## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

BESSIE ABOTT (IRE) stalked in behind two to three wide up the backstretch, edged nearer late on the turn, was asked past the quarter pole, took command at the top of the stretch and quickly drew clear, had enough in reserve and held sway. ELLA IT IS bumped with a foe at the start, settled at the rear inside, saved ground on the turn, moved out to rally between foes in mid-stretch past the furlong marker, could make no headway on the winner late but securely annexed the place. TWO SIP SALLY tracked from inside up close, angled four wide coming into upper stretch, lugged out a bit, went evenly late. DETERMINED FIRST settled outside at the rear, was in a bit tight two to three wide between foes past the quarter pole, came out seven wide in mid-stretch, ran on. ORION BEACH settled outside stalking from off the pace, advanced mildly leaving the turn coming into upper stretch five wide, moved out further,

lacked the needed late kick. SOUPER SUPREME was urged to the lead and soon clear, set the pace from off the rail, gave way in mid-stretch. AN CHORR DUBH (IRE) exchanged a bump at the start, was well held rating off the pace near the inside, allowed some reign three furlongs out and advanced inside, shifted out three to four wide past the quarter pole in range, faltered and faded. ZISISIT (IRE) stalked three to four wide, dropped back past the three-eighths and was asked by the five-sixteenths, had no late response and faded.
