REMARKABLY HUMAN tracked the pacesetter on the outside around the first of two turns, rated kindly hounding the frontrunner outside down the backstretch, moved in outside through the last bend to get the advantage by the quarter marker, dueled determinedly through the lane clinging onto the lead with challengers on either side in the final furlong and prevailed at the finish line in a blanket finish for the top three placings. ARCTIC BLONDE assumed command just off the fence early on, dictated an even pace along the backside, relinquished the lead to the winner outside by the quarter pole when slowing the pace down considerably on the final bend, was resurgent on the fence fighting back in upper stretch, battled stubbornly inside to the wire but gave way grudgingly in a tight finish at the line. SERENADING KITTEN pressed the issue on the rail through the initial turn, was content drafting behind the frontrunner keeping a close eye along the backside, shifted outside starting to come with a rally at the quarter pole, loomed between foes four wide in upper stretch, drifted out in the last eighth of a mile while under left handed encouragement, still was gaining gradually outside on the embattled duo at the sixteenth pole but could not get to winner in time when being on the losing end of a three way picture for the win. DAISYCREST had a stalking role outside a runner in the third flight early on, improved outside horses down the backstretch, came under a ride edging up three wide outside foes midway on the far turn, swung out widest in the mix having the five path turning for home and finished up one paced to settle on the fringes in the end. PAT'S HOLIDAY had a good spot isolated watching the lead trio on the first turn, sat in midfield inside another while well in touch with the lead pair down the backside, kept pace with rivals taking the shortest way along the last bend but lacked a rally in the stretch, failing to fire inside rivals in the final furlong. SUNNYVILLE leapt in the air at the start to co-trail i

outside seeing the field around the final turn and could only manage to pass a weary rival outside at the top of the stretch. CHURCH AVE had a stalking trip inside others near the rear, made no movement along the fence down the backside, could not offer a rally with horses making a run outside through the running on the last turn and failed to menace inside in the stretch running.

CLOUD RIDER was nudged on taking the lead inside foes down the back straight, rolled along briskly unopposed through the bend, was well in control having the four path at the furlong marker, began to get leg weary late and just held on, saved by the wire from the fast charging runner up. ABINO BAY was

allowed to relax on the fence part of the back threesome early on, started to reach for more ground just off the rail at the quarter pole, moved out having clear run four wide with a furlong remaining and stormed home late just missing for the win by a stride at the finish line. AINT NO GIRLY GIRL flanked the pacesetter outside along the backstretch, chased the leader but could make no gain around the bend, had the rail for the drive to the wire and finished up evenly in the last furlong to be a non threatening third at the wire. STRAWBERRY WORLD had an outside tracking position going three deep down the back straight, was under a ride trying to hold her spot three wide between horses at the quarter pole, shifted out to the five path straightening for home and ran on mildly to be a fringe player winning the battle inside another at the finish line. AUSSIE HYPER was unhurried trailing between rivals at the half, made little headway on the outside through the bend, gathered speed swinging out widest in the nine path at the top of the lane and found her best stride late just losing the duel for the minors outside at the wire. DANCIN MARY MARIE had the rail position in the tracking second flight down the backstretch, was shuffled slightly inside rivals at the five sixteenths pole, came with a run skimming the fence in upper stretch but needed more when inside runners in the final sixteenth to be a contender at the wire. TANZANITE LILY stumbled then broke out at the start, recouped to sit in mid-division inside along the backstretch, offered a brief turn of foot splitting rivals two wide at the quarter pole to be in the mix fighting for the show money four wide turning for home, could not sustain the rally and flattened out in the last eighth. VERI COLLECTED was forwardly placed sitting in the second flight with runners on both sides, could not keep up to the lead two running around the oval by midturn and little offer for the stretch run when wilting in the two path in the final sixteenth of a mile. MIA MITOLE travelled in midfield on the outside of another down the backstretch, tried to make a circling move five wide outside foes at the quarter pole, angled to the seven path for the drive between rivals but could not get involved in the stretch running. SUNSHINE REGGAE was bumped by the troubled inside rival on the break, settled into stride three deep on the outside part of the back trio at the half, lagged well behind runners through the turn, lost touch with the field by upper stretch and cantered home.

GENIUS OF LOVE was hard held eager drafting behind the frontrunner down the back straight, waited for the cue to go rating kindly behind the embattled trio while on the fence around the bend, pounced in the four path with the field five abreast straightening out for the drive, powered past by the furlong pole seizing control and won going away at the finish line under a patient ride. SARATOGA HOLIDAY had the outside position at the back of the pack with the group tightly bunched at the half, edged up outside trying to keep the eventual winner in through the turn, angled out to the five path unable to keep winner in behind rivals at the top of the stretch, could not match strides on the front end with a furlong to go but finished up well to easily best the rest for the runners up share in the end. CATCH THE DRIFT travelled on the outside going three deep keeping a close eye on the leader early on, moved in to force the issue around runners while three wide on the turn, poked her head in front for a moment three wide between foes turning for home, offered no resistance when the winner drove past at the furlong pole and faded slightly in the late running easily holding for the show money at the wire. ROCKET RILEY prompted the early pace between horses along the backside, inched up even closer vying with runners on either side up top around the oval, remained in the hunt just off the rail two wide in upper stretch and finished up one paced in the last eighth of a mile for a minor award in the end. WORLD SHOWCASE had the lead narrowly on the rail down the backside, continued up front on the fence by a slim margin throughout the turn, surrendered the lead while scraping paint turning for home, had little left inside for the late drive and faltered by the furlong marker.

MIGHT BEE TROUBLE was brushed outside on the start settling close to the back of the pack early on, advanced outside horses at the half, ranged closer going three to four wide outside challengers around the bend, had a full head of steam when set down six wide turning for home, stayed on the incorrect lead down the lane, kept on coming nevertheless and under a well timed late surge got up right at the wire for the win. NOT SO SWIFT settled in the middle of the field going four deep in the early going, moved in to track the lead trio by the half, waited to move sitting behind the front twosome on the turn, darted

up the fence in the lane taking control sharply by the furlong pole, battled determinedly inside late but was nabbed in the final jump for the win at the wire. ROOKIE COURT pressed the pace outside in the beginning, was reined back at the half tracking the engaged duo, travelled three wide measuring the contesting pair through the turn, angled to the five path between horses running on to the end down the lane, could not threaten the lead pair late and finished up to be a clear third at the wire. ROSIEPOSIE was situated close to the back of the pack just off the fence going down the backside, regressed between horses to see the field at the quarter pole, angled out six wide having clear run straightening out for home and finished with good late energy outside horses to close in for a minor placing in the end. KITTY'SSPEEDYSTARR broke inwards on the break, recovered to duel outside at the half up front, bobbed heads fighting for the lead with an inside foe throughout the turn, got the better of the pesky speed rival inching away briefly having command at the top of the lane, had little in reserve from her early efforts and tired inside runners in the final sixteenth. GET OUT THE VOTE settled on the fence in midfield along the backstretch, dropped back saving ground on the turn at the quarter pole, shifted out in the two path at the top of the lane but could not get into contention driving to the finish line inside horses. MARYLAND SPIRIT stalked near the rear inside runners down the backside, was hard ridden making little impact while at the back on the fence around the bend, moved out four wide for the drive, was checked mild leaving the furlong marker losing momentum and could not factor in the late running. SILENT SUNSHINE was hustled to duel on the rail for the lead at the half, continued to fight on inside up top through the turn, could not continue on three wide in upper stretch and was engulfed by runners on either side by the furlong marker. LA BELVA could see the field down the backside straight, moved
