TIME ZAPPER rated kindly sitting between horses in the middle of the pack down the backstretch, moved closer on the fence while in hand around the turn, shifted out two wide gathering more speed straightening out for home and under mild asking by a left handed tap powered past on the outside at the sixteenth pole taking over and won going away with authority when crossing the finish line. BANKINGONAMIRACLE pressed the lead inside in the beginning, took over control on the rail by the half, shook loose on the turn edging clear comfortably by the quarter pole, hugged the rail still in command at the top of the stretch, offered no resistance when the winner drove past at the sixteenth pole but still finished up strong enough in the late going to easily best the rest for the runners up share. LEAN MUSIC MACHINE was unhurried seeing the field along the back straight, started to come with a run passing an inside foe at the three eighths pole, shifted out further four wide circling rivals at the quarter marker, swung out widest in the five path gaining momentum at the top of the lane and closed in belatedly for the show money. SILVER IS BEST had the rail sitting inside a couple of rivals in midfield early on, was relegated to the rear being passed outside at the three furlong marker, saved ground seeing the field around the bend, skimmed the fence turning for home and managed to pass a couple of outside tired runners at the sixteenth pole to garner a minor placing in the end. SIGNATURE SIR broke sharp but dropped back to be three deep in midfield by the half, travelled three wide outside two others through the bend chasing the frontrunner, angled out to the four path in upper stretch, had no rally to give and wilted between foes in the final furlong. BIG BOLD AND FIRST was hustled early on between foes getting a neck advantage by the five eighths pole, relinquished to front end an inside rival at the half, was roused through the turn with runners on both sides but could not gain on the pacesetter, shifted to the three path for the stretch running but had little to give, folding by the furlong marker.

SPICY BOURBON broke a half-step slowly, was coaxed forward between runners to take the lead and edge clear shifting in to set the pace near but just off the rail, was challenged late up the backstretch, shook clear turning into upper stretch, just held under steady handling. CHOCOLATECROISSANT (IRE) tracked from inside, was ridden along by the five-sixteenths, came out in upper- to mid-stretch bumping a rival in the process, gained steadily on the leader but just missed. REALLY BIG SHOW broke a half-step slowly, tucked in settling at the back in hand off the fence, moved out on the far turn beginning to advance, was five wide past the quarter pole, came into upper stretch eight deep and gaining while drifting in a hair, evened out late and was best of the rest. PAT'S HOLIDAY hopped at the start, shifted in settling near the inside off the pace, made an early advance near the nine-sixteenths moving rapidly between foes and drawing even with the leader by the seven-sixteenths, continued to chase that one from outside, was bumped and forced out in mid-stretch then continued to weaken. CHERVONARUTA stalked from mid-division racing between runners, failed to rally. LITA MARIE had light brushes heading into the first turn while forced out, raced four to five wide settling outside foes mid-pack, fanned seven deep into upper stretch, failed to menace. STRAWBERRY WORLD switched out in the early going brushing the outside rival, had forward positions talking three to four wide, came out six deep at the

top of the stretch, failed to rally. HEART TAP was forced five wide and exchanged light brushes into the first turn, shifted in on the far turn and failed to menace.

CHARGETHATMOUNTAIN was away alertly getting to the front end, edged clear down the backstretch, increased the advantage finally getting to the fence by the half, set an even pace while unopposed through the turn, spurted away further scraping paint taking the stretch corner, began to get leg weary shortening stride still holding at the sixteenth pole, was asking for the wire with a couple of outside runners bearing down late but just had enough to last inside at the finish line. OLIVIA'S MELODY broke out at the start, improved along the backside to sit in midfield by the half, could not quicken with others in midturn travelling three wide, angled out to the five path in upper stretch, did not switch leads down the entire lane, still kept kept on coming nevertheless in the final furlong and just missed between foes getting to the winner who was on fumes at the wire. CLOSING APPEAL settled in midfield inside another, travelled two to three wide on the turn unable to keep up to others by the quarter pole, shifted to the three path entering the lane, angled out four wide getting clear run with a furlong to go finding his best stride late and closed in sharply in deep stretch outside but had to settle for the show award just coming up shy for the win and place share at the wire. SCAT HUMOR shared the back end outside with a half mile still remaining, made an early move three wide at the three eighths pole trying to circle around horses, travelled four wide at the quarter marker still coming on, had the five path in upper stretch in the mix for a piece of the prize, shifted back inside two wide at the furlong pole and ran on only mildly getting outfinished in deep stretch unable to hold for third nearing the wire. BLING D'MONEY HOME had the outside position on another foe in the second flight watching the pacesetter, inched closer going three wide around the oval at the quarter pole, posed a threat making a bid in the four path turning for home but could not find more in the late drive and flattened out between rivals at the sixteenth pole. RELOAD BABA was allowed to settle into stride at the tail end having the fence in the beginning, shared the back with an outside foe at the half mile marker while tugging on the rider in the process, took the short way around the turn but was unable to keep up by the quarter pole, shifted out off horses to be widest in the five path in mid-stretch, closed ground on the winner like many did with the pace slowing down

considerably late but could not get involved at the wire though. OOKPIK was hard held on the rail watching the frontrunner early on, had to be checked slightly shifting outside off the leader at the half, travelled two wide on the bend but was going in the wrong direction chasing the frontrunner by the quarter pole, emptied out on the fence by the furlong marker and was eased up when crossing the finish line

NAUGHTY DESTINY assumed the lead under a snug hold down the backstretch, rolled along setting an even tempo uncontested throughout the bend, moved strong in the two path in upper stretch and had plenty left late holding well for the frontwinning win. MISTY EYED was hustled from the get go settling between runners tracking the leader while in the second flight, had to be checked out in tight with runners on both sides at the seven sixteenths pole, kept pace isolated in mid-division around the oval, shifted to the four path full of run in the late stretch drive, could not get to the winner who had things her own way up top throughout but did show grit still getting the nod for the runners up position between rivals at the wire. SOCIETY'S KAT had a poor beginning, hesitated then hopped up on the start trailing the field, advanced smartly outside of runners along the backside, closed the gap while widest circling foes four wide at the quarter pole, angled to the five path having clear run in the drive and rallied late just missing out on getting up outside for the place share showing a solid effort considering the break. ONDINE LADY was fractious behind the gate prior the start, had the rail being checked briefly coming up to the

pacesetter at the nine sixteenths pole, sat poised measuring the leader on the turn, remained on the fence in the mix at the top of the lane, drifted out considerably under left handing asking from the sixteenth pole to the seventy yard marker and faded late losing the three way duel for second at the finish line. ZIPPY GAMBLE broke with the group but dropped back outside through the backstretch to be in last place at the half mile marker, co-trailed two wide outside another in the turn running, swung out widest in the six path at the head of the lane but could not get into contention, passing only a troubled rival in deep stretch. CRUMLIN TROUBLE pressed the issue early on the outside, tracked the frontrunner three deep by the half, remained close going two wide with the leader in her sights while keeping pace on the turn, shifted to the three path in hunt straightening out for the stretch run, idled by the sixteenth pole between horses, had to be checked with the inside rival bearing out coming up to the seventy yard marker and could not factor afterwards. BRAVO KATE was all alone sitting in midfield down the backside, retreated through the turn while two wide at the quarter pole, moved to the three path turning for home but had little to give in the stretch running. NO WHAMMIE settled on the rail near the rear having only one beaten at the half, took the shortest way around the bend seeing the field in tandem with an outside foe, swung out to the five path for the stretch run but failed to menace in the drive to the wire. STEWARDS INQUIRY THROUGH THE STRETCH RUN IN THE VICINITY OF THE SEVENTY YARD MARKER RESULTED IN #1 ONDINE LADY BEING DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED SIXTH FOR INTERFERENCE ON #7 CRUMLIN TROUBLE

SIPPING HISTORY was forwardly placed outside keeping a close eye on the front twosome down the backstretch, started to come with a rally three wide with a quarter mile from home, shifted out to the four path coming on at the top of the lane and determinedly wore down a stubborn frontrunner inside just before the wire for the hard earned victory. RULE THE WAVES bobbled a touch on the break, quickly recouped on the fence to be on the engine by the half, zoomed along with no challengers opening up on the turn setting a rapid pace in the process, kept finding more on the rail in mid-stretch holding onto the lead but could not fend off the relentless pursuit by the winner outside in the final sixteenth of a mile just getting nabbed in the shadow of the wire for the win. EPISODE had runners on either side while in mid-division along the backside, was roused trying just to keep up on the turn, started to get into gear two wide by mid-stretch, moved to the three path off a tiring rival at the sixteenth pole and with a solid late run got up for third but could not threaten the front pair at the finish line. VEGAS ROAD was fleet footed between horses having the lead in the beginning, let the inside rival go on with it surrendering the front end by the half, gave futile chase on the frontrunner under a brisk tempo around the bend, had the two path in with a chance for a share in upper stretch but stalled with a furlong remaining and lost a couple of positions late settling on the fringes in the end. ARTFUL DIAMOND had the rail position in midfield midway down the back straightaway, ran on evenly keeping pace around the oval, continued the inside trip shaving the corner in upper stretch but lacked a finishing kick inside others in the final furlong. DEFINITE DIVA had no early speed lagging behind the pack down the backside, saved ground while still well behind runners throughout the turn, started to pick up the bit lengthening her stride in upper stretch, moved out widest getting a clear lane at the furlong pole and closed in quickly in the final eighth of a mile but could not factor outside of foes at the wire. ROSE FORTUNE travelled in the middle of the pack three deep outside of rivals, continued the overland route making little headway while going three to four wide around the bend, shifted to the five path at the top

of the lane but had no rally to offer in the stretch running.

NILE PASSAGE utilized the inside post dictating the pace on the first turn, continued up top while hounded outside slowing the tempo down the back straight, opened up through the far turn getting a breather in the third split with no pressure being applied from her closest pursuers, had company outside while having the fence in upper stretch and under a vigorous ride inside had more late to repel the challenge through deep stretch. RIDEAU FALLS had a

good spot tucked in on the fence drafting behind the frontrunner, moved out to the three path entering the backstretch, opted to go back to the rail again following the leader at the half, crept closer cruised up by the quarter pole shifting outside, loomed boldly in the three path in mid-stretch, fought on to the very end outside but could not get by the stubborn winner at the wire. DANISH COOKIE had runners on both sides while in midpack for the first half of this two turn event, started to narrow the margin two wide on the far turn with a quarter mile from home, had the two path still battling for the show money with the front pair having it to themselves up top in the final furlong, veered out under left handed encouragement driving to the wire in the heat of battle late around the sixteenth pole and just prevailed inside capturing third place. FULLY COMPLETELY settled in midfield while four wide around the initial bend, made little progression four deep along the backside, continued a four wide journey on the final turn making mild gain in the leader, fought on between rivals for the third place share at the furlong marker well back of the front duo who were in a race of their own by then, was bumped by the inside runner getting out in deep stretch and settled for a minor role losing the nod for show at the finish line. DON'T SAY A WORD broke slowly, tossing its head veering out then was snatched up briefly trailing in the beginning, shared the rear outside a couple of runners down the backstretch, closed the gap going two wide through the last bend at the quarter pole, duelled outside two rivals while in the four path at the furlong pole for the show award, was brushed inside losing some momentum late and could not recover in time to factor for a small share at the wire. RACE DAY CHANCE was antsy in the gate just before the break, hopped up at the start having only the other troubled starter beaten in the early going, remained part of the back trio inside two others on the rail at the half, as relegated to solo last by the quarter pole taking the shortest route through the far turn, skimmed the fence turning for home and had some interest late passing tired rivals. MAXIMUM REACTION settled close to the back while going five wide on the first corner, co-trailed outside down the backstretch, had a mild spurt three wide at the three eighths pole, was fanned out four wide at the quarter marker giving way and in the five path could not be a factor in the stretch running. TOAST THE GHOST was content to shadow the pacesetter outside in the early stages, was driven on trying to hold position between runners tracking the leader on the far turn, shifted out to the five path but came up empty by the top of the lane yielding to rivals. FLIGHTMARE was restless in the stall prior to the start with the rider having to get off briefly, travelled six wide sitting back outside the lead duo on the first of two turns, dropped back entering the backstretch, ranged up again four deep by the half, chased the pacesetter four wide midway around the final bend, had enough by the quarter pole and folded widest in the seven path in upper stretch. RIDERS CLAIM OFFFOUL #7 FULLY COMPLETELY AGAINST #5 DANISH COOKIE THROUGH THE STRETCH RESULTED IN #5 DANISH COOKIE BEING DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED FOURTH FOR INTERFERENCE
