KEY STROKE shared the rear inside another in the first half of this route race, edged up on the rail through the far turn, skimmed the fence turning for home and found another gear having late energy inside down the lane to get up at the wire besting the rest. COUNTRY LIVING was loose on the lead down the backstretch at the half, rolled along well in control through the turn, was pressured briefly outside in upper stretch but when asked had more to give at the furlong marker to hold safe for the frontrunning score. SECRET THREAT was unhurried trying to find his stride regressing outside rivals to co-trail at the half, had a sharp turn of foot circling horses three wide midway around the bend, found a seam posing the main threat in upper stretch, was gaining gradually on the leader late but did not have enough to get to the winner while fighting the strong headwind in the lane. BACKONTHECHAINGANG had an outside position in the middle of the pack, picked up the bit when urged with five sixteenths outside narrowing the margin, shifted out five wide in the mix on the outside of challengers straightening out for home but could only finish up mildly to settle for the show money in the end. CAUGHT SPEEDING was content to sit back off the lone speed down the back straight, was urged but made little gain chasing the pacesetter around the turn, took closer order to offer a mild bid three wide at the head of the stretch, was repelled by the winner with a sixteenth to go and faded inside losing a couple of placings in the late stages. COOLER MAN broke a step slow trailing in the beginning, picked up a runner inside leaving the half mile marker, was relegated to the back of the pack again by the five sixteenths pole, spurted up the fence a quarter mile from the wire to be in with a chance for a share turning for home but evened out inside foes in the final sixteenth. LITTLE RED DOMI travelled on the inside of another in the third flight early on, could not accelerate in the two path between horses losing forward position at the quarter marker, dropped back inside at the top of the lane and could not get involved between foes in deep stretch. RY PIE had a stalking role ahead of a couple of runners down the backside, was passed by rivals on either side on the turn to see the field

PAYNES SPIRIT was well-placed stalking outside the second flight, entered the turn three wide, moved leaving that bend striking the lead at the top of the stretch, came in a bit brushing a foe lightly, edged clear. SIGNATURE SIR was bumped a couple times after the start, pressed the pace from outside, bid past the three-eighths taking a narrow lead, was forced in and brushed in upper stretch, kept on to secure the place. POCKET SPEED bumped a rival at the start then was in turn bumped by that foe, exchanged more contact soon after, tracked from in behind inside a foe in the second group, angled five wide at the top of the stretch, kept on but needed more. BEE ME was bumped and exchanged some bumps after the start, set the pace inside facing pressure, was headed past the three-eighths, pressed while still unasked, was put to urging leaving the turn and came out just a bit, was brushed and forced in at that juncture being put in a bit tight, was outkicked. SOUPER STRIDER broke outwardly but alertly, settled into stride outside a foe off the pace, fanned six wide, went evenly. PADRAIG had bumps and steadied after the start, raced off the pace near the inside, was never a threat. STRAWBERRY AGAIN raced a bit greenly early, was outpaced and not a factor.

COUNTRYBOYSURVIVE shifted outside when the early leader cleared to the rail in the beginning, poked his head in front by the time they entered the backstretch setting a moderate tempo considering the wind was behind them, edged away from the inside early pace foe by midturn, braced for the new challenge outside with a quarter mile to run, angled out in the four path holding on in upper stretch and found another gear late to win going away in the final furlong. SOUPER EFFECT could see the field going four deep outside foes early on, made an early move going around runners four wide at the seven sixteenths pole, continued the big swooping move around rivals throughout the turn to bid three wide at the quarter pole, posed the main opposition outside in the five path turning for home, could not sustain the long rally staying on the wrong lead at the furlong pole with the winner opening up again but did hold on valiantly to be second best at the wire. JUST JACOBO travelled three deep keeping a close eye on the engaged duo down the back straight, was scrubbed three wide inside a rival try to hold position through the turn, angled out five wide battling outside runners for a minor share down the stretch and surged right at the line to get the nose down at the finish for the show award inside. WAHEELA settled between horses near the rear with the field tightly bunched at the half mile marker, had a quick turn of foot inside a rival making a run with five sixteenths from the wire, shifted out four wide for the drive, dueled determinedly between runners in mid-stretch for the show money but lost by the slimmest of margins at the finish line settling for a minor share instead. SPIRITUAL MAN broke sharp getting to the rail on the lead in the chute, pressed the pace inside down the back straight, could not continue on in the mix up top inside dropping back slightly by the quarter pole, tried to fight back on the rail briefly in upper stretch but tired inside rivals in the final furlong. PLEASE DON'T GO was away slowly on the break trailing in the beginning, recovered to sit in mid-pack down the backstretch inside runners, was nudged for more but was back pedaling on the fence in midturn, lagged behind the field at the top of the stretch and could not play a role in the late running.

EXECUTIVE SEARCH forced the issue on the outside in the early going, was reined back letting an outside rival go ahead making an early move outside entering the turn, closed in on the embattled duo when roused through the turn at the quarter pole to be in the hunt three wide between horses straightening out for the drive and relentlessly wore down a stubborn frontrunner in deep stretch to get up for the win a few strides before the finish line. CLASSIC DANCER broke out on the break, recovered to have the lead on the rail midway down the back straight, dictated the pace but by only a narrow margin on the rail going with the bias in the favor of frontrunners through the turn, still maintained albeit a shrinking advantage on the fence by the furlong pole and gave way grudgingly in deep stretch to the winner staying on for the runners up share with a strong effort on this day. FAIRWAY TO HEAVEN broke in at the start, trailed the field along the backside, began to reach for more ground picking up rivals three wide at the quarter pole, swung out widest in the seven path gathering more speed in upper stretch and was gaining steadily through the lane but could not get to the top two in time and settled for a clear third in the end. MID DAY IMAGE travelled on the outside in mid-pack going three deep down the back straight, kept pace three wide between foes midway through the turn, shifted out five wide looking for a seam turning for home, was shuffled back to last losing his path at the furlong marker and when having clear run

in deep stretch surged late to get up for a minor share at the wire. TRICKY MAGICIAN had a stalking trip ahead of only one runner down the backside, made a sharp move bursting around foes four wide in midturn, shifted to the six path between rivals while still coming on at the top of the stretch but could not sustain the rally and stalled with runners on either side with a sixteenth of a mile remaining. HARPER CITY travelled in midfield in the two path between runners early on, made little movement under a drive near the rear just off the fence in the running around the oval and finished with interest dueling for a minor share in deep stretch just fading for that position inside rivals in the final seventy yards. PAPERBACK HERO was nudged along trying to hold inside position in mid-division along the backside, could not keep up to the outside flow of runners making a move at the three eighths marker, regressed on the fence around the bend and could only manage to pick up a tired runner in the stretch drive at the furlong pole. DISSECTOLOGIST progressed four deep outside rivals down the backside to track the front two by the half, continued to move on forwardly on the turn to bid for the lead outside at the quarter pole, was still in the conversation between foes in the four path at the top of the lane, had nothing more left to offer in upper stretch and wilted by the furlong pole being engulfed by runners on both sides.
