YACHT BOY was eager inside when entering the backstretch, settled in mid-pack being reined back on the rail under a snug hold at the half, waited behind the engaged trio taking the short way around turn, had horses looking for a seam skimming the fence in upper stretch, darted through inside at the sixteenth pole and won drawing off at the wire. BANKINGONAMIRACLE veered in on the start, was loose on the lead moving comfortably at the half, was nudged along having a diminishing advantage through the bend, edged away still in hand just off the rail at the top of the lane but could not find more in the late running to fend off the winner inside in deep stretch. NEXT PITCH was jostled between horses on the start, settled into stride outside foes in mid-division down the back straight, rallied smartly swooping around horses three wide on the turn to threaten up top four wide exiting the turn, switched leads at the sixteenth pole finding a little bit extra and was gaining late but just missed outside for the place share at the finish line. EL COHETE was brushed between rivals on the break to trail the group in the beginning, improved slightly by the half, was in range relegated back to the rear on the turn at the quarter pole, shifted out to the four path for the drive to the wire and finished up willingly between runners in the last eighth mile to garner a minor share while not inching up at the wire to be not that far off for the place share as well. TUTTI CONTENTI stalked four deep near the rear, trailed the field outside with a half mile to run, offered a brief surge circling three wide at the midpoint of the turn to swing out widest in the five path turning for home but could not continue the sustained rally and stalled outside horses in the final furlong. PAINTTHETOWNSILVER improved in the three path between rivals under a right hold down the backside, pulled the rider closer to track the pacesetter outside at the half, chased through the turn, was roused with rivals on either side but was going the wrong way by the quarter pole and emptied three wide straightening out for the drive.

POLITICAL WARFARE assumed command having the fence into the first turn, travelled comfortably unopposed along the backside, spurted away when called upon turning for home and held safe keeping to the task in deep stretch. HIGHLY POTENT was pushed out by the inside foe to travelled five wide into the first bend, improved sharply three deep down the backstretch, closed in three wide outside foes on the final turn, was in the thick of things between horses in the three path in upper stretch, was no match for the winner who had down the lane but determinedly fought on with challengers on both sides to just capture the runners up share at the finish line. PROMISING was unhurried co-trailing inside another at the half, burst between rivals sharply with strong momentum at the quarter pole, bullied her way through four wide at the top of the lane dueling up front, was in tight quarters battling for the win at the sixteenth pole but settled for second best this day at the wire in a close finish. GONE WITH DUWYN was up top narrowly on the rail but travelling well in hand midway down the backstretch, opened up setting an even tempo all the while the rider statuesque throughout the turn and improved the advantage under only a hand ride down the stretch. DEPUTY GHOST settled in the third flight on the outside in the beginning, made a sharp move splitting foes in the two path at the five sixteenths pole, reached for more ground coming with a good run on the fence at the quarter pole, was no match for the dominant winner in the lane but did finish up stronly to best the rest inside for the runners up placing. CRUMLIN LAD tracked on the outside of another down the back straight, closed in to force the issue outside at the three eighths marker, poked his head in front seizing control a quarter mile from home, was challenged outside in upper stretch in the three path and tenaciously prevailed showing a game effort inside runners just holding on at the wire. LAST AMERICAN EXIT had the rail in mid-division in the beginning, made a savvy move gaining better inside position pulling the rider up to draft behind the pacesetter by the half, edged up on the turn waiting for the cue to move, shifted out at the quarter pole to be

five wide straightening out for home and was gaining steadily on the lead pair in the final furlong but just missed getting there in time. INDIAN PEAK was void of early foot lagging behind at the start, made a sharp move swooping around horses four wide at the three furlong pole, continued to move forward bidding for the lead outside at the quarter pole, loomed menacingly between in the four path turning for home and stubbornly never wavered with challengers on either side in the drive but was on the wrong end of a tight three way scramble for the win at the finish line. WALTER ME LAD had the inside position watching the frontrunner, watched the embattled duo between foes in the two path at the three furlong pole, dropped back with a quarter mile to run, moved out four wide at the top of the stretch and resurged in deep stretch to be a fringe player in the end. BLAZING BO stalked on the inside down the backstretch, began to lengthen stride inching up taking the short way around by midturn, angled out in the three path exiting the turn and finished with intent in the late running. WESTERN WHIRL broke out on the start, had an uncontested lead into the backstretch, was pressed inside for the front end by the half mile marker, went head to head with the pesky inside for into the turn, comfortably edged away outside with five sixteenths to go, was well in hand in the two path in control at the top of the lane and drew off with ease when asked for more in the final furlong. BABBO bobbled on the break, appeared to be content tracking the pacesetter inside early down the backside, moved in with no one else pressing the pace at the half having the rail, battled inside up top going into the bend, could not keep up to the winner under a vigorous ride midway on the turn and chased in vain down the stretch to be a clear second at the finish line. POSEIDON STEEL could see the field leaving the chute, co-trailed on the inside by the half, took closer order hugging the fence around the turn, shifted out four wide coming with a run and ran on willingly in the four path to capture the show money albeit a distant third at the finish line. TIME FOR TRUTH had the rail in midfield down the back straight, offered a mild burst urged to go after the frontrunner in midturn, shifted to the three path with a chance for a small share in upper stretch and finished up one paced to garner a minor role in the end. GILT EDGE stalked near the rear in early backstretch, shared the rear outside with a half mile remaining, narrow the margin when scrubbed on for more three wide at the quarter pole, swung out widest in the six path turning for home but had little to show outside foes in the late running. THE GREAT OZ travelled in the middle of the group outside another rival, was hard ridden but could not keep up to the lead three halfway around the bend, emptied out between rivals five wide at the top of the lane and was not persevered with in deep stretch.

GLOBETROTTING tucked in settling mid-pack, entered the turn four wide, advanced on that bend fanning seven wide into upper stretch, drifted in a couple paths bidding for the lead, took charge past the eighth pole and forged clear. ASHUKA bumped a rival after the start, was forwardly-placed stalking outside, advanced four to five wide on the turn, made a mild bid in mid-stretch, was no match but second best, LIVININTHEFASTLANE quickly moved clear, set the pace inside, was shadowed by foes into the turn then shook clear of those extending the lead past the three-eighths, weakened in the stretch while shifting out a bit in mid-stretch, saved show. HALCON NEGRO bumped a rival at the start, settled well back, saved ground inside on the turn, angled eight wide at the top of the stretch, gained late. GINGER'S HOLIDAY dropped back early, was far back heading into the turn, fanned nine wide turning for home, gained late outside. MICHAELS GIFT was lightly brushed at the start, settled inside, ran on evenly. RINGINTHEHOLIDAY was outsprinted early chasing mid-pack mostly three to four wide on the turn, came out seven wide in upper stretch, ran on. DROGON bumped with a rival at the start, chased in behind inside foes but off the fence on the turn, weakened in the stretch. GHOST BUSTED steadily dropped back into and on the turn, passed a few tired ones in the stretch. GERALD was bumped at the start, chased three wide up close into the turn, faltered and faded. Z HUB was bumped at the break, raced outside a foe well off the pace, came into stretch seven deep, failed to rally. AIM DON'T MISS was outpaced, saved ground on the turn, came out a few paths for the stretch run, made no bid. EARNING MY EARS chased from between foes, steadily dropped back, shifted in on the turn, faded. COSMOSTORM bumped a foe then was bumped at the start, lacked early speed and was never close.
