MARVELLOUS MARVIN was away alertly being up top at the start, relinquished the front to the inside foe while calmly running alongside the pacesetter at the half, continued outside battling two wide on the engine around the turn, had the three path starting to inch away from the stubborn early speed rival by the furlong pole and edged clear when getting the win at the finish line. TUCKAMORE broke inwards on the start, moved inside taking the lead getting a head in front by the half mile marker, threw it down on the rail having a slim advantage throughout the bend, had the two path fighting up front still in upper stretch, conceded the top spot to the winner by the furlong marker but kept trying to the finish holding safely at the wire for the runners up share. PERMANENT ACCESS was prominent up top in the beginning inside, took back being reined in off the engaged duo by the half tracking the lead pair with some outside company, sat poised in the two path measuring the lead trio waiting for a seam, had the three path very much in the conversation turning for home but ran on greenly in the last eight of a mile finishing up evenly securing the show award. RUBY ROSSO had a nice set-up sitting outside in tandem with a rival watching the contesting lead twosome, rallied three wide on the turn taking closer order by the quarter pole making a bid, shifted out widest in the four path in the hunt taking the final corner but could not find more late and stalled in the final furlong only capturing a minor placing in the end. MY JUSTYN THYME was off a step slow having only the other poor starter beaten down the back straightaway, had a brief turn of foot slipping up the fence getting into contention at the quarter pole, could not sustain the rally by mid-stretch inside and flattened out on the rail in the final furlong. CELEBRATOR hopped at the start breaking slowly to trail the pack down the backside, lagged well behind unable to get things going taking the short way around the oval and could not play a factor in the stretch running.

MOVENTOTHECOUNTRY had a head in front on the fence in the early stages, edged away for a clear advantage by the half, opened up at will travelling well in hand at the five sixteenths pole, had a commanding advantage at the top of the stretch and cruised on in through the lane to win comfortably for the frontrunning tally. MCKENZIE ROAD was situated outside the pacesetter pressing the issue two wide on the initial turn, contently sat just off the frontrunner outside down the backstretch, was urged for more at the three eighths pole but the winner pulling further away by the five sixteenths marker, had the two path giving futile chase down the stretch and lasted at the wire besting the rest for the place share. MAXINE MAGIC had to be checked slightly between runners coming under the wire for the first time, settled close to the back in the early stages, started to lengthen stride two wide at the quarter pole making a good rally inside of horses straightening out for the drive and had good late energy in the three path down the stretch to close in and just get up outside at the wire for the show award. THATSITTHATSALL ran as a pair with an outside foe in the second flight well off the contesting lead twosome, started to come with a run trying to narrow the margin midway around the second turn on the lead pair while separating herself from the rest of the pack, had the three path in the stretch running but was drifting in and out getting weary in the last sixteenth and got nabbed on the outside losing third place at the finish line. THAT GIRL ARTEMUS had the rail position in midfield with the group very spread out along the backside, saved ground closing the gap on the far turn, moved in two wide in upper stretch having a chance for a small share but could not continue the run and idled inside of rivals in the final sixteenth of a mile. SERENADING AMAYA settled near the rear while having to go three wide on the first of two turns, travelled on the outside still while three deep along the

back straight, ran one paced on the second bend remaining three wide, swung out widest in the five path in upper stretch and had little offer offer down the lane. LADIES RUM broke inwards being taken up briefly at the start, trailed the field around the first turn, continued at the rear along the backside, made no progression while three wide around the final bend and could only manage to pass a weary foe in the stretch drive. MAKAYLA travelled two wide outside another watching the lead pair early on, remained on the outside in the second flight well behind the front duo down the backstretch, could no quicken at the five sixteenths pole when called upon for more, retreated two wide between runners with a quarter mile from home, emptied out in the three path by the furlong marker and cantered home in the late going.

WHERE'S SAMNBAILEY was bumped sideways early then bumped again just after, settled mid-division stalking from outside, went four wide on the turn, came into upper stretch six deep, drove past inside the final furlong and held well. SERIOUS GREEN bumped with a rival at the start, settled off the pace, saved ground on the turn cutting the corner into upper stretch, tipped out in late stretch rallying between foes near the sixteenth pole but was second best. MISS CANDY GIRL tracked inside, tipped out a couple paths, went evenly and made no bid. FEATHERWEIGHT was coaxed forward from the start making a clear lead and shifting in, faced brief pressure up the backstretch, edged clear on the turn, weakened in the lane. TAKE CHANCES steadied slightly when put in tight quarters heading up the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, came out three to four deep turning for home, ran on without threatening. JINX ME bumped with a rival at the start, chased from between runners, came into upper stretch five wide, faded. AMI'S CRY veered into a rival twice in the early going, switched out and moved forward briefly pressing the pacesetter, retreated between foes on the turn, came out for the stretch run and failed to

menace. RYO AMAZING was outside at the rear, swung seven wide into upper stretch, was never near enough to threaten.

UNHEARD had runners on either side sitting in mid-division, began to lengthen stride angling inwards from the five path coming up to the three eighths pole, crept up through the turn two wide waiting to pounce at the quarter pole, found a lane darting up the fence in the final furlong and got up in the shadow of the wire for the rail skimming late rally. VELVET RAGE had the lead narrowly on the inside down the backstretch well off the rail, continued to dictate the pace getting to the fence while hounded outside through the turn, spurted away on the rail in upper stretch, still remained up top clinging between foes with a sixteenth to run but was caught by the winner inside in the last few jumps while saving the place share by a nose at the wire. WILD RED forced the pace on the outside in the three to four path in the early going, argued for the top spot two wide outside around the bend, drifted out to the four path letting the leader edge away in upper stretch, determinedly fought back coming on in the last sixteenth of a mile but was on the wrong end on the outside of a three way win picture at the finish line. CAYENNE KISS was forwardly placed removed from the rail keeping a close eye on the front twosome down the backside as well as throughout the turn, shifted to the two path in the mix in upper stretch but needed more three wide late when evening out in deep stretch to settle on the fringes. REACH FOR THE TOP travelled four deep on the outside of foes in midfield, dropped back at the seven sixteenths pole, made little

improvement two wide in the turn running, charged home late making one final burst between horses in the five path in the late stages but ran out of stretch just coming up shy with the late kick. ENCHANTED FOREST was unhurried at the rear in the beginning, started to come with a run three wide at the three furlong marker, continued to gain making a circling move outside foes at the quarter pole, swung out widest in the five path turning for home and was still coming on gradually in deep stretch but just came up short of getting into contention for a share at the finish line. STARSHIP PARADISE was situated inside rivals in mid-pack early on, took closer aim going two wide tracking the lead pair while outside another around the bend, moved out to the four path in with a chance for a piece of the prize in upper stretch but wilted between horses by the furlong pole. MONTY'S INN settled close to the back end while inside runners in the two to three path off the fence when entering the turn, was steadied on the rail at the three eighths pole to be in last throughout the oval and could not regroup to be a factor in the stretch running. I'M TENACIOUS was forced out a bit at the start, settled last but one, advanced inside late up the backstretch, saved some ground inside foes on or just off the rail on the turn, came out six wide in upper stretch, rallied to just get up in a head-bobbing finish. SOBIECH broke outwardly then was coaxed forward to a brief early lead, was headed by an inside rival, dueled with that one, took a narrow advantage again leaving the turn, led while drifting just a bit, was just nailed. MRS. C stalked the dueling leaders from outside, moved closer under urging three to four wide late on the turn, kept on in the lane while drifting in a bit, needed more. TEXAS HOLIDAY was urged forward from the start, moved to a narrow lead inside, dueled through the turn and was headed leaving that bend, continued to contend inside the stretch but was outfinished. PRETTY LIZA moved forward inside tracking the dueling leaders, came out three wide for room in the stretch attempting to split rivals, faced some traffic and steadied about a sixteenth out then again at the wire. TANZANITE LILY was reluctant to load, raced off the pace and off the inside, dropped back between foes and was asked for more three furlongs out, came out six then seven wide in upper stretch, ran on. SILENT PATSY settled at the rear outside, went mostly four wide on the turn still trailing outside foes, came into upper stretch seven then eight wide, failed to menace.

BUTTERFLY BILLIE prompted the issue while running in hand down the back straight, shot through seizing control with three furlongs from home, pulled away from the closest pursuer at the quarter marker, moved strongly under a hand ride at the furlong pole and was kept to the task in deep stretch holding safely for the win. SYMPATICO had two runners to her inside sitting in mid-pack three deep, moved in three wide on the turn closing the gap smartly at the quarter pole, remained in the three path in the hunt in upper stretch and had a good late stretch charge but was unable to threaten the winner but besting the rest comfortably for the secondary award. LADY DAYRELLS had the outside position being close the back end, started to pick up the bit two wide in midturn, moved to the four path gathering momentum turning for home and finished up willingly in the last eighth to be all alone at the wire for the show money. BEAU PINK had the early advantage on the outside, surrendered the front end to the eventual winner inside at the three eighths marker, chased in vain around the turn, still remained in the thick of things for a piece of the prize at the head of the lane but faded inside runners in the last eighth of a mile

holding for a minor placing. TOO MANY AMYS rated kindly in midfield between foes, kept pace travelling two wide on the turn with challengers on both sides, moved to the rail in mid-stretch but failed to fire in the late going. DANISH COOKIE broke a step slowly trailing on the rail in the early going, passed an outside runner starting to reach for more ground entering the turn, narrowed the margin slightly but could not improve position through the bend but did show some late intest trying to catch up to rivals in the final furlong. RED DRAGON had the fence while sitting in mid-division down the backstretch and along the turn, regressed at the quarter pole inside of runners with the pace quickening and yielded to others outside in upper stretch. NIKA'S PASSION settled near the rear having rivals on either side in the backstretch running, was relegated to last at the three eighths pole, lost more ground to runners through the turn and galloped in having little run in the stretch drive.
