TWO SIP SALLY had a good position nestled on the rail just behind the leader, shifted out with five sixteenths to go lengthening her stride, bid three wide looming boldly at the top of the stretch, went right on by taking control outside at the furlong pole and was kept to the task to hold safe comfortably at the finish line. NIKITA'S GEM settled on the rail having a stalking trip in the final pair down the backside, could see the field still inside foes at the three furlong pole, began to reach for more ground edging up on the fence around the last turn, angled out gathering momentum three wide straightening out for home and chased the winner in vain to the finish easily bested the rest at the wire. SHARP FLAME settled on the outside tracking the pacesetter, took closer order pursuing the frontrunner down the backside, vied between runners in the second flight but could not reel in the leader around the final bend, shifted out four wide turning for home and finished up mildly in this compact field to close in nearing the wire for third money. KNOTTY AND NICE was hustled early intent for the lead, continued to set the pace unopposed up top along the backside, was headed outside by the winner in upper stretch, made no resistance when the winner was set down taking command at the furlong marker and had little left in deep stretch fading late just holding for a minor share in the end. BOWMAN'S RUN broke in soon after the start, tracked the pacesetter outside into the first turn, chased the leader down the backstretch, took closer order to be in the fray up front in the two path between foes coming out of the last turn, could not go on with others late and yielded by the sixteenth pole. MYRA'S BOY settled in midfield on the outside, continued in mid-pack three deep down the backside, made a brief rally three wide at the three furlong pole until the top of the lane still in the three path, could not sustain the run by upper stretch and weakened in the stretch drive. PAT'SSEWINGMACHINE was checked between horses at the start to trail in the early going, was hard ridden but made no movement around the last turn and had little offer in the stretch drive. NORTH WARDEN forced the issue on the fence in the beginning, dropped back quickly on the rail inside rivals at the half, lost touch with the field around the far turn, cantered down the stretch and was eased when crossing the finish line.

AMERICAN GAMBLE had a good spot sitting behind the contesting trio while between runners in the early stages, patiently waited, looking for clear running room at the top of the stretch, found another gear bursting between rivals at the eighth pole finding a lane three wide and wore down runners in the final seventy yards for the gutsy win. KNOW HOW (GB) broke out on the break, settled in the two path close to the back of the pack down the backside, closed in watching the front three fighting up top while travelling three wide between horses in the second flight through the turn, angled out five wide posing the main threat at the top of the lane, could not go with the winner who had a smart turn of foot late but did run on nonetheless and got up for second money at the wire. FRERET shadowed the pacesetter on the outside down the backside, vied between runners up front in the two path around the turn, poked his head in front at the top of the stretch, edged away briefly by the eighth pole but could not fend off the winner and the runner up in deep stretch, settling for a clear third in the end. DREAMING OF AUDREY settled on the fence in mid-division watching the front three up top, continued to save ground keeping a close eye on the three rivals battling for the lead around the turn, lacked running room behind the leaders in upper stretch two wide, shifted out finally having clear run

in the five path at the furlong pole and finished up with good energy late for a minor role in the end. BIG GINGER settled in midfield four deep down the backside, moved to prompt the pace three wide on the outside around the bend, was in the mix four wide straightening out for home, could not continue the run late and evened out in the final furlong. TAYLORMOON was unhurried trailing down the backside, was well back of the field throughout the running around the turn, angled out six wide for the drive and showed some late interest to pass some tired foes in deep stretch. MI TORMENTA stalked near the back of the pack ahead of only one runner along the backside, put in a mild rally taking closer order going the overland route four wide tracking the lead three through the turn, had a chance for a share of the prize six wide at the top of the lane but emptied out by upper stretch. DAISYCREST stalked near the rear on the rail, commenced a mild rally passing rivals outside three wide at the quarter pole, was in range for a share in the five path turning for home and finished up willingly to get up to be a distant third in the end. SILENT PASSION was bumped inside at the break, recouped to prompt the issue outside in the first of two turns, poked her head in front outside down the backstretch, put way that early speed foe

by the three furlong pole, braced for the new challenger outside while dueling on the rail up top around the last bend, still maintained a narrow lead in the two path with runners moving in on either side in upper stretch, was no match for the top two finishers who separated themselves in the final furlong and faded in the final seventy yards losing the show as well. BLING D'MONEY HOME broke out on the start, then was forced out when the troubled inside rival angled abruptly outside off heels into the first turn, recovered four deep closing the gap outside along the backside, battled outside for the lead through the far turn, still was in the hunt three wide at the top of the lane but wilted by the furlong marker. LOOKHOWPRETTY tracked the front two horses having runners on both sides in the beginning, grabbed onto the bit becoming eager behind the leaders heels in tight quarters, was forced to angle out four wide into the first turn, kept tabs on the front duo three wide inside another rival down the backside but could not quicken with others making a move at the three eighths marker and had little to show in the stretch running. DISGRUNTLEDPELICAN was antsy in the stall prior to the start, seized command inside into the first turn, battled up top on the fence down the backside, had little left to give on the rail with three eighths left to run, backed through the field on the fence on turn and was not persevered late galloping to the finish line.
