AMORE MIO broke in but was quickly corrected on the start, sat behind the loose leader on the first turn, narrowed the gap along the backside, moved in on the outside to poke her head in front at the three eighths pole, opened up on the fence at the top of the lane, was kept busy through the drive to the wire while not switching leads down the lane but stubbornly fought on prevailing at the wire. HOLY RAMBO was reined in taking back off the leaders coming under the wire for the first time, stalked outside close to the back on the first turn, ranged up four deep outside horses down the backstretch, mounted a rally three wide midway on the last turn on the outside to have aim on the winner two wide turning for home but could not get to the winner who had something left late and just managed to save the place share at the finish line. FIRE AND WINE had the rail loose up top on the first turn, maintained a shrinking advantage slowing the pace down considerably at the half, relinquished the lead in tight inside at the three furlong pole, determinedly tried to fight back on the fence through the entire stretch drive, kept on trying in the late running but just missed for the runners up share at the wire. SANHEDRIN was unhurried seeing the field in the beginning, caught up to the tightly compacted group down the backside by the half, ran on mildly on the fence in the far turn going by one rival inside when shifting out at the quarter pole, angled three wide in upper stretch and was gradually gaining under left-handed encouragement trying to keep a straight course through the lane settling on the fringes in the end. HOLY MIRAGE had the rail tracking the leader pair on the initial bend, continued to watch the front pair while three deep between foes along the back straight, retreated in the two path outside another midway on the last turn, shifted out four wide outside for the drive but emptied out by upper stretch. GOOD KING SAM settled on the outside of rivals keeping a close eye on the pace setter, came under a ride edging up between foes to the frontrunner at the quarter pole, was in the hunt three wide having horses on both sides straightening out for home and determinedly wore down the leader in the final seventy yards for the gutsy win. ISAAC LEO had the lead on the fence along the backside, continued to dictate the pace around the turn, was on top marginally inside foes in upper stretch, switched leads at the furlong marker finding another gear but could not fend off the winner outside in deep stretch. COUNTRYBOYSURVIVE travelled three deep watching the front twosome down the back straight, dropped back slightly at the half, began to lengthen stride three wide midturn to be in the hunt in the four path outside rivals at the top of the lane but could only inch up on the winner in the late stages just coming up short for the runners up share at the finish line. CONACHER improved on the rail down the backstretch to sit behind the frontrunner at the half, saved ground on the turn but could not keep up to the lead trio by the quarter pole, hugged the rail turning for home and stayed on well enough to be a

fringe player in the end. AMERICAN DECISION was unhurried sharing the back spot on the outside through the backstretch, made little impact running inside horses around the bend and showed some late interest passing a few runners inside through the stretch drive. PRIME PLUS ONE broke out on the start, had an inside stalking position down the backside, could not make any gain around the bend, angled out three wide for the stretch run and finished up one paced down the lane. GLOBETROTTING was all alone in midfield down the back straight, kept pace with others while going three wide on the oval, moved out to the four path turning for home but lacked a rally in the stretch running. ETHNIC SOUL had a outside stalking trip down the backstretch, was roused three wide outside foes midturn but offering little response, swung out widest in the five path at the top of the lane but could not get involved in the drive to the finish line. BLONDINA'S BOY was brushed on the inside then jostled between foes on the start to co-trail on the outside, came under a ride at the quarter pole showing little through the turn and could not make a presence four wide in upper stretch.

ELLA IT IS was caught three wide into the first settling down soon after to stalk in behind, came out a bit turning into upper stretch, took the lead about the eighth pole, edged clear. MISS PIERRE soon moved clear and shifted in, set the pace inside on or just off the rail, was challenged and overtaken in mid-stretch, saved the place. MAGICAL TRICK settled at the rear, swung six wide, gained late but missed second. BEDAZZLE ME was taken back heading into the first turn shifting in a bit three wide into that bend, settled outside a foe off the pace, came four wide past the quarter pole in range, ran on but needed more. GO GIFFEN tucked in saving ground, ran evenly. BLAMELESS GHOST shifted out early racing three to four wide on the turns and in range, failed to rally.

CATEGORY FIVE had the fence in a stalking position down the backside, commenced a rally edging up initially inside rivals midway on the bend, was in full flight three wide with runners on either side dueling up front at the top of the lane, drove past between horses leaving the furlong pole and was kept to the task late to hold safe by a diminishing margin at the finish line. FOG D'ORO settled between rivals close to the back of the pack, dropped back to co-trail on the inside heading into the turn, began to pick up the bit when scrubbed for more at the five sixteenths pole, shifted out five wide full of run down the stretch, was unable to get to the winner in time the final sixteenth of a mile but closed in sharply to get up at the wire for the runners up share. DRI SADDLE tracked the engaged duo while in the two path inside another along the backside, chased the contesting couple but to no avail through the turn, still remained in the mix closing the gap four wide in upper stretch with the dueling leaders coming back to the field and finished up willingly to be a clear third at the finish line. DIGITAL SECURITY stalked near the rear going three deep, was hard ridden midturn making no progression, swung out widest in the six path turning for home, found his best stride late and came with a solid charge in the final furlong to get a minor award right at the wire. QUADZILLA pressed the issue inside at the start, took even closer order to battle on the fence at the half mile marker, slugged it out inside another through the bend, scraped paint still fighting inside horses at the top of the lane, could not offer a finishing kick down the stretch and yielded inside at the eighth pole. CELESTIAL HEART was away slowly on the break, had the head in front under a hustling ride leaving the chute, dueled outside at the half and continued that run through the turn, still was in the fray up front in the two path between rivals by upper stretch, had little left to give down the lane and wilted on the wrong lead by the furlong marker.

HOT POTATO was void of early foot trailing in the beginning, caught up to a rival outside at the half, remained back at the rear midway on the oval and could only manage to pass one straggler in the stretch running. RAINBOWS HERO had the outside travelling three deep tracking the engaged pair, was urged for more but was going in the wrong direction on the turn three wide at the quarter pole, had nothing to offer in the stretch drive and folded just off the fence between horses in upper stretch.

RED WEAVER settled mid-division outside a rival, advanced while shifting out four wide leaving the turn, struck the lead in upper stretch with an outside challenger in near pursuit, held that one. WILD CARD got away well, was taken back early reserved about mid-pack, advanced outside foes on the turn, fanned five wide making a bid at the top of the stretch taking a narrow and brief lead, was soon stripped of that lead, chased the winner home but was second best. SIGNATURE SIR got away well, vied between runners then dueled outside two to three wide, was no match for the top pair, kept on to hold show. HIGHLY POTENT attended the early pace outside but soon dropped off the leading pair, chased those from outside, was asked for more at the five-sixteenths, came into upper stretch seven deep, kept on for the minors. BEE ME exchanged a brush with a rival at the start, moved forward inside to contest the pace, took a narrow lead late up the backstretch, dueled on the turn, weakened in the stretch. AWESOME BOURBON had a good spot in the early stages nestled on the rail drafting behind the pacesetter moving comfortably, waited for the cue to go on the rail through the far turn behind the dueling pair, shifted out three wide very much in the conversation up top straightening out for home, stayed on the wrong lead but nevertheless kept grinding away down the stretch and pulled away from rivals in the last sixteenth. RAPID TEST travelled three wide outside rivals in midfield early on,, stalked along the backside making little movement, was relegated to last at the three furlong pole saving ground through the final turn, shifted two wide looking for running room in upper stretch, angled to the three path having clear run on the battling lead pair at the sixteenth on the outside and surged in deep stretch to get up for the runners up share in the shadow of the wire. ICE CHOCOLAT (BRZ) had a tracking role between foes on the first turn, kept a close eye measuring the pacesetter down the backstretch, was forced to move for the lead between runners when the outside rival tried to circle three wide around horses at the three eighths pole, battled outside up top at the quarter pole, poked his head in front at the head of the lane but could not fight on inside with the winner charging on by at the sixteenth pole and was just caught late for the secondary share at the finish line. NEVER SURPRISED broke out brushing a rival on the start, had trouble navigating the first turn bearing out four wide while at the rear, trailed the field outside down the back straight, was roused making a mild move outside another at the five sixteenths pole, swung out widest in the six path turning for home and ran on evenly passing weary inside runners coming up to the sixteenth pole. HUNT MASTER was loose up top on the fence in the first turn, continued

unchallenged up front setting a lively pace down the backside, fought on inside two others just holding onto the lead on the last turn, was collared outside by the quarter pole, could not find more skimming the fence in upper stretch and weakened on the rail at the eighth pole. PIPER'S FACTOR was reined back under the wire for the first time to stalk on the outside in the beginning, made an early move advancing sharply outside horses down the backstretch to bid for the lead three wide at the three eighths marker, could not sustain the run while under urging stalling by the quarter pole and tired five wide between foes by the furlong marker.

SUMMER COMMANDER pulled the rider outside horses to be loose on the lead taking command from the troubled rival by the five furlong pole, was nursed along uncontested rationing out the speed setting an even pace around the bend, was well in control just off the fence in mid-stretch and was kept to the task under a busy ride late to hold safe by a shrinking margin at the finish line. DEPUTY DADDY had the fence tracking the lead pair leaving the chute, had a good trip sitting behind the pacesetter at the half, took the short way edging up inside foes on the turn, shifted just outside two wide with his sights set on the winner at the top of the stretch, closed in determinedly late but could not get to the winner in time. FRIENDLY GHOST settled four deep close to the back of the pack, edged up having to go four wide outside runners around the oval, swung out widest in the six path offering a late charge outside runners down the lane, closed in belatedly and finished up a non threatening third at the wire. INDIAN PEAK broke a step slow trailing down the backside, shared the rear in the three path between foes going into the turn, closed the gap but could not gain position by the quarter pole, moved to the two-path turning for home and ran on mildly in the last eighth a mile to win the battle for the minors. PAT'S GAMBLE broke in at the start, stalked near the rear inside horses

down the back straight, co-trailed inside with the field bunching up at the three-furlong marker, hugged the rail in with a chance for a piece of the prize in upper stretch but was outkicked late dueling for a minor share. LAST AMERICAN EXIT had a tracking position behind the lead pair down the backside, chased the pace between rivals on the turn, shifted out three wide for the drive to the wire, had no rally when called upon in upper stretch and wilted by the eighth pole. DARK SCREEN broke outwards on the start, watched the leader while three deep down the backside, made no gain going three wide on the outside of rivals under ride through the turn, shifted out five wide at the top of the lane, lacked a finish and gave way between runners in the stretch. HANLAN was away alertly having his head in front leaving the chute, took an awkward step losing all action leaving the eleven sixteenths marker, was quickly eased up by the turn and walked off.

OLD CHESTNUT was nudged on seizing control from the onset, travelled very comfortably up top under a quiet ride on the turn, was set down under right handed encouragement at the furlong marker, had more to give in deep stretch and held well at the finish line for the front end score. RUNNIN' ROCKET had the inside settling in midfield along the back straight, saved ground making little movement on the bend, shifted out to the three path having horse while looking for running room, finally had a clear lane five wide at the furlong marker and with open run closed with a late rush to be second best unable to get to the winner in time at the wire. SOCIETY'S THUNDER was situated in mid-division while three deep down the backside, began to mount a rally three wide outside horses at the three furlong marker, reached for more ground gaining momentum circling horses at the quarter pole to be in the mix four wide in upper stretch and ran on willingly between rivals in the final seventy yards to be a clear third getting the show money when crossing the wire. GARDEN OF WAR had a good spot drafting behind the frontrunner in the early stages, kept pace sitting back following the leader on the fence through the turn, shifted out two wide moving into contention at the top of the stretch, could not continue with the rally and evened out in the final furlong to settle on the fringes. RAT PORTAGE was allowed to settle into stride on the fence at the back of the pack, co-trailed inside another foe throughout the turn, swung out widest in the six path for the drive to the wire and finished up with late interest to pass a couple rivals in the stretch running. GIANT TEDDY kept tabs on the lead

twosome while three deep outside rivals at the half, moved in smartly three wide closing the gap at the quarter pole to be in the thick of things straightening for home, could not find more late and tired between challengers with a sixteenth still to run. POSEIDON STEEL had a stalking role with rivals on either side, co-trailed outside going three wide on the oval, moved out five wide seeing the field turning for home, darted to the rail by the eighth pole but made little impact in the late running. BABBO tracked inside another in the two path along the back straight, chased between runners hard ridden on the turn, could not keep up to rivals by the quarter pole and folded four wide in upper stretch.

DADDY HAS DIAMONDS broke a step slow trailing down the backside, began to pick up the bit when roused passing a rival outside at the five sixteenths pole, swooped around runners going five wide with a quarter mile still to run, swung out widest in the six path in upper stretch, was flying outside foes down

the lane and stormed past the frontrunner in the final seventy yards with an impressive stretch running kick. PHILIP BANKS narrowly had the lead outside in the beginning, edged clear by the half, was headed outside by a few runners at the quarter pole with the rider sitting chilly, spurted away repelling those challengers in upper stretch, moved well bracing for the oncoming charge by the winner at the furlong pole but had no answer when that rival powered past in deep stretch and finished up second best easily besting the rest at the finish line. ROAR OF THE CROWD travelled in mid-pack while three deep outside horses, circled around runners smartly four wide in midturn to bid on the outside up top by the quarter pole, was repelled by the leader at the top of the lane, kept on trying but then was passed on the outside by the eventual winner at the furlong pole and finished up mildly in the late running to just last for the show money at the wire. PAYNES SPIRIT settled between foes in midfield, kept pace with inside two others in the running around the turn, shifted out in the five path finding late energy in the stretch run and just missed closing in for the third-place share, settling on the fringes at the wire. DEMBA travelled near the rear inside rivals, offered a mild run in the two path at three eighths pole, angled out four wide straightening out for home, could not get involved down the lane but did pass a few tired foes in the late running. AWESOME RAINBOW was washy prior to the start, had a stalking trip on the rail close to the back of the pack ahead of a few runners along the backside, dropped back to last on the rail midway on the turn, made a brief rally inside at the quarter pole, hugged the rail for the drive to the wire, shifted off a tiring foe going three wide in upper stretch and finished up one paced in the last furlong. GLASWEIGIAN was brushed on the inside on the break, had a good spot isolated watching the contesting duo early in the backstretch, closed the gap on the turn to battle three wide with rivals on either side for the lead with a quarter mile to go, had little left in the tank having the three path turning for home and folded between rivals at the furlong marker. SUNDAY'S WELL was brushed on the outside on the start, pressed the pace inside in the beginning, was reined back off the leader by the half, moved in on the turn to reengage between rivals in the two path dueling for the lead at the quarter pole, had the fence entering the stretch but could not continue on with others to the wire and flattered inside horses by the eighth pole. DARK DANGER stalked close to the back on the outside, made no progression going four wide through the turn, could not keep up with the eventual winner sweeping past outside at the quarter marker, moved in five wide at the top of the lane but failed to menace in the late stages.
