MCGILL was content four deep on the outside keeping a very close eye on the embattled trio down the backstretch, inched up through the turn four wide, was coaxed taking the lead at the quarter pole, put away a resurging early leader in upper stretch, lost the lead again to a rallying inside foe with a furlong from the wire and gamely came back on late for the win in deep stretch. MINE SEEKER settled inside a rival travelling in mid-division down the backside, waited patiently for the cue to go watching the contesting quartet throughout the turn, skimmed the fence in upper stretch to move in for the top spot at the eighth pole but was just outkicked late by a determined winner. IRISH DEPUTY co-trailed on the inside in the early stages, began to uncork a stretch rally six wide turning for home, was full of run late and surged in the final sixteenth of a mile to be a clear but non-threatening third. GEE POWER broke sharp to be up close to the front on the start, dropped back four deep outside foes to be near the rear along the backside, co-trailed while moving three wide around the bend, swung out widest in the nine path for the stretch running and ran on willingly to be a fringe player when crossing the finish line. ZONE CONTROL settled in midfield on the outside in the early stages, angled out to the seven path at the top of the lane and finished up mildly fighting between runners for a minor placing in the end. AWE INSPIRED was hustled on the fence leaving the chute to take command inside three others at the five eighths pole, continued to have a slim margin up top around the bend, ceded the lead on the rail at the quarter pole, re-engaged in the three path up front briefly at the top of the lane but wilted still on the wrong lead at the sixteenth pole. BAPTIST BILLY moved up after the break to vie between horses in the two path with rivals on either side setting the pace, dueled stubbornly still travelling two wide contesting with three others for the lead through the turn, could not go with

the frontrunners in upper stretch and was one paced making little impression down the lane. ARABIAN PRINCE tossed his head on the break to trail four deep at the half, made a strong move circling four wide around horses midpoint on the turn, posed the only threat four wide at the top of the stretch but could only chase the winner in vain holding for second best down the stretch. COOLER MAN settled at the rear on the break, was under restraint wanting to go between runners near the rear down the backside, shifted outside off a tiring foe at the quarter pole for clear running room, angled widest in the five path in upper stretch and with good late energy closed in to capture the show award. JAGGERSGOTAGUN tracked on the rail in midfield, saved ground keeping pace throughout the turn to be in range for a share on the fence entering the stretch and under right-handed encouragement won the battle for a minor placing fighting inside a fellow rival in the final furlong. WESTERN WHIRL shifted outside after the start in pursuit of the frontrunner down the backside, edged closer to the leader outside around the bend, was hard ridden with rivals on either side trying to maintain position at the quarter pole and tired by the furlong marker. CAUSIN' MAYHEM was jostled between rivals after the start, settled in midfield three wide between foes down the backside, could not quicken with others when roused between foes at the three furlong pole, retreated through the turn and could not factor four wide in the stretch drive.

P. S. RISING STAR had a stalking role in the second to last pairing, began to pick up the bit in the two path with a quarter mile to run, angled out seven wide having a clear lane for the stretch drive and was full of run late to almost close in and get the show money in the end. I HAVE AN IDEA cleared from the outer post to set an honest pace on the fence into the first turn, slowed the tempo down a touch while unopposed down the back straight, continued up top but by a diminishing margin through the last turn, gave way to the winner on the fence by the eighth pole and was engulfed by rivals in deep stretch losing a few positions nearing the wire. MISS WATERLOO was part of a clustered second flight three wide between rivals down the backstretch, stalked in the third tier outside on the turn, was roused at the quarter pole offering a good turn of foot six wide by the time they straightened out for the drive, closed belatedly to be second by mid-stretch and finished up to be a clear runner up when crossing the finish line. MRS. BENJAMIN settled in the two path between horses with a half mile left to run, angled out from the two path in the turn to be seven wide when in upper stretch, switched leads finding more at the eighth pole and closed in late to capture the show placing. SUMMER HOLIDAY travelled on the rail at the half in mid-division, ran evenly on the fence around the turn, shifted out three wide at the quarter but had to be checked for a moment when in tight quarters, shifted to the fence at the top of the lane, weaved between horses reaching for more ground by mid-stretch and finished up with interest to settle on the fringes in the end. TRUSTMYDADDYISSUES was bumped inside on the break to trail inside rivals along the backside, began to mount a rally passing foes just on the outside at the quarter pole, swung out widest gathering momentum in the nine path turning for home and found his best stride late passing many rivals in deep stretch. ABSOLUTELYSTUNNING was ahead of only one runner while two wide in the early stages, lost its path having to be checked on the fence with three sixteenths remaining, lacked running room down the lane darting in and out through traffic and finished up with interest when clear in deep stretch. FIREBOLT pressed the pace on the fence, was shuffled back ceding the rail position with seven sixteenths from the wire, kept pace with others on the rail through the turn, angled out in the five path but could only finish up one paced down the lane. ON PARADISE HILL was hustled from the outer post at the start, dropped back six deep to sit in midfield at the half mile marker, improved position moving in under urging four wide midturn watching the engaged pair of leaders, travelled three wide at the top of the stretch still in range for a share, took over the second spot on the rail with an eighth left to run but faded on the fence in the final seventy yards. ANOTHER PINKY travelled four wide with runners on either side in mid-pack down the backside, made little movement four wide around the turn, lost its path seven wide with three sixteenths from home, angled inside for the drive but lacked a bid in deep stretch. FLATTERING LOOK settled three wide close to the back of the pack down the backside, made little advance four wide around the bend, angled out to the eight path straightening out for home but had little to show down the stretch. MAGNETIZE stalked near the rear at the start, made an early move bursting between rivals five wide at the half to prompt the issue outside by the three furlong pole, dueled outside up top through the turn, still had a chance for a piece of the prize four wide in upper stretch when the winner was drawing away, could not find more late and stopped in the three path with a furlong remaining. LADY WITH ATTITUDE prompted the pace three wide outside early on, was reined back when in tight between horses at the three furlong marker, chased the embattled duo around the bend and folded on the fence by the furlong
