EXUDE was unhurried on the fence being part of the back trio in the early stages, shared the rear saving all the ground midway around the turn, closed the gap gathering speed swinging out widest in the six path with a quarter mile to run, drove by sharply outside by the sixteenth pole and won going away when crossing the finish line. SOUTHERN STYLE was going three deep at the back end with two inside runners in the early going, started to reach for more ground four wide at the half mile marker, angled to the five path in the hunt at the top of the stretch, briefly took control between runners with a furlong from home but did not have enough left late to fend off the winner outside in the last sixteenth of a mile. KING ROSSO had a stalking trip settling in mid-field along the backside, made no movement travelling one paced around the bend, had the four path turning for home, shifted out off tiring runners to be six wide getting clear run at the furlong pole and closed in belatedly in deep stretch to capture the show award. SPRUNG LOOSE had a nice set up sitting on the rail all alone watching the contesting front pair up top down the backside and throughout the turn, shifted out coming to the lead duo at the three eighths pole, had the four path with horses on either side in the conversation for the top spot in upper stretch but needed more late when fading in the final furlong to settle on the fringes in the end. QUIET VISTA broke in a touch on the start, shared the rear between rivals along the backside, co-trailed outside with the eventual winner early in the turn running, could see the field skimming the fence straightening out for the drive and managed to only pass the leg weary early leaders who were spent fighting for the lead in the beginning that were tiring by the furlong marker. PRIVATE LABEL was brushed on the outside slightly on the break, recovered to duel inside down the backstretch for the top spot, continued to throw it down with a pesky outside foe quickening the tempo on the turn, shifted to the two path clinging onto the lead with outside runners bearing down at the head of the lane, had nothing left in the tank for the drive and yielded inside by the furlong marker. MOTION GRANTED was roused battling outside with intent on the lead along the back straight, still was being coaxed fighting outside throughout the turn with an inside foe on the front end, had the three path between horses starting to shorten stride by the quarter pole and came up empty folding with runners on both sides in the final furlong.

THREE SONNY SIDEUP shared the rear on the outside initially, advanced along the backstretch closing the gap by the half sitting in midfield, rallied three wide around foes at the five sixteenths pole, posed the main threat in the four path outside the leader at the top of the stretch, wore down rivals one by one in the stretch drive getting a head in front by the sixteenth pole and held sway from a late surging runner up at the finish line. CATHOLIC JACKIE travelled three wide on the outside close to the back, had one beaten while finding its stride with the field very strung out down the backstretch under a brisk pace, took the short way around narrowing the margin on the last bend by the quarter pole, shifted outside in the four path looking for running room turning for home, finally got a clear lane with only a sixteenth of a mile left to run and surged late closing on the winner but could not get there in time. FAST AND READY had the rail position tracking the contesting lead twosome, edged up measuring the front duo closing in while shifting out midway along the far turn, angled to the three-path seizing command in upper stretch, fought determinedly between foes up top until stalling at the sixteenth pole and just held on saving the show money at the wire. AUDAX MINOR was allowed to settle into stride co-trailing on the inside with the eventual winner on the first of two turns, lagged behind the group down the backstretch, began to pick up the bit catching up to an inside rival at the five sixteenths pole, swung out widest in the five path gathering some momentum in with a chance for a piece of the prize but could only finish up gradually, closing in through deep stretch but could not threaten for the win at the wire. SHAMATEUR dueled inside with an unrelenting foe for the first part of this two turn event opening up on the rest of the field down the backside under a lively tempo, still had a slim advantage with the pace slowing down around the far turn, was collared outside in the two path disposing of the speed rival in upper stretch, stubbornly fought back on through the drive but could not find more late due to being softened up early and faded in the final seventy yards losing a couple of positions coming to the wire. BUTTONWOOD TREE battled outside in the early stages with the front pair

in a match race to themselves under an energetic first half, was the first of the lead speed duo to give way in the three path between foes turning for home and faltered running out of gas by the furlong pole. BLONDINA'S BOY travelled two wide outside another tracking the contesting twosome, was hard ridden at the three eighths pole with the pace slowing down but still was going in the wrong direction through the second bend to be last on the fence by the quarter pole and came up empty unable to even pick up even a leg weary rival who was used up fighting for the front end in the beginning.

SUIGU BELLE was away alertly unchallenged on the front end down the backstretch, remained loose on the engine slackening the pace but freewheeling it while in hand around the turn, had company threatening outside at the head of the lane and under a well rated ride had plenty more to offer when called upon at the eighth pole spurting away again to win comfortably at the finish line for the front end tally. WILD RED was forwardly placed sitting back off the lone speed leader along the backside, made no gain chasing the leader throughout the turn, dropped back slightly in the two path losing a position at the top of the lane and fought on smartly having the fence in the final furlong to be resurgent inside late to best the rest for the runners up share. CAYENNE KISS settled on the inside in mid-division down the backstretch, came under a ride at the five sixteenths pole but could not keep up to the lead three on the turn, angled to the four path in upper stretch, found its best stride late closing in the final sixteenth of a mile to get up right at the wire outside for the show money. UNHEARD bobbed on the break, sat outside another in the middle of the pack down the back straightaway, made a bold move circling three wide around horses in midturn, loomed menacingly coming to the pacesetter four wide at the top of the stretch, could not quicken with the leader being repelled by the furlong marker and faded in the late going losing a couple of positions in deep stretch. WUNHAPPY WABBIT broke with the pack but was soon shuffled back void of any early foot spotting the field down the backside, lagged behind off the fence around the oval, passed an inside foe going four wide at the quarter pole, swung out widest in the five path straightening out for the drive but had little to offer outside in the late running. TANZANITE LILY had an awkward start stalking near the back having only one runner beaten in the early going, made little impression around the turn, was at the rear being passed outside at the quarter pole and could not play a factor in the stretch running.

PINE KNOLL moved forward to press the pace from outside, dueled through the turn into upper stretch, edged away in mid-stretch, held. GIVEMEMYTHEMUSIC was in tight altering outside a foe past the five-eighths, raced at the back into the turn just off the inside, came out in upper stretch, was flying late. NAPA SPIRIT (IRE) was urged to the lead setting the early tempo but soon joined by an outside foe, dueled with that one through the turn into upper stretch, lacked the needed late kick. NIAGARA SKYLINE shifted in to the two or three path heading into the turn, stalked the leading pair from off the rail, took aim in upper stretch but only ground on steadily and needed more. ECHO WITH LAUGHTER was under a hold in behind the leader early, saved ground on the turn, came out then back in about the furlong marker, ran on. RED WEAVER shifted in heading into the turn racing between foes

CRUMLIN FASHION was outside three others travelling four deep in the middle of the pack down the backside, cruised three wide well in hand around the turn coming the lead pair outside by the quarter pole, had a head in front three wide with horses on both sides taking the corner, drifted out driving for the lead with a host of challengers at the furlong pole while being encouraged by a right handed crop and under a vigorous ride clinging up top in deep stretch held on getting the head down right at the wire for the gutsy win. TAKE CHANCES made a savvy move saving ground getting to the fence tracking the front pair with a half mile remaining, sat poised behind the engaged leaders waiting for the cue to go on the turn running, shifted to the four path moving closer to be a serious threat at the top of the lane, battled outside of the winner getting floated out fighting for the lead in the final furlong, was inching ever so close coming to the wire but was denied losing the nod right on the line. HOPE SHE FIRES had a head in front on the fence in the beginning, gamely dueled inside going nose to nose up top around the oval, had the inside with others outside bearing down in upper stretch, could not fend off the top two finishers in the last sixteenth of a mile but dug in stubbornly in the final few strides to edge away from a couple of rivals late to collect the show money at the finish line. SUNNYVILLE settled in midfield like many did while in the two path between horses in the early stages, was shuffled back slightly at the five sixteenths pole

losing a bit of momentum, angled to the five path straightening out for the drive, moved back inside three wide at the furlong pole and showed some late interest trying to close for the third place share late but just missing in the end settling on the fringes instead. SERIOUS GREEN prompted the issue outside down the back straight, got on even terms two wide outside midway around the turn arguing up front, vied between rivals at the quarter pole, had the two path still in the hunt in upper stretch, was no match giving way fighting for the win at the sixteenth pole and faded late losing the three way battle between foes for the show award in deep stretch. ALMASTY'S LUST was away slowly spotting the pack at the start, co-trailed on the inside with another at the half, offered a mild run closing the gap on the fence in midturn, scraped paint at the top of the stretch in with a chance for a small share in upper stretch but lacked a finishing rally inside of runners in the final furlong. JAPONKA was unhurried sharing the rear outside with a half mile still to run, could not keep up to the bunch around the turn, angled to the three path for the drive to the finish line but failed to menace only passing a weary foe in the stretch run. BLACK GODDESS was part of the foursome in midfield having the three path between foes midway down the backside, dropped back under to hold losing position three wide at the three eighths marker, shifted out widest in the six path turning for home but had little to offer in the stretch running outside.

NOISY CRICKET had the two path situated closer to the back end with a half mile from the wire, moved closer getting better position inside from the three eighths pole to midturn, was held up by traffic in front briefly until shifting out three wide by the quarter pole, angled to the six path having aim on the pacesetter in upper stretch, was full of run through the lane getting up taking the lead outside by the seventy yard marker and won going away impressively in the end. GLORIOUS REVENGE kept a close eye on the lead pair while inside another down the backside, took the shortest way around the turn closing the gap on the leader smartly at the quarter marker, shifted to the two path in the hunt taking the final corner and had a strong late charge between rivals at the sixteenth pole but was outkicked by the winner outside in deep stretch safely coming in besting the rest for the place award. TEAM ALMASTY was brushed outside leaving the gate, pressed the pace inside with the rider low in the saddle coaxing for more down the backstretch, opened up quickly with the early leader backing away to be loose up top by the three furlong pole, rambled on unopposed through the turn, had the rail still in command by a comfortable margin in mid-stretch, started to get leg weary shortening stride never switching leads surrendering the front end to the winner by the sixteenth pole and still finished up well enough to be a clear third at the wire. ROYAL FONZ veered out at the start, sat widest down the backside stalking four deep in mid-pack with four furlongs still to run, ranged up through the turn going three to four wide outside of horses, had the five path in the mix at the top of the stretch, could not quicken with the outside stablemate charging home at the furlong marker but still ran on mildly in deep stretch lasting for a minor placing at the finish line. MARSHALLTOWN was in tight between horses at the break, settled in the third flight with runners at the half, regressed slightly at the five sixteenths pole even though roused for more, angled to the seven path at the top of the lane and finished up with good intent closing in with seventy yards to go almost getting up for a minor role at the finish line. BETTERMUSTCOME was roused early on but was dropping back lacking early foot stalking close to the tail end having only one runner beaten midway through the backstretch, saved ground but making little impact around the turn, shifted initially to the three path in upper stretch, moved back inside to the fence in the final furlong and had a little interest late passing some runners. METRO KING was squeezed between horses on the start trailing down the backside, lagged behind the group going three wide around the oval, swung out widest in the seven path in upper stretch and could only manage to go by tiring rivals through the lane. A REAL WAR STORY veered out at the break, had the three path ahead of only a couple of challengers along the back straight, made little movement three wide around the bend and could not get involved finishing up one paced in the drive to the wire. SCOTTIE'S BARN had a good spot on the outside tracking the lead duo, offered a sharp rally between foes three wide with a quarter mile from home, had a chance for a small share of the prize in upper stretch but could not find more in the late running and wilted by the sixteenth pole. WILD EYES FOREVER was bumped on the inside on the break, settled in the three path in midfield by the half between horses, travelled three wide but going the wrong way on the turn by the quarter pole, shifted to the five path turning for home and had little to give in the stretch run tiring by the furlong marker. HARD RELOAD broke in at the start, recovered to have a narrow advantage outside down the backstretch, lost the lead two wide by the three-eighths pole, dropped back abruptly between horses through the turn by the quarter pole and was not persevered with on the fence in the final furlong.
