QUIET MADDELENA was hustled from the outer post to get a clear advantage on the fence by the half, rolled along on the turn but was briefly headed outside with a quarter mile to run, had more when repelling the outside challenger by the furlong pole and won going away in deep stretch. IMA BEAST was away alertly up top after the break, rated kindly behind the pacesetter with a half mile to run, moved in to bid outside at the quarter pole, could not quicken with the winner who had something left in reserve for the drive midway down the lane and just saved for the place share in a tight photo when crossing the finish line. QUANDALE had a good spot all alone watching the engaged duo, was nudged at the five sixteenths pole starting to creep closer to the embattled pair at the quarter pole to be in the thick of things three wide between foes at the top of the stretch, drifted inwards slightly driving to the wire dueling up front outside at the seventy yard pole and just inched away coming up to the finish line for the hard fought stretch win. BREEZERO was content to draft behind the pacesetter down the backside, waited while inside another on the turn for the cue to go moving comfortably, shifted out in the two path having clear run at the top of the lane, powered past taking control at the furlong marker and impressively increased the winning margin when crossing the finish line. EMPTY GESTURE was unhurried co-trailing on the inside down the backstretch, shifted out mounting a rally at the five sixteenths pole, swung out widest with a full head of steam in the five path in upper stretch having aim on the lead trio and surged outside picking up rivals one by one to the wire and under a well-timed stretch rally got up for the win in the final jump. OL' BLONDIE had a nice set-up all alone watching the contesting twosome, edged up just off the fence to the lead pair on the turn, shifted out four wide straightening out for the drive to pose a threat by the furlong marker, seized control between foes with a sixteenth from the wire but could not fend of the late charge by the winner just getting nabbed at the finish line for the win. SOUPER SUNDAY shadowed the pace on the outside in the early going, dueled determinedly outside around the turn, dug in by mid-stretch to poke her head in front briefly between horses with a furlong from home but was no match for the closing in outside rivals in the final sixteenth of a mile and comfortably held for the show prize in the end. FOREST B had a slim lead inside down the back straight, battled stubbornly inside through the running around the bend, narrowly still had the lead inside at the top on the stretch in the two path, could not continue on with the outside rivals charging late and faded in the final eighth of mile to settle on the fringes. I'M INTO MISCHIEF co-trailed on the outside in the early going down the backstretch, was hard ridden outside another but was backing up midway on the turn, shifted out four wide for the stretch drive, was eased up by the furlong pole and left via equine ambulance.

MIGHT BEE TROUBLE was unhurried while second to last ahead of only the slow starter down the back straight, darted between horses making a move at the five sixteenths pole, swung out five wide reaching for more ground turning for home, kept on coming down the lane while staying on the incorrect lead, nevertheless grinded away and edged clear for the win outside in the final seventy yards. CHEAT THE DEVIL had a tracking role inside another foe down the back straight, was scrubbed on keeping pace with the frontrunner on the turn, shifted out two wide having a clear run at the top of the lane, kept on coming down the stretch, could not match strides with the winner in the final seventy yards but did still run on late to be second best at the finish line. FEATHERWEIGHT took this field up front on the fence down the backside, increased the advantage up top throughout the turn, was clinging onto the lead with rivals closing in with a furlong to run and faded in deep stretch inside rivals to just hold for the third money at the wire. JUICY HANNA was away slowly seeing the field along the backside, lagged well behind through the turn, shifted out at the quarter pole with a quick turn of foot to burst between rivals four wide straightening out for home and found her best stride late, full of run on the fence in the final furlong trying to get up for the show position at the wire. SKY DIVINE hopped on the break, recovered quickly to track the frontrunner outside down the backside, chased the leader but to no avail outside another around the bend, shifted out three wide for the drive, did not switch leads down the lane dueling for a minor share and shortened stride tiring in the last sixteenth of a mile. SHE'S SO CROATIAN broke in at the start, sat alone watching the front three challengers along the backside, was roused on the turn but could not gain on the lead threesome on the bend, shifted out four wide in the conversation for a piece of the prize in upper stretch but evened out in the final furlong. SECRET PLAN settled on the rail in the middle of the pack down the backstretch, was asked for more on the turn but had little to offer by the five sixteenths pole and could not get involved in the two path driving to the finish line down the stretch. HYPER HOLIDAY stalked close to the back on the inside ahead of a few runners along the backside, made little progression three wide around the oval, shifted out to the six path in upper stretch but failed to menace in the stretch running. IMPERIAL TRICK was fractious prior to the start unseating the rider and running off briefly in the chute, broke sharp to have the lead after the break, dropped back along the backstretch to sit three deep near the rear by the half, travelled four wide around the turn regressing at the quarter pole, was pushed out seven wide at the top of the lane and had little to give outside rivals down the lane.
