KITTEN'S ROMANCE was allowed to settle at the back ahead of one runner, waited patiently behind a wall of tracking rivals through the turn, found a seam five wide in early stretch, was let loose quickly extending her stride at the furlong pole and drew off smartly in the late stages. LADY MOONSHINE tracked the top two while between runners down the backside, rallied in the two path with a quarter mile left to go, moved in to be in the thick of things on the fence with a furlong from the wire, was no match for the winner late but easily bested the rest at the wire. SPIDER BELLE broke inwards, was slow into stride trailing down the backstretch, started to uncork a rally shifting out three wide at the quarter pole, swung out four wide behind runners in upper stretch, angled out more getting a clear lane in the five path at the eighth pole and closed belatedly for the show money. KATHERINE'S GEM shadowed the pacesetter outside down the back straight, could not make any gain on the leader chasing outside around the bend, shifted out four wide in the mix at the top of the stretch and evened out finishing up on the wrong lead in the final furlong. ADDENDUM seized command from the onset, continued to roll along up top quickening the tempo around the turn, was collared in the three path with rivals on both sides at the eighth pole and faded in the final sixteenth of a mile. DIOSA CATRINA travelled three deep in the second flight, continued a three wide journey keeping pace with others throughout the turn, angled six wide for

the drive, could not quicken between foes and lacked a finish in deep stretch. LOOKS LUCKY TO ME stalked near the rear on the outside, offered a brief run circling rivals five wide at the quarter pole to be in range in the seven path turning for home, could not sustain the rally and weakened at the furlong marker. HELLO FRIENDS had a good position nestled on the rail in midfield along the backside, travelled comfortably on the fence keeping pace while watching the front pair around the turn, hugged the rail turning for home but faltered inside foes by mid-stretch.

COMPTON broke outwardly, gained forward position into the first turn, was caught three to four wide, prompted the leader a couple times early up the backstretch, settled off that one to stalk the remainder of the way up the straight and into the far turn, began to edge nearer at the quarter pole, struck the lead at the three-sixteenths, dug in under steady handling and held off a late charging rival. OUT N OUT DISGRACE settled off the pace and off the inside in the two to three path, moved out up the backstretch brushing lightly with a rival, moved out further fanning six wide turning for home, gained late but missed. STARVIN prompted the early pace then was wrangled back at the three-quarter to stalk in behind the leaders racing two to three deep, chased evenly in the stretch and needed more. ROYAL ENTRY angled in early, saved ground on both turns racing at the rear, ran on in the stretch to improve. SHINIGAMI quickly moved to the lead, set the pace inside facing pressure from outside foes, edged clear up the backstretch, was overtaken at the top of the lane, gave way near the eighth pole. I'MANISLANDBOY tracked from inside, was put to urging three furlongs out, angled five wide leaving the far turn, was within range in upper stretch but had no extra. AUDAX MINOR chased mostly three to four wide, was ridden along by the three-eighths, steadied when in tight between foes coming to the quarter pole, weakened thereafter. SOUPER STRIDER was outside at the back, had some light brushing with a rival late up the backstretch, went four to five deep on the far turn, altered outside a rival past the quarter pole, failed to make a bid.

HAMMERHEAD was jostled between runners to begin, settled near the rear ahead of the other poor starter down the backside, closed the gap under a hard hold at the half, weaved through runners in the three path midway on the final turn, got outside having clear run at the quarter pole, moved in for the lead six wide by mid-stretch and powerfully drew off in the last furlong for a dominating win. CASH THE MONEY was nestled on the fence in the third flight, improved on the rail at the half to keep a close eye on the engaged front pair, edged closer through the final turn, angled out four wide in the hunt in upper stretch, could not match strides with the overpowering winner at the furlong pole but did finish up well enough to hold for the place share at the wire. GLOBETROTTING settled on the rail in mid-division, advanced smartly on the fence with three furlongs from home, shifted out five wide gaining on the

leaders at the top of the lane but could only finish up gradually in deep stretch to be a clear third in the end. MOST LIKELY watched the frontrunner in the two path inside horses around the first turn, shadowed the pacesetter outside down the back straight, took over the lead with a quarter mile left to run, had no answer when the winner flew past at the eighth pole and evened out late to settle on the fringes when crossing the finish line. NIIGON'S LAW rated three wide between rivals sitting just off the leader, tracked the lead twosome between horses at the half, dropped back in the two path with five sixteenths from the wire, resurged to be in range on the rail in upper stretch but finished up mildly in deep stretch losing the battle for the minors. SCUDERIA travelled close to the back having one foe beaten along the backside, saved ground around the last turn making little movement and finished up on the rail going by some rivals through the stretch. ARMINO broke in at the start, trailed in the early stages, angled outside two wide for the stretch running and managed to pass some rivals down the lane. DILWAALA assumed command after the break, slowed the pace down up top leading by a narrow margin at the half, conceded the front inside at the quarter pole and backed away on the fence by the furlong marker. CHASING MEMORIES travelled in midfield outside horses down the back straight, could not advance going four wide around runners on the far turn, had nothing more to offer with a quarter mile to run and gave way to others turning for home. FUN FELLA tracked the pacesetter going four wide around the initial bend, settled three deep watching the contesting duo outside at the half, was hard ridden in the three path but was being passed by rivals on either side at the quarter pole and wilted by upper stretch. ACCELERANDO travelled three wide into the first turn, had a stalking role ahead of a few runners down the backside, was urged for more three eighths out, offered no response and came up empty for the stret

HUNT MASTER was hustled getting the clear lead into the first turn, kept an even pace unopposed up top down the backside, had a slim advantage inside straightening out for the drive, dug in stubbornly in the two path with rivals closing in at the eighth pole and was resilient in deep stretch holding off both challengers on either side at the wire. SOCIETY'S THUNDER co-trailed on the inside, made an early move down the backstretch closing the gap passing foes at the half, was in tight quarters dropping back brushing the rail nearing the three furlong pole, recovered by the quarter pole picking up the bit again and under left handed encouragement had a strong late surge drifting out mildly with a furlong from home and just missed closing in for the win at the finish. AWESOME BOURBON was content to shadow the frontrunner in the early stages, edged closer outside around the final turn, bid three wide outside in upper stretch, fought on determinedly to the finish line but did not have enough late to threaten the winner and just missed holding for place as well. RAPID TEST had a stalking trip inside a runner settling in the third tier, was shuffled back to last running around the far turn and found his best stride late to move in in the final furlong to get up late to be a fringe player in the end. TOWN CRUISE was under a snug hold watching the engaged front two early on, moved in while travelling in hand on the fence at the three furlong marker posing a threat, chased the contesting pair four wide at the top of the lane, could not find more down the stretch and stalled in the final sixteenth losing the duel for the minors at the wire. DUN DRUM stalked in the third flight outside, travelled between foes in midfield at the half, was roused three furlongs out making little impact around the final bend and failed to menace five wide down the stretch. PERFECT CRIME co-trailed on the outside in the beginning, tracked three deep along the backside, took closer order by the three eighths pole, was scrubbed on through the far turn keeping pace, floated out widest in the six path turning for home and had little to show down the lane.

MEYER had a nice set up all alone settling in a good rhythm watching the loose leader, was coaxed three furlongs out reeling in the pacesetter through the far turn, cruised on past outside taking control at the quarter pole, opened up on rivals at the furlong marker and held safe, comfortably in first when crossing the finish line. LEGAL CATCH was nestled on the inside in midfield, waited on the fence for the cue to move around the last turn, skimmed the rail straightening out for home, rallied inside foes at the furlong pole, shifted out in the two path reaching for more ground and finished up smartly but was just second best to the winner who had it all his own way. JIM'S HOPE was situated on the rail ahead a rival down the backstretch, made no progression three wide around the final bend, shifted out finding a clear lane six wide by mid-stretch and closed in belatedly to be a clear but non threatening third in the end. SILENT SUNDAY travelled in the two path in mid-pack down the backside, was in tight three wide between horses looking for a seam throughout the far turn, had no room to move when stuck behind a tiring foe in the three path with a sixteenth remaining, was checked repeatedly late but still fought on gamely weaving between runners in deep stretch to get up for a minor placing. DAY TRIPPER was eager under restraint taking this field into the first turn, rolled along up front quickening the pace along the backside, offered little resistance on the rail when the winner swept on past with a quarter mile left to run, chased briefly in upper stretch but eventually faded on the fence with seventy yards from the finish line. NOAHS ARK settled on the outside ahead of one foe in the beginning, continued to stalk near the rear on the outside down the backstretch, kept pace with others moving three wide in the third flight in the far turn, was in tight looking for running room in the five path in upper stretch and stalled when trapped behind a weakening rival in the final furlong. ONENIGHTSTANDARDS was three wide in the third tier, came under a ride gaining some ground on the lead duo by the quarter pole, moved in closer to be in range in the five path if good enough turning for home but could only finish up one paced to the wire. EXUDE travelled on the rail in the third grouping, was roused for more on the fence through the far turn trying to maintain forward position with three eighths remaining, dueled three wide for the third place money in early stretch but had little left and folded at the seventy yard marker. DERBY STREET broke in a tangle to trail in the beginning, caught up to the field three deep at the half, made little impression around the last turn going four wide, swung out widest in the seven path at the top of the lane and could not factor outside in the stretch running. SUNRISE DRIVE advanced four wide outside horses in the first turn, stalked three deep ahead of a few runners down the backside, offered a brief run four wide around horses with five sixteenths from the prize, had nothing left by the time he straightened out in the six path for the drive and retreated in upper stretch. AMERICAN DECISION tracked the front two in the third flight with runners on both sides, chased the lead pair while in the two path around the final turn, angled out five wide battling for the show award at the top of the stretch but stopped in the final furlong.
