SPLASH OF BOURBON broke a step slow spotting the field on the break, quickly recovered to be in the fray up top three deep by the half, battled outside around the bend, switched leads at the top of the lane disposing of the inside early speed rivals and was kept to the task to hold on by a diminishing margin at the wire. DADDY'S SECRET was unhurried trailing on the fence, began to pick up runners taking the short way around the turn at the five sixteenths pole, hugged the rail lengthening stride turning for home, burst between rivals in the two path coming with a rally at the furlong marker and was gaining on the winner late bit it wasn't enough at the finish line. FORESTERS EXEC was unhurried co-trailing outside another in the four path along the backside, began to pick up the bit outside reaching for more ground around the turn, was full of run widest having a clear path five wide at the top of the stretch and flew home outside foes late to edge away for the stretch running win in the final few strides. GOOD SIN prompted the pace three wide in the beginning, settled outside another in the middle of the pack down the backstretch, started to gain on the leader when nudged for more at the quarter pole, rallied sharply three wide turning for home between runners, switched leads finding another gear at the furlong marker and under a well-timed late run got up in the shadow of the wire for the score. CHANCEL was loose on the lead on the first turn, moved well uncontested up top along the backstretch, travelled comfortably with no rivals in sight through the final turn, continued on by a good margin at the furlong pole, was under a busy ride hearing hoofbeats in deep stretch but was just caught on the outside at the finish line. MEHLEK was allowed to settle inside sharing the rear in the early part, lagged behind the field down the backside, made a sharp move circling around horses three wide midpoint on the final bend, had a full head of steam four wide outside rivals straightening out for the drive and was flying home late but just missed getting to the top pair at the finish line a picture. SAMMY STONE hopped at the break spotting the group, improved splitting foes in the first turn to be all alone tracking the loose leader down the backside, made no gain chasing the frontrunner on the second bend, could not quicken inside foes who were making a rally at the top of the stretch and ran on one paced in the final furlong to be a fringe player in the end. LAUGHING OUT LOUD pressed inside at the start, was taken hold off losing inside position being brushed outside midway on the first turn, travelled in midfield on the fence along the backside, regressed to the rear with a quarter mile to go and could not factor inside in the late running. OUR FLAG FLYING co-trailed on the outside in the beginning, had a stalking position outside ahead of one runner along the back straight, made little movement between runners around the final bend and emptied out in the three path at the top of the stretch.

MYSTIC SONG improved down the backside making a quick move getting better position on the fence sitting in midfield, was poised inside another rival waiting for the cue to go while watching the engaged duo through the turn, shifted just outside two wide coming with a run in upper stretch, darted between horses at the sixteenth pole taking over control and won going clear at the finish line. TEQUILASOUPERNOVA veered in on the break, settled into stride well in hand flanking the pacesetter outside down the back straight, inched up on the outside around the bend when nudged for more at the quarter pole, seized command three wide at the top of the lane, was collared inside by the winner with a sixteenth to go offering little resistance and just lasted at the wire saving the runners up share. CRUMLIN FASHION was keen under a hard hold seeing the field coming up to a rival at the half, moved off the fence making little impact outside runners on the turn, shifted out five wide for the drive to the wire and had strong late energy finishing up quickly to just miss out on the place share at the finish line. FLORIDA VACATION was forced in by the outside rival on the break, recouped quickly inside to have the lead by the half, continued holding on inside up top while hound throughout the turn, relinquished the lead on the rail in upper stretch and faded on the fence in the final sixteenth of mile holding in the end for a minor role. MONTY'S INN stalked on the rail ahead of one runner in the early stages, closed in smartly hugging the fence in the mix straightening out for home, was steadied sharply losing the inside lane coming up to the sixteenth pole costing her all the momentum and could not recover in time to factor late. CUPIDS BEST ARROW prompted the pace three deep along the backside, tracked the lead pair outside in the second flight on the turn, bore out at the quarter pole to be widest in the seven-path turning for home, stayed on the wrong lead down the lane and could not be involved in the late running.

COOL KISS had a good position nestled on the rail drafting behind the frontrunner, rated kindly inside another in midfield down the backstretch, began to reel in the embattled duo when roused for more at the five sixteenths pole, gathered more speed shifting out to the four-path straightening out for home and determinedly wore down foes through the stretch to get up in the final few jumps outside for the victory. DRESDEN ROW was forwardly placed shadowing the frontrunner outside on the first turn, vied between runners up top down the backside, moved in to duel for the front end at the quarter pole, began to edge away on the early leader two wide midway down the lane, braced for the oncoming challenge outside by the winner in deep stretch but just missed holding on at the wire in a tight finish. PARAMOUNT PRINCE assumed command having the fence early on, maintained a slim advantage quickening the pace into a headwind along the backside, was headed outside midpoint on the final bend, fought on stubbornly inside on the fence in upper stretch, gave way to the top pair by the sixteenth pole and finished up well enough to be all alone for the show money at the wire. PLAYMEA TUNE broke in at the start,

had a stalking trip on the rail in the early stages, made a sharp rally progressing inside runners on the far turn from the three eighths marker to the quarter pole, was no match for the lead three down the lane but did finish up willingly to settle on the fringes in the end. CLASSIC MO TOWN hopped, brushing the outside rival on the start to trail the field on the first turn, shared the rear outside with a couple of rivals going three deep along the backside, picked up the bit circling around horses taking the overland route four wide midway on the last turn, moved out widest in the six path for the stretch drive, could not sustain the run and finished up evenly in the last furlong. SKYRO was situated in mid-division in the three path on the initial turn, co-trailed with runners on both sides with a half mile still to go, made a brief moved keeping pace with others at the five sixteenths pole but could not get into contention four wide in the late running. LOOSE WIRE was floated out five wide outside horses in mid-pack on the first turn, took closer order prompting the pace three deep outside the lead pair down the backstretch, dropped back off the lead duo by the half, had little to give retreating three wide between horses at the five sixteenths pole and could not offer a finish through the lane. JOURNEYMAN settled in midfield on the outside of the eventual winner along the backside, was hard ridden unable to keep up to others making a run at the five sixteenths pole and failed to menace in the three path for the drive to the wire.

7 Video Race Replay MOVENTOTHECOUNTRY was quite content tracking the pacesetter outside in the first half of the race, moved in cruised around the leader taking control at the three furlong pole, opened up getting the jump on the field on the far turn by the quarter pole, was urged on finding more through the lane in the two path and was kept to the task late to hold on narrowly for the win. HURRICANE GIZMO was tucked in on the rail just behind the frontrunner watching the lead pair, shifted out off the tiring early leader coming with a run midway on the far turn, posed the main threat in the three path in upper stretch and came with a strong late kick gaining with every stride in deep stretch inside but just could not get to the winner in time. TAKE CHANCES had a good spot on the outside in the second flight keeping a close eye on the front two early on, settled between horses still well in touch with the lead pair at the three furlong marker, was shuffled back slightly in the three path between foes at the quarter pole, angled out five wide having a lane at the top of the stretch and kept running on to the end to be a non-threatening but clear third at the finish line. SERENADING AMAYA was situated on the rail near the rear, co-trailed on the fence with a few others at the half mile marker, was scrubbed on looking for tunning room in the three path at the quarter pole commencing a rally, kept plugging away four wide outside foes down the lane and with late interest in the final eighth of a mile got up to be a fringe player in the end on the outside. RIGHT BRIGHTLY travelled all alone in midfield, began to pick up the bit when called upon inside rivals at the five sixteenths pole to be in with a chance just off the rail for a small share at the top of the stretch and finished up willingly between rivals in the late running just being nosed out for the minors at the wire. SINFUL FORESTER broke in at the start, assumed command setting a soft pace in the early going unchallenged, surrender the front when the winner cruised on by outside at the three-furlong pole and was under a vigorous ride trying to hold on the fence for the runners up share down the stretch but yielded inside horses in the final furlong. ALL FOR HONOR was away slowly trailing the field on the fence, made a premature move advancing quickly outside rivals four deep from last down the backside, came under a ride trying to continue on with the swooping rally three wide outside horses through the turn, could not sustain the lengthy run and folded in the six path between foes in upper stretch. DANCING IN RIO stalked close to the back just off the fence early on, shared the rear between foes at the half, regressed in the three path through the far turn to be last by the quarter pole, angled out six wide for the drive and passed a weary foe inside in the final furlong. THATSITTHATSALL was squeezed on the break to stalk three wide ahead of only the other poor starter on the first turn, co-trailed four deep at the half, was under a drive trying to circle outside rivals four wide at the three furlong pole making little headway, shifted out widest in the eight path turning for home and had nothing more to offer by mid-stretch.
