FRAC IS THE JUDGE settled near the rear on the fence down the backside, shifted out two wide off a tiring foe at the five sixteenths pole, moved to the three-path starting to get into gear between horses in upper stretch and was full of run in the final furlong charging strongly outside late under a well-timed rally to just get up at the wire. ATLANTIC PASSAGE vied between runners at the start, was reined back off the engaged duo at the half mile marker, kept pace with the frontrunner while two wide on the turn, appeared to be the main threat closing at the furlong pole, was coming on smartly with a sixteenth remaining but lost the nod for the win with runners on both sides at the finish line. TWIST OF SUGAR was hustled three deep at the break having a slim lead in the beginning, cleared off getting to the rail loose on the engine by the seven sixteenths marker, rolled along unopposed around the bend, had the rail at the top of the stretch getting a slight breather in the second split, was asking for the wire hearing outside runners bearing down at the sixteenth pole but was nabbed at the finish line to be on the losing end of a three way win picture. KIMBERLINA settled on the outside close to the tail end, moved in gradually while going three wide outside rivals through the turn, shifted to the four path for the stretch drive and finished up evenly in the final eighth of a mile garnering a minor placing. GREENWICH PIKE was outrun early seeing the field along the back straight, lagged behind travelling two to three wide around the oval, swung out widest in the five path turning for home but could only manage to pass the leg weary inside foe at the sixteenth pole. ASTONESTHROWAWAY pressed the early pace on the inside, could not match strides giving way arguing up front by the seven sixteenths pole, took the shortest way around the bend but was going in the wrong direction by the quarter marker and folded on the fence in the last furlong.

IDEOLOGIST was away alertly having the lead on the rail while allowed to set a very soft pace early down the backside, quickened the tempo mildly while having little pressure applied through the turn, shifted to the two path having things quite in control by upper stretch and was kept interested in the late going to come home comfortably for the gate to wire score. HARD RIGHT was brushed inside on the break settled close to the back having only one runner beaten down the back straight, ranged up smartly three wide in hand around the turn, moved to the four-path posing the only opposition at the head of the lane, stayed on the incorrect lead chasing the winner in vain throughout the stretch drive but still finished up strong enough to easily best the rest for the runners up position at the wire. BONGINO WARRIOR travelled three wide on the outside in the mix down the back straightaway, edged up still going three wide outside foes on the turn making a bid for the lead briefly at the quarter pole, had the three path in upper stretch, drifted inwards under right-handed encouragement to be on the rail at the furlong pole and ran on mildly holding onto the third place share by a diminishing margin when crossing the finish line. SUPER TOM broke a step slow at the start trailing down the backstretch, shared the rear catching up to an outside rival by the half, closed the gap between horses on the turn, swung out widest in the five path at the head of the lane and was making gradual gains outside through the stretch drive to be a fringe player in the end. HAPPY TO BE HERE broke out at the start, tracked the loose leader between horses in the early stages, took closer order prompting the pace at the half, remained in the mix vying between foes on the bend, could not keep up to others by the quarter pole losing ground, moved to the three path at the top of the stretch, had clear run in the final furlong but showed little in the drive to the wire. FOREVER FROSTY was keen on the fence drafting behind the pacesetter having to be throttled down by the rider on a few occasions down the backstretch, waited on the turn following the winner taking the shortest way around, scraped paint moving into contention taking the corner but failed to fire in the final furlong.

FIGHTER IN THE WIN pressed the issue on the inside, edged away getting the advantage at the half, remained up top on the fence narrowly around the bend, had the two path inside the only opposition for the winners share at the top of the lane, determinedly kept finding more in the stretch battle shrugging off the outside rival by the furlong pole and pulled away in deep stretch for the gutsy win. LASKAY had a head in front outside in the beginning, relinquished the top spot opting to hound the new leader at the half, sat contently outside on the pacesetters flank separating themselves from the group in the turn running, shifted to the four path with only the inside rival to beat straightening out for home, did not switch leads through the entire stretch drive still fighting on admirably at the furlong pole but conceded to the winner in the final seventy yards. FRIENDLY GHOST was unhurried at the rear early on, started to pick up the bit shifting out three wide at the quarter pole, moved to the four path for the stretch running and closed in belatedly outside in the final furlong getting up to be a distant third at the wire. MOHAYMEN DIAMOND tracked the top duo down the backside in tandem with another rival inside, was hard ridden two wide outside unable to make any gains on the embattled twosome throughout the turn, shifted to the three path at the head of the lane battling between rivals in mid-stretch for the show money share but weakened inside in the final sixteenth of a mile having to settle for a minor role instead. TUX had a slow beginning trailing at the start, rated kindly on the inside of another in the second flight watching the lead pair down the backside, was scrubbed on for more in midturn with the front twosome opening up, skimmed the fence turning for home but tired by the furlong pole.

TRACTION PARK had the lead inside from the stablemate, edged away getting to the rail around the bend, moved smoothly in the two path well in control from his pursuers taking the final corner, was kept to the task in the last furlong with the outside rival relentlessly chasing down the stretch and just held on at the wire for the front-running tally. SECURED ASSETS had a good spot on the fence all alone watching the engaged duo early down the backside, was nudged on to go after the lone leader midway through the turn, shifted out three wide making his presence felt on the frontrunner outside in upper stretch, kept fighting on chipping away in the final furlong at the winner's advantage but just missed closing in at the finish line. VERGE was on the outside near the rear having only the troubled starter beaten, moved in three wide through the bend taken closer order sharply by the quarter pole, continued to make a good rally looking for a clear lane in the three path turning for home, switched leads at the furlong pole within aim of the front pair but finished up only evenly in deep stretch to be a clear third at the wire. CHARLATAN SUCCESS had the outside position while sitting in midfield, travelled three to four wide on the bend closing the gap by the quarter pole, swung out widest in the six path at the top of the stretch, drifted inwards slightly coming to the furlong marker making a mild run and finished up evenly in deep stretch for a minor placing. WINCHESTER ROAD prompted the barn buddy on the outside in the early stages, chased the frontrunner two to three wide on the turn making little headway, shifted to the five path in upper stretch still in the mix for a piece of the prize, had some trouble between horses shying from the inside foe and then brushed as well by the outside rival coming to the furlong pole and fading in the late going. ALOHA KITTY settled close to the back inside down the backstretch, made no progression around the oval, moved out to the three-path turning for home but could not make any impression in the stretch running. WORTHY PARK travelled on the inside sitting in midfield, regressed on the fence around

the bend, hugged the rail at the top of the stretch but could not get involved in the stretch drive. CANDY FACTORY broke outwards hitting the gate hard at the start understandably trailing the field down the backside, lagged well behind the group around the turn, lost touch with the pack by the top of the stretch and galloped on in.

PARAMOUNT PRINCE had the rail setting a slow pace in the beginning, sat all alone up top quickening the pace slightly settling into a good rhythm down the backside, remained on the fence being let out a notch starting to speed up the tempo on the turn with rivals trying to bear down outside at the quarter pole, was finally set down in upper stretch under a well rationed out ride playing coy when spurting away sharply at the furlong pole having plenty left in reserve and won going away for the wire to wire score. WICKED DJANGO had the rail co-trailing on the inside, was under a snug hold at the rear entering the backstretch, crept closer on the fence by the half, moved inside at the three furlong pole coming with a good rally, shifted out at the five sixteenths pole being tapped on the shoulder going after the leader, loomed three wide outside for a fleeting moment turning for home posing a threat but was repelled by the winner who had the run of the race by the furlong pole while still finishing up smartly to easily be second best. RAPID TEST shared the rear outside going two wide on the initial bend, ranged closer in the three path outside foes with the group bunching up at the half, travelled four wide being pushed out slightly midway on the last turn just trying to keep up, was no match to the lead pair who had their own separate race in the final furlong but did show grit to win the duel for the third place prize outside in deep stretch. SAUGEEN was content to sit outside off the pacesetter around the first of two turns, had his head cocked to the outside looking uncomfortable chasing the frontrunner down the backstretch, could not hold forward position three wide on the second bend between foes by the quarter pole, shifted to the rail for the drive to the wire but faded inside in the last eighth of a mile losing the battle for the show award.

KING'S COUNSEL bumped with a rival at the start, settled off the rail mid-division, edged closer in behind the leaders on the turn, moved out six to seven wide turning for home, was asked in upper stretch, struck a narrow lead in mid-stretch, drifted in then out but held under steady handling. LONGSHOT LEO chased from between runners in the second flight to midway on the turn then nearer the rail inside rivals, moved out a path in upper stretch, made a mild bid in mid-stretch between foes, fought on to get the place. SOUPER SURVIVOR chased from between runners early then outside foes late up the backstretch, was ridden along three wide between foes nearing the five-sixteenths, made a mild bid near the furlong grounds, was outfinished for both win and place. IT WASN'T A BLUFF settled outside dropping back to the rear, went three to five wide on the turn and stretch, was gaining late. LOGAN'S THUNDER broke outwardly then was coaxed to the lead and clear, set the pace inside, gave way in mid-stretch. FORZA was close up outside the second flight early, dropped back a bit up the backstretch settling off those rivals, advanced four wide on the turn, could not sustain the effort and flattened out in the lane. SILENT KEY lacked early speed having switched out off the rail, went two wide on the turn, came out a bit in the stretch, was never near enough to threaten. SWEET BORDEAUX caught a flyer on the outside quickly crossing over clearing to the rail with ease from the outer post heading into the backstretch, rolled along unopposed down the back straight, comfortably dictated the pace on the front end having the fence around the bend, spurted away when asked for more two wide at the head of the lane and drew off with authority in the final eighth of a mile having plenty left late with an impressive 'catch me if you can' showing. ZAHARI broke in at the start, sat forwardly placed three deep keeping aim on the lone speed leader down the backstretch, was shuffled back slightly outside foes at the half, offered a good turn of foot circling four wide midway around the turn, had a sharp burst coming on at the quarter pole to threaten the winner outside two to three wide taking the corner, was no match though by the furlong pole but still finished up solidly to be a clear second best at the wire. MARCH settled with runners on either side having the two path keeping tabs on the front foursome, was scrubbed along keeping pace

basically throughout the turn, shifted to the four path with a chance for a piece of the prize straightening out for home and finished up willingly outside another in the last furlong getting up for the show money late. MARIA SOFIA chased the frontrunner outside down the backstretch, was roused two wide on the turn not letting the leader get away, had to be checked while two wide in tight losing its path from the outside runner turning for home, shifted out three wide for clear run at the furlong pole, dug in late inside battling for third but was just outkicked in deep stretch taking a minor share instead. REDEMPTON SONG was forced in by the outside rival on the break, stumbled badly possibly clipping heels at the five eighths pole, trailed at the half trying to find her footing again, picked up outside runners coming on two wide at the five sixteenths pole, shifted out looking for a seam in upper stretch, had clear run finally in the seven path by mid-stretch and finished up with good intent in the final furlong. WILLING GUEST broke out on the start, had only a few foes beaten just off the rail in the backstretch running, made little impact going two wide around the bend, angled out sharply making a brief run seven wide narrowing the margin at the top of the stretch but could not rally in the final furlong finishing up one paced in the late going. CHAMPAGNE SUNDAY was bumped by the inside runner at the start, had the three path near the tail end between horses down the backstretch, travelled four wide making a gradual move outside foes in midturn closing the gap slightly by the quarter pole, was pushed out to the eight-path turning for home and could only pass tired runners down the lane. AWESOME GRACE was eager at the five eighths pole pulling the rider closer to sit just back off the lead trio at the half, had the fence being nudged on for more travelling just behind the pacesetter on the turn, scraped paint in the mix at the top of the stretch, dueled inside others for third place share at the furlong pole but yielded to runners in the last sixteenth of a mile. TUSCANY ROSE veered in soon after the leaving the gate having to be taken hold of briefly trailing in the beginning, improved on the rail to mid-pack by the half, saved ground through the turn hard ridden just to hold position, moved back to the rail in mid-stretch but wilted inside rivals in the last furlong. BANDOLIER stayed in touch with the front pair while three deep down the backstretch, was spurred on three wide around the bend at the five sixteenths pole being forced to move holding forward position from the outside runner who was making a rally, had to be checked briefly in tight from the pressure of the outer rival at the quarter pole and could not recover to be a factor afterwards. HONOR MY LEGACY had one runner beaten while four deep outside midway down the backstretch, made no impact three wide around the oval relegated to last by the quarter pole, swung out widest in the nine path for the drive to the finish line but had little to offer only passing a weary straggler in the stretch run. WHITEMUDWEST settled between rivals in midfield by the half, came under a drive three wide on the turn being passed on both sides by runners at the quarter pole, shifted to the seven path in upper stretch and emptied out at the furlong pole. SCORCHING was allowed to settle then rapidly advanced willingly and in hand to force the pace taking the lead at the half, soon moved clear and shifted in dictating terms inside, was asked in upper stretch, responded to draw clear in mid-stretch, was much the best while kept to the task. DARK SCREEN faced mild traffic altering out a path then back in at the five- and one-half, settled mid-pack tracking the leaders, saved ground on the turn, kept on up the rail in the stretch to get up for second. PAYNES SPIRIT settled in behind just off the leading pair, advanced three wide on the turn, kept on in the lane to get the nod for show honors just failing to secure place. CARNEW got away alertly setting the early tempo, was overtaken at the half, switched outside the leader entering the turn, fought on gamely between runners but was outfinished for place and show. SEDBURYS GHOST broke a bit awkwardly, made a steady advance outside foes up the backstretch to reach mid-pack, raced outside a rival two to three deep on the turn, came into upper stretch five wide, gained late but just missed the minor awards. KEKOA brushed with a foe at the start, clipped heels early, steadied slightly when in tight near the five-eighths, shifted seven wide leaving the turn, gained late. YUKON STRIKER moved up outside chasing the pace from the second flight, went four wide on the turn, weakened in the stretch. CHAIRMAN BOB broke outwards trading bumps with the outside foe on the start, travelled three wide close the back on the first turn, had little movement along the backside, started to come with a run on the rail at the quarter pole, angled out gathering speed five wide at the top of the lane and was full of run switching leads and gears in the final furlong driving by outside at the sixteenth pole for the win. RAPID GREY broke out at the start, had the lead galloping along low headed on the first turn, continued the same down the back straightaway, was roused being let out a notch with the chasing rivals bearing down at the five sixteenths pole maintaining the front end, continued to hold off challengers on the fence turning for home but had no answer when the winner drove on by outside briskly at the sixteenth pole but still finished up well enough to be a clear second best at the wire. MASON'S GAMBLE had one runner beaten while going widest in the four path outside horses in the first turn, ran in tandem with an inside foe at the back of the pack at the half, started to make a rally

two wide midway around the second bend, swung out widest gaining momentum in the six path taking the corner and found his best stride late closing in smartly in deep stretch outside to just get up from a couple of inside runners capturing third place. PRINCE OF THIEVES sat in midfield having the rail position, was isolated watching the lead three runners down the backside rating kindly, rallied when asked for more shifting out three wide on the final bend at the quarter pole to have a chance in the four path in upper stretch but could only run only mildly between horses in the last sixteenth losing the nod at the wire to a surging outside foe for the show award. SECRET STORM travelled two wide on the initial bend watching the leader, still sat outside another keeping a close eye on the frontrunner down the backside as well as around the far turn, had the two path in the conversation at the head of the lane but needed more in the late going and was on the wrong end of a three-way tight finish for the show placing. GRANDE SOIREE had the rail tracking the frontrunner for most of the race, sat poised waiting for running room behind the leader at the quarter pole, briefly shifted out to the two path looking for a lane in upper stretch, moved back again to the fence at the furlong pole having some clear run finally but failed to fire inside foes for the last eighth of a mile. CONN SMYTHE (GB) broke in getting the worst of the exchange of bumps with the eventual winner at the start, could see the field three wide on the first of two turns, shared the rear inside another down the backstretch, was relegated back to sole last unable to quicken with others at the five sixteenths pole, straightening out for the drive well back of the pack and showed little in the stretch running.
