CRUCIAL TAUNT was unhurried stalking on the outside early on, begin to reach for more ground at the half, circled runners three wide going into the turn, had a strong turn of foot midway on the bend closing in sharply, pounced outside with a quarter mile from home, was well in control in the three path in upper stretch and won going away at the finish line. ADELAIDE COURT was hustled right from the break to be well in front midway down the backside, continued up top in the turn but by a shrinking margin with five sixteenths to go, had no answer when the winner swept past outside at the quarter pole but stubbornly dug in to hold besting the rest for the runners up prize at the wire. JMR SPEEDY ESCAPE was isolated content while tracking the lone speed, closed the gap in the two path between horses in midturn, shifted out three wide in the mix at the top of the lane and travelled one paced down the stretch to garner the show award at the wire. BIG BABY HENRY stumbled on the break, had a stalking role inside the eventual winner down the backstretch, started to get into gear three wide at the quarter pole, gathered momentum angling out five wide straightening out for home and finished up mildly outside rivals to be a fringe player in the end. CATHOLIC JACKIE was situated outside another keeping a close eye on the lead two down the backstretch, was checked between rivals leaving the seven sixteenths pole, made little impact around the bend, was checked again losing his path five wide at the top of the stretch and could not factor in the late running. CABERNAYDO was nudged along trailing while exiting the chute, could see the field down the backside, lagged behind runners around the bend but did show some interest on the rail in the stretch drive to pass a weary for in the final furlong. PASSTHEPUDDINPLEAZ had the rail position watching the front dup down the back straight, saved ground under a ride but retreating inside runners around the bend, moved out three wide turning for home but emptied out by the furlong marker. PHILLIP MY WINE had a nice spot tucked in on the rail behind the leader in the early on, rated kindly measuring the lead duo down the backside, shifted out off the fence at the three-furlong marker, rallied three wide around foes at the quarter pole, took control easily three wide turning for home and proved much the best drawing off by a good margin under mild handling. BOWMAN'S RUN was brushed inside on the break, stalked near the rear in the first turn, moved up inside foes by the half, edged up on the fence early in the far turn, angled out continuing the rally three wide at the quarter pole, was no match for the dominant winner down the lane but finished up strongly outside foes to clearly be second best at the wire. WELLER GREEN was allowed to settle sharing the rear inside another early, still could see the field finding his stride down the back straight, began to pick up the bit outside foes at the quarter pole, was full of run in the four path straightening out for home and with a strong late surge got up to capture third money just before the finish line. HERE I GO was loose up top on the first turn, set a lively pace while hounded outside along the backside, had a diminishing advantage on the turn, was collared outside offering no resistance to the winner in upper stretch, drifted out to the three path by the furlong pole getting weary and faded inside runners in the last seventy yards to just get nabbed in the final few jumps for the show money. THORNBURY tracked the lone speed outside on the first turn, narrowed the margin outside to flank the pacesetter by the half, was scrubbed on but could not gain on the contesting pair at the quarter pole, shifted off the fence from the tiring leader in upper stretch, had to angle back inside with a furlong to go but lacked a finish inside horses in deep stretch. LASTING SILENCE had the rail keeping a close eye on the frontrunner after the break, travelled alone in midfield through the first turn, made little headway along the backside, was unable to hold position outside another midway around the last bend and could not get involved having the three path in the stretch running. ADAPTED broke out on the start to co-trail outside in the beginning, improved slightly outside foes along the backstretch, was asked for more offering little response midway on the last turn and failed to menace inside rivals in the late running.

RELOAD RALEIGH was pushed out on the start, had a slim advantage outside foes in the beginning, contested the pace outside relinquishing the lead at the half, regained the front outside midway around the bend, was clinging onto the top spot inside two wide turning for home, lost the front end for a stride or two in upper stretch, switched leads coming up the furlong pole and was game inside in the late stages to edge away for the hard fought victory. TIME ZAPPER veered outwards on the start, vied between runners in the early going, was taken back of the engaged pair by the five eighths pole, shifted out three wide at the three furlong marker moving up through the turn, pounced three wide with a quarter still to run, had hid head in front briefly in the four path in upper stretch but was outkicked by the determined winner inside in the final furlong. EUBANK was brushed inside at the start, traveled four deep in midfield down the backside, closed the gap taking the overland route four wide at the five sixteenths pole, shifted out to the five path in upper stretch and ran on mildly to be a distant third at the finish line. WAITINGFORAHOLIDAY broke out on the start, stalked inside a rival down the back straight, was hard ridden losing ground to the lead group throughout the bend, angled out five wide for the drive to the wire and only picked up a weary rival in deep stretch outside to get a minor share in the end. SMOKE MCLEOD pressed the pace on the rail at the start, moved up getting his head in front on the fence by the half, surrendered the lead inside while encouraged left handed in midturn, could not keep up to the embattled duo who had it to themselves in upper stretch and wilted inside horses in the final seventy yards. NOT A CARE was antsy behind the gate prior to the start, broke sluggishly spotting the field, was hustled entering the backstretch by the rider to stay in touch, took the short way around the turn still at the back of the pack but could not play a role inside horses in the stretch running.

SULTANA broke just a half-step slowly, settled outside toward the rear, made a moderate advance outside foes up the backstretch, stepped it up on the far turn past the five-sixteenths rapidly gaining on the leaders, swept to the lead by upper stretch and moved clear, held. JUSTIFY PERFECTION tucked in tracking inside the leaders saving ground till upper stretch, came out, ran on to be clearly second best without threatening the winner. BRUTALLY HONEST settled off the pace, saved ground inside, came out a few paths in upper stretch, kept on, was best of the rest. NANTUCKETS DAY exchanged minor contact at the start, was between foes off the pace early and then again into the far turn racing two to three wide, came out six deep in the stretch, ran on. DESIGN brushed with the aforementioned foe at the start, settled inside a foe but off the rail toward the rear, swung eight wide turning into upper stretch, came in a bit in the lane, ran on. RATINGS UPGRADE (IRE) broke a half-step slowly, settled in at the rear, was still last past the quarter pole, moved out ten wide in the stretch, was never near enough to threaten. READY TO BATTLE was forwardly-placed moving up outside, stalked two to four wide, was still within range of the lead coming to the top of the stretch, was four to five wide at that juncture, faltered and faded. MY GIRL DELLA moved forward outside to mid-division heading into the first turn, stalked three to four wide, came out for the drive, faded. TEXAS HOLIDAY got away alertly, set the pace from the

### Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

JAGGERSGOTAGUN had a stalking role on the fence in the beginning, could see the field by the half mile marker, began to pass foes outside at the five sixteenths pole, had a full head of steam plus a clear path six wide at the top of the stretch, picked up rivals one by one through the lane and under a well timed late move got up for the stretch run win in the shadow of the wire. PRIVATE LABEL had a good trip on the first turn drafting behind the leader on the fence, dropped back briefly between foes in the two path at the half losing positioning, liked what he saw while three wide outside another watching the dueling foursome through the turn waiting to move, shot through in the three path taking control leaving the furlong marker but could not withstand the late charge by the winner outside in deep stretch. ARISTOTLE bore out five wide in the first turn taking another foe that was outside with him, was under a snug hold tracking the pacesetter outside down the back straight, battled for the front in the two path with runners on both sides throughout the final turn, poked his head up top in the two path in upper stretch, still was clinging onto the lead inside at the furlong pole but could not quicken with the two outside closers late and faded in deep stretch to be a clear third at the wire. MOHAYMEN DIAMOND was floated out going six wide into the first turn, travelled four deep down the backside improving outside foes by the half, continued to advance four wide circling horses at the five sixteenths pole making a bid for the lead, angled out in the six path in the hunt turning for home and kept finding more and tried gamely to the wire settling for only a minor share but a solid effort regardless. MALDINI drifted out going three wide causing a chain reaction with outside rivals going into the first turn, travelled three deep keeping a close eye on the front three at the half, moved in to bid for the lead three wide between challengers at the quarter pole, stayed in the mix in the five path in upper stretch but evened out by the sixteenth pole. YORKTON'S HONOUR was brushed inside when in tight having the four path between horses heading into the first bend, settled in the three path in midfield down the backside while rivals on both sides, got shuffled back at the three-furlong pole, shifted out five wide for the stretch run and passed tiring foes in the final furlong. LONNY'S GAMBLE was pushed out five wide between horses in a stalking role heading into the first turn, settled on the fence ahead of a couple of rivals down the backside, offered a brief run when scrubbed for more on the rail with five sixteenths to go, shifted to the three path straightening out for home, could not sustain the rally and stalled at the furlong marker. GOTME GOOD was carried out six wide when tracking the leader into the first turn, continued to move forward outside to shake loose up front by the half, was swarmed by outside runners while under a drive trying to hold the lead at the quarter pole, had nothing more to give at the head of the lane and wilted on the fence by the furlong pole. CAPTIVATING NAME assumed command having the rail into the first bend, relinquished the front entering the backstretch, tracked behind leader at the half, was scrubbed on but could not maintain position heading into the second bend, saved ground while trying to keep up to others on the turn but had little left to offer just off the rail by the furlong marker. TIMES A BREEZE was unhurried trailing the field into the first turn, moved outside picking up a runner closing in comfortably down the back straight, rallied three wide around foes at the three-furlong pole, stalled by the midpoint of the last turn, was eased at the top of the stretch and left via equine ambulance.
