H C GAMBLE prompted the pace at the start, smartly took back off the engaged pair having a tracking role with runners on either side at the half mile pole, had the rail in the second flight waiting for the cue to go throughout the bend, was aching for running room skimming the fence turning for home, darted between rivals in the two path finding a seam at the furlong pole quickly taking the lead and held safe at the wire from a late oncoming foe. GOLD DRAGON was unhurried sharing the rear inside another, was urged on coming to the half trying to get inside position before the bend, had to drop back unable to quicken into the turn, started to pick up the bit at the quarter pole, loomed widest in the five path at the top of the lane but was outkicked by the winner in the late going besting the rest for the runners up share instead. MOLLY'S CORNER had a slow start, improved inside rivals through the chute to get a head in front on the fence by the half, continued having a slim lead inside around the oval, shaved the corner still holding on in upper stretch, was asking for the wire clinging up top with a host of outside foes bearing down with a furlong from home but could not fend off rivals late and faded at the sixteenth pole lasting for a clear third at the wire. MR BOND setting in midfield three deep outside a couple of runners, had the second flight outside the eventual winner chasing the contesting twosome around the bend, closed the gap at the quarter pole making a bid shifting out to the four-path turning for home, stalled at the furlong pole fighting for the win but did win the duel of the stablemates outside for a minor award. IRON WEAWE narrowly had the front between runners in the early going, battled on the outside around the bend, shifted to the three path in the mix in upper stretch but had little left for the drive and weakened at the sixteenth pole. ASTRAL broke a step slow, co-trailed on the outside down the backstretch, was roused at the half seeing the field offering little response, lagged well behind the group in the turn running, lost touch at the head of the lane and cantered down the stretch crossing the finish line.

MAGIC MODIE was under a snug hold having the early advantage, let the outside rival making a move go on with it early through the first turn, had a good spot watching the loose leader on the fence midway down the back straight, had to be put on hold getting throttled down on the inside from the three eighths marker to the seven sixteenths pole, rallied with a sharp turn of foot when asked midway along the final turn, shifted out three wide with a crisp move around foes at the quarter pole, gathered more speed in the four path straightening out for the drive, seized control getting a head in front at the furlong marker and held safe at the wire for the stretch running win. PURRFECT GIRL broke out but was quickly corrected at the start, had tight quarters three wide on the first turn having to be checked at the three quarters pole, trailed down the backside, closed the gap but could not gain position at the half, circled strongly three wide at the five sixteenths pole, angled to the four path in upper stretch coming on, threatened three wide at the furlong pole but could not get to the winner late being just second best on this day. TWISTING PISTONS had the outside sitting in mid-division, improved entering the backstretch to track the loose leader outside the eventual winner, continued to close in dueling three wide outside going head-to-head up front going into the last bend, edged clear briefly at the quarter pole, had company on both sides just holding on two wide in upper stretch, could not keep up relinquishing the lead to the winner outside by the eighth pole but did show some late grit digging in late to just last at the finish line for the show award. AUSSIE HYPER had the rail position sitting in mid-pack, settled inside two others in the third tier early down the backside, pulled the rider up the fence to battle for the front end by the seven sixteenths marker, threw it down with an outside foe around the last turn, came under a drive but was giving way slightly up top at the quarter pole, resurged when scraping paint at the top of the stretch and fought on gamely inside down the lane but gave way slightly in deep stretch to settle for a minor share only in the end. TALENT SHOW was near the rear between foes being checked slightly on heels briefly midway along the initial turn, remained close to the back end with runners on both sides along the back straight, started to pick up the bit at the three-furlong marker, could not match strides with the eventual winner on the outside leaving the quarter pole and faded in the three path by the furlong marker. MRS. HOT SHOT was brushed by the inside foe on the start, travelled four wide outside foes in midfield on the first of two bends, remained outside three deep in the third flight down the backstretch, was scrubbed on

but could not quicken with others commencing a run while three wide at the three eighths marker and came up empty running just off the fence through the lane. PICKFORD SWEET travelled five wide on the outside of runners heading into the first, circled foes to seize command by the three quarters pole crossing over to the rail, was loose up top down midway down the backstretch, offered no resistance surrendering the lead being engulfed by runners on both sides by the seven sixteenths pole, dropped back steadily between foes in the far turn running and could not factor onside in the stretch drive.

SUPER SICILY was lightly bumped into a rival at the start, pressed the pacesetter from outside in hand, moved willingly to the lead at the top of the stretch, was asked for more at the three-sixteenths, was in command in mid-stretch and held. RETAIL THERAPIST was lightly bumped at the start, tracked inside the second flight saving ground on the turn, came out at the three-sixteenths, gained late but missed. SWEET FUSION settled mid-pack off the inside, came out five then seven wide in upper stretch under urging, needed more. EARENDEL was bumped at the break, stalked from outside the second flight, moved to challenge in upper stretch drawing nearly even at the three-sixteenths but evened out late. HARD TO CAPTURE bumped a rival at the start, settled at the back inside, saved ground on the turn, came out eight wide in the stretch, ran on. LAINEY bumped a rival lightly at the start, set the pace inside shadowed by the winner, was asked past the five-sixteenths, yielded in the stretch. ROCKET RILEY was brushed at the start, settled outside at the rear, swung six wide into upper stretch then shifted in.

VANITY travelled three deep in midfield in the beginning, took closer order outside to shadow the engaged pair at the five eighths pole, made a strong move three wide outside in midturn arguing for the lead, shifted to the four path going head to head with a stubborn frontrunner in upper stretch, stayed on the incorrect lead throughout the stretch battle but did get the better of the stubborn inside foe inching away for the win at the wire. FANCY PEARLS had a narrow lead inside early on, edged away momentarily at the half, had company in the form of two stablemates bearing down outside midway along the turn, still kept a head in front at the quarter pole, dueled in the two path inside another in upper stretch, did not switch leads on the rail throughout the entire drive but still fought on gamely until the end but just missed at the wire in a thrilling stretch finish. FURY'S FLIGHT veered out sharply having to be snatched up for a moment by the rider, co-trailed inside another in the chute, was hard held very headstrong behind rivals from the half mile marker to the seven sixteenths pole, shifted to the two path coming with a good move having clear run at the five sixteenths pole, reached for even more ground three wide at the quarter pole, swung out widest in the six path for the stretch drive, could not get to the front duo who had a race to themselves in the last eighth of a mile but did finish up strongly late to capture the show award in deep stretch. GOLDLEAF was bumped on the break by the inside runner settling on the rail in mid-division in the early going, narrowed the margin along the backside nestled just behind the pacesetter at the half, was nudged on for more saving ground in midturn but the lead twosome was getting away, shifted to the three path making a brief move getting up to the third place share at the head of the lane, could only finish up evenly while being roused for more late and just got nabbed outside coming to the wire having to settle on the fringes instead. ABDUL co-trailed on the outside down the back straightaway, was hard ridden going three wide on the turn making no gain outside rivals throughout, shifted to the four path turning for home but could only manage to pass a weary foe inside by the sixteenth pole. SUGAR BUNNY prompted the pace outside in the beginning, dropped back a touch at the half, re-engaged vying between foes at the five sixteenths pole for the lead, was the first of the lead threesome giving way up top by the quarter pole and had little to offer down the stretch tiring on the rail by the furlong marker. GOLDEN SUNSET settled in midfield with rivals on either side, was relegated to the back trio between horses at the half, could see the field midway around the oval and had little to show in the

stretch running on the rail.

BACHELOR PAD emerged from the pack leaving the chute having a head in front, edged clear at the half, moved well in hand with the rider sitting chilly unchallenged around the bend, had the rail with an outside foe coming on at the top of the stretch, was headed outside at the furlong pole but kept finding more when called upon and prevailed inside for the frontrunning tally. FRACEN MACHO had a nice set up on the fence keeping a close eye on the front pair, sat poised drafting behind the pacesetter on the fence throughout the turn, shifted out two wide at the quarter pole, posed the only threat outside at the top of the lane, fought on determinedly outside in the final furlong but just could not get by the tenacious winner. BREAKING ALONE broke with the field but lacked early foot trailing the group along the backside, continued to see the field around the bend but was narrowing the margin when asked for more angling out three wide at the quarter pole, swung out widest gathering momentum in upper stretch and closed in belatedly to be a distant third on the outside. POSEIDON STEEL had the rail position sitting near the rear, was nudged along for more taking the shortest way around the bend closing the gap by the quarter pole, had the two path in the mix at the top of the stretch, shifted inside to the rail for the last furlong but was nabbed outside just before the wire losing the show award. PERFECT CRIME had the two path down the backside having only one runner beaten, made little impression two wide along the oval, angled out to the three-path taking the corner and had some late interest inside pass a few tiring outside foes in the final furlong. INDIAN PEAK

was brushed inside on the break, settled on the outside in midfield travelling three deep, took closer order outside rivals but had to go three to four wide to do so, moved to the six path in upper stretch but could not sustain the rally and idled outside in the last eighth of a mile. SUMMER COMMANDER forced the issue on the outside down the backstretch, chased the frontrunner two wide between horses in vain midway around the turn and emptied out giving way in the four path in upper stretch. LAST AMERICAN EXIT broke out at the start, was forwardly placed outside tracking the lead twosome, edged up through the turn to be in striking distance three wide at the quarter pole, shifted out to the five path between runners in with a chance for a piece of the prize turning for home but could not offer a finish in the final furlong folding between runners late.

EL COHETE advanced outside foes four wide on the turn, came into upper stretch five deep, fought on for place late without threatening the winner. SHADOW REALM got away slowly when a bit unprepared for the start, unhurriedly brought up the rear, angled six wide for the drive, kept on outside but missed second. UNCAPTURED MOMENT stalked the leaders in behind racing between foes late on the turn, was bumped in upper stretch, kept on. LITTLE TEDDY broke a step slow seeing the field leaving the gate, moved inside two others getting better tactical position at the half, began to smoothly lengthen stride on the fence in hand closing in smartly midway along the turn, scraped paint making a bid for the lead having a big gap inside turning for home, seized control under a busy hand ride only at the furlong marker and was kept to the task in the late going safely holding for the win while under a snappy clocking. DOLCE FORTUNA was away alertly loose up top clearing to the rail by the seven sixteenths pole, freewheeled unopposed setting a brisk pace throughout the turn, drifted out to the three path still up front at the head of the lane, could not quicken as much as the winner inside surrendering the lead at the furlong pole but did show some resiliency fighting back late but just could not get threaten for the win at the finish line while comfortably besting the rest for the runners share. SINCLAIRITY was allowed to settle into stride outside foes with a half mile still to run trailing the pack, edged up getting to the rail following the path of the eventual winner around the turn, was in the conversation briefly skimming the fence at the top of the stretch, could not keep up to the lead pair by the furlong pole but still finished up willingly to be a clear but non-threatening third. OLIVIA ROSE advanced on the fence down the backstretch sitting just behind the leader at the half, shifted outside at the seven sixteenths pole, chased the pacesetter two wide on the outside throughout the turn, moved to the four path in the mix straightening out for home but faded in the final furlong just holding on for a minor placing inside at the finish line. FORESTERS EXEC settled close to the back end between horses at the half, travelled in the two path offering little around the bend to be in the last place position by the quarter pole, moved out three wide for the stretch running and had good late energy trying to close in for a small share but just missed with one final surge in the last jump at the finish line outside. HOME FOR A REST tracked the frontrunner outside three deep, took the outside route three wide regressing outside horses around the bend, swung out widest in the five path at the top of the lane but lacked a rally in the stretch running. ALPHA GAMMA GIRL settled between rivals watching the lone speed runner down the backstretch, was hard ridden two wide through the turn just trying to hold position,

shifted to the four-path turning for home but had little left to give in the drive and yielded between foes in the last furlong.

MONEY HEIST bumped a rival at the start, pressed from outside, struck the lead outside the five-sixteenths, moved clear in upper stretch, was outkicked. ALEATORIC was bumped at the start, settled off the pace shifting in up the backstretch, advanced inside on the turn, came out a path or two for the drive, kept on and just missed second. MY TURN NOW broke a step slowly, settled last but one along the inside, was encouraged along three furlongs out, came out in the stretch four to five deep and had good late effort. ONCE UPON A KISS pressed from between runners, dropped back on the turn, came out six wide for the drive, ran on evenly. MISS BRIT broke a step slowly,

raced outside at the rear, passed tired rivals. IVY'S MISSION was coaxed to the lead, set the pace inside, gave way. HURRICANE AMELIA chased from off the inside, dropped back and faded.
