SOUPER STRIDER was unhurried but in a good spot trailing the contesting fivesome down the backstretch, saved ground on the turn starting to commence a run picking up the bit at the quarter pole, moved to the three path possibly going outside for a brief moment at the head of the lane, smartly chose to go back to the rail at the furlong getting a clear run and darted up the fence at the sixteenth pole taking the lead and was kept busy nearing the wire holding on for the win by a nod at the finish line. PADRAIG vied between runners having the three path in the early stages, chased the loose leader while two wide while ridden for more around the bend, angled to the five path in the thick of it all at the top of the stretch, was gaining steadily outside down the lane but could not quicken enough nearing the wire with the winner who had a ground saving trip throughout. KNOWING was nudged on pressing the pace on the fence down the backside, dropped back conceding the rail to the pacesetter with three furlongs from home, waited inside taking the short way around the bend, shifted out coming on at the quarter pole to bid three wide in upper stretch, inched up between foes staying on the incorrect lead at the furlong pole and ran on willingly in deep stretch to capture the show money. BIG LEW had a narrow advantage between runners in an early scramble for the front end, edged away for a clear lead getting to the fence finally by the three eighths pole, rolled along up top with little pressure applied by his closest pursuers on the turn, spurted away briefly just off the fence in upper stretch but could not find more in the late running and was engulfed by runners on both sides in the final sixteenth of a mile to last at the wire only for a minor share. INTERIM ANALYSIS travelled five deep outside rivals part of the early pace scenario down the backstretch, continued an overland journey four wide under a drive just holding position around the oval, swung out widest in the six path for the stretch run but could not factor in the late going. SCREEN SCENE was forwardly placed having the four path between horses in the mix up top along the back straight, travelled three wide tracking the frontrunner with runners still on each side, was the first of the chasing pack to give way by the quarter pole and emptied out in the five path by the furlong marker.

PARTY HOTLINE prompted the pace outside going three deep along the backstretch, travelled two to three wide on the turn measuring the frontrunner inching up when roused at the quarter pole, loomed boldly outside posing the main opposition at the top of the stretch, wore down the inside pacesetter by the sixteenth pole and was kept to the task holding safely for the win at the wire. FRAC'S C E O broke inwards on the start, settled in midfield having a good set up watching the engaged trio down the backside, closed the gap on the lead three when called upon for more on the turn by the quarter pole, swung out widest in the five path finding his best stride late and closed in steadily in the final furlong unable to threaten the winner but still finishing up strongly to be a solid second best. SILENT PAL broke outwards but was quickly corrected leaving the gate, pressed the pace inside early on, was scrubbed for more chasing the leader but was making no gain throughout the turn, shifted out off the cover of the frontrunner three wide by the furlong marker, did not switch leads until late in the drive coming to the seventy yard marker and found another gear surging late getting up for the show award. RED SYMPHONY broke out leaving the gate, recovered to have a slim lead outside two others down the backstretch, shook loose from his closest pursuers at the three-furlong pole, moved well up top dictating the pace throughout the turn, , had the rail holding on up front in mid-stretch, began to get leg weary shortening stride surrendering the lead to the outside winner at the sixteenth pole and tired in deep stretch lasting at the finish line for a minor placing only. FINANCE IS SECURE was sandwiched between horses to trail the field leaving the chute, continued to see the field along the backside, tried to make a run passing an inside rivals at the five sixteenths pole, angled out to the four path for the stretch drive, showed little in the late running and could not get involved under only mild coaxing in deep stretch. C C ATHENA stalked near the rear on the rail having one runner beaten down the backstretch, was relegated to last being passed outside in midturn, caught up to runners making a move three wide in upper stretch, had the two path at the furlong pole still closing in, drove up on heels in tight having no wiggle room behind the weakening early leader in deep stretch, tried to alter course inside at the last minute but caught heels, stumbling and falling unseating the rider nearing the finish line and walked off. CHARMINGLY EVASIVE was urged from the start taking the lead and moving clear to set the pace from just off the rail, was asked in upper stretch, responded and held sway under steady handling. LAKOTA LADY tracked the eventual winner from inside, switched outside that foe coming past the quarter pole three wide and in range, was asked at the top of the stretch but made no headway. PARTY CENTRAL settled off the pace inside, saved ground on the turn and was strongly ridden at the five-sixteenths, kept on in the lane to just get show honors. HEADSPIN was outside off the pace, swung five to six wide for the drive, kept on but missed third. GOLDEN SUNSET broke on top but settled dropping back to last, trailed near the inside, passed a tired rival. BORIKA (IRE) was coaxed forward at the start, chased from outside a foe, went about three wide on the turn and was under urging by the five-sixteenths, steadily weakened.

KEYTOTHEPARK broke a step slow at the start, galloped along under a snug hold finding her feet co-trailing inside another through the backstretch, was let out a notch reaching for more ground at the three eighths pole, shifted out circling around foes four wide at the quarter mile marker, continued to swoop around rivals widest in the six path full of run turning for home and stormed on by at the sixteenth pole outside taking control and winning going away at the wire with an impressive stretch kick. VELOCITA was pushed out by the inside rival at the start, recouped to be forwardly placed three deep early into the backstretch, dropped back slightly at the half sitting in mid-division, started to make a rally three wide at the quarter pole to be in the hunt five wide at the top of the lane, drifted in for moment under right-handed encouragement in upper stretch having be taken a hold of briefly losing momentum for a stride or two, was no match for the winner in the final furlong but did fight back to get up right at the wire in a photo for the runners up share oustdie. SKYDIGGER was the lone speed unchallenged comfortably clearing off getting to the fence by the five eighths pole, rolled along up top having a diminishing advantage by the quarter pole while slowing the tempo down in the turn running, had the two path down the lane holding on still with a furlong to go, offered no resistance when the winner stormed past at the sixteenth pole and just got nabbed outside right at the finish line for the second place share. SANS DANCER broke out at the start, kept a close eye on the frontrunner while in the two path along the back straight, chased two wide narrowing the margin by the quarter pole, moved to the four path straightening out for home in the mix for a share but needed more late fading in deep stretch when on the losing end between foes in a three finish for the third place share. ADORABLE ANGEL was jostled between runners at the start, settled in midfield initially on the outside, stalked inside

another by the half mile pole, offered a mild run two to three wide between horses with outside rivals charging around quicker at the quarter pole, had the two path still in with a chance in upper stretch but idled by the sixteenth pole and could not threaten late. MOMANDA had the inside position in mid-pack in the beginning, closed in advancing smartly on the rail by the half, was driven on having the fence at the five sixteenths pole trying to just hold forward position and failed to menace lacking a rally in the stretch drive. FLY TRUE NORTH was bumped on the inside at the start sharing the rear outside in the early stages, travelled three wide but could not quicken with the eventual winner who was commencing a rally inside at the three-furlong pole, could see the field backing away in midturn, lost touch with the pack in the three path at the top of the stretch and cantered home.

ONE SHOT SCOTT had a head in front on the inside throughout the backstretch, inched away on the turn by the quarter pole with the rider looking to his inside, quickly opened up just off the rail in upper stretch and cruised home in the last furlong under a dominant front end performance. LITTLE LOLA travelled three deep on the outside in mid-pack, dropped back slightly at the half, started to make a rally around foes three wide in midturn, gathered more speed swinging out widest in the six-path straightening out for the drive and closed in belatedly to be a distant second behind the overpowering winner. ILLY had the rail position in midfield, sat poised keeping tabs on the front two around the turn waiting for the cue to move, shifted to the three path posing the only threat to the winner just for a fleeting moment in upper stretch, battled between rivals for the secondary share with the winner long gone by the furlong marker and just got caught outside in deep stretch. BELLALINA broke a step slow on the start, co-trailed on the fence along the backside, travelled two wide inside foes creeping up on the bend by the quarter pole, hugged the rail getting a seam turning for home battled inside for the place share with a furlong from the finish but could only finish up mildly to settle on the fringes. LET IT ALL OUT settled in mid-division along the backside between runners, made no headway still in the middle of the pack under a ride on the turn inside a runner, shifted to the five path between horses at the head of the lane but could not get involved failing to fire in the final furlong. TREASURED MISCHIEF stalked in tandem at the rear with an inside rival, could see the field at the half mile pole, could not make up any ground on challengers through the turn and could only manage to pass a weary runner in the final furlong. C C'S DREAM hounded the frontrunning winner outside along the backstretch and throughout the turn, was roused trying to keep up by the quarter pole, gave way in the fight for the front end four wide by upper stretch and dropped back tiring by the furlong marker.

NICKI KNOWS BEST was coaxed forward from the start with the early lead from just off the rail, was overtaken late on the first turn dropping back between foes to stalk between runners in the second flight, asked for run passing the quarter pole, drove past in late stretch. REAGAN'S FLAME was away alertly getting the early advantage, took back content to sit off the new leader outside down the backstretch, was scrubbed on two wide not wanting the pacesetter to get away any further at the midpoint through the turn, shifted to the four-path closing in to be a menacing presence outside at the top of the lane, wore down a determined frontrunner taking over control by the sixteenth pole and won drawing away smartly at the wire. UPHILL DANCE had a tracking role inside after the break, moved in to assume command on the fence entering the backstretch, dictated a soft pace unopposed at the half, travelled well within herself still loose on the front end around the oval, had company outside while in the two-path straightening out for home, tried to dig in but could not fend off the winners charge by the sixteenth pole and ran on to the end to be a clear second best at the finish line. QUADRUPLE (GB) was well held being a little keen to go after the lead duo early on down the backstretch, settled into a good rhythm by the half keeping a close eye on the front pair, came under a drive two wide in midturn unable to close the gap on the pacesetter, moved out to the five path for the stretch run but could only finish up mildly being a non-threatening third in the end. SCAT GIRL hopped at the break trailing the field while within striking distance along the backside, lagged well the group on the turn running, was asked for more offering little response at the five sixteenths pole and could not factor just off the fence in the stretch drive.

ONTOLOGY was allowed to settle into stride at the back of the pack travelling two wide on the first turn, galloped along unfazed seeing the field down the backside, shifted out getting scrubbed on for more at the five sixteenths pole, had a sharp turn of foot outside foes leaving the quarter pole, swooped around horses widest in the five path at the top of the stretch and was full of run in the drive outside picking off rivals one by one through the lane taking the lead by the sixteenth pole and winning going away at the wire. GO OLIVIA was headstrong behind rivals in the two path entering the first turn, settled down having a good spot on the rail alone watching the engaged trio down the backside on the fence, edged up on the far turn hugging the rail at the quarter pole, shaved the corner in the hunt in upper stretch, chased the winner in earnest home in the final furlong but had to settle for a tie for the runners up share at the finish line inside. FAITH UNDERSTOOD was floated out four wide heading the first turn, advanced in the three path around the initial bend to prompt the pace three deep outside by the half, continued an overland journey still going three wide on the far turn arguing for the lead outside of two others, shifted to the four path at the top of the lane, was in the heat of battle between rivals at the furlong pole, could not match strides with the winner outside late but did surge right at the wire to share for the runners up share outside. EDEY was under a snug hold taking this field on the rail through the first turn, set the pace having a narrow advantage on the fence while pestered by two outside rivals along the backside, continued holding off foes while taking the shortest way around the final bend, had the two path clinging up top with rivals on both sides bearing down and could not find more late fading between rivals in the final sixteenth of a mile to only be a fringe player in the end. SOLO MISSION travelled three wide tracking the frontrunner outside around the first of two turn, sat off the leaders right flank from runners down the backside, continued to apply pressure vying between foes on the second bend, shifted to the three path for the stretch drive but had no finish being outkicked by foes on each side in the final furlong.
