FOXY DIVA was content to track the lone speed while outside another in the early going, narrowed the margin at the quarter pole going three wide between horses, shifted out to the four path in the hunt with runners on both sides in mid-stretch and ran in determinedly in the final sixteenth of a mile to get up then hold off a oncoming outside rival in deep stretch. MAGICAL TRICK co-trailed on the outside leaving the chute, advanced smartly outside foes at the half, ranged up circling rivals midturn, was forced out gathering speed widest in the five path turning for home, found its best stride late but lost the win in a photo at the wire. WORLD SHOWCASE was well in hand loose up top along the backside, continued up front unopposed around the oval, dug in stubbornly when headed outside initially in upper stretch, held that rival at bay to the wire but was no match for the pair of late chargers outside in the final seventy yards. I'M TENACIOUS had the rail position keeping a close eye on the loose leader along the backside straight, was roused with five sixteenths from home moving in sharply by the quarter pole to bid for the lead three wide between foes at the top of the lane but was outkicked by rivals on either side in the final furlong to settle on the fringes in the end. DREAMS AND SCHEMES broke a step slow to trail the field in the beginning, improved slightly inside runners down the backstretch, made little headway taking the short way around the turn, skimmed the fence straightening out for the drive but could not get into contention inside rivals in the late running. RED SAMURAI settled in mid-division between horses along the backside, dropped back to the rear unable to quicken with others who were making a move by the three furling pole and had little to give in the two path in the drive to the wire.

LOVE STRIKE pressed the issue on the rail through the first bend, dueled inside head to head for the lead down the back straight, edged clear up top midway in the final turn, was collared on both sides in the two path with a furlong to go, relinquished the lead by the sixteenth pole but tenaciously found more resurging late to get up front once again at the finish line. SUNNYVILLE was squeezed to trail the field just off the fence after the break, stalked three deep sharing the back end of things by the half, made a sharp move swooping four wide around runners with five sixteenths to go, loomed menacingly outside in the four path turning for home and kept on coming fighting outside to the very end but was denied by a resilient winner in a tight three way photo for the win. BLAZE OF MISCHIEF broke outwards on the start, travelled under a snug hold in midfield inside foes on the first turn, closed the gap down the backside, edged up on the fence behind the leader waiting for the cue to go by the quarter pole, darted up the fence with clear run at the furlong pole, had its head in front for a moment inside two others with a sixteenth remaining but could not find that little bit more late and settled for the show award being on the losing end of a three horse picture for all the money. ARCTIC BLONDE had a good spot tracking the engaged duo on the first turn, settled in the second flight inside another down the back straight, kept pace between rivals through the last bend to be in the mix for a share three wide in upper stretch but evened out by the furlong marker to settle on the fringes in the end. BLACK GODDESS broke in at the start, stalked near the rear between foes in the early stages, lagged behind the rest of the group midway on the far turn, angled out widest in the five path and picked up a couple of weary foes inside when turning for home. MOMANDA had a slim advantage just off the rail early on, battled outside for the front along the backside, was scrubbed for more but gave way up top at the five sixteenths pole, had no resistance when engulfed between rallying rivals a quarter mile from home and had nothing left galloping in to the wire not being persevered with in the final furlong. MORE MONEY HUNNY travelled well contently hounding the pace outside along the back straight, moved in to force the issue outside quickening the tempo up top around the turn, got the better of the pacesetter outside by the furlong pole to edge clear for the outright lead and had enough left in deep stretch to comfortably hold on for the win from the oncoming closer at the wire. BOUND TO BE TRUE was unhurried co-trailing on the fence early on, started to mount a rally shifting out three wide around horses at the quarter pole, angled to the four path full of run outside foes in mid-stretch, was gaining gradually on the winner late but settled for besting the rest for the runners up share at the finish line. SPELLCHECK emerged from the chute having a slim advantage inside down the backstretch, dueled inside with the eventual winner setting a brisk second split time opening up on others through the turn, could not match strides giving way up front on the inside by the furlong pole but did finish up well enough to hold for the third place share. TANDHONEYWITHANE had the rail position under an early hustling ride to track the contesting duo down the back straight, was roused for more trying to keep up to the lead pair through the turn, was in the mix on the fence for a piece of the prize straightening out for the drive and finished up mildly in the last furlong inside rivals to be a fringe player in the end. SIL'S GAMBLE kept a close eye on the embattled twosome while outside in the second flight, came under a ride but could not close the gap to the lead pair around the bend, dueled for a minor share just off the fence in upper stretch but faded between runners in the final sixteenth of a mile. RELOAD EH had a stalking role outside another with the field paired up down the backstretch, was scrubbed for more at the three eighths pole but made little impact around the bend inside and had little to show in the stretch running.

GOING LUCKY was forwardly placed tracking the leader while between runners early on, waited to move in poised in the two path having challengers on either side on the oval, pounced outside three wide in upper stretch and drew away convincingly when asked at the furlong marker to get the win with an impressive debut. KATHERINE'S CUB popped up then was in tight being pinched between runners on the break, improved along the backside to sit in midfield outside a rival by the half, closed the gap on the turn smartly reaching for more ground in the two path between horses at the quarter pole, was no match for the winner in the lane but with a solid late charge outside in the final eighth of a mile got up nearing the finish line to be second best. LET'S GO SOUPER was nudged along to emerge with the lead on the rail leaving the chute, rolled along up top setting an even pace up front through the turn, offered no resistance when collared outside by the winner in mid-stretch and was just caught for the secondary share in the last few strides before the wire. MO ARGENTO had the rail in the second flight keeping in touch with the frontrunner down the backside, continued to keep pace with rivals while saving all the

ground around the bend, shifted out in the two path at the furlong pole and finished up evenly to settle for a minor share in the end. TEQUILASOUPERNOVA tracked the pacesetter while going three deep outside foes along the backside, inched up taking the overland round runners three wide on the turn, shifted to the five path with a chance turning for home but failed to fire outside horses in the later stages. LADY ON THE NILE had the fence travelling in mid-division with a half mile remaining, took the short way throughout the turn holding its own inside rivals but had little to offer down the lane lacking a rally on the fence in deep stretch. MANIFESTING was void of early speed sharing the rear inside another at the half, narrowed the margin on the leader while between foes going three wide around the bend, angled out to the five path for the stretch drive but could not find more down the lane to be a factor in the late running. CRUMLIN BEACH co-trailed on the outside midway down the backstretch, was hard ridden making a brief rally circling foes four wide on the outside at the five sixteenths pole, shifted out widest in the six path turning for home, stayed on the left lead outside foes down the lane and weakened at the furlong marker.

VRANA (IRE) broke sharp for the early lead, was taken back up top when the inside leader was getting out considerably by the nine sixteenths pole, tracked the pacesetter four deep at the half, rallied three wide circling outside foes through the turn, loomed boldly five wide at the top of the lane and drew off

smartly in the final furling for the victory. VERI COLLECTED was forwardly positioned alone watching the front foursome in the mix up top with a half mile still to run, kept pace on the outside in the third tier with five sixteenths to go, angled out in the six path full of run through the lane and charged by runners late on the outside to get up for a non threatening second at the wire. JUICY HANNA stalked inside near the rear with a half mile still to run, started to pick up runners three wide on the outside commencing at the three eighths pole, swung out widest in the seven path full of run down the stretch and closed in late to capture the show money while not that far beaten for the runners up share as well at the wire. RYO AMAZING had the outside in a stalking position along the back straight, rallied inside foes at the three furling pole, adavanced smartly on the fence through the bend, burst between foes dueling for the lead in the two path at the head of the lane, could not continue on up top late and stalled with seventy yards to go settling on the fringes at the finish line. OUTFORARIP watched the contesting duo while nestled on the rail in the beginning, took closer order forcing the pace inside at the half mile marker, slipped up the fence taking over the lead by midturn, was collared on both sides three wide in upper stretch and wilted between rivals in the final furlong. BEACH CRICKET settled on the rail in mid-pack in the beginning, dropped back to be between horses in the rear trio on the turn and finished up with late interest to pass a few tired rivals in the stretch running. SISTER MARJORIE tracked the lead trio outside early on, moved in to draft behind the frontrunner at the half, was under a ride but was shuffled back by the five sixteenths pole, lacked running room in tight in the two path between horses at the top of the stretch and yielded in the final furlong. MALIBU BETTY was allowed to settle into stride trailing the field down the backstretch, took the short way around the bend still at the back of the pack and could only pass the leg weary early leader inside by the furlong pole. TALLAWAH seized command pulling the rider to the lead between foes leaving the chute, was getting out considerably up front at the nine sixteenths pole, still remained on the lead by a slim margin in the three path at the half, surrendered the front letting a rival up the fence midway on the turn, was swarmed by runners while four wide turning for home and emptied out by the eighth pole.
