STARSHIP SERENITY was situated close to the back going three wide in the beginning, ranged up three deep down the backstretch, moved in swooping around rivals three to four wide in the last turn, pounced in the four path straightening out for home, powered past taking control by the furlong pole and cleared off smartly when crossing the finish line. BELLA CLASSICA had a tracking spot between rivals initially, closed in to shadow the frontrunner outside down the backstretch, came under a ride drafting behind the leader on the fence through the far turn, shifted four wide for the drive to the wire, could not get to the winner but kept on trying to the end and just got up at the wire outside for the second place prize. NYAATA had the lead just off the fence going into the first of two turns, remained in control slowing the tempo down along the backside, had a shrinking advantage through the last turn, offered little resistance in upper stretch when collared by the winner outside and faded slightly in deep stretch to just get nabbed late for the place share. FORE FIVE BUCKS was nestled on the rail under a snug hold behind the leader, eagerly pulled the rider under restraint inside to prompt the pace down the backstretch, was asked three furlongs out unable to match strides with the leaders on the far turn, hugged the rail turning for home and finished up evenly inside horses for a minor role in the end. BERTHA travelled three wide tracking the pacesetter on the initial bend, mildly improved three deep outside others down the backside, offered a brief rally three wide between rivals with the winner outside making a run at the three furlong marker, weakened outside foes by the quarter pole and could not factor in the late running. PHAST PHOEBE was allowed to settle trailing the field on the fence early on, narrowed the margin inside horses down the back straight, was urged for more but offered little response at the three eighths pole making little progression through the far turn and could not factor in the three path in the stretch drive. DIXIE IS A BREEZE stalked near the rear just off the rail in the beginning, could see the field under

right-handed encouragement to keep up by the half, lagged well the group on the far turn and cantered through the lane crossing the wire.

ARGOS was keen to go on inside but faced traffic racing in tight behind rivals past the wire the first turn, steadied slightly on heels near the six- and one-half marker, settled down mid-pack once less crowded, began to advance saving ground through the far turn, angled out seven wide in upper stretch, struck the lead past the sixteenth pole, just held a rival late. WILD DESERT (IRE) was carried out five to six wide entering the first turn by drifting foes, came back in settling toward the rear outside three to four wide, was encouraged nearing the quarter pole, swung nine deep for the drive, made a steady bid in late stretch but couldn't get past and was second best. TWO OUT HERO came in early gaining forward position moving to the rail and placing runners in tight, subsequently exchanged a bump with one of those runners at the six- and one-half, tracked in behind inside, saved ground till upper stretch, angled out four wide, bid past mid-stretch taking a brief lead but lacked the needed finishing kick. mid-division, steadied on heels coming to the quarter pole altering in to the rail at that juncture cutting the corner, navigated traffic in the stretch coming back out two to three wide to rally between foes but was not enough. CASSON crowded a rival at the start then came in and clipped heels behind, moved forward outside, pressed the leader, took over at the top of the stretch, weakened when headed past mid-stretch. BILL OF ICE bobbled slightly at the start then was bumped and crowded just after, clipping heels in the process and nearly stumbling to the ground, recovered and settled well back at the rear, came out four to five wide turning for home, rallied mildly between foes. RUDE PROCEDURE was placed in tight quarters exchanging minor contact early then again between runners about the six- and one-half altering out a bit into the first turn three to four wide, came back in stalking outside about three wide, advanced some on the far turn and was within range coming to the top of the stretch, was floated out a bit, weakened in the lane. CAITLINHERGRTNESS travelled three wide outside in the third flight on the first turn, had aim on the pacesetter moving closer three deep at the half, cruised around three wide outside horses on the last turn moving in menacingly by the quarter pole, took control still in hand four wide in upper stretch and drew away when asked for more at the furlong pole dominating rivals when crossing the finish line. HURRICANE CLAIR cleared from an outer post easily getting to the rail setting the pace, slowed the pace down slightly while uncontested down the backstretch, had company outside at the quarter pole, dug in trying to stave off rivals outside while two wide turning or home, gave way to the overpowering winner by the furlong pole but stayed on determinedly to be a solid second best on this day. FOR FLYING (BRZ) was tucked in on the rail behind the leader on the first turn, moved well just a few lengths off following the pacesetter down the backside, crept closer inside rivals on the last turn, skimmed the fence in the mix at the top of the lane, shifted out in the two path by the furlong marker and finished up willingly to be a clear third at the wire. FIVE TOWNS (GB) was nestled between two others watching the lead two on the first turn, had good forward position with the field strung out down the backside keeping a close eye on the front foursome, kept pace in the two path with the embattled trio at the quarter pole, angled five wide in with a chance for a share leaving the far turn and finished up mildly to get up in the final jump to be a fringe player in the end. FASHIONABLY FAB had a good early position getting to the two path from the outside post to track the leader in the early stages, was hard ridden vying between runners up front with a quarter mile from the wire, shifted three wide for the stretch drive but could not go with the lead duo in upper stretch, battled between foes for the show award down the lane still under a vigorous ride but had little left late and faded slightly in deep stretch. DANCING N DIXIE was at the back of the pack on the initial bend, stalked ahead of only one runner down the backside, started to pass runners four wide at the quarter pole, swung out widest in the nine path for a clear run in upper stretch and had a good late surge outside passing many runners in the last eighth of a mile. AVENUE NIEL (IRE) stalked close to the back of the pack in the beginning, trailed down the backstretch, lagged at the rear on the far bend, shifted to the six path at the top of the lane and went by tired runners while outside down the stretch. LITERATE was situated inside horses just off the fence close to the back in the early going, made little headway along the backstretch, was under a drive making no impact in the three path through the far turn, angled out seven wide straightening out for home but could not get involved in the late running. TALK TO YA LATER was steadied hard on the rail inside foes while in tight behind the leaders on the first turn, continued to argue with the rider on the fence early down the backside sitting in mid-pack, retreated on the rail through the last turn and had little to offer in the drive to the wire travelling in the three path. WILD PANSY (GB) had a slow start on the break, improved angled out five wide in the first bend, settled into stride in the three path between horses in mid-division along the back straight, edged closer three wide with rivals on each side on the last turn, shifted out six wide turning for home but faltered at the eighth pole. JOHANNY was a little antsy in the stall prior to the start, was forced out by the inside runner going six wide on the first turn, improved four deep outside rivals to midfield along the backside, had a good turn of foot coming with a run four wide outside foes from the five sixteenths pole to the quarter marker, was again pushed out seven wide for the stretch drive between rivals and folded by the furlong marker.

CORSIA VELOCE settled in behind the leaders inside, came off the rail early up the backstretch advancing mildly then back in, saved ground on the far turn, tipped out for the drive, bid between foes past the furlong marker, took a narrow lead near the sixteenth pole and held while being kept busy. HOT MASH moved clear and shifted in to set the early pace from just off the rail, was overtaken past the five-eighths and let that one go stalking in behind, moved on the far turn making a secondary bid at the top of the stretch four to five wide, was outkicked for the top prize but kept on to secure the place. LA CULASSE was just lightly bumped at the start, stalked three wide early, moved rapidly to the lead past the five-eighths and cleared, dictated terms, was challenged in mid-stretch but kept on gamely while simply being outkicked. DANCE TO THE MUSIC (GB) broke a step slowly, was in tight between runners steadying just slightly early, settled down and unhurriedly brought up the rear, swung nine wide for the drive, gained modestly widest of all but needed more. DEEP LEARNING came in then altered back out early, went three to four wide through the first turn settling well off the leaders, still raced outside toward the rear with much to do on the far turn, asked for more past the quarter pole, swung six deep into upper stretch, ran on well but needed more. DIXIE LAW was forwardly-placed outside in pursuit of the leaders, went three to four wide both turns, came out a bit for the drive, failed to rally. STAR ATTRACTION bumped a rival just lightly at the start, was caught three to four wide early, settled mid-pack up the backstretch, swung eight wide turning for home, weakened. SWEET FUSION chased up close inside early, dropped back up the backstretch, was just off the rail on the far turn, weakened in the stretch.

PINA COLADA was a bit headstrong early racing off the rail, settled down saving ground thereafter and racing toward the rear, failed to menace.

AWESOME BOURBON was part of the mix up front early, took back to draft behind the frontrunner on the first turn, shifted outside entering the backstretch to move in bidding for the lead by the half, opened up powerfully around the last turn on rivals and continued to move strong down the stretch increasing the winning margin by many at the finish line. NIAGARA SKYLINE broke sharp in the mix at the start, was allowed to drift out down the stretch for the very first time watching the frontrunner, had a good spot isolated keeping a close eye on the engaged duo down the back straight, rallied outside taking closer order midway on the last turn, appeared to be the only one with a chance on the winner three wide in upper stretch, could not gain by the furlong pole and just held on to be second best at the wire inside. JAYHAWK was bumped outside on the break, then, was in tight between foes having to be checked leaving the seven eighths pole, settled into stride with rivals on each side down the backside in midfield, began to reach for ground splitting runners in the two path midway on the final bend, shifted out four wide for the drive, could not get to the winner who was long gone by the furlong pole but ran on determinedly down the lane and almost got up for the runners up share outside in the end. MASON'S GAMBLE was all alone stalking near the rear on the first turn, made no progression along the backside, edged up by the five sixteenths pole, was stuck behind foes looking for a seam at the quarter pole, shot through finding a lane between rivals five wide in upper stretch and with a good late charge got up for a minor role at the wire. JUNIPERO SERRA had the rail position co-trailing on the inside of another in the early stages, still saved all the ground through the far turn, skimmed the rail entering the stretch and finished with interest shifting out three wide at the furlong pole going by many rivals in the late running. LAC MACAZA was nestled on the rail in midfield, closed the gap improving inside runners to track the lead duo by the half, came under a ride keeping pace taking the short way around the final bend, moved out three wide for the drive but finished up evenly between rivals in the last furlong. DAI VERNON co-trailed on the outside for most of the race, shifted out three wide turning for home, passed a few tired foes down the lane but failed to menace in the stretch running. NO MORE OPTIONS angled in coming under the wire for the first time to track the leader outside going three wide on the initial turn, travelled three deep in the second flight outside watching the contesting duo down the backstretch, could not hold position dropping back in the three path by the three eighths marker, swung out widest in the seven path turning for home and could not factor outside rivals in the drive to the wire. IRONSTONE was hustled from the outer post to clear for the lead on the fence around the first turn, dueled inside up top with the eventual winner under a quick pace down the backside, gave way on the front-end by the three furlong pole and stopped in the two path in the final furlong. MALIBU MAMBO broke inwards bumping a rival on the start, had to be steadied coming under the wire for the first time leaving the seven eighths marker, sat in mid-pack three deep along the backside, offered a mild run when urged for more three wide at the three furlong pole, angled to the six path in upper stretch but folded at the furlong marker.STEWARDS INQUIRY COMING UNDER THE WIRE THE FIRST TIME IN TGE VICINITY OF THE SEVEN-EIGHTHS POLE RESULTED IN NO CHANGE
