READY TO COLLECT was pushed out on the start, rated kindly having the rail position in the tracking trio along the backstretch, inched up behind the embattled duo waiting for the cue to move on the turn, angled out in the four path at the head of the lane, switched leads as well as gears coming to the furlong pole and powered on by with a sixteenth from home to win going away when crossing the finish line. RELOAD'S REBEL was situated three deep outside horses in the second flight down the backside, stalked close to the back making little headway while saving ground around the oval, shifted out gathering momentum four wide in upper stretch and surged late staying on the wrong lead nonetheless to best the rest for the runners up share at the finish line. FIFTY B M G broke outwards on the start, had his head in front on the inside down the back straight, dueled on the fence maintaining a slim advantage on the turn, shifted out just off the fence for the stretch run, was clinging onto the lead inside at the furlong marker, had no answer when the winner swept past with a sixteenth remaining and finished up mildly to hold for the show money at the wire. FRAC RIGHT prompted the pace outside in the early going, battled for the lead outside throughout the turn, vied up front between rivals in the three path in the stretch drive but could not continue on late with others and faded between foes in the final seventy yards to hold for a minor share in the end. WAGNER was bumped on the break to trail the group down the backstretch, could see the field still quite in range around the bend, swung out widest in the six path at the top of the lane and could only manage to pick up a tired runner in deep stretch outside. HE SHOOTS HE WINS was jostled between rivals on the break, settled between rivals in midfield along the back straight, travelled three wide on the outside watching the front pair around the turn, shifted out in the five path but had nothing to give for the drive and wilted in the final furlong.

C C'S KINGDOM was unhurried at the back travelling into the first turn, improved smartly inside runners by the half, was shuffled back a touch at the three furlong pole, started to make a rally when scrubbed for more on the rail at the quarter pole, "scraped the paint" turning for home having run, darted through a tight seam on the fence at the sixteenth pole and got up for the nod at the wire under a ground saving trip. U S ARMY CORPS cleared away from the inside runners to get to the fence tracking the engaged duo in the beginning, kept a distant eye on the front two down the backside, edged up taking the short way around the far turn, angled out finding his best stride four wide in upper stretch, came with a strong late charge in deep stretch but was denied by the inside winner in a tight finish. SUNRISE DRIVE travelled on the rail in midfield early on, took closer order to the top pair travelling three deep along the backside, came under a ride narrowing the margin on the front duo around the last bend to pose a threat three wide turning for home, could not sustain the rally stalling slightly at the furlong pole, switched leads late and just got up at the line for the show award. SAMMY STONE was roused getting to the front outside into the first bend, had a narrow lead inside from a pesky co-leader while opening up considerably on the rest of the field down the backside, shook loose by the three eighth marker having sole command on the last turn, had rivals closing in on both side while in the two path having a dwindling lead at the furlong pole, tried to fight on but conceded the front by the seventy yard pole and faded a touch more at the wire getting nabbed for the show money right at the finish line outside. CHANCEL was content to let the outside foe go ahead for the lead entering the lead, moved outside around the bend to re-engage up top down the backstretch, could not keep up to the leader who was edging away at the three furlong pole, came back on for more in the hunt three wide in

MISTER HOLDEN prompted the pace under a snug hold three deep in the early going, moved in three wide around runners on the turn, posed the main opposition in the three path straightening out for the drive and relentlessly wore down the frontrunner in the shadow of the wire for the win. HEY CUE was in hand up top marginally inside down the backside, edged away on the rail from the early speed rival by midturn, still was in command but by a diminishing advantage in upper stretch and could not find enough in reserve late to fend off the winner outside in deep stretch. BREAK THE SPELL was unhurried on the rail trailing the field down the backside, made a smart circling move around foes going three to four wide on the bend, shifted out to the five path still coming on in upper stretch, could not threaten the top pair who were in a match to themselves in deep stretch but finish up a clear third with that solid effort. WINSTON BLUE settled on the outside in midfield, was under encouragement in the three path but was going in the wrong direction midway around the

GROOT broke outwardly bothering a rival, settled at the back soon advancing between foes at the rear, moved out while advancing five wide on the turn, took aim in upper stretch, gained steadily, surged late to just get up. MAY AND JUNE quickly moved clear, set the pace near the inside, was off the rail a bit past the furlong marker having extended the advantage in upper stretch, was desperate and just caught. ROAR OF THE CROWD chased from between runners two to three wide, came in a bit in upper stretch, gained mildly inside. SPEEDY BEAR was outsprinted early, fanned seven wide, gained mildly late. WESTMINSTER chased from between foes three to four wide into the turn, failed to menace. TIERNAN tracked inside alternately chasing and under a hold in behind, was under urging past the quarter pole, failed to rally. RED PHARAOH was bothered and forced out at the start, settled at the back, fanned six to seven wide, was never a threat. YODDHA stumbled at the start then was bumped, moved forward outside chasing four to five wide, dropped back and faded.

RAT PORTAGE settled into stride at the rear inside, saved ground on the turn, came out five wide bumping a rival lightly then six wide in upper stretch while

commencing a bid between foes, kicked clear, held under steady handling. PRICELESS WILL settled off the pace inside, advanced late on the turn while shifting out, came into upper stretch seven then eight deep, gained slowly and steadily but was not enough. FORESTER'S FORTUNE was bumped into a rival after the start, settled off the pace and off the inside, came into upper stretch in behind foes and about five or six deep, altered outside rivals ten wide, finished strongly but too late. PINE KNOLL was lightly bumped into a rival after the start, eased back off the leaders and switched out stalking three to four wide into the turn, came into upper stretch six wide, kept on evenly but failed to produce a bid. PAT'S GAMBLE was off the pace outside, put to urging by the five-sixteenths, fanned ten wide for the drive, moved inside a foe in the stretch and improved position. HANLAN steadied after the start, was outside foes at the rear into the turn racing four to six wide, fanned eleven deep into upper stretch and passed a few tired rivals. RAPID GREY came out after the start lightly bumping a rival, was prominent between foes early, was bumped then shuffled back at the half, stalked in behind the leaders just off the fence, came out leaving the turn, clipped heels at that juncture stumbling badly, recovered and was still in contention, was then bumped and squeezed back near the eighth pole, shifted in and ran on. SOUPER DORMY was forwardly-positioned pressing outside five then four wide, dueled outside a rival three deep through the turn, faded in the stretch. HIGHLAND LIFE moved forward inside, vied inside, gave way. CALL ME SUE was bumped at the start, vied between runners was three wide past the half exchanging contact with an inside foe, began to drop back between rivals soon after, faded.

TWOWAYCROSSING was allowed to settle at the back in the early stages loping along, was well within range while still at the rear down the backstretch, closed the gap still unleashed with the field bunching up tightly at the quarter pole, swung out five abreast having a clear run outside foes turning for home and drove past basically under a hand ride at the furlong pole to open up with ease in dominating fashion at the finish line. CORNWALL stalked in the third flight on the outside for the beginning mile, was the first to make a move when roused outside rivals at the three furlong pole, circled runners three wide being scrubbed on at the quarter pole, could not threaten the winner in the lane but had a good finish outside runners in the final furlong to get up late besting others for the place share. ONE MORE BREW was content to track the leader in the early going, inched up to make a bid outside the pacesetter with five sixteenths to go, poked his head in front in the two path between horses straightening out for the drive, offered no resistance when the winner flew by at the eighth pole and was caught late giving way to the outside foe for the runners up share in deep stretch. JOURNEYMAN had the rail in the third flight, settled in midfield alone down the back straight, saved ground keeping pace with rivals on the last of three turns, had no room in the three path behind horses having to be checked when coming up the eighth pole and could not get re-started to pose a threat in the late stages. FIGHTER IN THE WIN assumed command loose up top on the first turn, set an even pace along the backside, continued unopposed on the front end still setting a moderate tempo on the final bend, relinquished the lead unable to quicken inside rivals at the top of the stretch and had nothing to give folded on the fence in the last furlong.

#### Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

COMMANDER WORSLEY had the rail position in midfield by the half, had a sharp turn of foot shifting off the fence by the five sixteenths pole, loomed boldly four wide at the top of the lane and went on by with ease having a sixteenth left to go and drew off convincingly in deep stretch. TIGER TOWN was loose up top along the backside, cruised along unopposed throughout the turn, still had command at the furlong pole, could not find more to fend off the winner outside when collared with a sixteenth to run but stayed on easily to be second best at the wire. RIDE FOR THE PURSE was situated near the back with runners on either side while travelling in the two path, co-trailed inside another at the five sixteenths pole, shifted out finding his best stride eighth wide at the top of the lane and surged on the outside by multiple runners with seven yards from home to the get the show money at the finish line. ALPHA KADIN was forced on out the break, co-trailed inside at the half, took the short way around the turn making a move at the quarter marker, skimmed the rail closing the gap straightening out for the drive and had a good late rally inside foes to beat out a few rivals at the wire for the minor share in the end. GRAFFITI WRITER broke out on the start, kept a close eye on the leader down the backstretch, dropped back slightly midway through the bend, had a chance for a piece of the prize three wide turning for home and was one paced being involved in a late scramble for a minor role at the finish line. CONACHER moved well sitting just back off the leader in the early stages, tracked the leader inside on the turn, was in the hunt in the two path in upper stretch, drifted out at the sixteenths pole and weakened in the late stages. PRIME PLUS ONE was in tight between horses on the break to trail after the gates opened up, made a brief rally improving outside foes at the three eighths marker, angled five wide at the top of the stretch but could not get involved stuck behind runners in mid-stretch. DROP YOUR GLOVES settled in the middle of the pack outside others, made little impression between rivals on the oval, shifted seven wide at the top of the lane and finished with some late interest but could not get involved late for a small share of the prize. SPRUNG LOOSE watched the frontrunner while in the three path outside in the early going, chased the leader while just off the rail around the bend midturn, shifted out four wide with a quarter mile from home, angled to be in the six path for the drive to the wire but wilted between horses in the final furlong. MY BOY BRUCE was bumped on the inside at the start, stalked in the three path outside another down the backside, was part of the trailing quartet at the half, could see the field four wide through the turn, swung out widest in the nine path in upper stretch but could not factor in the late running.
