NICKI IS A BREEZE travelled three wide in mid-pack early on, galloped along keeping a close eye on the lead twosome down the backside, crept up outside rivals narrowing the margin by the half, moved in three wide at the three-furlong marker to bid for the lead with a quarter mile remaining, began to draw off with a furlong from home and won going away under a hand ride. DAISYCREST rated kindly watching the lone speed into the first of two turns, began to whittle away on the lead at the half mile pole, moved in between rivals to assume control leaving the three furlong pole, had company outside with a quarter mile to run, dug in on the fence fighting back inside until the furlong marker, could not go with the winner late but easily bested the rest for the runners up share at the finish. BLACK GODDESS settled on the rail near the rear in the early stages, co-trailed inside down the backstretch, took the short way around the far turn keeping pace with others, angled out coming up to tired runners three wide splitting horses straightening out for home and finished up mildly through the lane to be a distant third at the wire. CONQUER THE STORM was unhurried trailing the field into the first turn, shifted outside to co-trail with an inside foe down the back straight, was hard ridden outside rivals closing the gap at the three eighths pole, could not threaten the lead duo at the top of the stretch shifting out four wide and finished up one paced outside challengers to garner a minor share in the end. LA RONDE settled in midfield between horses early on, stalked ahead of a couple of rivals narrowing the margin along the backstretch, came under a ride but could not keep up to the front two who had the race to themselves at the quarter pole, dueled for the show award with horses on either side while two wide turning for home but wilted on the fence at the sixteenth pole. ANNIA CORNIFICIA F took advantage of the rail post to take this field into the first turn, was loose up top setting an even pace along the backstretch,

GATHER was allowed to settle at the back outside runners, travelled three wide outside another seeing the field on the turn comfortably keeping pace with rivals, shifted out widest in the five path having a clear lane for the drive to the wire, was gaining steadily down the stretch, moved in by the eighth pole dueling for the front and drew off with authority in the last sixteenth for the stretch running score. PRINCESSONAMISSION settled between horses watching the pacesetter down the backstretch, edged up closing the gap on the leader outside through the bend, shifted out three wide in the thick of things having rivals on both sides in upper stretch, battled up top with a furlong to go but was outkicked by the winner in the late stages settling for the runner up finish in the end. DANCETOTHERHYTHM pressed the issue inside after the break, dropped back to sit in mid-division on the fence around the bend, took closer order on the rail just behind the frontrunner to be in the conversation turning for home, shifted out off the tiring early leader three wide with a furlong from home and finished up willingly to capture the show money in deep stretch. PRETTY GOOD JOKE hopped then bobbled on the break, quickly recovered to have a clear lead outside by the five eighths pole, tugged the rider along unopposed through the turn, moved well up front just off the fence turning for home, had company bearing down outside nearing the furlong pole, could not find more late and faded inside horses in the last sixteenth of a mile to settle on the fringes. NOW IS A BREEZE stalked close to the back of the pack in the early going, co-trailed inside with the eventual winner making little headway around the bend, shifted out to the two path for the stretch run but failed to fire through the lane. COMPLEX SECRET tracked the pacesetter three deep on the outside down the back straight, travelled three wide still taking the overland route on the turn but was moving in closer by the three eighths pole, shifted out four wide between rivals in the mix at the top of the lane but had little left by mid-stretch.

HOULIHAN rated kindly in the second flight on the outside down the backstretch, improved smartly three wide closing in on the leader around the bend, loomed outside in the five path in upper stretch and wore down the two inside challengers down the lane to edge away for the victory in the final seventy yards. KIMBERLINA forced the issue inside in the beginning, let the pacesetter go ahead at the half still keeping a close eye on that rival, travelled inside the winner in the second flight around the bend inching up by the quarter pole, shifted four wide between foes turning for home, vied for the lead at the furlong pole, kept on trying until the end but needed just a bit more late to threaten the winner at the wire. TENTOMIDNIGHT broke in at the start, had a slim lead on the outside in the early going, shook clear by the half, rolled along unchallenged around the oval, still was up top but clinging onto the lead inside three wide by mid-stretch, could not find something in reserve for the late running and gave way up top in the final sixteenth of a mile to hold for the show award at the wire. POOKIESLOOKINGFIRE was pushed in on the break, stalked close to the back having a couple of runners beaten down the backside, improved mildly advancing outside passing a foe at the five sixteenths pole, angled out five wide with a chance for a piece of the prize straightening for home and finished up evenly to be on the fringes in the end. UNCARRICK TERISTIC had a poor start to trail the field by many along the backside, caught up to a runner inside by the three furlong pole and finished up with good late energy in the final furlong reaching for more ground almost getting up for a minor share at the wire. COUNTRY DOLLY settled in the second flight on the inside in the beginning, was scrubbed on for more but was being passed on the outside by another in midturn, shifted to the two path for the drive to the wire but had little to offer and yielded between horses in the final sixteenth of a mile. KOZY BABE stalked on the out

PICKFORD SWEET was hard held behind the leader who was slowing the pace down into the first turn, settled into stride in midfield well in hand in range of the lead trio down the backside, waited inside foes behind the embattled duo with five sixteenths to go, found a seam and quickly shot through three wide at the top of the stretch and under a busy ride with left handed encouragement got up in the final few jumps for the win. ALL FOR HONOR went three wide on the outside of horses in midfield entering the first turn, continued on circling rivals through the initial bend to prompt the pace three deep down the backside, rallied to poke her head in front midpoint of the final turn, stubbornly kept digging in with the winner bearing down through the lane and gave way grudgingly inside in the last few jumps before the wire to settle for the runners up share instead. TAKE CHANCES was situated between runners in the middle of the pack in the early stages, settled in the second flight watching the front trio at the half, could not quicken with rivals when in tight at the three furlong pole to be shuffled back on the far turn, swung out six wide for the drive, could not get to the front duo down the stretch but did fight on determinedly to win the show money outside in the final seventy yards. SERENADING AMAYA hounded the pace outside on the first of two turns, continued vying up front with horses on both sides down the backstretch, was asked for more trying to hold position at the three furlong pole keeping a close eye on the contesting duo on the second turn, shifted four wide in the hunt in upper stretch, exchanged bumps with the outside rival a furlong from home and finished up with interest to be a fringe player at the wire. POWAQA was unhurried being at the rear in the early stages, moved in three deep outside foes at the half, travelled three wide on the far turn in the second flight holding her own around the far turn, angled out five wide still in the mix at the top of the lane, exchanged bumps with the inside runner when between horses dueling for the show award at the furlong marker and weakened in deep stretch. SPIRIT O'TIPPERARY was hustled

from the outside post clearing to lead on the rail while gearing down bunching up the field going into the first turn, narrowly had the front inside under a snug hold setting a dawdling pace along the backside, was under a vigorous ride trying to keep her head in front with outside rivals moving in at the five sixteenths pole, gave way inside with a quarter mile to run and had little to offer three wide in the stretch drive.

PURR FACTOR dueled inside in the early part of the backstretch running, inched away on the fence by the half, moved comfortably inside dictating terms up front around the bend, spurted away from the early speed foe two wide turning for home and kept finding more down the stretch when called upon to prevail at the wire for the frontrunning score. HAPPY VALENTINE had a good spot rating kindly on the rail watching the engaged twosome while inside two others down the backside, had horse waiting for the cue to move just behind the lead pair on the turn, shifted out three wide bursting between rivals posing the main opposition at the head of the lane, ran on gamely down the stretch but just could not get by the winner who kept on going until the end. GLORIANNIA had an outside trip in midfield going three deep along the backside, kept pace with the leaders tracking in the second flight outside through the oval, angled out five wide between horses in upper stretch and found something more in the last sixteenth of a mile to surge through horses in the late running to just get the show money at the wire. ANAM CARA had little early foot seeing the field outside at the half, made a good rally commencing three wide going around horses at the three eighths pole, continued to circle foes through the turn to be six wide in the mix straightening out for home and finished up mildly outside challengers to just get nabbed for the third-place share at the finish line. SOCIETY'S KAT leapt up at the start to trail the field leaving the chute, was eager stalking inside at the half under a tight hold, improved smartly on the fence around the turn, shifted out four wide at the top of the lane,

angled back inside to be on the rail making a run at the furlong pole fighting for the show award late but faded nearing the wire losing a couple of positions in the end. CARA CARA was prominent between runners early, dropped back leaving the backstretch, angled in late on the turn cutting the corner, rallied along the rail inside foes, got up late. CHROMEPLATED HEART was outsprinted early dropped back, steadied and altered in near the half, advanced inside just off the rail to bid in the two path in late stretch, took a narrow lead, was outfinished. MAY MAY STRONG was outpaced early bringing up the rear well back of the leaders, swung eight wide into upper stretch, was flying late. LUZ DE LA LUNA vied between early then made the lead, moved clear by the five-sixteenths setting the pace from off the rail in about the three path, let them into upper stretch, was challenged and overtaken and had no extra for the late stages. MISS VYVYANNE attended the pace between foes early, eased back off a pair stalking on the turn, shifted out late on that bend coming into upper stretch four wide, was within range again coming to the furlong marker but lacked the needed late kick. WINTERBERRY had company to her inside when up front heading into the first turn, kept on going around the bend to shake loose well in front unopposed down the backside moving well in hand, remained all alone up top getting a breather in the third split with the rider statuesque on the far turn, was well in control of things just off the fence at the top of the stretch, when asked for more switched leads on a dime at the furlong pole and held safe for the front-end victory when crossing the finish line. SHIFTY had an ideal set-up on the rail isolated watching the engaged duo in the beginning, tracked the lone speed stablemate in the three path outside another along the back straight, sensing the slow pace on the last turn was urged to close in at the three furlong pole, posed the only threat in range of the leader three wide straightening out for home but was under a drive, finished up strongly to the wire but could not run down the winner who had it all her own way through the race. ARISTELLA travelled three wide part of the back threesome into the initial bend, continued on three deep outside horses down the backside making little headway, picked up the bit smartly circling a few runners three wide around the far turn, was no match to the lead pair at the top of the stretch but did finish up willingly to be a clear but non threatening third at the finish line. CRYSTAL VISIONS had the rail position at the rear trio in the early going, made little movement on the fence stalking ahead of a couple runners by the half, was hard ridden making little headway on the final bend, shifted out at the quarter coming up to a tired runner and finished up evenly in the three path through the stretch to be a fringe player with the field quite strung out in the end. HIBISCUS had early foot dueling inside the winner going into the first turn, was relegated to an inside tracking role with the frontrunner shaking clear along the backstretch, came under a ride at the three eighths pole but was retreating between horses with a quarter mile to run and folded on the fence by mid-stretch. INNISFREE ISLE bobbled slightly on the break, was part of the back threesome stalking between runners on the first of two turns, continued near the rear with rivals on either side down the backstretch making little gain, was scrubbed on for more run having in the two path between foes making no progression on the running around the far turn, shifted out four wide for the drive to the wire but had little to show in the stretch runinna.

HOSHIANA (FR) settled into stride last but one, saved ground on the turn riding the rail into upper stretch and was put to urging at the quarter pole, came out six wide in mid-stretch, surged past late. SHOTGUN WEDDING tracked from inside not too far in behind the leaders, shifted five to six wide turning into upper stretch, struck the lead about the three-sixteenths, moved clear by mid-stretch, was outfinished but second best. YOU BE THE JUDGE settled off the pace, fanned seven wide into upper stretch starting to advance, kept on evenly while widest to capture show honors but was no match for the top pair. DARE TO BREEZE was forced outside foes three to four wide on the turn mid-pack, was within range of the leaders in upper stretch but failed to rally. SMUDGE broke outwardly, settled at the rear, could see them all coming into upper stretch five to seven wide, passed some tired rivals. BARBARA JOAN was prominent inside early, wrangled back off the pace after pressing briefly, tracked in behind, came out a bit coming into upper stretch seeking room, found none in upper stretch, moved back in brushing a rival lightly past the furlong marker, ran on evenly inside late. BRITTANY'S WAY broke outwardly, steadily advanced outside into and on the turn, bid at the five-sixteenths taking a narrow lead, faltered and faded. RUTHLESS ACTION raced up close two to three wide and between foes in the second flight entering the turn, came up empty in the lane. SCARY SPEEDY got away well, set the early pace from off

the rail, was overtaken late on the turn, weakened in the stretch drifting inward a bit, was brushed and steadied past the furlong marker and faded thereafter.

## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

RARIFIED (IRE) had a nice position all alone just outside watching the contesting twosome battle down the backstretch, elected to stay inside at the five sixteenths pole riding the bias on the turn waiting to go, burst between horses with a sharp turn of foot three wide to poke her head in front in upper stretch, drifted in coming to the furlong marker fighting up top and dueled tenaciously inside in the final furlong holding on while getting out under left handed encouragement when coming up to the finish line. TEQUILASOUPERNOVA was isolated down the backside keeping a close eye on the front three in the early going, made a sharp move surging between foes midway on the turn to get into contention four wide on the outside turning for home, battled down the entire lane never giving way while staying on the incorrect lead to the wire but just missed by a head nod in a tight finish. CRUMLIN FASHION settled on the outside of another in the middle of the pack along the back straight, was scrubbed on mounting a rally outside foes at the three furlong pole, continued to close the gap going two to four wide around the turn to be in the mix in the five path at the top of the lane, could not keep up to the front pair who had it to themselves in the final furlong but did run on well enough to hold for the show money at the wire. LEMON SWEETS was unhurried co-trailing on the outside down the backstretch, stalked ahead of only one runner around the bend, swung out widest finding her best stride in the six-path turning for home and closed in smartly to get a minor role when crossing the finish line outside horses. TUNED OUT was away slowly on the fence at the break, stalked inside ahead of a couple of runners down the backside, was under a busy riding making little gain around the oval, angled out to the four path for the stretch drive and finished up with good late interest between runners just missing out on the battle for a minor share. MONTY'S INN had an inside position in mid-division along the backside, kept pace taking the shortest route around the turn to be in with a chance just off the fence behind the embattled trio in upper stretch, could not continue on with the stretch rally with a sixteenth remaining and evened out in the late stages. BALLS IN UR COURT was bumped outside on the start, recouped quickly to duel inside for the front down the backstretch began to edge away from the other front-end challenger by midturn, had more company outside turning for home, was in tight retreating on the fence coming to the eighth pole and folded inside runners in the final sixteenth of a mile. STRAWBERRY WORLD broke inwards on the start to trail between foes down the back straight, lagged behind taking the short way around unable to catch up to any rivals through the turn, shifted out in the two path for the drive to the wire and could only pass the early speed rival who was getting leg weary by the furlong pole. FLORIDA VACATION forced the pace on the outside along the backstretch, came under a ride trying to keep up to the leader inside who was inching away in midturn, gave way between runners at the quarter pole and emptied out three wide between foes in mid-stretch.
