CITORI shook loose from the early speed foe to have uncontested lead by the half, rolled along still unchallenged throughout the turn, built up a commanding lead at the top of the stretch, began to get weary drifting out in the last sixteenth of a mile but had enough of an advantage to hold safe front the frontrunning score at the wire. SMART ALMASTY had the rail in mid-division in the early going, closed the gap on the fence by the half, shifted out three wide at the three furlong pole uncorking a run, was full of run four wide straightening out for the drive, powered past the leader with a furlong to go and held safe keeping to the task in the late going. PET SOUNDS tracked the frontrunner on the rail in the beginning, continued to watch the loose leader down the backstretch, moved in at the quarter pole with the eventual winner outside doing the same, shifted out four wide turning for home, kept on coming down the lane but could get to the winner late to be a non-threatening runner up at the finish line. GUARD OF HONOUR seized command from the onset, increased the margin up front travelling well along the backside, slowed the tempo down trying to get a breather still in control through the far turn, was collared outside by the winner at the furlong marker, offered little resistance inside and faded inside in deep stretch but still held for the show money at the wire. PERFECT PLAY was allowed to settle at the back of the pack in the early parts of this race, rallied going by a rival on the rail at the three eighths pole, continued to move steadily on the fence through the turn, picked up another foe inside at the top of the stretch and finished up evenly to be a fringe player in the end. LONHRO'S GAMBLE stalked three wide outside into the first turn, improved entering the backstretch outside horses to track the pacesetter outside by the half, was hard ridden but could not go with rivals on either side who making a run midway on the final bend, had little left for the drive and yielded three wide in upper stretch. DIVA'S GHOST was in between rivals in the two path stalking the leader in the first of two turns, settled inside horses in mid-pack along the back straight, was roused for more offering no response being passed inside at the three-furlong pole and could not get involved in the stretch running.

PHILIP BANKS got away well and set the early tempo from just off the rail, was headed by an outside rival at the seven-sixteenths, retook the lead a furlong later, began edging away willingly once in upper stretch, was shaken up past the eighth pole, drew off under mild hand urging while much the best. GOLDEN TRUTH shifted in two to three wide mid-pack, came out five wide at the top of the stretch, chased the winner home in vain but was clearly second best. TIME PASSES settled last but one, advanced between foes in mid- to late-stretch to secure show honors while no threat to the top pair. GONE HUNTING switched outside a foe into the turn, went three to four wide on that bend outside mid-division, came into upper stretch five deep, ran on but needed more. SOUPER TUSCAN was brushed inside at the start, was part of the fray up top vying for the lead early on in the two path between foes, edged away to lead narrowly up front at the half, opened up sharply at the quarter pole travelling smoothly and cruised home through the stretch comfortably prevailing at the wire for the win. BEE ME had the rail part of the early scrum for the lead, was reined back on the fence at the half, waited in the second flight inside behind the pacesetter on the turn, shifted out in the two path for the drive, could not get to the winner who was long gone by the furlong marker but did fight on stubbornly outside to just win the secondary battle at the finish line. SIGNATURE SIR travelled between horses in mid-division early on, was shuffled back under a snug hold at the half, edged up on the fence moving smartly at the quarter pole and rallied strongly on the fence down the lane to just miss getting the nod for the runners share at the finish line. POCKET SPEED stalked three deep midway down the backstretch, made a brief move having to go four wide outside runners with five sixteenths remaining, shifted to the five path in upper stretch and was one paced outside foes to settle on the fringes at the wire. RED WEAVER dueled for the lead being part of the foursome up top while in the three path between horses in the beginning, chased the frontrunner in vain throughout the turn, angled three wide in the mix for a share at the top of the lane but had to offer late and faded in the last sixteenth of a mile.

SOUPER STRIDER broke in then hopped to co-trail inside down the backstretch, could see the field making no impact running around the turn, shifted out three wide at the top of the lane unable to make a run, drifted to the rail by the furlong pole and angled out again late to pass a tired rival in deep stretch. STIRLING CASTLE prompted the pace four deep at the start, was taken back off the lead group at the half, was scrubbed midturn three wide between horses trying to keep position in midfield and lacked a rally in the three path in the final furlong. HOWSITGOINOWEN was away slowly to co-trail on the outside entering the backstretch, rushed up down the back straight to prompt the issue three deep on the outside with seven sixteenths still to run, had little left from his earlier efforts and retreated outside midway around the turn and galloped home crossing the finish line.

FIGHTER IN THE WIN had an ideal spot alone watching the contest duo set at brisk pace down the backside, rated kindly on the rail in the final turn waiting for the order to go from the rider, shifted out having clear run five wide turning for home, picked up the bit when called upon at the furlong marker taking the lead by the sixteenths pole and held on for the win at the wire. CORNWALL had an inside position in mid- pack down the backside, closed the gap on the fence through the far turn, was in the thick of things four wide at the quarter pole, kept on coming down the entire stretch but just could not get to the winner in time and settled for the seond place prize at the witre. ONE MORE BREW broke in at the start, stalked ahead of only one runner in the early stages, started to make a rally angling put three wide outside foes at the five sixteenths pole, shifted out further in the eight path gaining momentum in upper stretch and finished up willingly to capture the show money in the late going. BREAKING ALONE was in tight leaving the gate to trail after the start, lagged behind down the backside, made little impression still at the rear through the far turn, shifted out from the fence at the five sixteenths pole to be widest swinging for home in the nine path, finished up gradually outside down the lane to just get up and settled on the fringes in the end. SOULMATE had the lead under a snug hold in the beginning, was pressed by an outside foe who was making a premature move quickening the tempo considerably down the backstretch, held hos own up front on the fence around the final bend, continued to dig in clinging onto the lead at the furlong pole on the rail but had little left in the tank in deep stretch and faded inside runners in the final sixteenth. WAGNER stalked on the outside near the rear in the early going, co-trailed outside galloping along relaxed outside through the bend, swung out widest gathering speed six wide turning for home and under a well-timed move having a strong kick in the final eighth of a mile got up in the shadow of the wire for the stretch running score. BACKROADSBILLY flanked the frontrunner outside down the back straight, inched up even closer outside in the running through the turn, poked his head in front two wide at the furlong pole but could not withstand the late charge by the winner in deep stretch outside. YODDHA drafted behind the pacesetter well in hand along the backside, continued nestled on the rail waiting to go behind the leader around the turn, shifted out four wide off the lead duo in upper stretch, was in tight rubbing the outside rival with three sixteenths to go, could not get to the front pair in the last eighth of a mile but did fight on determinedly to win the show battle inside at the wire. TIERNAN had a slight lead on the fence down the backside, narrowly maintained the advantage inside around the bend, relinquished the front inside a rival coming up to the furlong pole and little to give late wilting in the final sixteenth. ROAR OF THE CROWD was allowed to settle into stride trailing on the fence along the backside, co-trailed inside paired up with the eventual winner throughout the turn,
