PRINCESS ORLAITH was away slowly spotting the field many lengths along the backside, continued to lag behind in midturn, had a full head of steam circling three wide around a couple of rivals at the quarter pole, gathered more speed in the five path but was drifting in even though under left handed encouragement in upper stretch, had a strong late charge albeit the frontrunner was weakening quite a bit in the final sixteenth of a mile and got up a few strides before the wire for the impressive late closing score nevertheless. HAVE RESPECT scampered away easily clearing off getting to the rail to have a commanding advantage by the half setting a rapid pace, rolled along well up top unchallenged through the turn, continued to play catch me if you can still on top comfortably in mid-stretch, began to shorten stride while never switching leads by the sixteenth pole and ran out of gas being caught late by the winner while just lasted from an inside foe for the runners up share at the wire. SWIFTY KIM stalked near the rear in tandem with an outside foe ahead of only the poor starting eventual winner down the backstretch, saved all the ground but could not improve travelling around the oval, shifted to the two path turning for home and finished up willingly on the fence in the final furlong to be a clear third almost getting up late inside for the place share as well. KUZ I'M CHARMING stumbled on the break, had an outside stalking role paired up with another down the back straight, travelled two wide but could not get into another gear when called upon midway around the turn, angled out to the four path at the rear straightening for home and managed to pass a couple of weary inside runners in the final furlong to settle on the fringes in the end. MY ANGEL NICOLE was well back in the second spot content to let the pacesetter who was on a mission go on with it dictating a brisk early tempo down the back straight, gave futile chase unable to make any gains on the leader around the bend and had little left to offer when wilting between horses in the two path coming up to the sixteenth pole. LOVELY RAINBOW was isolated watching the lead front two runners down the backstretch with the small field quite strung out by the half, was asked to go after the top two rivals at the five sixteenths pole but to no avail through the turn running, shifted to the three path for the stretch drive but came up empty by the furlong pole.

LADY ON A MISSION was quick to take the lead, set the pace from just off the rail, shook clear by mid-stretch and held sway. DADDY'S SECRET stalked in behind the leading pair racing outside a foe two to three wide, swung out five to six wide for the drive, kept on in a battle for minor awards and got the nod for place. TAP MY DESIRE broke a bit awkwardly, moved up inside on the turn, angled six wide leaving that bend then out a further path in upper stretch, finished strongly but missed the place. KINZIE GIRL pulled against the rider's restraint in the early going tracking in behind, saved ground on the turn, kept on in the stretch but was outfinished for minor placings. HYMN TO HER broke a bit awkwardly, settled off the pace racing two to three wide on the turn, kept on in the stretch to improve while just short from between runners. CLEARWATER BEACH settled nicely mid-division, moved out and advanced passing the

three-eighths, came into upper stretch five wide, brushed with a rival at that juncture, drifted in a bit, flattened out. DIVINELY INSPIRED was off the pace outside two to three wide, swung eight deep for the drive but was never near enough to threaten. GREENWICH PIKE moved forward from between foes to press the eventual winner racing two to three wide into the turn, came into upper stretch four deep, was brushed lightly, faltered and faded. CONQUER THE STORM was a little fractious behind the gate, broke a step slowly, lacked speed trailing into the turn near the inside, failed to menace.

ARMADA RISING (IRE) assumed command getting to the rail setting a leisurely pace up front on the initial bend, still controlled a soft tempo unopposed along the back straight, moved well in hand with the closest pursuers unable to threaten midway around the far turn and under a well rated ride had plenty left for the stretch run winning easily proving much the best comfortably ahead of the others at the finish line. THATSITTHATSALL settled between foes in mid-pack on the first turn, made little progression having the rail down the backstretch at the four furlong marker, started to make a rally when nudged on the fence at the quarter pole, shaved the corner at the top of the stretch, angled out to the four path bumping a rival in the process of trying to get a clear lane and found her best stride late unable to get to the overpowering winner in the final furlong but holding for second best inside at the finish line. SERENADING

AMAYA settled at the back end just off the rail in the beginning, shared the rear outside another along the backstretch at the half mile marker, started to come with a good turn of foot inside a couple of runners at the quarter pole, veered out pushing her way through in the five path at the top of the stretch, drifted out again making contact with the outside foe coming up to the eighth pole full of run and closed in strongly to be a clear third while just missing outside at the wire for the place award as well. MAKAYLA was all alone contently sitting behind the pacesetter, came under a drive but gave futile chase to the front running winner on the last turn by the quarter pole and faded inside of horses in the final furlong to hold on for a minor share in the end. MOVENTOTHECOUNTRY had the rail sitting in midfield on the first bend, dropped back to co-trail on the outside at the half mile marker, offered a mild run three wide outside foes at the quarter pole, was forced out widest in the seven path straightening out for the drive and finished up gradually through the lane but could not get involved late. MAXINE MAGIC stalked close to the back but had to be checked slightly two wide between runners at the midpoint of the first turn, made an early move closing in sharply four deep down the backside with a half mile remaining, continued the long sustained run three wide on the last turn still improving on the outside, shifted to the five path being brushed inside by a rival nearing the furlong pole and weakened in the late stages. THAT GIRL ARTEMUS was forwardly placed inside another tracking the front two runners for the first half of this two turn event, travelled two wide still keeping pace with the leader around the final bend, was bumped and jostled between horses in mid-stretch losing its momentum and gave way thereafter. BEAUTIFUL SKY travelled three wide on the first turn keeping a close eye on the lead two runners in the early stages, could not quicken with others while between horses at the five sixteenths pole, was pushed out by an inside rival going six wide at the head of the lane then was bumped again by the same runner coming up to the furlong marker and could not recover in the late going to be a factor in deep stretch. LADIES RUM was fractious behind the gate prior to the start unseating the rider, dwelt trailing the field under the wire for the first time, improved slightly around horses while going three wide on the first turn, made little movement along the backside, retreated through the field on the second bend to be last by the quarter pole and emptied out in upper stretch. STEWARDS INQUIRY REGARDING #9 LADIES RUN ON THE BREAK WAS DEEMED TO HAVE RECEIVED A FAIR START. STEWARDS INQUIRY REGARDING #4 THAT GIRL ARTEMUS AND #6 THATSITTHATSALL IN MID-STRETCH IN THE VICINITY OF THE EIGHTH POLE RESULTED IN #6 THATSITTHATSALL BEING DISQUALIFIED FOR INTERFERENCE AND PLACED SIXTH. STEWARDS INQUIRY REGARDING #3 SERENADING AMAYA AND #7 BEAUTIFUL SKY IN UPPER STRETCH RESULTED IN #3 SERENADING AMAYA BEING DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED EIGHTH FOR INTERFERENCE.

NIKITA'S GEM moved to the lead inside after the opening furlong, set the pace facing outside pressure, edged away willingly on the far turn, was asked leaving that bend, responded and extended the margin in upper stretch to be well clear, held safe. HOLIDAY WITH AMY unhurriedly brought up the rear shifting in and saving ground at the back, was encouraged outside the quarter pole moving out at that juncture, swung five wide into upper stretch, gained steadily through the lane to close the gap. FOXY DIVA settled in behind along the inside saving ground, ran on evenly, was no match for the top pair but just got show honors. FLYING BLACK attended the pace heading to the first turn, steadily dropped back between foes racing into the far turn, asked to pick it up three furlongs out, swung seven wide into upper stretch, came again running on late but missed third. GALLEY HEAD was up close into the first turn moving in from four to three wide, stalked the pace up the backstretch, was asked about the five-sixteenths, came into upper stretch four wide, failed to rally. JUST MAGNIFICENT was unhurried on the fence having only the troubled starter beaten down the backside, picked up the bit narrowing the margin three wide between rivals on the turn at the three eighths marker, loomed boldly in the five path at the top of the stretch seized control outside but was wandering about at the three sixteenths marker and was kept to the task in the final furlong edging away for the clear win in deep stretch. BOLD RIPASSO stalked near the rear going four deep early on, ranged up three wide outside of horses through the bend, shifted to the four path in the hunt taking the corner, dueled inside with the winner in the last eighth of a mile but could not keep up in the final seventy yards conceding the win while comfortably besting the others for the secondary award. PEACE POSEY was bounced around between horses on the break to trail just off the fence down the backside, started to make a rally three to four wide at the three furlong pole moving the eventual winner to his inside, swung out widest to the seven path in upper stretch and ran on willingly outside of rivals to close in belatedly being a non threatening third. SECRET LOAD travelled on the outside of another tracking the front pair in the second flight, regressed slightly between horses in midfield two wide running around the turn, dropped back to last in the three path entering the homestretch, moved to the four path for the final furlong and finished up one paced to settle on the fringes in the end. SPUN AROUND broke out on the start, recovered to have the outright lead on the fence with three quarters of a mile left to run, had a slim advantage on the turn hounded outside by a rival throughout, shifted to the two path clinging onto the front end at the head of the lane, surrendered the top spot to outside runners by the three sixteenths pole and faded further in the late stages. ENGLISH JUBILEE settled between runners in mid-division along the backside, took the short way around the turn

edging closer by the three eighths pole, skimmed the fence straightening out for home, could not find a seam in the fourth path by mid-stretch, finally had clear run outside five wide with a furlong to go and passed tired runners in the late going. NORTH YORK had the rail position watching the engaged duo along the backside, had a nice set up on the fence all alone still keeping a close eye on the contesting twosome throughout the turn, scraped paint at the head of the lane, moved to the two to three path at the furlong marker but lacked a rally throughout the stretch drive. ZABARTA broke inwards on the start, recovered to have a head in front outside in the beginning, relinquished the front end by the three quarters marker, continued to press the issue outside on the turn flanking the leader, shifted to the three path still in the mix turning for home but folded in the four path drifting in and out between horses at the furlong pole.

SURE SHOT TIMBER was loose on the lead on the fence entering the backside, rolled along smoothly doing it well within himself alone on the engine around the bend, had the rail with outside company bearing down at the furlong pole, switched back to the incorrect lead in the heat of battle at the sixteenth poke with the advantage diminishing but found just enough in reserve late to last at the wire for the front running tally. CAN'T TIE ME DOWN was situated three deep outside a couple of runners in mid-pack early on, made a sharp move around foes three wide in midturn, was the main opposition still in the three path outside the leader at the top of the lane, grinded away tenaciously outside in the final furlong and was closing in late but just lost the nod to the winner at the finish line. WELL LIT had the rail drafting behind the pacesetter down the backside, inched up closer saving ground around the turn, had the two path in the conversation briefly at the top of the stretch, was no match for the lead pair who had it to themselves in the final furlong but still finished up mildly to be all alone at the wire for the show money. COSA TAPA hopped on the break then was taken a hold of briefly between runners, became headstrong fighting the riders restraint behind horses down the backside near the rear at the five eighths marker, travelled three wide going the wrong way on the turn to be at the tail end by the five sixteenths pole, hugged the rail in upper stretch and ran one one paced to garner a minor placing. MANCHESTER ICE was allowed to settle into stride seeing the field at the half, tried to commence a rally circling foes three to four wide in the turn running, swung out widest in the six path in with a chance for a piece of the prize turning for home but could not sustain the run and idled in the final furlong outside of horses. BACCARO POINT had his neck bowed sitting just off the pacesetter outside down the backstretch, was roused for more offering no response three wide around the turn backing away through the field to be at the rear by the quarter pole and had nothing to give coming up empty in the stretch drive.

FEATHERWEIGHT tracked from inside mid-pack, shifted four wide coming to the quarter pole, took command just outside the furlong marker and quickly drew clear, held. BEAU PINK broke outwardly, chased from between foes two to three wide into the turn, angled six deep in mid-stretch, closed the gap and secured the place. BUTTERFLY BILLIE settled outside a foe heading to the turn two to three wide, was carried out five wide coming past the quarter pole, kept on in the stretch but needed more. YOU SIGNED IT moved to the lead outside foes after the opening furlong, quickly drew clear and shifted in near but

just off the fence dictating terms, weakened in the lane. HEARTY CHRISTINI got away well with the early lead for the opening furlong, steadily dropped back along the inside while chasing, kept on in the stretch coming out late but needed more. SPORTY ANGELA broke a step slowly hitting the gate and ducking in at the start, settled at the back near the inside, swung six wide leaving the turn, was never a threat. RED DRAGON was asked for run from the start but outsprinted early, raced outside at the back three wide on the turn, swung seven wide, failed to menace. BROWN BUTTER SAGE chased three to four wide into and on the turn, was asked by the quarter pole but had no response and faded.
