CHAMBERS had a ideal setup tucked in on the rail watching the engaged pair along the backside, rated kindly just off the fence measuring the embattled trio midway on the turn, pounced finding a seam two wide at the top of the lane, drove past by the furlong marker and won going away at the finish line. TOTAL SENSATION travelled outside the eventual winner keeping a close eye on the lead pair down the back straight, was roused three wide in midturn to bid for the lead by the quarter pole, briefly took over control outside three others in the four path turning for home, was no match at the furlong pole for the top spot but ran on well to easily best the rest for the runners up share. SOMEKINDA MISCHIEF had a slim lead on the inside in the beginning, relinquished the front heading into the turn, dueled determinedly inside foes around the bend on the front end, skimmed the fence still in the thick of things turning for home and finished up well inside horses to be a non threatening but clear third at the wire. CONN SMYTHE (GB) had a stalking trip close to the back on the

fence in the early stages, started to reach for more ground when urged in upper stretch, split runners making a good rally in the three path with an eighth remaining and finished up with energy capturing a minor award in the end. JUST JACOBO hounded the pace outside in the beginning, moved in to seize command outside at the three eighths pole, came under a ride clinging up front with challengers on both sides with a quarter mile to run, gave way between rivals up front three wide at the top of the stretch and evened out in the final furlong. WAHEELA was situated in mid-pack on the rail, lost ground to the leaders while inside horses throughout the turn and made little impression just off the fence running inside rivals down the lane. SOUPER EFFECT settled between horses in mid-division, advanced slightly in the three path midway on the turn, shifted out five wide at the top of the lane but lacked a rally through the stretch. SOUPER STRIDER was unhurried trailing the group early on, saved ground but made little headway on the turn, shifted out widest in the seven path passing a weary foe straightening out for the drive and could not factor in the late running. PRINCE ALMASTY travelled four deep in midfield along the backside, continued the four wide journey outside foes making little progression while hard ridden around the bend, emptied out in the six path turning for home and galloped in down the lane.

SHERIF ALI settled on the rail close to the back of the pack in the beginning, co-trailed on the fence along the backside, mounted a rally moving outside following a rival that was circling the field around the final bend, angled out five wide full of run turning for home, powered past taking command leaving the eighth pole outside rivals and drew off convincingly at the wire for the win. SWAN LAKE had a good trip on the outside keeping tabs on the contesting front duo for the first half of this route race, rallied smartly when urged three wide on the last turn to bid for the lead at the quarter pole between foes, had his head in front momentarily two wide with a furlong still to run but could not fend off the winners late charge outside in deep stretch. C C'S KINGDOM was allowed to settle into stride seeing the field into the first of two turns, co-trailed outside three deep along the backside, made a bid swooping move four wide around runners on the far turn to be in the hunt at the top of the lane, could not sustain the rally and stalked at the eighth pole to settle for the show money at the finish line. CAUGHT SPEEDING had a narrow advantage on the rail along the backside, edged away for a clear lead at the three furlong pole setting an even pace through the turn, shifted out to be two to three wide holding on up front inside at the top of the lane and was resilient in the final furlong prevailing in a hard fought duel in deep stretch to get the nod inside at the wire for the frontrunning score. WICO (IRE) was situated outside another keeping a close eye on the engaged twosome along the back straight, had a quick turn of foot bursting between the early speed foes two wide at the five sixteenths to bid for the lead, posed the only threat outside in the four path in upper stretch, was driving outside inching up in the final furlong and with one final push just missed at the wire outside being denied in a close photo. COMMANDER AT SEA had the rail position in the second flight inside another rival down the back straight, edged closer saving ground throughout the turn, angled three wide at the top of the stretch, was no match for the front pair who had it to themselves in the last eighth of a mile but finished up willingly nonetheless to be a clear third on the fence at the wire. RY PIE was squeezed at the start to trail the field down the backside, lagged at the rear through the bend, swung out widest in the six path having clear run straightening out for home and with a solid late charge outside runners surged right at the finish line to be a fringe player in a tight picture. BIG BABY HENRY broke inwards on the break, travelled outside in mid-division along the backside, narrowed the margin in the three path around the turn with a quarter mile to run, shifted four wide turning for home and ran on evenly in the last furlong nosed out battling for a minor share at the wire. JMR SPEEDY ESCAPE was forced in at the start, stalking ahead of only the very troubled starter down the backstretch, offered a brief run closing the gap in the two path inside another by midturn and had little to offer in the stretch running inside horses down the lane. LUCKY ROMANCE had a good spot on the outside watching the engaged pair down the backside, was forced to take closer order vying between runners at the three furlong pole, dueled with rivals on either side around the bend, battled head to head outside with a tenacious frontrunner down the lane and found a little bit more under a busy ride late to edge away between horses in deep stretch for the gutsy win. BACKONTHECHAINGANG pulled the rider to the lead just off the rail down the backside, maintained a head in front on the fence with a couple of challengers pressing outside through the turn, was stubbornly clinging inside up front through the stretch drive but was just outkicked in the final seventy yards by the winner all the while just saving the place share in a thrilling finish at the wire. SECRET THREAT settled near the rear inside early on, kept pace while between horses in the tracking back trio around the oval, shifted out in the four path in the mix in upper stretch, was steadily gaining outside on the contesting duo in the last eighth of a mile but just fell short of getting there, losing the three way win picture outside at the finish line. GLINTINDADDYSEYE was away alertly up top at the beginning, pressed the pace inside through the backstretch, dropped back unable to maintain forward position on the fence entering the turn, made no gain taking the shortest route around the bend, hugged the rail straightening out for the drive and finished up one paced being a fringe player in the end. COOLER MAN stalked three deep unhurried at the back of the pack down the backside, travelled three wide outside two other rivals in the second group around the turn making little progression, offered a brief rally gathering some speed swinging widest in the six path at the head of the lane but could not offer a stretch finish outside rivals in the late running. CRUCIAL TAUNT travelled outside four deep off runners in midfield, made an early move going three wide bidding for the lead outside at the three furlong marker, could not keep up to the contesting lead pair by the quarter pole and folded five wide between horses turning for home.

HELLO JELLO was nestled on the rail drafting behind the pacesetter down the backstretch, waited for the cue to go behind the leader around the bend, pounced three wide splitting rivals at the top of the lane, dueled outside relentlessly through the stretch and got the head down at the wire winning the nod. LIVININTHEFASTLANE was hustled having a slim lead on the rail down the backside, edged away from the outside early speed foe in midturn, had

company outside turning for home, was unyielding digging in down the lane to the wire inside but lost the bob at the finish line in a thrilling stretch battle. AIM DON'T MISS had the fence while sitting in mid-pack down the backstretch, crept up inside runners through the turn, was looking for running room shifting out for wide for the drive to the wire, darted to the fence having clear run at the eighth pole and finished up gamely to be a clear third while not that far off the top pair as well at the wire. ASHUKA kept a close eye watching the lead pair while travelling three deep early on, dropped back slightly at the half, improved outside rivals on the turn going five wide at the quarter pole coming with a run, angled to the six path straightening out for home and ran on mildly for a minor placing in the end. HALCON NEGRO broke out on the start, travelled outside foes in midfield by the half, could not advance outside rivals running around the turn but did show some late interest in the three path in mid-stretch. GLORIOUS REVENGE press the issue outside down the backstretch, was roused at the five sixteenths pole but the frontrunner was starting to inch away, gave way up top between foes four wide at the top of the lane and faded further in the final furlong. SUMMER TRAIN was in tight on the break trailing in the chute, stalked close to the rear along the back straight, made no progression saving all the ground through the turn and could only manage to pick up weary rivals in the last eighth of a mile. BIG LEW tracked between horses at the half, had outside position in the second flight closing the gap around the bend to be in the mix five wide in upper stretch, could not find more late and tired between rivals at the furlong marker. WANNA'S LEGACY stalked close to the rear having rail position, made no headway inside another around the oval and never was a factor coming up empty on the fence for the stretch run. HIGHLAND ROCKY was allowed to settle into stride seeing the field along the backside, lagged wel
