight, moved in to vie between horses on the far turn, battled determinedly with horses on either side through the stretch never wavering, was in tight driving in deep stretch but was denied in a photo at the wire. POETIC AMY travelled three wide watching the leader in the first turn, continued to be three deep measuring the frontrunner outside down the backside, moved in to duel three wide outside throughout the last turn, shifted to the four path in the thick of things up top entering the stretch but needed more late when losing the three way photo for the win. DESIGN DIVA travelled on the fence at the back of the pack, lagged behind the group down the backstretch, could not really make any headway on the last turn, shifted three wide at the top of the stretch starting to get into gear late and closed in smartly in the final furlong but switched back to the incorrect lead just before the wire to be a fringe player in the end. NIKITA'S GEM stalked on the rail in the early stages, made little movement between foes along the backside, was part of the second flight trio still between runners on the last turn, shifted out four wide in upper stretch but could only finish up one paced in the late going. MAXINE MAGIC was tucked in on the fence behind the pacesetter on the first turn, settled into a good rhythm on the rail in midfield along the backside, waited to move while inside runners watching the engaged threesome through the

far turn, skimmed the fence to have a clear path in with a chance at the top of the lane but failed to fire in the late stages. HOLIDAY ROSE settled near the rear on the outside in the beginning, made no progression three deep on the outside along the backstretch, offered a mild run when urged for more three wide from the three eighths pole under the quarter marker outside rivals, angled out in the five-path turning for home but came up empty in the stretch running.

WESTSIDE TIDE settled mid-pack near but off the fence, swung five to six wide turning for home, ground on steadily to take the lead a sixteenth out, moved clear and held. HAMMERHEAD broke a step slowly, made a mild early advance near inside to race with the field but in the back half, shifted out past the five-sixteenths, came into upper stretch six wide, was lugging in through mid- to late-stretch while rallying but could continue to gain while trying to straighten

out and settled for second best. THUNDERING stalked then rapidly advanced at the half four then three wide momentarily applying pressure, found the leader get away then moved again to challenge dueling for the lead at the three-eighths, put a short head in front, continued to battle through the stretch, was no match for the top two who ran by outside but kept on to hold show honors. WALKING IN MEMPHIS was quickly to the lead and clear, set the pace near the inside, faced pressure at the half but promptly moved away again, was rejoined by the same foe at the three-eighths and dueled in earnest, was headed but fought on inside although lacked the needed late kick. ENGLISH ACTOR was coaxed forward then immediately put to a halt wrangled back off the leader to track from inside, dropped back along the rail through the turn, kept on late coming out and rallying between foes for minor prizes but was not enough. CAPTAIN JUNUH chased mid-pack three to four wide, failed to rally. FLIRTING WITH FIRE stalked early three wide, weakened. THORNBURY lacked early speed, was forced out six wide into the turn, shifted in a bit later on that bend, came out in the stretch, failed to menace but improved position passing tired rivals. LOST STAR was in behind runners early keen to go on but blocked and fought restraint having to steady at the six- and one-half and again a furlong later, altered out five wide entering the turn, shifted back in to the three path having gotten clear of trouble, failed to rally thereafter. ALPHA KADIN chased mid-pack outside four wide through the turn, dropped back and faded. ARISTOTLE was briefly mid-pack outside but soon dropped back, was forced seven wide into the turn, never got near enough to threaten.

HUMBER RIVER broke in at the start, was pushed out four wide in the front group on the first bend, was four deep in the middle of the pack outside foes along the backside, ranged up still having a four wide journey on the last turn closing the gap and in the four path kept on finding more to edge away for the win in deep stretch. GOTME GOOD had the rail watching the lead quartet on the initial turn, drafted just behind the frontrunner at the half, kept pace saving ground at the five sixteenths pole, scarped paint to be in the mix in upper stretch, could not get to the winner in the final furlong but did continue on smartly to best the rest at the wire. BOWMAN'S RUN was going four wide outside runners in the tracking group on the first bend, settled into stride near the rear down the back straight, mounted a rally four wide with a quarter mile to run to be full in flight five wide turning for home, could not sustain the run never switching leads and stalled in the final furlong to settle for the show award in the end. PRIVATE LABEL tracked the pacesetter between runners, pressed the issue with runners on each side down the backstretch, duelled outside midway on the final turn, remained in the hunt three wide between rivals

straightening out for the drive but needed more when fading in deep stretch to settle for a minor placing at the wire. GOOD KING SAM advanced on the rail utilizing the inside post to take this field into the first turn, had a slim advantage on the fence along the backside, bobbed heads dueling up top inside around the last turn, stayed on the incorrect lead two wide fighting on the front end in mid-stretch but could not continue on late and wilted in the final seventy yards. TIMES A BREEZE had a slow start to trail the field in the early going, stalked near the rear under a snug hold down the backside, was shuffled back to be last at the quarter pole and while in the five path passed a couple of weary runners down the stretch. WESTMINSTER was in tight on the break, recovered to prompt the pace three wide on the outside, shadowed the leader outside three deep at the half, bid for the lead three wide with three eights to go, could not keep up to the front duo by the five sixteenths under urging and tired in the three path in upper stretch. SILVER RALEIGH travelled in the two path in the middle of the pack for the early parts of the race, came under a ride trying to hold position between foes at the quarter pole, had little left for the drive and folded inside horses down the stretch. GRAFFITI WRITER travelled three wide between horses in the lead flight on the first turn, settled in midfield three deep along the backside, was urged for more midway on the final bend but was going the wrong way by the quarter pole and emptied out in the six path turning for home.

MY GIRL SKY had the fence watching the lead trio into the first turn, stalked in the third flight on the inside down the backstretch, edged up the rail behind the contesting duo at the quarter pole under a hand ride, shifted out four wide midway down the lane gathering speed and with a late surge in the final sixteenth of a mile got up for the win on the outside in the last few jumps. AMERICAN WOMEN was eager fighting the rider while up top after the start, settled down content on tracking the loose front end pacesetter down the backstretch, closed in confidently outside around the final bend, took control outside in the three path at the top of the lane, drifted in driving through the lane in mid-stretch but could not fend off the late charge by the winner in the shadow of the wire. WAR PAINTER was unhurried at the back of the pack for the first half of the race, started to pick up the bit when scrubbed between foes with five sixteenths to go, shifted out five wide turning for home and finished dup mildly to be a non-threatening third in the end. BOLT ENOREE pressed between horses in the beginning, settled into a good rhythm in the third flight down the back straight, moved up three wide lengthening her stride at the quarter pole posing a threat with furlong from home, could not continue on late stalling with a sixteenth to run and was checked nearing the wire to hold for the minors. BEACH READY pressed the pace outside three wide heading into the first turn, kept on advancing around the bend to seize command loose up

top along the backside, continued to roll along by the half, still had the lead inside on the far turn but by a diminishing margin at the quarter pole, was collared outside turning for home and could only finish up evenly in the final furlong. MIZZEN ASH had an outside stalking role ahead of only one runner in the early stages, dropped back to last unable to quicken with others making a move at the quarter pole, angled out six wide for the drive but could not factor in the late running.

BOREALIS TRAIL settled in mid-division just off the fence along the backside, galloped along relaxed in the third tier inside foes waiting for the cue to go,

shifted out four wide at the quarter pole reaching for more ground, angled out further coming with a sharp turn of foot at the furlong marker in the six path and stormed past for the win in the final seventy yards. PERFECTWORKS broke out on the break, pressed inside in the early going, darted up the rail to assume command with five eighths still to go, continued up top on the rail by a narrow margin around the turn, spurted away from his pursuer two wide straightening out for the drive, moved strong down the lane but just could not find enough in deep stretch to fend off the late burst by the winner in the final seventy yards. MO' SPRESSO prompted the pace three deep early on, took back to watch the front two at the five furlong pole, moved comfortably tracking the lead pair outside around the bend, began to make a run four wide turning for home closing between rivals, could not accelerate with the winner charging outside in the final sixteenth but finished up determinedly trying to get into second money late but having to settle for third place instead at the wire. KING ROSSO was away alertly on the start, dropped back outside horses through the backstretch to stalk only ahead of one rival at the five eighths marker, made no progression on the turn co-trailing inside at the five sixteenths pole, tried to begin a rally two wide at the quarter pole but traded bumps with the outside runner in upper stretch, shifted out in the five path at the furlong marker finding his best stride and finished up willingly to settle on the fringes. TRIP ACES stalked close to the back ahead of only two rivals in the early stages, lacked running room in the two path between rivals around the turn making no progression, shifted out five wide at the top of the lane having a clear path but could only finish up gradually in the stretch never reaching contention in the late running. ACCELERANDO broke in on the start, tussled for the front between foes in the beginning, tracked the frontrunner outside at the five furlong pole, moved in to hound the pacesetter outside through the turn, chased on the rail when urged in upper stretch in the hunt for a piece of the prize but faded on the fence in the last sixteenth of a mile. PROUDLY HAILED (GB) was in the mix in the five path up front after the break, was checked losing momentum for a few strides around the seven eighths pole, settled in the second flight in the three path between horses down the backside, travelled three wide in midfield on the turn, was shuffled back at the five sixteenths pole, exchanged bumps with the inside foes three wide leaving the quarter pole and failed to menace in the stretch drive. HELLO STRANGER was void of any early speed trailing along the backside, still remained at the back of the pack around the turn, swung out widest in the eight path in upper stretch but managed to pass a few tired runners down the lane. MOPHARRA broke in at the break, stalked ahead of only one rival while on the fence along the backside, took the short way on the turn going in hand, edged up by the five sixteenths pole, skimmed the fence turning for home, shifted out three wide for clear run at the three sixteenths pole but failed to offer a finishing rally inside foes in the final furlong. KAMASI was squeezed at the start to be at the rear leaving the gate, advanced quickly inside horses down the backstretch to draft behind the frontrunner at the five eighths pole, had the rail in the second flight holding position through the turn, shifted to the two path entering the long stretch, could not find another gear and folded inside runners at the furlong marker. GLOBETROTTING was bumped inside on the start, recovered to watch the lead trio while going three deep along the backside, kept pace in the second flight three wide on the bend, was urged for more right handed at the five sixteenth pole but was going in the wrong direction and faltered in the six path at the top of the lane between runners. NAUGHTY FROSTY settled in the middle of the pack four deep midway down the back straight, travelled four wide outside horses under a ride finding it hard to keep up with inside rivals by the three eighths pole, shifted out to the seven path for the drive to the wire but had no more to give between runners by the furlong pole.
