TWEETERNITY tossed its head hopping upwards then was followed by stumbling a few jumps later out of the gate spotting the field understandably so leaving the chute, started to relax improving on the fence smartly by the half, kept a close eye on the embattled trio saving all the ground on the turn, shifted to the two path in the mix but lacking running room, had to be wrangled back at the furlong pole having no seam, shifted out getting clear run three wide at the sixteenth pole and determinedly ran down the embattled pair in deep stretch for the impressive score considering all the bad racing luck throughout. HOT GYAL MOSSOP broke inwards on the break, chased the frontrunner outside at the half mile pole, vied between horses midway through the oval, had the two path battling stubbornly through the drive between foes in the late going but was no match for the winner outside in the final seventy yards settling for second best on this day. BENKA had a slim lead on the inside in the early going, inched further away at the four furlong marker, slowed the tempo down while pressed outside by a couple of rivals keeping a head in front in the turn running, skimmed the fence still keeping foes at bay in upper stretch, dug in clinging inside with a furlong to go but could not find a little bit more late when fading on the fence in the final sixteenth of a mile to be a clear third at the wire. NEXT OF KIN was four deep initially being part of the foursome up top entering the backstretch, took closer order only now three deep by the half mile marker outside, rallied three wide throughout the bend making a bid outside of two others in midturn, shifted out to the four path still in the hunt outside the leaders at the top of the stretch but stalled by the furlong pole just holding on for a minor placing in the end. STILETTO VIXEN broke in at the start, was prominent early on having the three-path close to the pace in the beginning, took back at the half tracking the duo while inside another, dropped out of it relegated to the rear two wide at the three eighths pole, swung out widest in the five-path turning for home but could not factor in the stretch running.

TIHO SRCE had the fence keeping tabs on the engaged twosome, was reined back a touch shifting outside three wide in midturn, angled to the four path looming boldly outside turning for home and wore down foes one by one in the drive to edge clear for the win when crossing the finish line. HOWSITGOINOWEN prompted the issue outside down the backside, seized command two wide outside by the three eighths marker, opened up smartly through the turn, remained well in control just off the fence in mid-stretch, started to get leg weary asking for the wire with a sixteenth left to run but could not fend off the winner any longer at the seventy yards marker and then just held at the finish line for the runners up position. DWIGHT tracked the front pair while three deep down the backstretch, chased the duo while going two wide on the bend, angled to the three path in the mix in upper stretch and finished up mildly in the last furlong to be a clear third while almost closing in late for the place share. LOHAN became restless behind the gate getting loaded last with the rider off, was hustled for the early lead on the rail, surrendered the front inside at the three eighths pole, came under a ride being urged on through the turn with the pacesetter getting away at the quarter pole, had the two path chasing the leader in upper stretch but faded inside of rivals in the last furlong settling on the fringes. MARSHALLTOWN travelled with runners on either side in the second flight along the back straight, was hard ridden around the bend but retreated with a quarter mile from home dropping out of contention, hugged the rail staying on the wrong lead at the top of the stretch and could not get involved in the late going. WU TANG KING had a slow start probably due to being in the stall for a lengthy period prior to the gates opening up, lagged well behind in the turn running and lost touch with the pack by upper stretch.

DADDY'S THE BOSS had an ideal spot all alone rating kindly watching the contesting duo midway along the back straight, started to edge closer measuring the battling twosome at the five sixteenths pole to loom boldly angling out between foes five wide at the top of the lane and with a strong stretch kick drove by at the sixteenth pole holding safely at the finish line for the win. HYMN TO HER was unhurried seeing the field inside another down the backstretch, began to lengthen stride passing an outside foe midway around the turn, shifted out coming on four wide at the quarter pole, was floated out widest in the six-path straightening out for the drive and had a good late surge in deep stretch but could not threaten the winner at the wire. LET'S GO SOUPER broke a step slowly on the start, was then hustled inside forcing the pace into the backstretch, edged away on the fence assuming command at the half, remained up top narrowly taking the shortest route around the bend, spurted away further scraping paint at the head of the lane, had no answer inside when the winner stormed past by the sixteenth pole and then got picked up by another in the late stages losing the lace share as well. MATHEMATICAL broke sharp having the lead under a snug hold in the beginning, had company on the inside down the backstretch, contently relinquished the front end by the half, shadowed the new leader outside through the oval, drifted out four wide in the thick of things up top taking the corner but could only finish up one paced in the last furlong securing a minor share. TAN TOAST was taken a hold of between rivals on the break, settled near the rear having only one runner beaten along the backside, travelled three wide on the bend coming under a drive but being relegated to the rear at the five sixteenths pole and failed to menace in the three path through the stretch running.

TEA BISCUIT was brushed in the early going while attending the pace from outside, eased back to stalk from just off the leaders, moved rapidly from the three-eighths advancing four wide, took command by the top of the stretch, edged clear in upper stretch, held a foe under steady handling. STARLA bobbled at the start, moved forward near mid-pack outside a foe racing two to three wide early, was under a strong hold about the one-mile marker early up the backstretch, settled down soon after, began advancing willingly on the far turn, angled four to five wide in upper stretch, struck the lead in mid-stretch quickly drawing clear, held while kept to task. ONEHOTMESS settled off the rail at the rear two to three deep, was still unhurried into the far turn moving out a bit and let loose at that juncture, came out a bit for the drive then angled out eight wide past the three-sixteenths, rallied to close the gap but was too little too late. UNFORGETTABLE FACE (IRE) settled at the back tucking in a bit, raced off the inside still trailing up the backstretch, went four wide on the far turn, swung out a few paths turning for home, kept on to gain show honors. BAZOOKA JANE stalked the loose leader early from off the inside, advanced willingly on that one leaving the far turn, made a mild bid in upper stretch, lacked the needed late kick. CLASSIC DISCOVERY settled off the pace two to three wide, navigated traffic through the stretch moving in then out then kept on between runners late but needed more. SCOTCH MIST tucked in settling toward the rear inside a foe, saved ground and bided time, came out a few paths turning into upper stretch then shifted back in, ran on inside before altering out in mid-stretch then again late and continuing to improve but was too late. GOLDEN HARVEST settled mid-pack along the inside, steadily

dropped back into and on the far turn, came out in late stretch, failed to menace. AFLEET FLATTER moved forward but caught four wide into the first turn, stalked outside a foe up the backstretch, came into upper stretch six wide, dropped back and faded. HOPE IS A BREEZE was under a good hold having a neck in front leaving the chute, cleared off setting an honest pace at the half, rolled along uncontested controlling an even tempo throughout the turn, travelled very comfortably just off the fence in command at the top of the stretch and when finally asked for more run drew away smartly increasing the winning advantage when crossing the finish line for the front end score. SUNDAY FINERY flanked the frontrunner outside through the backstretch, chased between rivals being driven on for more under a busy ride at the quarter pole, posed the only threat in the three path in upper stretch and kept on fighting on determinedly to the very end unable to get to the winner who had things her own way through the race but still ran on solidly to be a very good second best. LITKAS DREAM bobbled slightly on the break, sat forwardly placed between foes in the second flight early on, was shuffled back a touch when throttled down for a few strides at the five sixteenths pole, swung out widest in the six path making a charge to be in the mix heading for the backstretch, drifted inwards briefly when switching leads in upper stretch losing a little momentum but quickly got back into gear and finished up strongly well ahead of rivals for the show award. HASTILY leapt up on the start, rushed up through the chute to be in midfield inside two others at the half mile pole, inched closer when nudged for more in midturn, skimmed the fence in with a chance for a piece of the prize turning for home but evened out in the final eighth of a mile settling only for a minor share in the end. IMSOSPICY was allowed to settle into stride outside seeing the field midway down the backside, started to pick up the bit three wide on the turn with five sixteenths remaining, shifted out four wide taking closer order at the quarter pole, angled to the five path for the drive to the wire and showed some good late interest battling outside for a small share in deep stretch. ANNASTAIJ was sluggish leaving the gate trailing into the backstretch, had the fence ahead of one runner with a half mile from home, made little impact just off the rail two wide in the turn running, shifted to the three path for the stretch drive, angled to the rail when losing its path by the sixteenth pole but lacked a

rally inside late. LAIKIPIA settled three deep having close aim outside on the lead pair, moved in three wide on the turn making a bid up front outside two others at the quarter pole, angled to the five path still in the hunt straightening out for home but could not find more late and folded between runners at the furlong marker. LOUNROBIN was roused for more between horses being part of the back trio at the four-furlong marker, could not keep up while ridden on for more setting at the rear with five sixteenths from home and had little to offer in the two path down the lane.

HEMLO GOLD loped along with his head quite low relaxed following the pacesetter early on, moved closer going outside down the backstretch, dueled for the lead at the three eighths pole, shook loose taking over control by the quarter pole and in the two-path kept to the task through the drive to hold safe from a closing in rival for the win at the wire. STRATUS broke out at the start, had the rail position watching the lead two rivals on the first bend as well as through the back straightaway, stayed inside keeping pace through the far turn, rallied when switching outside five wide in upper stretch and closed in steadily outside the winner in the final furlong but could not get there in time. PEJA DU was bumped by the inside rival on the break, stayed in touch with the front duo outside another for the first half of this two-turn event, closed in when under a hustling ride three wide at the quarter pole, looked to be the main threat outside at the top of the stretch but stalled at the sixteenth pole holding for the show award. C MY MEISTER hesitated at the start trailing the field, continued to find his feet lagging behind others down the backside, started to come with a run circling two runners three wide at the quarter pole, shifted out widest in the six path turning for home and had a good, sustained rally through the stretch to settle on the fringes. NINJA STAR had trouble negotiating the first of two turns going five wide, sat isolated in midfield midway along the backstretch, came under a vigorous ride at the five sixteenths pole going in the wrong direction on the final turn and could not factor three wide down the lane. AMERICAN DECISION cleared the field crossing over from the outer post having the lead setting a brisk pace on the rail around the initial bend, continued up top but was hounded outside by the eventual winner at the half, could not keep up giving way on the front end by the quarter pole and yielded on the fence to outside rivals staying on the wrong lead through the stretch drive.

CORNWALL had only one runner beaten in the early stages, was asked for more at the three eighths pole offering no response, dropped back to last two wide with a quarter mile from the finish line and came up empty having little in the stretch drive.

TOMASELLO stalked in behind the leaders three wide early moving out and stalking from outside early up the backstretch before tucking back in behind, raced three then four wide on the far turn, advanced on the leaders leaving that bend, took command in upper stretch and was asked for run, held from foes while being kept to task. DANCIN IN DA'NILE settled mid-pack off the rail in the two to three path, was given encouragement leaving the far turn swinging four to five wide into upper stretch, shifted inside the leader in mid-stretch, kept on inside to get up for place but was not enough to capture the top prize. SIDE STREET was strongly urged at the break moving forward outside a foe in the second group, tucked in behind the leaders up the backstretch, continued three to four wide on the far turn, swung six deep for the drive, was encouraged along by the five-sixteenths, asked further in upper stretch, gained steadily and slowly but missed second. MESERO settled mid-division inside saving ground through the first turn, advanced willingly inside up the backstretch tracking in behind on the far turn, waited momentarily at the top of stretch just off the rail, moved nearer the fence where there was room but lacked the needed late kick. JUNIPERO SERRA altered inside a rival soon after the start saving ground on the first turn bringing up the rear, switched out leaving that bend, advanced outside foes midway up the backstretch shifting back in a bit nearer but still off the fence and now mid-pack, moved out on the far turn while encourage along at the half, asked thoroughly coming past the five-sixteenths, fanned eight wide into upper stretch, ran on but needed more. SWIFT DELIVERY was unhurried at the rear outside a foe into the first turn, dropped well back trailing up the backstretch, advanced willingly inside into and on the far turn, swung nine wide turning for home, ran on but needed more. COBURG soon made the lead from outside, edged clear into the first turn shifting in a bit to set the tempo from just off the rail, was hounded by an outside rival after the opening quarter, faltered in the stretch. ENGLISH ACTOR moved forward and shifted in after the start close to the lead heading to the first turn, switched outside the leader settling off and outside that foe then advanced near the one-mile marker to press up the backstretch, was in contention till upper stretch then faltered and faded. MAGNA TIME tucked in racing inside foes on or just off the rail, saved ground on the far turn, failed to rally. LAZY Y COLLECTION assumed command just off the fence heading into the first turn, slowed the pace down slightly unchallenged down the backside, continued to cruise along up top with no pressure being applied by the closest pursuers on the last turn and under a well rationed out ride had plenty more in the final furlong winning comfortably while on the wrong lead through the stretch. PERFECT RING was bumped soon after the break from the chain reaction

from the outside two runners at the start, settled in the latter part of midfield along the backside, had to wait on the rail from the five sixteenths pole to upper stretch, charged home having clear run inside in the final furlong but could not get to the winner who had it her own way throughout on the front end. WINNING AGENDA settled near the rear with runners on both sides, started to advance outside three deep midway along the backside, made a sustained circling move from being three wide at the five sixteenths around foes to be in the six path at the top of the lane, continued with relentless pursuit outside at the furlong pole and closed in belatedly well ahead of the rest of the pack capturing third money at the wire. BALLET BEAUTY was keen early on pulling at the rider on the fence, sat in midfield under a hard hold starting to relax down the backside, dropped back lacking running room behind and between horses at the quarter pole and showed some good grit on the rail in the final furlong coming back on late for a minor placing. WHISKEY OVER WINE travelled four wide outside two others stalking the frontrunner, narrowed the margin three deep on the outside still at the half, was ridden along trying to keep pace three to four wide on the far turn, moved out to the five path for the stretch run staying on the incorrect lead and fading between runners at the furlong marker. MRS. G broke outwards exchanging bumps on the break, had the two path following just back off the leader in the initial bend, continued to draft behind the front runner down the back straight, took the short way inching up around the far turn closing the gap by the quarter pole, shifted to the three path straightening out for home but wilted between foes by the sixteenth pole. DEANNA broke in trading bumps at the start, tracked the pacesetter three wide between horses early on, chased the pace along the backstretch, was hard ridden just to hold second position with the winner getting away at the quarter pole and had little left turning for home tiring between rivals four wide in upper stretch.
