SNOOKERED had the rail position watching the lead three contest the pace on the first turn, moved up travelling smartly in hand at the half mile marker through the backstretch, shifted out at the five sixteenths pole continuing the rally coming after the frontrunner, pounced outside with a quarter mile to run, never switched leads down the lane but still determinedly fought on to edge away for the win in the last seventy yards. WAR IN CHARGE had a slim lead on the rail into the first bend, continued up top quickening the tempo slightly along the backstretch, opened up to increase the advantage at the three furlong pole, had company outside with a quarter mile from home, dug in stubbornly inside fighting down the lane but faded a touch to the winner in deep stretch to settle for the runners up share at the finish line. KIKITSA seized command at the start angling in to get to the rail up top by the half, was well in hand comfortably up front while shadowed outside through the turn, was finally let loose spurting away from challengers at the top of the stretch and was kept to the task to the wire to hold safe for the frontrunning score at the finish line. CYMBAL COURT settled between runners in midfield at the half, travelled in the second flight with runners on either side watching the front pair midway around the turn, angled out four wide finding her best stride down the lane, could not get to the winner in the final furlong but did close in belatedly to win the secondary battle outside with seventy yards to go. REALLY THIRSTY had a tracking role on the outside in the early going, took closer order to hound the pacesetter outside around the bend, was still in the thick of things three wide straightening out for home but faded inside foes in the last sixteenth to hold for the show money in the end. PRIMA broke out on the start, bounced off the rail when angling in soon after the break, then was steadied sharply in tight with the field shifting in after the first sixteenth of a mile, lagged well behind at the half after the incident down the backside, started to close the gap on runners when nudged for more midway on the turn and had some late energy in the final furlong to get up for a minor role at the wire. WORLD SHOWCASE was one of a few who were checked in tight quarters at the nine sixteenths pole soon after the break, travelled three deep on the outside near the rear at the half, tried to circle around horses moving three wide on the turn, angled out to the four path but had little left for the stretch running outside runners at the top of the lane. SHOOTIN' AMY was in tight with the field crowding together at the nine sixteenths pole, recovered to nestle behind the pacesetter going into the turn, took the short way around following the leader through the turn, shifted just out in the two path having a chance for a piec

BACKONTHECHAINGANG was under a tight hold early along the inside just off the leaders, saved ground on the turn biding time, bid up the rail past the furlong marker, took a narrow lead in deep stretch and prevailed. RED PHARAOH stalked from outside going five wide into the turn, dropped back a bit early on that bend, allowed a rival to come up inside, was forced out and bumped by that one turning for home, bid near the eighth pole, kept on but was outfinished. CRUCIAL TAUNT settled outside at the rear, began to advance moving out from three wide late on the turn, fanned five to six deep between foes turning for home and bumped the outer rival at that juncture, ran on but needed more. BENNYS JETS set a pressured pace near the rail, was challenged in earnest by outside foes coming past the quarter pole, shook clear coming into upper stretch, was challenged in mid-stretch and weakened. DONTGOBACKONURWORD pressed from between foes two to three wide into the turn, made a mild bid under urging at the quarter pole, lugged out a path turning for home, weakened in the stretch. MAGIC POWER was forwardly-positioned pressing three to four wide between foes, moved closer to contend for the lead coming to the quarter pole, floated out a bit turning for home, faded.

WAGSTAFF was unhurried on the fence at the rear well within range of the leader down the back straight, rated kindly galloping along under a good rhythm just off the rail keeping a close eye on the pacesetter around the bend, made a sharp move with a quick turn of foot bursting between horses with three sixteenths still to run getting into contention, had aim on the frontrunner shifting out to the three path at the furlong pole and was gaining with every stride in deep stretch to drive past for the win coming up to the finish line. CLASSY WAR assumed command just off the fence setting a moderate pace down the backside, continued unopposed up top while quickening the tempo in the running around the bend, opened up turning for home moving well, was kept to the task at the furlong pole hearing hoofbeats bearing down on the outside but could not find something in reserve in deep stretch to hold off the winner nearing the finish line. CHURCH AND STATE travelled three deep clear of rivals on the outside watching the front two along the backstretch, inched up three wide outside foes throughout the turn, swung out widest in the four-path posing the main threat at the top of the lane but could not kick on with the leaders in the final furlong and held for a non-threating third at the wire. GARDEN OF WAR was hard held on the rail content to let the stablemate dictate the pace early down the backstretch, moved in closer to apply mild pressure inside from the five eights marker to the half, continued on the fence watching the frontrunner around the turn waiting for the cue to go, was in tight inside rivals leaving the quarter pole, could not quicken in time with the outside challengers who were making a rally and was unable to hold inside position being shuffled back to last with three sixteenths to run, shifted out three wide with a furlong from home having clear lane but offered little finish in the late running.

MAY AND JUNE was forced out still seizing control from the onset, dictated terms unchallenged at the half, improved the advantage rolling along smoothly in hand throughout the turn, was well in front turning for home and was kept to the task to comfortably hold sway for the front-running tally. PIN BOY settled on the outside of a runner in the third tier midway down the backside, was urged for more with five sixteenths to go, picked up the bit to split rivals having run three wide at the quarter pole, angled out in the five path between foes at the top of the lane, kept on coming through the stretch closing the gap on the leader who had built up an insurmountable lead by mid-stretch and easily bested the rest for the runners up placing when the dust settled. DEVIL'S TONGUE stalked in the third flight inside another at the half, made a brief move midway on the turn to move up to the second position, shifted out four wide with the winner long gone in upper stretch and finished up mildly inside rivals to hold for the show award at the wire. HELLO JELLO tracked just outside the

leader at the half, chased the frontrunner but to no avail between horses on the turn, was pushed out six wide by the inside rival making a move straightening out for home and was one paced staying on the incorrect lead down the lane to the wire to settle for a minor placing in the end. DROGON broke out on the start, tracked the pacesetter going three deep along the backside, was going the wrong way retreating three wide midway around the turn and failed to menace in the three path in the stretch running. HATRIXIE MOMENT stalked three deep on the outside ahead of only the poor starter down the back straight, made no progression on rivals travelling two wide going around the bend and could not factor inside in the stretch drive. INSTAMATICAL dwelt then veered in when finally leaving the gate to trail by many along the backside and could not recover through the running of the race to be involved in the late stages.
