ANOTHER CHARLIE travelled well hounding the pace outside along the backstretch, moved in to battle outside up front around the turn, shook clear, opening up at the quarter pole and was kept to the task late to win comfortably in a solid debut. STIRLING CASTLE was nestled on the fence watching the engaged duo early on, came under a ride saving ground but could not gain in the contesting lead pair through the turn, shifted out three wide turning for home, was no match for the winner by the furlong pole but did finish up willingly to be a distant runner up at the wire. GUS'S DRUMBEET had a poor start trailing in the beginning, stalked ahead of only one other runner down the backstretch, made little headway travelling three wide around the oval, swung out widest in the five path straightening for the drive, found his best stride late and finished up with energy being a clear third while just missing out in the duel for the place share outside. DILWAALA had the outside position in mid-division travelling three deep along the back straight, kept pace still outside others while remaining three wide on the turn, was in the mix in the four path between runners in upper stretch but evened out with a furlong still to run to settle on the fringes in the end. TEMPLE HALL broke inwards on the start, was hustled having the lead on the rail down the backside, dueled inside with the eventual winner throughout the turn, gave way up top by the quarter pole, did not switch leads down the stretch, shortened stride and wilted inside rivals by the furlong marker. MORE THAN SCAT settled between rivals in the second flight along the backside, dropped back unable to quicken with runners on each side at the quarter pole and showed little running in the fence down the lane. BLACK THUNDER was unhurried trailing the field down the back straight, lagged well behind unable to get into gear around the bend, lost touch with the group at the top of the lane and cantered home.

RETAIL THERAPIST was in tight being pinched slightly on the break, recovered nicely to sit in a good spot relaxed on the fence keeping a close eye on the lead pair, waited behind the embattled trio on the far turn ready to make a move, angled out four wide pouncing outside at the head of the lane and relentlessly wore down the leader in the shadow of the wire for the stretch running win. KITTEN'S ROMANCE was content to be on the outside of another paired up tracking the engaged duo, moved in at the three eighths pole three wide bidding outside for the lead around the second turn, poked his head in front moving well in the three path in upper stretch but needed more late unable to fend off the steady pursuit of the winner in the final seventy yards. MASON'S MUSIC had inside position stalking in the third tier, made little progression along the backside, was looking for running room three wide at the five sixteenths pole with near the rear, continued to try to find a lane in the three path behind a wall of dueling runners at the top of the stretch, darted to the rail having clear run at the furlong marker and surged late inside horses to capture the show money. DESTINY RO broke in at the start, prompted the issue outside going three wide into the initial bend, flanked the pacesetter outside down the back straight, vied between horses battling up top around the final turn, still was in the thick of things just off the fence straightening for home but could not quicken with others making a stretch rally and faded in the final eighth of a mile to garner a minor share in the end. MIZZEN ASH was allowed to settle at the rear early on, still could see the field along the backside, was roused catching up to a rival outside with five sixteenths from home, moved out to the five path between foes for the drive but could only manage to pass weary runners in the stretch run. LADY MOONSHINE took advantage of the inside post to take this field into the first turn, set a moderate pace while hounded outside down the backstretch, continued to remain up front on the fence narrowly while contesting inside two others through the last turn, could not find another gear when called upon at the top of the lane and folded between rivals in the two path at the furlong marker. LOOKS LUCKY TO ME had an outside stalking position in the early stages, offered a brief turn of foot three wide taking closer order midway on the final turn, swung out widest to be in the seven path turning for home, had little run left to offer and emptied out in upper stretch outside rivals.

MAGIC POWER rated kindly nestled on the rail watching the contesting leaders along the backside, began to reel in the front pair shifting out at the quarter pole, remained in hand posing the main opposition gliding up closer in the three path straightening out for home between foes and under a patient ride, drew away when asked for run at the sixteenth pole to win convincingly when crossing the finish line. BENNYS JETS bobbled on the break, nodded heads arguing inside another in the early stages setting a brisk pace, disposed of the outside early speed rival in upper stretch, was collared outside coming up to the sixteenth pole, offered no resistance to the stablemate who drove by in deep stretch but still ran on well enough to be second best. MY BOY BRUCE was unhurried trailing the pack at the half mile marker, made no improvement taking the short way around the bend, closed the gap smartly scraping paint turning for home and showed a good late charge in the final furlong to get up just before the wire capture the show award. YODDHA tracked the engaged twosome on the outside down the back straight and throughout the bend, narrowed the margin four wide outside rivals at the top of the stretch very much in the thick of things, could not sustain the rally by the eighth pole and finished up evenly to be a fringe player in the end. WILDFIRE broke slowly veering out as well on the start, was roused down the backside to be outside stalking horses by the half, made little impression off the fence while urged along through the turn, shifted out three wide initially at the top of the stretch, could not get involved going five wide at the furlong pole but did pass a weary foe outside in the late running. COME ON BIG LOU was away alertly dueling outside down the backstretch, continued to not waver fighting it out up top through the turn, could not quicken with others making a rally while in the two path between horses in upper stretch and faltered by the sixteenth pole.

NAPA SPIRIT (IRE) had a slim advantage on the fence down the backside, maintained control moving comfortably on the rail while pressured outside running around the oval, shot clear when nudged for more in the two path straightening out for the drive and under mild urging held safe for the frontrunning score. CLASSIC DANCER broke outwards on the start, pressed the issue outside three deep in the early going, shadowed the pacesetter outside throughout the turn and chased the winner in vain down the entire lane just saving the runners share from an oncoming outside rival at the finish line. GUILDSMAN (FR) was void of early foot sharing the rear inside after the start, could see the the compact group well within range at the half, made little improvement saving ground on the bend, shifted out gathering momentum in the two path exiting the turn, moved out further in the four path coming with a late charge, secured the show award in deep stretch but almost closed in for second money as well at the finish line. HIGHLAND SOCIETY vied between horses in the beginning, was reined back to have a good spot all alone watching the contesting pair at the half, was tucked in on the rail sitting just behind the frontrunner on the bend, angled out four wide at the top of the stretch but failed to fire between rivals in the late running. BORDER TOWN was pushed out by the inside rival on the break co-trailing outside at the start, improved slightly along the backside to stalk outside by the half, could not close the gap around the bend, shifted out four wide asking for run outside rivals in upper stretch, offered no response, was not persevered with in the final furlong and was eased up when crossing the wire.

MO TOURIST tracked the pacesetter outside on the initial turn, made a savvy move to take back sitting behind the engaged duo at the half on the outside, waited for the cue to go in the second flight with a rival inside on the last turn, shifted to the four path outside three others fighting for the top spot down the lane and in the final few jumps got the better of a stubborn frontrunner to edge away for the win. SHAMATEUR was roused in the beginning intent on getting the lead on the rail into the first turn, continued up top pressed by first one rival along the backstretch then another outside by the half, was headed outside with five sixteenths from the wire, dueled through the far turn, inched away getting the advantage again at the furlong pole, gamely dug in down the lane inside but just could not find that little bit more late to fend off the winner in deep stretch. COLONEL MUSTARD went three wide outside foes watching the pair in the first bend, took closer order to bid outside by the half, battled with an insside foe up front around the far turn, poked his head in front for a stride or two between rivals in upper stretch, could not sustain the rally and faded up top in the final seventy yards to just last for the third place share at the wire. PROUD RONIN had a good trip nestled on the rail drafting behind the pacesetter for the first part of the race, angled out off the dueling couple at the quarter pole to be three wide between horses in the hunt at the top of the lane, was in tight with the eventual outside bearing in driving through the stretch, had to take back, angled out for clear run with a sixteen to go being four wide and came on late to almost get the show money at the line. STONKS settled into stride trailing the field going four wide on the first of two turns, made an early move four deep advancing outside horses entering the backstretch, was situated three wide on the outside part of the rear trio on the final turn, shifted out five wide turning for home but could not get involved in the late running.

LIL BIT GANGSTA travelled between horses in midfield, was shuffled back losing positioning through the backstretch, had the rail sharing the back end with two outside rivals on the last turn and made little impression inside horses in the drive to the finish line. TRUE SHOT settled near the rear travelling three wide in the early stages, dropped back to last three deep at the half, made no movement with runners on either side in the final bend and could not be a factor in the three path in the stretch drive.

TAZMAN had the lead but had trouble navigating the first turn going five wide up top, was uncontested down the backside, rolled along with no rivals making a run through the far turn and under a well rationed out ride just had enough in reserve to last for the win by a shrinking margin at the finish line. WALTER ME LAD broke out mildly bumping the rival to his right on the break, tracked the pacesetter on the rail, closed in smartly just off the fence at the quarter pole, posed the only threat three wide at the top of the lane, was gaining gradually in deep stretch under a busy ride outside but just ran out of ground trying to get to the winner at the wire. PENNER ASH (IRE) had an inside stalking position in the third flight in the early stages, charged up the rail in the stretch dueling for a piece of the prize and finished up willingly outside in the final sixteenth of a mile to hold on being a non threatening third. C MY MEISTER co-trailed on the rail early on, continued to see the field along the backstretch, could not close the gap taking the short way around the last bend and finished with intent on the fence in the last eighth of a mile for a minor reward in the end. QUIET INTENT broke in exchanging a slight bump with the inside foe on the start to co-trail outside in the beginning, stalked outside ahead of only one runner along the backside, tried to circle around houses four wide midway on the far turn, could not sustain the outside rally in upper stretch and stalled by the furlong marker. ALLEY OOP JOHNNY had a tracking role four wide on the beginning turn, chased the pacesetter between foes along the backside, was going in the wrong direction in the two path with rivals on either side at the quarter pole and wilted just off the fence in upper stretch. LOVE YOU LIPPY had the early lead on the rail, continued to hold on up top narrowly on the fence moving well on the turn, edged away when nudged on at the top of the stretch and drew off with conviction in the final furlong. MY CASH FACTOR travelled in the middle of the pack inside another, began to pick up the bit between rivals three wide a quarter mile from the finish, charged down the lane in the five path with a good late kick, was no match for the dominant winner but easily bested the rest for the runners up share in the end. MI TORMENTA settled on the rail near the rear in a stalking role down the backstretch, made little impact around the bend, skimmed the fence mounting a rally at the top of the stretch, darted inside foes at the furlong pole and got up in the final few jumps for the third place share at the wire. REALLY THIRSTY vied between rivals along the backside, remained in the thick of things still having runners on each side battling around the turn, kept finding in the two path still in the hunt in upper stretch but faded between rivals in the last sixteenth to just save for a minor share at the finish line. VERI GIZMO was void of early speed trailing down the backside, lagged behind saving all the ground through the turn, swung out widest gathering speed in the eight path in upper stretch and had a solid late charge but was on the losing end of the three way photo for the show money outside. CINNAMON BITS stalked close to the back in the three path early on, made little headway going three wide outside challengers around the oval, moved out five wide straightening out for the drive but had not rally to give in the late stages. IMA BEAST pressed the issue three deep down the back straight, continued on three wide around the bend prompting the pace outside, still fought on in the mix having the three path turning for home, had little left for the late running and weakened a furlong still to run. VICTORIA ELIZABETH settled in midfield outside foes down the backstretch, offered a mild run around horses four wide narrowing the gap at the quarter pole, shifted out seven wide between foes in upper stretch but lacked a finishing kick through the stretch. SILENT TRIBUTE had an ideal spot isolated behind the engaged trio midway down the backside, was scrubbed on to go after the lead three with five sixteenths from home, offered little response and folded just off the fence by the eighth pole.
