HEAVEN'S CHAMPION settled into stride on the rail near the rear midway along the backside, crept up taking the shortest way around the oval while well in hand, loomed boldly in the two path in upper stretch, battled outside for the lead with the unwavering frontrunner in the final furlong inside but managed to inch away late for the win. TIGER TOWN broke a step slow, recovered to be on the engine having the rail by the half mile marker, edged away having a clear advantage on the turn by the quarter pole, dug in holding up top at the furlong pole but grudgingly conceded the top spot to the late closing winner outside in deep stretch. ALPHA KADIN had the two path unhurried seeing the field, was under a snug hold waiting for the cue to go behind horses on the turn, was forced to go widest in the six path to get clear run at the top of the stretch and charged home smartly down the lane but could not get to the front duo in time. COHERENCE broke sharp having the early lead, vied between rivals in the mix up front by the half mile marker, chased two wide but the pacesetter was beginning to get away at the quarter pole, shifted to the three path still in with a chance for a piece of the prize but finished up evenly in the final furlong to be a fringe player only in the end. JMR SPEEDY ESCAPE had the four path outside sitting in midfield, closed the gap while taking the outside route four wide along the bend, angled to the five path with the field strung across turning for home but had little to offer late when fading at the eighth pole. CADFAEL travelled three deep shadowing the lead pair with a half still left to run, held position coming under a ride while going three wide throughout the turn, shifted to the four path at the head of the lane, had to be checked in tight between horses at the furlong pole losing momentum and could not factor afterwards.

DISCO STAR settled three deep on the outside close to the back end in the early stages, ranged up three wide around the oval,, moved to the four path lengthening stride with aim on the frontrunner by the quarter pole and wore down rivals in the last furlong outside getting up just in time for the stretch running win. MIDNIGHT MARTINI broke away from the pack having a clear advantage by the five eighths marker, had company outside pressing the issue by midturn, continued to find more on the lead in upper stretch repelling the outside turn challenger by the furlong marker, braced inside with the eventual winner bearing down in deep stretch but was unable to fend off the stretch charge in the final seventy yards for the win but did still gutted it out lasting in a tight finish for the place share at the wire. ELUSIVE YAUPON had a nice set up sitting all alone watching the embattled duo throughout the turn, shifted to the two path for the drive, had to alter course three wide at the furlong pole between runners, fought on stubbornly with rivals on either side in deep stretch but was just nosed out for the place share at the finish line. SILICIUM (FR) had no early speed relegated to the rear down the down the back straight, still remained in last going two wide on the bend, swung out widest in the five path for the stretch drive and showed some late interest getting up for a minor placing. THANK YOU INDIA had the three path watching the top two runners, took up the chase two wide closing in sharply forcing the pace by midturn, angled three wide at the top of the stretch duelling up top outside but could not offer a finishing kick and wilted at the sixteenth pole. STROKE OF GENIUS had the rail position sitting in mid-pack in the early stages, dropped slightly back on the turn while saving all the ground, skimmed the fence taking the corner but had little to offer, coming up empty in the last furlong.

MANCHESTER ICE was hustled from the get go taking over control at the four furling marker clearing away getting to the rail, rolled along unopposed on the fence in the turn running and in the two path had plenty left to give going away for the dominant win at the finish line. UP N THE ANTE settled near the rear in the four path in the beginning, lagged behind the group midway down the backside, began to pick up the bit three wide at the midpoint of the turn outside runners and closed in late unable to get to the winner who had it all his way but still easily bested the rest for the runners up share in the end. MISTER BEAN was away slowly trailing after the start, improved position inside midway down the backstretch, advanced on the rail around the oval, had the two path inside two others duelling for a minor share in upper stretch and finished up smartly surging at the wire getting the nod for the third place share. TEAM ALMASTY had a slim lead inside when leaving the gate, was then relegated to a chasing role outside at the half, travelled two wide still in pursuit of the pacesetter through the turn, shifted to the rail straightening out for home but was no match for the winner who had lots in reserve in the final furlong and faded in the final sixteenth being nabbed at the finish line for third money. FRANKNESS was at the tail end far outside with a half mile still to run, made a brief spurt coming with a run splitting foes two wide improving midway around the bend, had the three path between horses fighting for the show award in mid-stretch but was out kicked in the late going. MONEY TALKS was fractious in the stall with the rider getting off then being backed out, settled outside of runners in the three path in midfield early on, dropped back abruptly three wide between runners at the five sixteenths pole, trailed the field at the top of the stretch and was not persevered with in the final eighth of a mile.

RELOAD EH went quickly to the fore to set the pace inside, faced pressure from the eventual winner, began edging away slightly past the seven-sixteenths but was soon after challenged again by that rival, was no match but kept on to be second best. BOOTSONTHEGROUND was situated three deep watching the lead pair down the back straightaway, contently travelled three wide outside a couple of runners measuring the engaged duo around the bend, shifted to the four path in the hunt turning for home, drifted in slightly trading brushes with an inside runner while closing in at the furlong pole and grinded away determinedly in the final seventy yards to get the better from the barn buddy at the wire. UNBRIDLED WEATHER was content to shadow the pacesetter outside in the early going, took even closer order flanking outside throughout the turn,, had the three path continuing to fight up front at the top of the stretch, drifted outwards exchanging brushes with the eventual winner at the furlong pole, moved inside to the rail for the late running but stalled in the final seventy yards to settle on the fringes. EXTRAORDINARY ONE (GB) had the rail while sitting in midfield along the backside, made no movement taking the shortest way around the bend, had the two path inside rivals still in the conversation at the head of the lane but finished up one paced and could not get involved late. BIG TIME BOSS had a tracking position between horses down the backside as well as throughout the turn when travelling two wide, moved to the three path within striking in upper stretch but could not quicken with others who were making a rally in the final furlong.

PURR FACTOR cleared and crossed over from the outer post to be loose up top around the first of two turns, rolled along picking up the pace increasing the advantage considerably down the backside, continued to throw it down bottoming out the field far ahead through the second bend and was kept interested in the stretch running overpowering rivals with a strong front end display. STAR ATTRACTION was content to let the pacesetter go on with it with sitting solely in the second spot early on, tracked the leader but was well behind down the backside, chased in vain throughout the far turn making no headway at all and finished up besting the rest for the runners up share but never threatening the winner at any point in the race. LADY ON THE NILE relaxed in the middle of the pack with an outside rival in the early stages, had runners on each side part of the last three going around the final bend, battled between foes in the last furlong and ran on willingly late splitting horses nearing the wire to capture the show money. CRYSTAL PEARL settled last but one racing off the rail in the two to three path, waited patiently before being asked leaving the far turn, swung five wide into upper stretch tipping out further at the quarter pole and under a ride, struck the lead near the furlong marker, drew clear late. BEYOND ADVERSITY was forwardly-placed but caught four wide into the first turn, shifted in late on that bend settling mid-pack along the inside, saved ground through the far turn, angled five wide at the top of the stretch then out a further path in upper stretch, ran on well late to gain the place. TORONTO CITY settled off the pace three to four wide early, advanced leaving the far turn coming five wide to the top of the stretch, struck the lead soon after, was outkicked and lost second late. IRISH MOJO set the pace inside but was soon confronted and headed by an outside rival, dueled up the backstretch retaking a narrow lead at the three-quarters, was overtaken in upper stretch, exchanged minor brushes with the dueling partner, fought on to hold the minor award. BEACH FACTOR unhurriedly brought up the rear, saved ground advancing willingly on the far turn, ran on inside. SILVERSTEIN attended the early pace from outside four wide, was taken back off the dueling leaders to stalk up the backstretch and in range, was asked by the top of the stretch but had no late response. CONNECT THE EMPIRE pulled from between foes to contend for the lead continuing a bit rank early up the backstretch with a narrow lead to force the pace, continued to press and vie on the far turn, exchanged light brushes in upper stretch, dropped back and faded.

LAKE COMO HEIST was prominent up top on the outside leaving the chute, chased the pacesetter outside at the half, moved in two wide on the turn making a bid outside at the quarter pole, had slim lead by the furlong marker, relinquished the front end to the early speed rival with a sixteenth to go but tenaciously found more in deep stretch to come back on for the gutsy win. GLORIOUS REVENGE argued for the led inside leaving the chute, edged clear on the fence at the half mile pole, was headed outside at the quarter marker, gave way on the front end briefly with a furlong remaining, relentlessly fought back seizing control inside once again with a sixteenth from the wire but could not fend off the winner for a second time just getting nabbed outside at the finish line. FULL STAR ran in tandem with an outside foe in mid-pack, rated kindly under a snug hold behind a trio of horses at the seven sixteenths pole

waiting for running room, hugged the rail coining with a rally straightening out for home and finished up mildly inside winning the battle for third money but never threatening the front two who had it to themselves the entire race. IMPERIAL WAR was hard held behind the leader at the half while sitting on the fence, kept a close eye on the lead pair while inside another in the second flight through the turn, shifted to the three path in the hunt between horses but needed more late losing the show duel to an inside foe in deep stretch. NYCELY travelled three deep keeping tabs outside on the engaged pair, tracked the top duo while outside a rival in the second tier on the turn, shifted out four wide in upper stretch in the mix for a piece of the prize but faded in the last eighth of a mile. FOUND MONEY was in no rush settling into stride close to the back end outside another runner, narrowed the margin at the half, made no impact while going three wide around the bend, shifted to the two path for the drive to the wire and could only pass a tired foe in the stretch running. METRO KING settled in mid-division on the outside with the field paired up down the backstretch, made a brief move circling, taking closer three wide around foes at the three eighths marker, dropped back by the quarter pole and yielded to others in the five path by the furlong marker. BETTERMUSTCOME had the fence ahead of only one runner in the early going, offered no movement taking the shortest way around the bend, skimmed the fence at the top of the stretch but could not play a factor in the stretch drive. ALMASTY FIVE was void of early foot trailing down the backside, had the two path making no progression around the oval, shifted to the four path turning for home and galloped on in the final furlong unable to get anything going.
