FINAL ACCORD rated kindly keeping a close eye on the frontrunner while inside another down the backside, was poised narrowing the margin in midturn, angled out four wide pouncing on the leader straightening out for the drive and won going away impressively in the final furlong. TWIST OF SUGAR shook loose clearing to the fence by the half, rolled along unopposed setting a brisk pace on the turn, had a diminishing advantage by the quarter pole, was collared outside in the three path turning for home, offered little resistance to the winner with a furlong to go but did finish up stubbornly to clearly hold for the runners up share. INSTANT RESPONSE had a stalking role ahead of only one runner while getting to the fence midway down the backside, began to lengthen stride splitting rivals at the quarter pole improving position, drifted in for a moment in upper stretch and finished up with energy to be a non threatening, distant third at the wire. HEART TAP had the fence settling in mid-pack down the backstretch straight, drooped back slightly inside on the turn at the three eighths pole, advanced on the rail with a quarter mile to run, was in tight skimming the fence in upper stretch for a moment and ran on willingly to settle on the fringes in the end. AUNTIE'S BAMBINO was reined back on the rail with the field angling in to trail the group down the backstretch, lagged behind into the turn, took the short way around closing the gap with a quarter mile to run, shifted out to the three path in upper stretch and made little impact finishing up one paced outside horses down the lane. SPADINA had an outside position tracking the loose pacesetter along the backside, could not match strides with the front duo around the bend, regressed three wide outside foes at the quarter pole and emptied widest in the five path turning for home.

VOICE FROM ABOVE pulled the rider outside along the backstretch to take over control getting to the rail by the half, improved the margin up top when nudged for more at the quarter pole and drew off with authority in the final furlong for a commanding win. LIAM'S AWESOME broke a step slow seeing the field on the rail in the early stages, lagged behind saving ground on the turn, rallied sharply bursting between foes in the four path at the furlong pole, was no match for the winner who was long gone by then but did finish up determinedly fighting on inside to secure the place share in the end. KAVALA stalked on the outside ahead of only one runner down the backstretch, made little progression on the bend, angled out five wide at the top of the lane, shifted out further coming with a run in the six path by mid-stretch but was just outdueled by the inside rival for second money in the late stages. SARAH'S DANCER had a good spot alone alone moving comfortably watching the engaged pair at the half, was holding position three wide while roused midturn, angled out to the five path in the mix for a share turning for home and finished up mildly in the final seventy yards to come back on outside to be a fringe player at the wire. TATOOSONMYSOUL was loose in hand setting a moderate pace into the backstretch, relinquished the lead by the half mile marker, tried to re-rally while roused for more with five sixteenths from home, chased the winner to no avail by upper stretch just off the fence and wilted inside horses in the final furlong. VERI GIZMO had a stalking trip inside another in the early going, kept pace while under a ride outside in midfield through the turn, shifting to the three path between rivals with a chance for a piece of the prize but flattened out with rivals on both sides in deep stretch.

ENGLISH JUBILEE got away well then settled into stride in behind leaders, swung four wide leaving the far turn starting to advance, took over in upper stretch, kicked clear, held. NIKITA'S GEM briefly pressed the leader into the first turn, chased up the backstretch outside, was ridden along past the three-eighths, swung six wide into upper stretch, kept on, held second from a fast-closing DESIGN DIVA, who settled between runners then dropped back racing last but one off the inside, swung seven wide into upper stretch, rallied well from between runners but too late. HYMN TO HER unhurriedly brought up the rear, was encouraged along three furlongs out advancing outside foes, fanned eight to nine wide into upper stretch, gained late outside. BEAUTIFUL SKY was outside foes mostly three to four wide on the turns, swung out a bit further for the drive, ran on evenly. SOUPER SPORTY dictated the pace inside with mild pressure applied outside at the half, set an even tempo well in control improving the margin up top in midturn, burst away from challengers straightening out for home to comfortably cruise in for the gate to wire score. GOLDEN GOOSE was situated near the rear going three deep outside foes down the backstretch straight, took the short way around the turn seeing the field trying to find one s stride, charged sharply up the fence full of run at the furlong marker and closed in belatedly to get up right at the wire besting the rest for second money. SOBIECH was nestled on the rail in midfield, held position inside rivals throughout the bend, shifted to the three path for the drive to the wire and finished up willingly down the lane but was caught right at the finish line by a late running inside foe for the runners up share. ZABARTA shared the rear while outside another down the backstretch, made little headway with runners on each side around the oval, angled out six wide at the top of the lane and finished with interest between horses for a minor role. CHOICES MADE stalked on the outside travelling three deep, made no progression taking the outside route three wide on the bend, swung out widest in the seven path turning for home and managed to pass weary foes outside in the stretch running. TOAST THE GHOST co-trailed on the inside along the back straight, inched up taking the inside trip around the bend, shifted just off the rail having a clear lane in the final eight of a mile but evened out in the last sixteenth. I THINK I CAN (IRE) was well position on the outside in the second flight in the early going, chased the pacesetter three wide but was unable to keep up through the turn, shifted to the four path between rivals at the head of the stretch but yielded to others by the furlong pole. HENNA GAL improved along the backstretch to hound the pace under a hold outside at the half, could not keep up to the front running winner by the five sixteenths pole inside another and had little left in the drive, folding between foes three wide by mid-stretch.

CANDID CANDACE was unhurried stalking ahead of only the poor starter down the backside straight, began to reach for more ground outside smartly by midturn, swooped around runners four wide coming with a powerful rally at the quarter pole, was in full flight in the six path taking control in mid-stretch and was kept to the task late to hold safe for the win at the wire outside. MCGILL had the inside position watching the embattled three down the backside, wait for the cue to go creeping closer to the front trio at the quarter pole, was looking for a seam behind the leader two wide turning for home, darted inside to the rail nearing the eight pole and chased the winner home on the inside to be a clear second at the wire. ENCHANTED FOREST travelled on the fence close to the back in the early going, improved slightly running just off the fence through the turn, hugged the rail closing in at the top of the lane, was checked for a stride or two having its taken away coming up to the furlong plle but never wavered and kept coming on nonetheless to be a non threatening third at the finish line. CYMBAL COURT had an outside trip tracking the contesting threesome, was scrubbed on three wide between foes creeping up on the lead trio

with a quarter mile remaining, angled out in the five path in upper stretch and ran on mildly outside horses to be a fringe player in the end. FANNY M tracked the lead pair inside in the beginning, took closer order to force the issue on the fence by the half, edged away to have a narrow advantage saving ground through the bend, was clinging on scraping the paint straightening out for the drive, had no answer when a rival on either side drove past at the eighth pole and faded further with a sixteenth of a mile left to run. HOLIDAY ROSE leapt up on the break to trail the group down the backside, lagged well behind rivals on the turn, shifted out at the quarter pole catching up to a runner outside, swung out five wide gathering momentum at the top of the lane and ran on late to pass a few rivals outside in the last furlong. VANDOO dueled three deep outside two others for the front end along the backside, continued the three wide journey around the bend still in the mix up front, shifted out to the four path between foes turning for home but had little left to offer and tired in the final eighth of a mile. SECRET GIZMO settled in the middle of the pack down the backside, back pedalled between foes at the five sixteenths pole u dera ride and could not factor in the late running inside of horses. MCKENZIE ROAD had the advantage on the fence around the first turn, surrendered the lead to an outside foe entering the backstretch, reclaimed the lead inside by the half, had a slim margin up top dueling inside around the far turn, put away the pesky early speed foe on the outside when pulling away at the eighth pole and held off all new challengers comfortably in the late running. TOP OF D MOUNTAIN stalked near the rear outside, travelled four deep along the back straight, had a good turn of foot circling four wide around foes at the three furling pole, swung out widest in the seven path full of run down the stretch but could not get to the winner late and finished up clearly second best at the wire. CHERVONARUTA was tucked in on the rail watching the contesting twosome for the first half of the race, kept pace inside another in the second flight through the last bend, shifted five wide in the mix between horses at the top of the lane, was no match for the front pair by the sixteenth pole but fought on determinedly outside to win the show battle in the final seventy yards. SYMPATICO had the outside position in midfield, regressed slightly in the three path with runners on either side at the half, rallied smartly between horses three wide with five sixteenths still to run, angled inside just off the rail straightening for home and under left handed encouragement was just outkicked late losing the show battle. MISS BOUJEE shadowed the pacesetter outside on the first turn, briefly assumed command outside entering the backstretch, flanked the resurging leader outside by the half, battled outside going head to head around the last turn, chased the winner to no avail in the two path down the lane then faded between horses in the last sixteenth losing a few placings in deep stretch. FAULTFINDER travelled three wide tracking the lead twosome on the initial bend, remained three deep on the outside still keeping a close eye on the contesting pair down the backside straight, came under a ride outside in the second flight well in touch with the lead duo on the second turn, was forced out by the inside foe six wide in upper stretch and ran on evenly failing to menace in the last furlong. BLING D'MONEY HOME broke out on the start, stalked only ahead of the poor starter in the early going, improved up the rail at the half, waited on the fence in the third tier having nowhere to go midway on the final bend, had clear run inside on the rail turning for home but failed to fire through the lane. SERENADING KITTEN was brushed by the inside foe on the break, had to be taken hold off when outside rivals were angling in soon after the start, sat in mid-division nestled on the rail on the first turn, made no movement along the backside, was shuffled back being checked mildly in the two path between horses at the quarter pole and could not get into contention three wide in the stretch drive. DANISH COOKIE leapt up at the start to trail in the beginning, lagged behind foes along the backside, caught up to a rival outside on the final bend by the quarter pole but could not get further involved in the late running. D'S KANDY settled between horses tracking the front pair in the early stages, dropped back unable to hold position by the half mile marker, was relegated to the rear with a quarter mile remaining and lost touch with the group by mid-stretch.
