KEE'S FLATTER was in hand contently shadowing the pacesetter along the backside, edged up outside measuring the leader around the bend, pounced outside three wide in upper stretch, powered past by the furlong pole and strolled home in deep stretch for the win. HYMN TO HER broke out on the start trailing the field on the rail along the backside, began to make a move at the three eighths pole, had to tap on the brakes slightly waiting behind a runner with a quarter mile from home, skimmed the fence coming with a run and finished up smartly to easily best the rest for the runners up share at the wire. PRINCESSONAMISSION was in between horses settling in midfield along the back straight, kept pace with runners on either side throughout the turn and finished up with interest four wide to be a clear third at the finish line. JUST LIKE THAT was under a snug hold setting a soft early pace, quickened thempo remaining up front around the turn inside, had no answer when the winner stormed on by outside at the eighth pole and faded between rivals with a sixteenth to run to settle on the fringes in the end. VRANA (IRE) was nestled on the rail moving well in mid-division along the backstretch, was scrubbed chasing the top pair but to no avail through the turn, had little for the drive and weakened between rivals by the furlong pole. CRYSTALAIRE (GB) travelled three deep in the middle of the pack by the half, retreated three wide outside foes running around the bend and could not play a factor in the late stretch running.

JUICY HANNA was nudged along trying to find her stride seeing the field along the backside, began to inch up on the rail at the three eighths marker, had to wait for a moment behind a rival in midturn, moved out two wide looking for a seam having run in upper stretch, darted to the fence surging inside runners at the furlong marker and with a solid late run pulled away in deep stretch for the tally. SYMPATICO broke outwards on the start, had the rail keeping tabs on the contesting pair down the backside, closed the gap with five sixteenths to run, shifted out three wide inside another at the quarter marker, found a seam three wide turning for home, took over control with an eighth still to run but could not withstand the late charge by the winner in deep stretch. LADY ON THE NILE was pinched at the start, recovered to sit between foes in the two path tracking the lead duo at the half, was under a vigorous ride just off the fence making little impact around the oval, swung out widest in the six path straightening out for home and finished with good energy charging late to be a clear third at the wire. OUTFORARIP utilized the inside post dictating terms on the rail down the back straight, comfortably maintained the front on the fence throughout the turn, narrowly remained in command two wide at the top of the stretch, was no match when engulfed on both sides by the top two finishers at the furlong pole but still kept on to the end settling on the fringes.. HUMBLE HEART travelled four deep in midfield at the half, regressed under a ride between foes a quarter mile from the wire, re-rallied smartly on the fence by the eighth pole, stayed on the wrong lead to the finish but ran on to the wire just missing for a minor share in the end. CRUMLIN BEACH broke inwards on the start, rated between foes in midfield in the three path down the backside, came under a ride making a mild run four wide outside foes at the quarter pole, battled outside in the four path for a piece of the prize in mid-stretch, stayed

on the incorrect lead down the lane and faded with a sixteenth left to run. TWOWAYCROSSING was unhurried seeing the field still within range early on, lagged behind well back in the second turn, ranged up taking closer order moving well along the backside, powerfully circled the field on the last turn still not asked for run, proved much the best in the four path easily taking over control coming to the furlong marker and under very mild urging won going away impressively at the wire. TOUR THE CITY was loose up top on the first of three turns, had company to his outside under the wire for the first time, remained up top by a narrow margin from two others outside along the backside, edged away from the pesky speed foe by the five sixteenths marker, braced for the challenge outside by the eventual winner in upper stretch, offered little resistance by the furlong pole but finished up well enough easily besting the rest for the runners up share at the finish line. ZABO bobbled on the break, tracked the frontrunner on the rail in the beginning, took back to smartly sit off the engaged trio with seven eighths to run, still patiently waited behind the contesting threesome along the backside, began to inch up on the fence midway on the last turn, scraped paint making a rally, was no threat to the lead two down the lane but finished up well enough inside another down the lane to be a clear but distant third at the finish line. CORNWALL settled between foes keeping an eye on the lone leader on the first turn, moved in by the second turn vying for the front with runners on either side, continued to force the issue between rivals down the backside for the last time, was hard ridden at the five sixteenths trying to duel outside but the winner was still in hand edging away on the final turn, had little left for the drive and wilted in the three path by mid-stretch. RATINGS UPGRADE (IRE) had a three wide trip in the early stages pressing the pace on the outside, remained forwardly placed three deep hounding the pacesetter along the backstretch, was going in the wrong direction between foes by the five sixteenths marker, emptied out seeing the field turning for home and cantered across the finish line.

SOUPER SUCCESS was urged leaving the chute taking control inside rivals up top entering the backstretch, maintained a narrow advantage on the fence by the half, edged away still in hand from the chasing rivals who were already under a ride midway on the bend, strongly spurted clear at the top of the stretch and held safe by a comfortable margin at the wire for the front end score. GILT EDGE had a stalking role outside down the back straight, rallied outside foes four wide making a good rally with a quarter mile remaining, could not get to the dominant winner while five wide between horses in mid-stretch but did run on determinedly late to hold for the runners up share at the finish line. PRICELESS WILL broke out brushing the gate on the start to see the field in the early going, started to reach for more ground shifting outside three wide at the quarter pole, swung out widest gathering speed in the six path turning for home, dueled outside for the place share with the winner long gone with a furlong to go but could only finish up mildly in the late running to settle for the show award in the end. HIGHLAND LIFE had a good spot three deep tracking the lead pair, took closer order three wide trying to get to the pacesetter in midturn, was unable to quicken with the winner while three wide in upper stretch and evened out inside horses in the final eighth of a mile to settle on the fringes at the wire. COUNTRY LIVING was eager rushing up behind the leader at the five eighths pole, settled down to sit in midfield on the rail by the half, saved ground but made little impression around the turn, hugged the fence having a chance for a small share at the top of the lane but flattened out inside rivals by the furlong marker. CADFAEL pressed the pace outside down the down the backstretch, chased the leader while inside another but in vain through the turn, started to back pedal at the quarter pole and had little left for the drive folding between runners in the four path by upper stretch.

MIRAMICHI assumed control on the fence with the rider still in the saddle along the backside, shook loose while well in hand midway around the turn, was set down just off the rail in upper stretch holding rivals at the bay and was kept to the task late to hold sway for the frontrunning score. SPEAK UP had a tracking spot travelling four deep outside foes down the backside, narrowed the margin on the leader rallying three wide outside horses at the three-furlong pole, chased the pacesetter but could not make up any ground through the turn, shifte

CRYSTAL VISIONS had a good spot on the outside tracking the early pace, edged up between foes with five sixteenths remaining, pounced quickly three wide on the outside in upper stretch taking over control and kept finding more when called upon each time through the lane to hold off the late charge by a couple of closing in rivals on either side at the wire. FOURFIFTYFOUR was hard held drafting behind the leader in the early stages, shifted out off the front pair to have clear run four wide by the furlong marker, closed in late but needed more in deep stretch unable to threaten the winner at the wire but did hold on stubbornly saving for the place award by a nod. ORION BEACH was under a snug hold settling on the fence in midfield, waited on the turn having nowhere to go inside rivals, found daylight skimming the fence at the top of the lane and closed in smartly in the last sixteenth inside horses but just could



GOLDEN CANARY settled off the pace inside a foe, moved nearer in behind on the turn racing off the fence past the quarter pole, dove to the inside in upper stretch and made an inside bid, edged clear. LUZ DE LA LUNA settled stalking in behind the leaders off the fence into the turn, moved out five wide turning for home, took over in upper stretch, was outkicked. BULLET stalked from outside moving to the lead past the half, was challenged again by the inside rival late on the turn, asked for more soon after, could not kick on with the top pair, dueled to get the nod for show. CHROMEPLATED HEART set the early pace, was overtaken past the half, chased then re-engaged the leader from inside past the five-sixteenths fighting back, was off the rail in upper stretch, kept on but missed show. DOLCE SOPRESA was ridden along inside but was not a factor. MAY MAY STRONG broke a half-step slowly, moved out from three to five wide on the turn, was not a threat, pulled up past the wire, bled, was transported off the track via equine ambulance.

MADAM GWEN settled on the fence in midfield on the initial bend, dropped back slightly down the backside, was roused finding room splitting horses sharply in the two path at the quarter pole, angled out five wide full of run in upper stretch and charged home outside horses to wear down a determined frontrunner in the final seventy yards. MCKENZIE ROAD was uncontested up top for the early parts of the race while setting only a moderate pace, had company on the outside by the guarter pole, repelled the brief challenge still moving well by the furlong pole, ran on to the wire stubbornly down the lane but

gave way to the winner grudgingly while inside in the final seventy yards. BEAUTIFUL SKY took the overland route going five wide outside horses trying to circle around horses on the first turn, tracked the lead pair going three deep down the backside, moved in through the final turn making a bid for the lead three wide with a quarter mile from home, could not sustain the rally by the furlong marker unable to match strides with the front two in the late running but did finish up well enough to hold for a clear third at the wire. POWAQA had a stalking position ahead of one runner for the first part of this route race, began to reach for more ground at the quarter pole in the four path outside foes, swung out seven wide with momentum at the top of the lane, found her best run late and closed in to be a fringe player in the end. BLACK DAGGER was allowed to settle into stride trailing the field early on, could not gain on rivals down the backside, lagged well behind through the last turn and found something more outside horses to pass weary foes in the final eighth of a mile. NICKI IS A BREEZE was content to track the leader outside on the first turn, moved well in hand still sitting outside in close range of the pacesetter down the backside, was asked right-handed in the hunt up top between rivals at the quarter pole, offered little response by the top of the stretch and weakened inside horses two wide at the furlong marker. MRS. HOT SHOT was situated in midfield between horses in the four path on the first bend, moved closer to watch the lead twosome while having rivals on either side down the backstretch, came under a ride trying to hold position midway on the far turn, had little to give for the drive and folded six wide in upper stretch. SEVEN P R C sat on the rail just behind the frontrunner early on, tracked the lead duo inside others down the back straight, was scrubbed on for more run with five sixteenths still to go but was going in the wrong direction by the quarter pole and faltered inside runners just o
