LET'S GO LIAM hopped slightly on the break, travelled on the rail in mid-division, improved on the fence down the backside, moved in smoothly shifting out reaching for ground at the three furlong pole, seized control easily going past the leader outside with a quarter mile to run and was kept to the task through the stretch to prove much the best at the finish line. ARMINO had an outside stalking trip near the rear in the early stages, settled into a good rhythm between horses watching the embattled duo along the backside, could not match strides trying to go with the eventual winner around the far turn, kept on trying outside late and got up in deep stretch for the runners up share. SMART ALMASTY broke out on the start, had a stalking role five wide outside on the first of two turns, improved outside runners four deep at the half mile marker, made a sharp move swooping around rivals four wide at the three eighths marker bidding for the front, edged away in the five path turning for home and stubbornly kept finding under a bust ride to hold safe at the finish line. MO TOURIST had the rail in midfield in the early good, mapped out an ideal trip all alone watching the contesting quartet at the three furlong pole, shifted out for clear run in the six path posing the main threat in upper stretch and determinedly kept picking up runners outside in the stretch run to be second best at the wire. SARATOGA HOLIDAY relaxed while tucked in on the fence drafting behind the lead pair down the backstretch, waited for the cue to go on the fence around the bend, angled out four wide start to come to the leader in upper stretch and drove by in the final seventy yards to win going away at the wire. PRINCESSONAMISSION was under a tight hold keeping a close eye on the engaged duo while outside another down the backstretch, rated kindly measuring the battling pair outside through the turn, moved in to threaten three wide at the quarter pole, gained control still in the three path in upper stretch but could not find more late to fend off the late surge by the winner outside in the final seventy yards. WHERE'S SAMNBAILEY was allowed to settle at the back of the pack finding her stride early on, lagged behind on the bend but was starting to pick up the bit closing the gap by the quarter pole, swung out widest in the five path for clear run in the stretch drive, charged late to get up for show award outside at the wire, was pulled up quickly galloping out and left via equine ambulance. SEVEN P R C assumed a narrow lead inside runners down the backstretch, stubbornly was holding on inside having the rail dueling through the bend, could not continue on up top inside by mid-stretch and faded in the late running to hold for a minor share in the end. FIRECRACKER FIONA pressed the pace on the outside down the backstretch, vied between runners fighting up front through the turn, gave way up top between horses with a quarter mile to run and tired four wide by upper stretch.

ROSCAR moved quickly to the lead and shifted in, set the pace facing outside pressure, was headed after about three-eighths, retook the lead past the seven-sixteenths, dueled through the far turn coming into upper stretch just off the rail, weakened. LEGAL CATCH took back and switched out, applied pressure to the early leader from outside, put a head in front passing the wire the first turn, dueled on the far turn, weakened in the stretch.

JUST LIKE THAT was left alone moving strongly up top along the backside, increased the advantage effortlessly around the oval and was urged only mildly in the stretch to coast home for the frontrunning score at the finish line. HER OBSESSION was allowed to settle trailing the field down the back straight, had a sharp turn of foot swooping around runners five wide at the quarter marker, swung out widest full of run in the seven path at the top of the stretch and was gaining steadily on the winner who built up an insurmountable lead by mid-stretch but still ran on smartly to the end well ahead of the rest of the field at the wire for the runners up placing. ECLIPTICAL LADYBUG chased the leader down the backstretch, was hard ridden but could not make up any ground the winner built up through turn, angled out three wide with the frontrunner long gone at the head of the lane and dueled for the secondary prize down the stretch but gave way inside in the final sixteenth. NASHYAN had the rail position in mid-division, was urged along holding her own taking the shortest way around the bend, shifted out just off the rail two wide in upper stretch and finished up mildly to settle on the fringes inside rivals in the end. HATRIXIE MOMENT was situated three deep in midfield outside foes, tried to maintain forward position watching the lead pair while scrubbed on three wide midway on the turn, shifted out five wide with rivals on either side at the top of the stretch and finished up one paced not playing a factor in the late running. SORRY I

MISSED U had a stalking journey just ahead of one runner in the early going, made a brief rally taking closer order four wide between horses at the quarter mile marker, angled six wide with a chance for a small share exiting the turn but could not continue the run and flattened out by the furlong marker. NOBLE BODAN tracked in the third flight with runners on either side along the backside, dropped back on the fence by the three eighths pole, came back on making a mild rally in the two path in midturn, shifted out three wide dueling for the minors inside in upper stretch but folded by the sixteenth pole.
