APRIL DE VELP had a good spot nestled on the rail watching the lead pair, shifted out two wide when nudged for more at the quarter pole, angled to the four path with her sights set on the frontrunner turning for home and wore down the leader by the seventy-yard pole to edge away for the win in the end. SIGIRIYA was slow into stride co-trailing on the inside down the back straight, began to inch up taking the short way around the turn, shifted in from the two path to start a rally on the fence in upper stretch and ran on to the end to just capture the runners up share when crossing the finish. PRACTICAL GIZMO was away alertly to seize command from the start, rolled along unopposed through the turn, was narrowly holding on up top between foes at the eighth pole, could not fend off the winner with seventy yards remaining and just got caught for the place share at the finish line. TATOOSONMYSOUL broke in on the break, stalked four deep near the rear along the backstretch, travelled four wide staying with rivals on the turn, shifted out to be in the six path straightening out for home and finished up mildly to just get up to be a fringe player at the wire. WAR'S END KISS co-trailed on the outside, made no impact at the rear through the turn, skimmed the fence at the top of the lane and finished up willingly late to just miss for a minor share in a photo. SPEEDY ROSE travelled in mid-division between foes two wide, made little headway around the bend, shifted to the three path for the drive and was one paced down the stretch. NOT A LOST CAUSE broke in on the start, was content to track outside the pacesetter down the backside, chased the leader throughout the turn, could not keep position four wide when others were making move at the quarter pole and yielded in the five path at the furlong marker. MORNING HOLIDAY was brushed inside at the start, settled three wide in midfield along the backside, rallied three wide midturn taking closer order, drifted out widest in the seven path turning for home but emptied out in mid-stretch.

LAST CALL had an ideal trip tucked in on the fence behind the engaged pair, moved in closer with three eighths to go, loomed the only threat just outside straightening out for the wire and with relentless pursuit got up in the final few strides for the victory. TIRUPATI co-led on the inside in the beginning, edged clear setting a lively pace at the half, was still moving well, in control comfortably in upper stretch but could not find more late to fend off the winner nearing the wire. ENDURING settled near the rear three deep in the early parts of the race, advanced smartly on the fence three eighths out, shifted out three wide around a rival gathering momentum at the quarter pole and finished up sharply on the fence to win the battle for the show money. GOOD AS GONE settled on the rail in midfield, started to mount a rally picking up horses inside with three furlongs from home, split foes lengthening stride two wide at the quarter

pole to be in range in the three path in upper stretch, stalled at the furlong marker and had to settle on the fringes in the end. VAZHI co-trailed on the outside, galloped along ahead of one rival down the back straight, edged up in the two path through the final bend, shifted out three wide at the top of the lane and ran on gradually on the fence to the finish line. COFFEE CRISP had a tracking role on the outside watching the lead duo, could not close the gap on the front two when urged at the three eighths marker, angled out to the three path for the drive and finished up evenly to the wire. IDYLLIC travelled four wide into the initial turn, stalked three deep in the third flight but was regressing along the backside, made little impression through the far turn and could not factor four wide in the stretch running. PERFECT LADY BEE co-trailed on the fence, came under a ride but to no response seeing the field at the half and could only manage to pass a weary foe in mid-stretch. FRENCH LAUNDRY (GB) hounded the frontrunner for the lead in the early stages, could not continue on up top outside by the half mile marker and backed away on the fence midway around the final turn.

CONACHER was all alone watching the lone speed into the first turn, began to reel in the pacesetter at the half, assumed command between foes three furlongs out, was headed outside for a brief moment at the quarter pole, opened up quickly when asked turning for home, lugged in even under left-handed encouragement down the lane but was much the best when crossing the finish line. CALLING HOME co-trailed on the inside, started to commence a run like many others at the three eighths marker between rivals, angled out widest in the five path entering the stretch and with a good late kick bested the rest being the runner up at the finish line. MAD CHATTER co-trailed on the outside, rallied four wide circling around horses three furlongs from the finish to be in the mix in the four path straightening out for the drive, got up for second money at the furlong pole but was outkicked late and settled for a clear third at the wire. CHARTED MAP was brushed inside then bobbed on the break, nonetheless, recovered to have the lead going into the first turn, was loose up top slowing the wind aided tempo down on the backside, had no answer when the winner rushed on by three eighths from home, still tried to fight on for a placing on the rail at the top of the lane, had to be checked off a tiring foe with an eighth remaining and came back on late for a minor role in the end. AIM DON'T MISS broke out on the start, settled in midfield in the beginning, advanced smartly outside foes down the backside, closed in through the turn to bid outside in the two path at the quarter pole, was quickly repelled by the winner turning for home and weakened on the rail at the sixteenth pole. THREE O EIGHT had a stalking position in the next to last pair inside a runner in the early going, made a brief move three furlongs out, duelled for a piece of the prize three wide between rivals in upper stretch, could not continue the run and stalled at the furlong marker. DIVA'S GHOST stalked in the second to last group

on the outside, made little progress along the backside, could not quicken with rivals while travelling in the three path at the three eighths marker and could not reach contention in the stretch drive. BET ON WHITE settled on the rail far back in the third flight with the field spread out down the backstretch, narrowed the margin but was losing positions to others down the back straight, had little to give and retreated on the rail around the far turn.

WILL THEN was brushed at the start, caught widest entering the first turn five deep gradually moving in just a bit leaving that bend for the run up the backstretch, stalked outside in the second flight, advanced four to five wide leaving the far turn, struck the lead just past the three-sixteenths, moved clear under urging while drifting in through mid-stretch, held from a fast-closing rival. TIZ HER MONEY unhurriedly brought up the rear inside, advanced on the far turn, angled eight wide turning for home, closed fast and was gaining but only second best. D'AURUM was forced into a rival not long after the start, settled off the pace inside, advanced mildly along the rail up the backstretch, saved ground through the far turn, tried to sneak up the rail in mid-stretch, hit the rail

in the process, got through and up to gain show honors. TALBOT HEIRLOOM came in on rivals in the early going, stalked mid-pack from off the inside, steadied on heels at the half and again nearing the three-eighths in tight, moved between foes soon after about four wide, floated out seven deep leaving the far turn, ran on but needed more. BEAUTIFUL CRAZY was caught outside four to five deep early, continued from that vantagepoint through the far turn near the rear, failed to rally. POP ROX was up close four to five wide, done at the three-eighths and promptly dropped back. JUSTIFY'S JEWELL was bumped soon after the start, raced at the back outside or otherwise off the inside part of the course, was not a factor.

ALTA CALIBRE hopped slightly on the break, stalked near the rear on the rail, made a sharp move taking closer order on the rail three furlongs out, shifted outside to the three path at the quarter pole and in the five path down the stretch rallied smartly outside foes to capture the show award. PAT'S HOLIDAY travelled three wide in midfield, had a quick turn of foot going around horse three wide entering the final bend to track the contesting duo by the quarter pole, angled out four wide between foes to be in the thick of things turning for home but was outkicked in the final eighth of a mile. RHAENYRA had an uncontested lead going into the first of two turns, slowed the pace down the backstretch still moving well up top, was headed outside by the winner three eighths from home, battled on stubbornly inside until the sixteenth pole. SERENADING KITTEN stumbled badly going to her knees at the start, trailed the field down the backside, started to offer a rally going around rivals four wide three eighths out, could not sustain the run and levelled off by the furlong pole. LEMONCELLA SPRITZ was pushed out four wide

into the first turn, settled near the rear ahead of only the poor starter along the backside, made a brief run three wide between horses at the three furlong marker but could not factor in the three path in the stretch drive. FAULTFINDER travelled between rivals in midfield in the early stages, had to be checked in tight quarters causing her to be shuffled back at the three eighths marker and could not recover late to be a presence running down the lane. DANCIN MARY MARIE tracked the leader on the rail, could not maintain forward position in the two path when scrubbed on at the three furlong pole, backed away around the final bend and emptied out between horses two wide in upper stretch.

FORTYFIVESEVENTY broke in on the start, was under a snug hold shadowing the frontrunner, cruised on past for the lead outside with three eighths left to run, was headed momentarily outside at the top of the lane, spurted clear when asked at the furlong marker and improved the advantage when crossing the finish line. PEMBERLEY stalked at the back ahead of only one runner, burst between foes in the two path midway through the final turn, was in touch of the leader five wide in early stretch and closed belatedly to be a non-threatening second best at the wire. DESTINY RO travelled three deep in mid-division, took closer order full of run three wide with five sixteenths remaining, posed the main challenger four wide when entering the stretch, was no match for the winner by the furlong marker and faded slightly losing the battle for the place share in deep stretch. FLYING BLACK was in tight on the break, travelled on the rail in midfield, dropped back at the half on the fence, was compromised briefly when stuck behind a tiring foe three furlongs from home, angled out widest in the seven path straightening out and finished up willingly outside for a minor role. MY GIRL DELLA was forced in being checked at the start, trailed in the beginning, caught up to rivals going three deep at the half, rallied four to five wide around horses in the final bend, angled to the six path in upper stretch, could not sustain the run and evened out by the furlong pole. VUCHELLA was squeezed at the break, stalked in the third flight between foes,

edged closer in the two path through the far turn to have a chance for a share at the top of the lane but lacked a bid through the stretch running. ANTENNA seized command at the start, continued to roll along up top while watched outside by the winner down the back straight, had no answer on the rail when the winner went right on by at the three-furlong pole, retreated on the fence with a quarter mile left to run and emptied out on the fence in the stretch drive. STREGA had a good spot early on nestled right behind the pacesetter under a tight hold, was roused three furlongs out, made no effort to pick up the bit, backed away abruptly inside by the five sixteenths pole and was eased through the stretch crossing the finish line.

NANTUCKETS DAY settled on the rail in mid-pack, shifted just outside making no advance galloping along in the two path down the backside, edged closer two wide through the far turn, shifted to the three path making a smart move in upper stretch, shifted four wide reaching for more ground with an eighth left

to go and with a strong late kick prevailed in a photo at the finish line. SACCHARINE co-trailed on the outside, began to pick up horses three wide at the three furlong marker, swung out to the six path finding her best stride late, was full of run in deep stretch but was denied by the winner in a tight finish at the wire. WHY EM SEA AY tracked in the second flight on the outside, closed in to battle three wide outside two other foes at the quarter pole for the lead, drifted out five wide carrying momentum at the top of the stretch, came back on three wide with a furlong left to run to be in the mix up top at the seventy yard pole but was outfinished late showing a game effort in deep stretch. DAY DAWNING flanked the pacesetter under a snug hold outside, moved in vying between runners for the lead in the two path midway around the last turn, dug in determinedly down the stretch to have a slim advantage with rivals on both sides at the eighth pole and gave way grudgingly in the two path in the final seventy yards. WHAPPEN was away alertly setting the pace on the fence, dictated terms up front on the inside down the backside, was headed outside with five sixteenths to go with two other rivals, dueled stubbornly on the fence until the furlong marker and flattened out late to dead heat for the fifth money. QUALITY PRESENCE co-trailed on the inside in the early stages, began to pass runners three wide at the top of the stretch and finished up mildly in the final furlong to get up sharing for the fifth-place position. MCKENZIE ROAD sat behind the frontrunner on the rail tracking, was urged around the far turn keeping pace while on the fence, kept trying on the inside down the lane but weakened in the final eighth of a mile. PLAISIR D'AMOUR stalked near the rear on the outside, improved going three deep outside rivals down the back straight, offered a brief rally around foes four wide with three eighths remaining, could not continue the run and yielded to others on either side by the quarter pole. RUSH TO GLORY stalked in the third tier on the outside, made little progression between rivals three wide midpoint around the final bend, angled out five wide for the drive but lost its path at the eighth pole and could not recoup to play a role late.
