AUDAX MINOR assumed command on the fence into the first turn, dictated the pace unchallenged along the backside, still remained in front by a diminishing margin at the quarter pole but got a breather on the far turn with the third split and was resilient down the lane holding for the front-running win while drifting out slightly exchanging bumps with the outside foe when in a tight, dueling coming to the finish line. COMPTON was unhurried co-trailing on the outside going three wide on the initial bend, stalked outside foes having clear lane down the back straight, mounted a rally circling foes three wide at the quarter marker to loom the main threat outside in the four path turning for home, dueled outside under right handed encouragement gradually gaining on the frontrunner down the lane, stayed on the wrong lead through to the finish, traded bumps drifting in mildly while battling in deep stretch but could not go past the winner. SOL DE VERANO had a good spot on the rail nestled just back off the pacesetter, rated kindly under a long rein settling into stride smartly in midfield down the backside, narrowed the margin taking the short way on the turn drafting behind the leader by the quarter pole, shifted out in the conversation two wide straightening out for the drive, was no match for the front duo by the furlong pole running inside rivals and just lasted for the show money at the wire. SPRUNG LOOSE broke a step slow sharing the rear inside another on the first bend, could see the field quite in range of the leader with the field compact at the half mile marker, started to make a move picking up horses outside at the quarter pole, angled out gathering momentum in the five path in upper stretch, closed belatedly in the final eighth of a mile outside just missing the nod in the final jump for the third place share at the finish line and settled on the fringes instead. MAGIC SLIPS travelled three wide on the outside tracking the pacesetter in the early stages, closed the gap smartly on the final bend to press the issue outside making a bid two furlongs from the wire, continued to fight in the mix three wide between rivals in upper stretch but had little left late and faded at the furlong marker. OUT N OUT DISGRACE was situated between horses tracing the pacesetter in the beginning, settled inside a rival keeping a close eye on the leader down the backstretch, could not quicken with others on either side who were commencing a run at the three furling pole, trailed the group with a quarter mile to run and galloped down the stretch playing no role in the late running.

POETIC AMY was allowed to settle into stride trailing in the beginning, stalked in the rail in the third tier patiently waiting for the cue to go around the bend, angled out five wide reaching for more ground getting a seam in upper stretch and powered past the leader by the sixteenth pole to smartly win going away at the wire. SAVE THE DATE had a stalking role inside runners near the rear,, could see the field by the half, lagged behind the group around the oval, shifted outside picking up the bit three wide with a quarter mile to run, swung out widest to the seven path finding its best stride late, could not get to the overpowering winner down the lane but nonetheless charged outside rivals in the final furlong to get up at the finish line to best the rest for the runners up share. INDIANA ROAD was situated three deep outside close to the back of the pack, travelled outside a rival in the third tier on the bend, angled out four wide trying to make a run at the quarter pole, was floated out six wide at the top of the lane and had no finish to give in the stretch drive. TOTALLY IN CHARGE tracked in the second pairing outside another in the early stages, closed in four wide outside foes at the quarter pole to be in

with a chance for a piece of the prize between foes turning for home but failed to menace in the late running lacking a rally in the final eighth of a mile. KID FORESTER had a stalking position near the back on the inside of two others, inched up on the fence taking the short way on the turn by the guarter pole, moved out to the four path coming with a good run and ran on willingly between foes to be a distant second behind the dominant winner at the wire. GOOD SIN stalked close to the back three deep outside runners, could see the field going four wide outside horses at the three eighths pole, angled to the six path with clear run by mid-stretch and while staying on the incorrect down the lane still dig in showing good late interest to get up for the show award. ENCHANT ME was part of the rear threesome running between rivals along the backside, started to mount a rally splitting foes in the two path by midturn, was in the mix shifting out five wide for the drive to the wire but finished up one paced still managing to catch the leg weary early leader late for a minor placing in the end. STYLISH GENT was under a sung hold assuming command down the back straight, continued up top on the rail but by a shrinking margin with a quarter mile from the wire, angled two wide clinging up front in upper stretch, had nothing answer when the winner charged past inside at the furlong pole and weakened late losing a couple of placings in deep stretch. DISSECTOLOGIST was in hand contently tracking the pacesetter in the early going, moved into force the issue outside by the quarter pole, was in the thick of things three wides between foes at the top of the lane but needed more in the late stages when willing in the final eighth of a mile. U S ARMY CORPS settled in mid-division along the backside, made little impression three wide between foes around the turn, was allowed to drift out widest in the seven path straightening for home, had nothing to offer

whatsoever by upper stretch and was not persevered with in the final furlong.

PEJA DU was unchallenged getting to the fence easily in the first turn, slowed the pace down considerably along the backside bunching up the field at the half, rolled along still with no rivals coming on through the far turn and under a well rationed ride had plenty left to comfortably cruise home down the lane for the frontrunning tally. EL KABONG travelled three wide on the outside part of the last trio early on, improved slightly going three deep outside horses along the back straight, tried to circle around rivals three wide on the second turn, angled to the five path at the top of the stretch and was full of run outside horses in the final furlong to get up at the wire for the runners up share. EVER DANGEROUS was all alone watching the frontrunner on the first turn, had company

outside down the backside keeping tabs on the pacesetter, chased the winner in vain around the last turn, continued to run on determinedly through the stretch run but was nabbed just before the wire for the secondary share. HEMLO GOLD travelled in midfield along the backside, was roused but could not gain on the leaders through the last turn, shifted three wide at the top of the stretch and found another gear late finishing up mildly between horses to settle on the fringes. SAILOR'S PASSION had the rail co-trailing inside two others, started to reach for more ground midway on the far turn, shifted out four wide with runners on either side in upper stretch and found his best stride late bursting between foes closing in deep stretch while not that far off for the scramble for second money. ALLEY OOP JOHNNY was tucked in a few lengths behind the leader, kept pace under a ride having the fence around the final oval, hugged the rail in the mix for a piece of the prize by mid-stretch but tired inside rivals seventy yards from the wire losing placings late. PALACE VIEW (IRE) kept a close eye on the front two around the initial bend, tracked in the second flight going three deep along the backstretch, was urged trying to hold position in midfield on the final turn, angled out four wide turning for home and could only finish up evenly paced unable to get involved in the late running. SOULMATE had the rail in a stalking position, narrowed the margin with the field bunching up at the half, made little progression taking the shortest route around on the far turn and failed to menace, unable to reach contention in the stretch drive. LIL BIT GANGSTA settled in between rivals part of the back threesome in the early stages, made little movement outside horses on the final bend and could not factor lagging well behind the pack in the stretch running.

IMPERIAL GOLD was away alertly getting to the rail exiting the chute, opened up slightly still well in hand at the half, set an even tempo uncontested around the bend and drew off with authority when set down at the furlong pole dominating the field at the finish line. SOUPER ICONIC drafted behind the pacesetter sitting a few lengths back on the rail, edged up inside foes through the turn, shifted out two wide at the quarter pole, could not quicken with the winner by mid-stretch and just lasted inside from the two late charging rivals at the wire for the place share. DIVA'S GHOST had a stalking role ahead of only one runner in the early going, made a sharp move closing the gap saving ground on the turn by the quarter pole, shifted out three wide straightening out for home and had good late energy between foes almost getting up in a tight three way photo for the place share. AWE INSPIRED stalked inside another early on, was checked briefly midway down the backside behind horses, edged up inside foes in midturn,, shifted out five to six wide at the top of the stretch and rallied smartly outside rivals down the lane, surging at the wire just missing in a close picture for second money. BENLION was void of early foot trailing in the beginning, could see the field two wide still in range around the bend, made a sharp move scraping paint in upper stretch and finished up gradually inside horses in the final furlong. A LA CARTE tracked the front two outside down the backstretch, chased the winner three wide around the oval, drifted out four wide in upper stretch but lacked a rally between rivals in the late running. POWAQA stalked on the outside travelling four deep down the backstretch, regressed three wide outside foes midway on the turn, swung out widest in the seven path turning for home and passed a couple of tired rivals through the lane. HOLYMOLYMEOHMY settled in mid-division with rivals on either side down the backstretch, held her own under a ride keeping pace between foes around the bend, was taken hold off, checking mildly losing her path five, six wide in upper stretch and could not recoup showing little running in the late stages. MIAH SAID sat off the frontrunner applying mild pressure outside along the backstretch, was roused for more midturn but was unable to maintain position between foes with a quarter mile to go while go chasing the pacesetter and emptied out three wide by upper stretch.
