KING PUTT got to the rail unchallenged up top in the early stages, disposed of the chasing rival by the quarter pole, skimmed the fence turning for home with a new rival pressuring outside, stayed on the incorrect lead down the lane continuing to hold up top, was getting leg weary drifting out under left handed encouragement in deep stretch but lasted to the finish for the gate to wire score. RUNAWAY MAXI broke out on the start, watched the frontrunner while outside a rival along the backstretch, regressed slightly three wide outside horses with a quarter mile from home, swung out widest in the four path in upper stretch and was the only one finishing up with late energy but could not get to the winner in time. ARRAKASTA IZAN had a good spot tucked in on the rail in midfield, started to come with a run on the fence at the quarter pole, moved out posing the main opposition three wide turning for home, did not change leads shortening stride by the furlong pole and wilted in deep stretch just saving the show money from an inside foe at the finish line. NIGHT STRIKER had an inside spot tracking the pacesetter, chased in vain through the last bend giving way by the quarter pole, finished up one paced in a slowly run stretch drive but did almost catch up to a tiring foe inside at the wire for the third place share. HIGHLAND PEAK was pushed out by the inside rival on the break, could see the field travelling three wide in the outside into the first turn, made an early move in the back straight to advance outside foes three deep closing the gap by the half mile marker, made little impression through the far turn and failed to menace running just off the fence down the lane. UPHILL ROAD stalked near the rear in the early going, narrowed the margin between foes at the half with position unchanged, lagged well behind offering no response when urged through the final turn and could not get involved in the stretch running.

PRIMA was in the three path part of the foursome watching the loose pacesetter down the backstretch, crept closer midway on the turn, posed the main threat in the three path turning for home and relentlessly plugged away in the stretch seizing command with a sixteenth to run to draw away for the victory when crossing the finish line. STEALIN'TIME stalked five deep on the outside early on, made a good move mounting a rally splitting runners two wide at the quarter pole, angled out three wide in upper stretch, was no match for the winner late but closed in belatedly to be second best at the wire. UNHEARD was unhurried in the beginning seeing the field, was carried out by the loose horse throughout the turn having no chance to get into contention but showed grit and determination to close in considerably on the pack in the deep stretch running. SHOOTIN' AMY was part of the quartet watching the frontrunner while between horses having the two path down the backside, took the short way around the oval keeping pace, had little to offer for the drive to the wire and yielded by mid-stretch. REACH FOR THE TOP was nestled on the fence tracking the lone speed along the backside in the second flight with a host of others on the outside, was in tight jostled inside possibly hitting the rail losing the rider at the three furlong marker, galloped along going to the outside fence taking another foe out there as well through th

SPRINGER narrowly had the front end on the outside down the back straight, shook clear midway on the turn up top, shifted just off the fence holding a shrinking advantage turning for home, drifted out in the last sixteenth clinging onto the lead under left-handed encouragement and just prevailed at the wire for the frontrunning tally. KNOWING watched the lead duo while three off the fence down the backstretch side, started to rally outside horses reaching for more ground at the three eighths marker, loomed menacingly in the three path in upper stretch, grinded away edging up to the leader outside through stretch but could not get to the winner at the wire. SWITCHIN' TO GLIDE had a hustling ride on the rail pushing the pace inside down the backstretch, was scrubbed on the fence letting the leader get away midturn, scraped paint chasing the winner in upper stretch, was still in the mix between foes three wide at the furlong marker, lost its path between rivals with the winner getting out late in deep stretch and managed to hold on for the show money in the end. SOUPER VINNIE was on the far outside stalking five deep early on, closed the gap sharply taking the overland route five wide through the turn, swung out widest in the six path at the top of the lane, could not threaten the lead duo late, settled on the fringes in the end but almost got up for third outside at the finish. PROFESSOR RELOAD had the inside position in midfield down the backside,continued the inside trip settling in the third flight watching the lead trio around the oval,, angled to the four path between rivals at the top of the stretch, shifted inwards two wide by the furlong pole and ran on evenly dueling for a

small piece of the prize in deep stretch. PRINCE ALMASTY was away slowly being a long last behind the field down the backside, closed in smartly on the turn, passed a rival inside leaving the quarter pole, kept on trying on the rail down the lane, could not get involved late but showed good late interest in his debut. ONDINE LADY pressed the issue inside early on, dueled on the rail moving very comfortably throughout the turn, spurted away just off the fence well in control turning for home and proved much the best coasting home in the last furlong while increasing the margin of victory at the wire. GIZMO'S B F F prompted the early pace three deep along the backside, tracked the engaged duo while outside a rival through the turn, angled five wide between foes in upper stretch and closed into be a distant second at the finish line behind the dominant winner. GOOGLY EYES was near the rear going four deep outside rivals down the back straight, made a big sweeping move four wide advancing around horses throughout the turn, angled to the six path in upper stretch, kept finding more when called upon and rallied late to capture the show money in the final seventy yards. FOREST B broke a step slow, recovered nicely sitting all alone watching the lead trio midway down the backstretch, kept pace under a ride in the second pairing on the bend, shifted four wide at the head of the lane and finished up one paced in the last eighth of a mile to settle on the fringes in the end. SHAMRA settled in midfield having challengers on either side down the backstretch, retreated into the turn to be three wide on the outside in the final trio around the bend, swung out widest in the seven path

straightening out for the drive and ran on mildly outside horses in deep stretch. PLUIE D'AVRIL was allowed to settle into stride trailing the group down the backstretch, had the fence still at the back inside two others travelling around the oval, hugged the rail straightening out for the drive but lacked a rally in the stretch running. APRIL DE VELP had a stalking trip inside another close to the back in the beginning, had no progression between foes while in the last group running around the turn and under a busy ride could not get into contention in the two path in the late stages. STRIKE A CHORD broke through the stall prior to the start, was away alertly to have a narrow advantage between rivals down the backside, battled outside with eventual winner around the turn, had little left to give two wide at the top of the stretch and folded with runners on both sides by the furlong pole.

HOME FOR A REST settled into a good rhythm on the fence part of the rear trio in the early going, saved ground through the turn, closed in sharply when urged for run turning for home, darted through having a clear lane inside runners at the furlong pole, seized command with a sixteenth remaining and was drawing away for the win at the finish line. VERDEJO had the three path between foes part of the scramble up front along the backstretch, poked her head in front with five sixteenths still to run, maintained control narrowly three wide in upper stretch, could not fend off the winners charge inside by the sixteenth pole and just had enough left to save for the runners up share at the wire. SPIRIT BEAR was in the mix in the two path in the beginning, took back by the half, was hard ridden chasing after the embattled trio midway on the turn, rallied taking closer order to be in the mix four wide at the top of the stretch and had good late energy surging in the final few strides to almost get up for second money outside at the finish line. ANAM CARA was situated close to the back going three deep outside challengers, picked up the bit improving around horses circling four wide at the three eighths pole, continued to close the gap around the oval, shifted inwards two wide by mid-stretch and finished up willingly to be a fringe player in the end. LOGISTICS argued for the lead travelling four deep on the outside down the backstretch, vied three wide outside two others on the turn, angled to the six path for the drive to the line, could not offer a finishing kick and flattened in the final furlong. SUPER SICILY had a slim lead inside a few rivals down the back straight, fought on stubbornly having the

fence around the bend up top, could not continue on with others at the head of the lane and tired in the two path between horses at the eighth pole. WICKED MERCURY was under a snug hold trailing between horses along the backstretch, had little movement running around the bend, shifted out five wide for the stretch drive, moved to the fence by the eighth pole but never factored in the late running.

THOR'S CAUSE had a stalking journey ahead of one runner in the early stages, co-trailed inside another while on the rail with five sixteenths to go, began to lengthen stride smartly shifting out at the quarter pole, had a full head of steam in the five path midway down the stretch and under steady gain got up in the last few jumps for the win. TRIP ACES was nudged on pressing the pace outside on the first of two turns, was content to let the leader go ahead tracking the pacesetter by the half, began to reel in the frontrunner through the second bend, pounced two wide poking his head in front in upper stretch, kept holding on inside down the lane but gave way grudgingly in the final seventy yards to share for the second place award at the finish line. PARADISE PERFECT travelled outside in midfield, moved in narrowing the margin on the lead two by the half, edged up through the far turn to be in the mix of things in the four path straightening out for home, dug in determinedly between foes with a sixteenth to go battling up top but was outfinished by the stablemate nearing the wire for the win. POCKET SPEED had his head cocked inside breaking a touch slow at the start, recovered quickly to take this field into the first turn on the rail, shook clear by the half, was collared outside with a quarter mile remaining, offered little resistance at the top of the lane and faded inside runners by the furlong marker for a minor role in the end. ROYAL ENTRY was void of early foot seeing the field in the first half of this route race, caught up to a rival outside who just happened to be the eventual winner at the five sixteenths pole, shifted out four wide turning for home but failed to menace outside

foes through the lane. BIG SCREEN BOSS emerged with a slim lead in the two path under the wire for the first time, tracked the leader while between rivals on the first turn, settled into stride on the outside in the second flight along the backside, could not keep up to others making a move on each side at the quarter pole and yielded on the rail in upper stretch.

BALLS IN UR COURT took over control soon after the start getting his head in front by the five eighths pole, rolled along unopposed slowing the tempo down up front around the oval, well rationed up top having more in reserve for the drive, opened up at will by mid-stretch and won as pleased when crossing the finish line. ROCK HARD ROSE was forwardly placed outside rivals along the backside, chased the frontrunning winner to no avail around the bend and down the lane but easily ran on to the end besting the rest for the runners up share at the wire. STRIKE A NOTE shared the rear on the outside down the backstretch, had little advancement between runners stalking near the rear through the turn, angled out seven wide in upper stretch and had a solid stretch run at the furlong pole outside horses to be a clear third at the wire. THAT'S A FACT was brushed on the outside to co-trail inside another early on, could see the field by the half, saved ground but lagged behind around the turn and put in a good stretch kick on the rail at the furling pole inside horses to garner a minor share at the finish line. LOVE TO DREAM stalked close to the back of the pack having the fence along the backside, still remained at the rear inside two others midway on the turn and had a good rally passing many rivals down the lane while having to weave its way through traffic in the stretch drive. UNCARRICK TERISTIC had a stalking role outside horses down the backstretch side, made no headway going three wide outside rivals on the oval, was pushed out seven wide exiting the turn, could not get involved but did pass many foes in the late running. TENTOMIDNIGHT settled between foes in mid-division, had a mild turn of foot advancing three wide outside rivals at the quarter pole, was in with a chance five wide in upper stretch but finished up one paced being passed by runners in the final furlong. BROWN BUTTER SAGE stalked with runners on both sides along the back straight, was roused offering little response inside foes taking the two path in the turn running and made little impression four wide driving down the lane. NO LAYUPS had a tracking role inside a rival down the backstretch side, settled in the second flight on the rail watching the lead pair around the bend and could not quicken with others making a run being checked slightly at the furlong marker then flattening out by the sixteenth pole. ARPISTAS ENCORE was away alertly having the advantage in the beginning, regressed down the backstretch to sit in midfield three deep by the half, was going the wrong way while three wide around the bend, shifted to the six path turning for home but had little to offer in the stretch running. CALL ME MISSLUCKY travelled in mid-pack on the fence at the half, kept pace just off the rail running around the turn, had no finish to offer for the drive to the wire and folded by the eighth pole. POOKIESLOOKINGFIRE travelled four deep watching the lead three runners along the backstretch, improved under a ride through the turn to be in touch with the front pair at the quarter pole, shifted out three wide having little left to give in the stretch drive and was engulfed by runners leaving the furlong pole.
