STUNNINGLY PERFECT tossed her head breaking slowly on the start, recovered smartly ranging up on the rail to seize control inside by the half, increased the advantage up top effortlessly cruising around the turn on the rail, skimmed the fence having things all her way turning for home and won as pleased well ahead of rivals when crossing the finish line. FEELING SUPERSONIC was checked on the outside soon after the break with the frontrunner bearing outwards, trailed by many down the backside, lengthened her stride closing the gap on rivals three wide midway through the turn, fought outside another for the runners up prize with the winner far ahead in upper stretch and finished up well enough to be a clear but distant second. RAINBOW TRAIL was away alertly but getting out soon after the break, had command early on in the backstretch off the rail, relinquished the lead inside midway along the backstretch, was nudged on for more at the three eighths pole giving futile chase to the leader around the oval, battled inside for the place share with the winner long gone at the top of the stretch but had little left late folding inside at the eighth pole.

TOP OF D MOUNTAIN was forwardly placed early on in the inside, took back having a nice set up watching the contesting pair by the half, rallied three wide shifting out off the engaged twosome at the quarter pole, loomed boldly outside at the top of the stretch, battled to the wire with a game inside rival but just got the better late, inching away outside for the win at the finish line. SURFSIDE BEACH had a slim lead on the outside initially, battled head to head with an outside foe at the half, saved the ground on the turn narrowly up front from a pesky outside runner, disposed of the early speed rival coming to the stretch, braced for a new challenge outside in upper stretch, stubbornly fought on until the end but gave way grudgingly in the final seventy yards. SYMPATICO hopped on the start, stalked inside another near the rear in the early going, started to make a rally between foes four wide midway around the turn but was checked losing his path in tight at the quarter pole, had the three path looking a seam behind the leaders in mid-stretch and ran on willingly to be a non threatening third. TOO MANY AMYS had an outside stalking trip having one beaten down the backstretch, narrowed the margin three wide in midturn, offered a mild spurt widest in the five path at the quarter pole but could not find more in the stretch run and finished up one paced capturing a minor share in the end. SEATTLE RISING travelled high headed seeing the field down the back straight, lagged well behind the pack making little impression in the turn running, had the two path for the drive and managed to pass a leg weary straggler that was used up in the early stages. HEAD COACH D R hopped on the break to be at the rear leaving the gate, rushed up along the backside on the outside to get a head in front at the half, battled two wide on the outside of another throughout the turn, had enough giving way fighting up top in the two path entering the stretch and emptied out on the rail by the furlong marker.

MOR JOE'S SPIRIT got away alertly, set the pace from just off the rail, shook clear of a brief challenger at the half, held sway under steady handling. AUNTIE'S BAMBINO settled toward the rear inside saving ground on the turn, advanced into upper stretch, came out nearing the sixteenth pole and was gaining but too little too late. STARSHIP SALUTE was forced out at the start but forwardly-placed tracking inside in behind the eventual winner, ran on evenly. CYCLONE TAYLOR got away slowly and in tight, settled at the back, advanced inside a foe but off the rail on the turn, had to alter course veering out seven wide at the quarter pole to avoid contacting a rival in front, ran on in the lane. ATERYA pursued from outside three wide up the backstretch, was forced out and steadied at the quarter pole, faded in the stretch. COPA DE PLATA settled at the back outside, was forced out by a veering foe past the quarter pole ending up ten wide coming to the top of the stretch, failed to rally. FIGHTIN TO SURVIVE broke out and steadied at the start, switched out and was encouraged forward between foes, briefly pressed at the half then chased from outside a rival, came out a bit near the quarter pole, faded in the stretch. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY AS WELL AS AN OBJECTION BY THE RIDER OF ATERYA AGAINST STARSHIP SALUTE ALLEGING INTERFERENCE NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.

THIS DUDE A BREEZE rated kindly nestled on the rail watching the lead duo, continued to have a nice set up isolated tucked behind the contesting trio at the seven sixteenths pole, sat poised on the far turn shifting out at the quarter pole waiting for the cue, pounced in the five path between horses straightening out for home and when asked for more with a furlong remaining drew off impressively for the late running tally. ONENIGHTSTANDARDS hesitated on the break, co-trailed outside going four wide on the beginning bend, made no progression outside down the backstretch, started to lengthen stride when roused three wide at the five sixteenths pole, swung out widest with five abreast turning for home in the conversation up top in upper stretch, was no match for the winner in the final eighth of a mile but still finished up strongly easily besting the rest for the secondary share. DELIAN LEAGUE shared the rear on the inside with the field moving in pairs for the first half, made little progression inside around the last turn, skimmed the fence making a rally at the top of the stretch, switched out off the tiring early leaders at the furlong marker and ran on mildly to be all alone at the wire for the show money. MILITARY FORCE tracked the lead pair outside another in the beginning, edged up three deep along the backside to bid outside the top two at the seven sixteenths pole, travelled widest in the three path battling outside on the final turn, had the four path with runners on both sides in the hunt in upper stretch but faded in the final eighth of a mile to settle on the fringes in the end. SWAN LAKE forced the pace outside going three wide, hounded the leader outside along the back straight, vied between foes fighting on the front end around the final turn, had the three path still in the thick of things turning for home but had little to give late wilting at the furlong marker. ALLEY OOP JOHNNY had the lead just off the rail around the first bend, set a soft pace having a narrow advantage inside down the backstretch, was scrubbed on having outside challengers at the five sixteenths pole clinging onto the lead through the far turn, had the two path inside four others battling up top at the head of the lane but could not find more in the late running and folded on the rail by the furlong pole.

MR. PERFECT emerged with the lead between runners entering the backside, dueled nose to nose with an outside foe up top through the bend, shaved the corner inching away from the pesky early speed foe at the furlong pole, kept busy with a new challenger closing in outside in deep stretch and stubbornly prevailed for the front running score. TRANQUILLO settled in mid-pack early on, took closer order outside keeping a close eye on the engaged twosome at the half, shifted out coming with a run three wide at the quarter pole, angled out widest in the five path in with a shot at the top of the lane, kept grinding away outside down the stretch, closed in late but just missed getting to the winner at the finish line. TONY FROM ANGUS was well held shadowing the pacesetter outside, crept up two wide to be on even terms with the inside rival around the turn on the front end, had the two path trying to get past the winner in mid-stretch but did not have enough late between horses and stalled in deep stretch to be a clear third. LEMON SWEETS pressed the issue inside early down the backstretch, sat off watching the lead duo inside another at the half, could not quicken with the front three rivals midway around the bend and ran on slightly through the lane for a minor placing well back of the front three at the wire. CELESTIAL HEART travelled in tandem with an inside foe at the tail end in the early stages, offered a short lived spurt outside in midturn, shifted to the three path turning for home but failed to menace in the stretch running. STELLA POINT co-trailed on the inside down the backstretch, lagged well behind unable to get into gear in the turn running, lost touch with the group in upper stretch and cantered in never getting involved throughout.

KING KADOOMENT broke a step slowly, advanced inside under some coaxing heading up the backstretch, bid up the rail at the five-sixteenths dueling with the prior leader, was headed by that on in upper-stretch, regained command edging away near the sixteenth pole but was caught late. TUCKAMORE was lightly bumped at the start, moved through inside to take the lead soon after coming out off the rail to dictate terms, faced an inside challenger at the five-sixteenths and was headed by that one, retook the lead by mid-stretch, weakened late. MAGIC POWER rated kindly on the rail in midfield watching the lead quartet, inched closer improving position at the three eighths pole, had a pocket trip on hold watching the embattled duo in front through the turn, shifted to the three path making a bid at the furlong pole and found another gear in deep stretch surging outside the leader late to get up for the gutsy win. ARMSTRONG was quickest out of the gate with rivals pressing outside down the backstretch, continued to roll along setting a lively pace on the rail with a neck in front around the bend, shifted to the two path edging away slightly in upper stretch, still was clinging onto the lead with seventy yards from home but could not fend off the winner anymore and was nabbed outside in the final few strides. ENDRICK was prominent on the outside going four deep near the lead, crept closer to the contesting pair having to go three wide to do so on the bend, loomed a threat outside in the five path at the top of the stretch, was gaining ever so little though with a furlong remaining and just got outkicked in the very late going being on the losing end of a three way win finish. LAZIO had an outside stalking role ahead of one rival down the backside, travelled three wide circling some horses around the oval, moved to the four path still coming on mildly down the stretch and got in the final furlong to be a fringe player in the end. ROI SOLEIL was void of early foot at the tail end well in touch of the compact group down the backside, travelled the shortest way around the turn passing an outside foe at the quarter pole, hugged the rail taking the stretch corner but could only manage to pass a weary foe in the final furlong. QUADZILLA pressed the pace between runners down the backside, chased the frontrunner outside throughout the turn, gave way fighting up top four wide

with runners on both sides in upper stretch and tired by the furlong pole. WILLIAM T settled outside off the leader racing four wide, moved closer late on the far turn, took command in upper- to mid-stretch and drew clear. PERFECTWORKS settled into stride off the pace on or just off the rail, advanced inside foes up the backstretch, shifted out nearing the five-sixteenths, was asked three wide at the quarter pole, reached contention in mid-stretch, was no match for the winner but kept on to get up for second. CATCH THE ACE bumped with a rival at the start and sped clear to set the pace while getting out a bit into the first turn, dictated terms from off the rail up the backstretch, weakened in the lane. LOVER BOY MO trailed along the inside, came out three wide at the top of the stretch, finished willingly but missed show honors. DEPUTY CURLIN bumped with a rival at the start, raced off the pace in the two to three path early, shifted in and saved ground on the far turn, was a bit rank in the stretch and failed to threaten. BRIGHT ANGEL (IRE) was well-placed off the leader switching out on the first turn, stalked three wide up the backstretch, weakened on the far turn coming into upper stretch six wide and came up empty.

FLYONBYE had a nice trip relaxed all alone watching the lone speed pacesetter, started to measure the frontrunner eating away at the leader on the turn by the quarter pole, shifted outside closing in sharply at the furlong pole, took control by the sixteenth pole but still had to stay busy late with the runner up fighting inside until the very end. NAMED FIREY broke sharp clearing from the outer post to get loose up top on the fence by the five eighths pole, increased the margin up top by midturn, had a diminishing advantage on the rail in upper stretch, tried to counter when the winner drove by at the sixteenth pole and was gallant in defeat trying to come back on in deep stretch inside. ANDTHEOSCARGOESTO had the rail keeping tabs on the front pair along the back straight, advanced on the rail on the turn taking closer order to the leader two furlongs from the wire, shifted to the three path straightening out and finished up willingly being a clear but distant third. FIN DEL MUNDO was unhurried at the tail end in the beginning, caught up to the pack sharing the rear inside at the half, made little headway saving ground through the bend and rallied smartly up the fence in mid-stretch to be a fringe player in the end. CHASING MEMORIES had the outside position keeping a close eye on the top two runners along the backside, travelled three wide on the turn narrowing the margin with a quarter mile from home, shifted to the four path turning for home but had little finish when evening out between runners in the final furlong. UP N THE

ANTE settled in midfield three deep at the half mile pole, travelled three to four wide on the bend trying to circle around horses at the quarter marker, angled to the five path in upper stretch but flattened out outside a couple of runners at the furlong marker. YORKSTREET had a stalking role early on having one runner beaten, co-trailed on the outside at the half, dropped back through the turn well behind the group and was empty in the drive never playing a factor down the stretch.
