SAMMY STONE was off a step slow on the break, sensing the moderate tempo drove up inside runners to assume command into the first turn, continued unchallenged up front setting a soft pace down the backside, still was in control of things dictating terms around the final bend, was headed outside at the top of the lane but under a well rated front end ride had more to give to pull away for the win in the final furlong. SUGAR IT'S ELI had an inside stalking trip in the beginning, co-trailed on the fence along the backside, moved up smartly to sit just behind the leader at the half, waited to go while drafting behind the pacesetter around the far turn, shifted out having clear aim on the frontrunner in the for path turning for home but could not match strides in the final furlong with the winner and just managed to hold the place share at the finish line. NORTH WARDEN had the early lead when the gates opened up, was relegated to a tracking role outside around the initial bend, continued to watch the pacesetter outside down the backstretch, chased the frontrunner with rivals on either side around the last turn but was empty, yielding four wide in upper stretch. TRUE SHOT had a good position between horses watching the top duo in the early going, kept a close eye on the engaged trio down the backstretch, edged up on the fence at the five sixteenths pole, sat just behind the pacesetter three wide turning for home looking for a seam, shifted inside to the rail having clear run in the final furlong and got up in the final few strides with a late burst for the win. BLONDINA'S BOY assumed the lead under the wire for the very first time, continued up top while hounded outside by a couple of rivals down the backstretch, spurted loose midway on the last bend, had rivals bearing down while clinging onto the front while drifting out at the furlong marker and gave way grudgingly in deep stretch for the win but did manage to save the place share in a picture. SOL DE VERANO was off a step slow breaking inwards at the start, made an early move circling around runners four wide on the first turn, prompted the pace three deep along the backside, was scrubbed on chasing the leader four wide on the final bend to be in the mix in the five path straightening out for home and was gaining gradually in the late running but was on the losing end of a three way photo for the win and place positions at the wire. DARE TO BE KING co-trailed on the inside in the beginning, was still unhurried seeing the field along the backside, started to go by rivals outside at the half, made little movement when hard ridden around the far turn, shifted out five wide off the leaders in mid-stretch and finished with interest to just get up for a minor share in the end. WHISKEY N ICE broke outwards on the start, had a slim advantage inside in the beginning, contently let the outside rival go on at the five sixteenths pole surrendering the lead, regained command having a slim lead on the fence around the turn, continued to be stubborn while inside horses turning for home still holding up front and found more in reserve in the last furlong to repel the outside challenger with a sixteenth left to run for the victory. RHAENYRA broke in at the start, had an ideal spot all alone watching the contesting duo around the turn, moved in four wide to loom boldly outside runners at the head of the lane, looked to getting to the winner at the eighth pole but was repelled in the last sixteenth with the leader finding just a bit more and saved the place share at the finish line. CATHOLIC JACKIE was bumped into a rival at the start, settled off the pace, trailed coming to the top of the stretch, tipped out in the lane eventually coming out six wide, rallied well but too late, got up for second. WICO (IRE) bumped a rival at the start, was prominent early then eased back off the leader to stalk, moved rapidly from three furlongs out, took a narrow lead at the quarter pole, drifted five wide into upper stretch, came out a bit then steadied just slightly and altered back in a path, ran on, was no match for the winner and just lost place late. PASSTHEPUDDINPLEAZ was bumped from both sides at the start, settled mid-pack, shifted in, raced near but off the fence on the turn cutting the corner into upper stretch, kicked on mildly inside but needed more. JMR SPEEDY ESCAPE was bumped into a rival at the start, settled off the pace, advanced between foes three wide past the quarter pole, was carried out a bit in the stretch, ran on eight wide late but needed more. CATCH THE DRIFT seized command from the start, set the pace while off the fence three wide up top on the first turn, became headstrong fighting the rider when slowing the tempo down along the backstretch, relinquished the lead for a moment on the fence at the five sixteenths pole, disposed of the early challenger when spurting away again two wide turning for home and had just enough left in the tank to prevail from the oncoming late chargers to hold for the win at the wire. PEGGY was on the outside in midfield on the first turn, stalked near the rear down the backside, improved position by the half, took the short way around closing the gap on the final bend, came with a run on the fence having a chance in upper stretch, shifted out at the furlong pole gathering more speed and surged late for the place share while just unable to get to the winner at the finish line. DESIGN DIVA had an inside position in the middle of the pack in the early stages, crept closer on the fence when nudged for more at the quarter pole, angled out five wide between runners at the head of the lane, drifted inwards dueling up top at the eight pole and determinedly kept on running to the wire closing in smartly late but just missed in a tight photo for

the runners up share at the finish line. POETIC AMY was part of the back trio between horses in the beginning, made no progression along the backside, mildly improved in the two path with a quarter mile to run, angled out six wide having clear run, found her best stride late and rallied in the final seventy yards to capture a minor role in the end. MRS. HOT SHOT sat outside watching the top two rivals around the first turn, settled in the third flight outside down the backstretch, was under a ride inching up on the leaders when outside another at the quarter pole, had a chance for a piece of the prize five wide straightening for home, fought on through the lane but evened out losing positions in deep stretch. INDIANA ROAD was under a snug hold rating kindly on the fence watching the pacesetter early on, sat behind the leader moving comfortably along the backside, shifted outside into the turn to get her head in front a stride or two with five sixteenth from home, could not continue on with the winner who had more left at the top of the stretch, weakened between runners four wide coming to furlong pole, lost all momentum when in tight with the rider having to stand up in the irons coming the sixteenth pole and was not persevered with in deep stretch. EASTER SUNDAY GIRL broke in at the start, was part of the back threesome on the outside going five wide on the initial turn, co-trailed inside another along the back straight, made a brief move splitting foes at the five sixteenths pole but could no factor anymore while in the five path down the lane. MADAM GWEN veered out sharply on the break travelled outside going seven wide into the first turn while in mid-pack, regressed outside horses three deep along the backside, saved ground seeing the field on the last turn and failed to menace in the stretch running.

DEPUTY DADDY tracked from inside, began shifting out at the seven-sixteenths racing in behind the leading pair three or four wide coming to the top of the stretch, tipped out wider in the lane, kept on to get up late. FIFTY B M G was quickly clear, set the pace from off the rail, was outkicked but held second. SHADOW REALM was bumped at the start, settled mid-pack shifting in a bit, moved nearer the rail advancing inside foes leaving the turn and cutting the corner, rallied up the inside while in a bit tight, missed second. YACHT BOY bumped a rival at the start, settled off the pace, swung seven to eight wide, kicked on mildly outside. BANKINGONAMIRACLE pursued the leader from outside three to four wide, was close through the turn, lacked the needed late kick. NEXT PITCH was mid-pack outside foes and one-paced. COUNTRY LIVING broke out a bit, stalked from between runners, steadied when in tight and

MISTY EYED settled in the third flight four deep outside foes leaving the chute, improved smartly while under a snug hold outside down the back straight, kept a close eye of the frontrunner throughout the turn, posed the main threat four wide in upper stretch and steadily kept on gaining on the leader to get up for the win in the final few strides. EM CHAMAS quickly opened up for the front after the break, set the pace moving comfortably on the fence along the backstretch, continued up top while hounded outside around the bend, shifted just outside in the two path holding onto the lead turning for home, continued to find more clinging up front with a furlong to go but could not fend off the persistent winner in the shadow of the wire. MOMANDA was in the second flight inside watching the contesting duo at the half, moved well in hand waiting inside on the rail for the cue to go around the turn, shifted out three wide between rivals battling up front in mid-stretch but needed more to threaten the top pair in deep stretch still easily finishing up for the show money in the end. AUSSIE HYPER stalked five deep outside horses close to the back of the pack in the early going, made little impression going three wide outside foes in midfield when ridden for more on the bend, shifted out five wide with clear run straightening out for home and had a good late charge in the final furlong to get up for a minor role in the end outside runners. BLAZE OF MISCHIEF was away alertly on the break, settled into the third tier between foes entering the backstretch, was shuffled back positions at the half, made little impact around the turn while on the fence, shifted out three wide mounting a rally in upper stretch, darted back to the inside at the furlong pole and finished with intent on the rail in deep stretch. JUST LIKE THAT broke out on the start, chased the leader down the backside, was reined in to track the lead duo outside another around the turn, was scrubbed on trying to keep up to the front three at the quarter pole and flattened out in the final seventy yards when dueling for a minor share. THIS IS GLORIA had a stalking role ahead of only a troubled starter along the back straight, made an early move circling three wide around horses at the three eighths pole to be in with a chance for a share in the five path at the top of the lane, could not sustain the rally and stalled by the furlong marker. ONE MORE DOLL had the fence near the rear in the early going, improved slightly to mid-pack inside rivals at the half, saved the ground holding position around the bend and failed to fire on the rail in the final eighth of a mile. BRAZILIAN LEGACY was in mid-division in the two path between foes to begin, dropped back when in tight at the half mile marker, could see the field just off the fence at the three eighths pole and offered a mild run going three wide passing a couple of rivals at the quarter pole. BLACKMARSH travelled in the middle of the pack in the three path between foes along the backside, was shuffled back at the half mile marker, made little impact between rivals through the turn and had little to offer four wide down the lane. ECLIPTICAL LADYBUG was forced out being in tight to trail the field leaving the chute, passed a rival inside at the seven sixteenths pole, saved ground making little impression through the turn and had no finish to give inside horses in the stretch run. WEAPONS MASTER hopped then broke out on the start, recouped to sit in the four path between foes into the backstretch, improved position at the half outside runners, was hard ridden midway around the turn but was being passed on either side, angled out four wide for the drive to the turn but came up empty in mid-stretch.
