SPEEDY PAL was the speed of the speed getting away up top down the backstretch, continued to roll along setting a quick pace while hounded outside throughout the turn, repelled the early speed foe to open up straightening out for home and coasted home with mild urging for the frontrunning score. MR. MARSHALL chased the frontrunner down the back straight, moved in on the turn to sit just outside off the flank of the pacesetter with a quarter mile to run, could not match strides with the winner who had something left at the top of the stretch and finished up well enough to hold on saving the place share at the wire. HEY LUIGI travelled in mid-division on the inside, was roused when in the third flight on the rail three furlongs out to take closer order on the front pair by the quarter pole, skimmed the fence to be in range of the leaders in early stretch and stubbornly fought on inside for the runners up share in the final furlong but just could not get by late. COMMANDER AT SEA had a slow start to trail early on, advanced smartly on the fence saving ground at the quarter pole picking up rivals, shifted out three wide with momentum at the top of the stretch and finished up mildly to win the battle for the minors. PRINCE SUSSEX watched the lead duo, tracking on the rail down the backstretch, offered a brief move separating from the field keeping an eye on the front two at the quarter pole, was in the hunt four wide for a placing in upper stretch, had little left late and stalled outside in the final furlong. DANCING IN RIO stalked near the back ahead of one rival, co-trailed on the inside at the half, began to reach for more ground between foes three wide at the quarter pole, angled out eight wide with a strong stretch run and while on the wrong lead to the wire got up for the win in the final few strides. PICKFORD SWEET was allowed to settle at the rear in the beginning, co-trailed on the outside at the half, started to mount a rally four wide with a quarter mile from the wire, shifted out in the nine path widest of all runners turning for home, was full of run in the last furlong and almost won the nod for the win at

the finish line. SALMIAKKI had a good spot watching the front two while settled on the fence, tracked in the second group inside a rival down the backside, shifted out off the tiring early leader at the quarter pole to be in the thick of things with many others at the top of the stretch, battled up front at the seventy yard marker and finished up solidly to capture the show money between foes. PEACE POSEY stalked three wide close to the back, improved three deep to midfield down the backside, inched closer on the outside in the third flight around the far turn, shifted out six wide starting a rally turning for home, was in tight fighting for the lead between rivals at the eighth pole and was just outfinished in the late stages to settle on the fringes in the end. SUPER SHAMAN was outside rivals in mid-division, took closer order between horses down the backside, travelled evenly with others around the last bend, had a chance three wide straightening out for the drive, shifted to the rail moving in at the furlong pole to be part of six runners bidding up top with seventy yards left to run and just faded slightly in deep stretch in a tight finish. NO VISOR stalked on the outside near the rear in the early parts of the race, edged closer going three wide on the far turn, was seven wide when the field fanned out at the top of the lane having a chance but lacked a late finish at the sixteenth pole. J M R TACITA travelled in midfield on the rail, dropped back at the half, made no advance between foes in the two path through the final turn, lacked running room in the five path behind runners in upper stretch and finished up evenly in the last furlong. ROSE OF SHARON settled in the third flight two wide outside on the first turn, narrowed the gap watching the lead trio down the backside, kept pace with rivals on the last turn, angled out five wide in the mix in upper stretch, lost its path in tight being checked at the eighth pole and could not recoup in time to be a factor late. HIDDEN IMAGE was reluctant to load at the start, pressed the issue five wide into the initial bend, hounded the pace outside in the early stages, took over control outside midway around the final turn, had little left for the drive and was engulfed by rivals on both sides just inside the furlong marker. WEGOTTATALK was intent going the lead four wide into the first of two turns, dictated terms up top while shadowed outside down the backstretch, was collared outside offering no resistance at the five sixteenths pole and folded on the fence in upper stretch. NO MALARKEY travelled on the rail in mid-pack, was shuffled back a few positions on the fence along the backside, backed away on the rail throughout the turn and was wrapped up in upper stretch cantering across the finish line. WILBERFORCE was content watching the pacesetter on the rail in the beginning, dropped back some at the five eighths marker, was nudged on the fence maintaining inside position at the three furlong pole, shifted outside when asked to go after the leader at the quarter pole, posed the main threat in the three path at the top of the lane and determinedly wore down the frontrunner at the seventy yard pole to edge away for the victory at the finish line. STYLISH GENT took control from the onset moving well along the backside, was loose up top setting a quicker second split throughout the turn, was clinging onto the lead in the two path straightening out for home, was headed outside in the final seventy yards but could not fend off the winner anymore in deep stretch. SALVATOR MUNDI sat alone in midfield by the half mile marker, waited behind challengers going two wide lacking running room through the bend, shifted out three wide entering the stretch, angled out more in the four path under left-handed encouragement at the eighth pole and was gaining late on the leaders but had to settle for third money in the end. STOP THE HUMBUG had a stalking trip near the rear inside of rivals, offered little change around the turn, rallied up the fence at the quarter pole to be in range for a share in upper stretch but stalled late settling on the fringes at the wire. ANSELMO settled

close to the back down the backstretch, travelled two to three wide making no progression through the turn, took the overland route five wide trying to make a run at the quarter pole and in the six path down the lane passed tired foes at the sixteenth pole. NATIVE PRINCE stalked four deep close to the back of the pack, improved outside runners at the half, came under a ride inching up closer four wide around horses in the turn, angled out six wide at the top of the lane, could not sustain the rally and evened out in the final furlong. DECIMATOR was unhurried trailing down the backside, continued at the rear making little improvement around the bend, shifted out four wide turning for home, angled out further for clear run eight wide at the furlong pole and managed to pass weary rivals late. SOCIETY JOE chased the leader in the early stages, battled for the minor placings in the four path at the top of the stretch but yielded with rivals on either side by the furlong marker. KID FORESTER travelled three wide tracking the pacesetter between horses, was hard ridden but going in the wrong direction midway around the turn and retreated five wide in upper stretch. **Footnotes** PHILIP MY DEAR bobbled on the break, sat alone in the third flight on the rail, shifted outside off a tiring foe at the quarter pole to have a clear path four wide at the top of the stretch, switched leads at the eighth pole and exploded in the final furlong coming home strongly to get up in plenty of time for the win. SOULMATE was nestled on the rail just behind the leader into the first turn, shifted out entering the backstretch to flank the pacesetter outside at the half, bid for the lead cruising up on the outside at the quarter pole, edged away for the lead with a sixteenth remaining but had no answer for the winner's late rush in deep stretch. SAILOR'S PASSION had a stalking role on the rail in the latter part of mid-division down the backside, saved ground advancing on the fence around the far turn, had a quick turn of foot bursting between horses at the furlong marker in the two path and finished with good late energy to be a clear third at the finish line. C MY MEISTER was allowed to settle at the back trailing in the early stages, still continued at the rear but was starting to uncork a run midway on the final turn, swung out eight wide in upper stretch, came with a good late rally flying past horses in the last seventy yards and settled for a minor role winning the photo at the wire. MAD DOG N JOE assumed command on the fence going into the first turn, set the pace while hounded outside along the backside, was collared outside at the quarter pole, dug in to battle inside down the lane but flattened out in deep stretch on the fence. GRANDE SOIREE travelled on the rail close to the back of the pack, shifted off the fence at the half, started to mount a charge four wide with a quarter mile left to run outside rivals, angled out seven wide entering the lane and finished up willingly in deep stretch. LUCKMAN was ahead of only one runner in the beginning, improved to mid-pack four deep outside rivals by the half, made little headway with five sixteenths left to run, angled out six wide at the top of the lane but had little to offer running through the stretch. CORNWALL was part of the group up top tracking the pacesetter three wide between runners early, watched the lead pair while inside a rival tucked in on the fence down the backside, made no gain on the lead two but was being scrubbed on for more with five sixteenths to go, dueled on the fence for the show money at the top of the stretch but retreated inside challengers at the sixteenth pole. TIBERIUS MERCURIUS tracked the leader going four wide outside foes in the first turn, kept a close eye on the lead pair outside down the back straight, could not close the margin on the contesting duo midway around the far turn, still was in range if having a kick three wide turning for home but tired between rivals at the sixteenth pole. C C'S KINGDOM travelled in midfield, was pulling at the rider while under restraint down the backside, offered a mild run three wide between horses through the final turn, angled out five wide at the top of the lane but failed to fire in the drive to the wire. GUNS N' ROJAS galloped along near the rear three wide on the outside, closed the gap three deep by the half, could not keep up to rivals making a move backing away midpoint around the last turn and was not a factor in the stretch running.

CATHOLIC JACKIE was hard held between rivals in the third tier after the start, began to confidently pass runners while in hand two wide around the bend, angled out to the six path full of run in upper stretch, found another gear when encouraged right-handed at the furlong marker and closed in sharply in deep stretch to win going away impressively at the finish line. WETIKO broke inwards on the start, had a nice set up outside watching the engaged duo down the backstretch, moved in smartly for the lead outside at the quarter pole, opened up on runners turning for home having a comfortable advantage, continued to

run to the wire down the stretch but just could not fend off the strong late surge by the winner in the final seventy yards. VINI VIDI VICI tracked the contesting pair on the fence in the beginning, shifted outside midturn off a tiring rival, rallied between runners to be in the hunt four wide straightening out for home and stubbornly prevailed in the duel for third place in deep stretch inside. CLIVE CROSS was checked on the break to be at the rear, co-trailed on the inside down the backside, began to pick up the bit four wide between horses midturn, gathered more speed eight wide swinging out for the drive, finished up on the wrong lead down the stretch and could not win the battle for the show money late. ASHUKA had a rail stalking position along the backside in the third flight, travelled two wide but was inside horses keeping up with the outside flow throughout the turn and finished up one paced in the drive to the wire. GLORIOUS REVENGE pressed the pace outside down the backside, assumed command when the other speed foe dropped back at the three furlong pole, lost the lead outside at the quarter marker offering no resistance, tried to hang on two wide in upper stretch fighting for a minor share but yielded inside by the sixteenth pole. SCREEN LEGEND veered out on the break, co-trailed on the outside down the back straight, offered a mild run going four to five wide outside horses around the bend, was then floated out widest in the nine path turning for home and had no finish to give down the stretch. MIAH SAID dueled inside up top along the backside, dropped back conceding the front end on the rail at the three furlong pole, could not carry on inside rivals through the turn and emptied out on the fence in mid-stretch. GENTLE PERSUASION stalked three deep near the rear, was under a vigorous ride three wide with five sixteenths remaining but could not keep up to others on either side through the turn and could not get involved in the stretch running.
