SURFSIDE BEACH sat forwardly placed on the outside tracking the lone speed runner down the backstretch, travelled two wide around the bend keeping her sights set on the frontrunner throughout, found more when switching leads at the furlong pole coming with a rally and drove past on the outside in the last sixteenth of a mile for the stretch running win. YOU SIGNED IT was fleet footed loose up top along the backside, rolled along unopposed through the turn while getting a slight breather, moved well still in control comfortably in mid-stretch on the fence but had no answer when the winner powered past outside in deep stretch while easily besting the field for the runners up share at the wire. RED HIGH HEELS was off very slowly being the distant trailer down the backside, continued to lag well behind the pack in the turn running, skimmed the fence turning for home seeing the field but had very good late energy inside through the stretch drive getting up right at the wire on the rail winning the show award. RED SYMPHONY veered in sharply on the break but recovered having the rail position watching the lead two runners, saved ground around the oval but the leader was getting away at the quarter pole, hugged the rail at the top of the lane, drifted out fading late at the sixteenth pole and was nabbed inside by a late charging foe for the third place share at the finish line. SIENNA AURA broke outwards brushing the gate on the start, settled three deep outside challengers having only the other poor starter beaten in the early stages, made little headway going three wide outside foes along the turn, showed some late interest closing in on the outside in the stretch drive but was on the wrong end of a three-way photo for the show money.

CONNOR soon led, set the pace near the inside chased by foes, shook clear of new pursuers leaving the far turn, drew off when asked in the stretch, was eased up late. SILVER RALEIGH settled outside mid-pack racing mostly two to three wide on the turns, advanced mildly coming to the quarter pole to get within range of the leader but was no match. LONNY'S GAMBLE settled inside off the pace near mid-pack, fanned six wide turning for home, ran on to get up for show honors late. BEACH CRICKET was between runners toward the rear through the early going, fanned eight wide into upper stretch and ran on. DRAW BOOT settled at the rear outside racing three to four wide, advanced on the far turn still four deep, came into upper stretch five wide, was outkicked for the minor awards. PARADISE PERFECT tracked the eventual winner from in behind and inside, shifted four wide leaving the far turn, failed to rally. MASTERFUL MOMENT trailed inside, failed to menace. SOMEKINDA MISCHIEF chased the eventual winner from outside, was ridden by the seven-sixteenths, eased through the lane and walked off.

ATOHI broke out on the break but was still away alertly to have the lead outside two others early on, continued to dictate the pace just off the rail along the backside, edged clear briefly at the half but was unable to get to the rail, remained up top two wide while pressed inside at the three eighths marker, shot clear once again by the quarter pole and proved much the best winning going away under mild urging late for the front running score. CANADA broke out at the start, improved along the backstretch to have a good spot on the outside of a rival tracking the front duo by the half, had the lines shook up at the three eighths pole wanting more run, made a sharp circling move four wide at the quarter pole, drifted inwards staying on the wrong lead at the furlong marker but still ran on solidly to be a distant but clear second best at the finish line. AUTHENTIC GOLD was in the mix on the rail in the beginning, took back being reined in off the lead twosome by the five-furlong marker, started to come with a run between horses three wide at the quarter pole, battled inside another for the place share in mid-stretch with the winner well ahead and finished up well enough holding for the show award at the finish line. WHATTA MOVE settled near the rear having only the slow starter beaten in the early stages, came under a drive but was going the wrong way losing ground to the leaders through the turn, shifted out to the four path at the head of the lane, veered in sharply for a moment when asked right-handed in upper stretch but was quickly corrected and showed some good late energy in the final furlong to get up for a minor placing. MO TONE hit the inside part of the gate hard knocking the rider off balance briefly spotting the field many down the backstretch, was hard ridden trying to catch up to rivals but to no avail around the oval, swung out widest in the five path turning for home and managed to only catch a weary straggler on the inside in the final seventy yards. WISE WALKER chased inside in the beginning, was steadied on the fence coming to the nine sixteenths pole losing momentum, re-engaged again inside by the half mile marker, pressed the issue up front taking the short way around early through the turn, was wrangled back preferring to go to the outside off the frontrunner who was getting away at the quarter pole and emptied out in the two path in the stretch drive.

FABER rated kindly settling on the inside close the back end, sat unfazed when relegated to last on the fence with a half mile remaining, started to reach for more ground smartly in the two path at the quarter pole, seized control on the rail making a sharp move with a furlong from home and was kept to the task with a sixteenth to run pulling away when crossing the finish line. TWOWAYCROSSING was unhurried at the back end in the early stages, began to pick up the bit three wide at the three eighths pole, swung out widest in the six path coming with a good rally outside in upper stretch, did not switch leads through the drive while still closing in making a bid for the lead at the furlong pole but was outkicked by the winner in the last sixteenth of a mile. WATSONVILLE RED had the rail sitting just back off the frontrunner, continued to draft behind the leader on the turn, was nudged for more at the three furlong pole lengthening stride and finished up willingly inside rivals in the final furlong to be a non threatening third in the end. CAIRO CAPER pulled the rider on the fence to the lead with a mile from the prize, galloped along unchallenged throughout the turn running, had the two path still in command at the top of the stretch, drifted out clinging onto the front with rivals bearing down on either side at the three sixteenths pole and faded surrendering the lead between foes in the final furlong holding for a minor role at the wire. KING D'ORO travelled three deep tracking on the outside along the back straightaway, narrowed the margin three wide on the turn by the three eighths marker, angled out to the four path still in the mix in upper stretch, bobbled when finally switching leads at the sixteenth pole but could not get involved in the late running. ROSCAR settled between foes watching the loose pacesetter down the backside, took closer order on the inside of another two wide at the three-furlong marker, had the three path in the hunt in upper stretch, was checked mildly with the leader getting tired drifting out at the three sixteenths pole and had little to offer afterwards folding with runners on each side at the furlong marker.

SUPERFLY CHICK broke sharp getting the advantage on the rail well in hand at the half mile marker, travelled very smoothly with the rider sitting still up top with no rivals in sight on the turn, was tapped on the shoulder just to stay interested at the furlong pole and won under a hand ride never being pressed at any point through the race. ILLY broke outwards on the start, was allowed to settle into stride at the rear on the fence early on, remained at the tail end seeing the field around the bend, shaved the corner coming with a sharp run at the top of the stretch and had a strong turn of foot inside horses in the final furlong taking the secondary share but could not get to the impressive frontrunning winner at the finish line. MOSCATO BABE kept a close eye on the front two runners along the backside settling on the fence, kept pace while saving all the ground around the oval, shifted out to the two path in upper stretch, battled between foes for the secondary share with the winner well in control by mid-stretch and was outfinished by the inside runner late settling for the show award instead at the wire. KINTYRE chased the frontrunner outside along the back straight as well as throughout the turn, moved to the three path for the drive to the finish line but yielded to a couple of inside foes at the furlong pole and lasted at the wire to settle on the fringes. ENDRICK had the top spot narrowly on the outside in the beginning, cleared away in hand getting to the rail at the half, settled into a good rhythm moving very comfortably up front unopposed around the turn, had the two-path opening up further in mid-stretch while not even being asked and pulled away with ease under no urging in the last sixteenth overpowering the field when crossing the finish line for the gate to wire victory. BREAK THE SPELL had to be checked at the start avoiding the troubled inside foe, trailed along the backside, was asked right-handed in midturn closing ground smartly by the quarter pole, swung out widest gathering more speed at the top of the stretch in the six path and finished up strongly outside rivals easily besting the rest for the runners up share while well behind the dominant winner. CIRCLE BACK JACK had only one runner beaten down the backstretch, made no movement two wide through the bend, angled out to the five path getting a clear lane between runners in upper stretch and finished up with intent just getting up at the wire for the third place share outside. ARMSTRONG prompted the early pace on the inside, took back letting the frontrunner go while altering outside at the five eighths marker, was scrubbed on inside chasing two wide through the turn with a host of others in pursuit as well, had the three-path posing the only threat for a fleeting moment at the head of the lane and faltered inside rivals losing a couple of positions in the late going. CLASSIC DANCER stumbled outwards on the break, recouped advancing on the rail down the backstretch when being nudged for more tracking the front two runners by the half, had the rail but could not quicken with rivals being unable to retain forward position inside by the five sixteenths pole, re-rallied briefly scraping paint moving into third straightening out for the drive but could not continue the run and wilted inside by the sixteenth pole. ECHO WITH LAUGHTER settled in mid-division three deep on the outside in the early stages, tried to make a rally circling around horses at the five sixteenths marker, continued in the four-path turning for home but yielded at the eighth pole while staying on the incorrect lead through the drive. CRUCIAL TAUNT had runners on either side while sitting in mid-pack

along the back straight, travelled three wide between foes part of the chasing group midway around the bend, remained in the three path in upper stretch but had little to offer in the stretch running and emptied out by the furlong pole.

ANDTHEOSCARGOESTO moved up between runners pressing the issue two wide on the first of two turns, hounded the pacesetter outside going neck and neck along the backstretch, seized command outside at the five sixteenths pole, shifted to the two path increasing the advantage turning for home, had to be kept busy on the rail in the final furlong having to fend off the resurgent early leader who was gaining outside again nearing the wire and in the end just held on for the win. MISTER DUDE was away very alertly having the lead on the rail, had company outside contesting the pace down the back straight, relinquished the front end inside at the five sixteenths pole, skimmed the fence with the winner opening up at the top of the lane but determinedly fought back shifting outside to the two path in the final furlong and showed some gumption coming back on again in the final sixteenth to make it interesting late but just falling short at the finish line. FORESTERS LASTLOVE travelled three wide on the outside in the front mix, dropped back to watch the engaged duo while outside another at the half, chased the pacesetter three in tandem with an inside rival at the quarter pole, shifted to the four path very much in the hunt

in upper stretch but could only run on evenly in the final furlong being a clear third when crossing the finish line. MUY GRACIAS settled on the inside paired up in midfield at the beginning, remained on the rail keeping a close eye on the lead twosome down the backside, was hard ridden on the fence just trying to keep up to the lead trio by the quarter pole, scraped paint taking the corner and finished up mildly to be a fringe player in the end. PADDY HOLIDAY had the two path outside another in mid-division, was in a good spot down the backside isolated still in the middle of the pack behind the engaged pair at the half, offered a mild turn of foot going three wide around foes on the second bend, angled to the five path in with a chance for a piece of the prize outside at the head of the lane but flattened out at the sixteenth pole losing the duel for the minors between horses. RAGING TIMBER brushed the outside part of the gate on the break, was eager veering out four wide on the first turn carrying out a runner, became very rank grabbing onto the bit at the three quarters marker having to be steadied, improved to midfield by the half, opted to wait behind runners at the five sixteenths pole, swung out widest to the six path straightening out for home and could not get into gear actually having to be checked again outside in deep stretch. MYSTIC PATH was off a step slow being at the rear three wide on the first turn, passed an inside foe entering the backstretch, offered little movement through the far turn, shifted to the four path for the drive to the wire but could only manage to pass a leg weary rival in the stretch running. PROUDLY CANADIAN was bumped out five wide by the inside foe on the initial bend while being close to the back end, made no progression along the backside as well as throughout the last turn even though under a busy ride by the quarter pole and came up empty in the three path for the stretch drive. RURAL ROOTS had the fence position ahead of only one runner in the beginning, could see the field by the midway point of the backside, lagged well behind runners on the far turn and lost touch with the group at the top of the stretch, cantering home.

DIXIE LAW settled off the loose leader saving ground through the first turn and racing inside a rival up the backstretch, took closer order on the far turn moving out three wide coming to the five-sixteenths, took the lead at the top of the stretch, was challenged by an outside foe soon after and put to urging, fended off that one then just held late under steady handling. KATIE'S GRACE settled outside foes at the back three to four wide early, continued outside a rival into the far turn racing about three deep, moved out five wide coming to the five-sixteenths advancing on the leader, drew up alongside the winner's flank in upper stretch, was fended off but kept coming at the end although it was too little too late. ASHLEE B was at the tail between foes into the first turn, dropped back up the backstretch trailing the field nearer the inside, saved ground on the far turn, cut the corner getting through along the rail in upper stretch, was no match for the top pair but best of the rest. BOLD TIME settled off the pace inside on or just off the rail, advanced on the far turn, swung three wide leaving that bend, was between runners in upper stretch, ran on. DISSECTOLOGIST had a neck in front with challengers on both sides midway along the backstretch with the field sorting itself out, edged clear on the rail in midturn, had the two path well in control in upper stretch and had to be kept busy in the final furlong holding at the wire for the win but by a quickly diminishing margin. GRAN SPIRITED settled on the rail close to the back of the pack when being nudged along down the backstretch, started to make a run three wide looking for a seam behind a wall of runners at the quarter pole, shifted out to the five path still having no running room, had to wait behind horses from the top of the stretch to the sixteenth pole, found a clear lane in the late running and surged between horses in the final seventy yards to best the rest for the runners up position. BIG BABY HENRY was antsy in the stall prior to the start, settled on the outside in midfield, narrowed the margin three wide on the turn between runners with the field bunching up by the quarter pole, shifted out to the six path closing in steadily in the final eighth of a mile but could not get to the winner late and just got picked up inside at the finish line for the place share. HARPER CITY was forwardly placed on the rail in the beginning, took back off the contesting trio by the half mile pole, kept pace while on the fence in the turn running, shaved the corner at the top of the lane in the hunt but could not finish up late evening out in deep stretch inside a host of others and lost a couple of placings at the wire. BOLD RELOAD had the two path down the backside keeping a close eye on the front three runners, travelled two to three wide on the turn inching closer by the quarter pole, angled to the five path between foes for the stretch drive, battled for the secondary share with a sixteenth still to run but was outkicked in a flurry of a finish in the final seventy yards. COMPUTER HACKER dueled on the inside along the backstretch, had the fence tracking the winner around the turn, shifted to the three path in the thick of things at the top of the stretch but could not find another gear late and faded between runners in the last seventy yards. WET AND WILD was situated inside another rival sitting in mid-pack, dropped back between horses at the three eighths pole, shifted out six wide around horses with a quarter mile remaining, swung out widest in the nine path for the stretch drive and managed to go by a few runners through the lane. BANKER'S HOURS broke with the field then had to be taken up briefly with the inside foe getting out, moved to the fence trailing the pack down the backside, remained in last but did close the gap by the quarter marker, had the two path inside rivals having a chance for a small share in upper stretch, lacked running room in the three path with a sixteenth left to run and could not get involved. SILENT FORTUNE battled three deep outside for the early lead, was two wide chasing the winner in vain around the oval, moved to the four path at the head of the lane but had little to give late when tiring between runners in the final furlong. SECRET THREAT was on the outside having only one runner beaten in the early stages, took the overland route throughout the turn going four to six wide, was floated out to the seven path for the stretch drive and stopped abruptly at the furlong pole.
