BLAZING SKY sat alone in midfield early on, was nudged at the quarter pole taking closer order five wide at the top of the lane, began to reach for more ground when asked at the eighth pole and drew off smartly for the win in deep stretch. KANTBACKOFF settled close to the back of the pack inside runners, came under a ride picking up the bit three wide going around foes at the quarter pole, was in range six wide at the top of the lane having a full head of stream and finished up strongly, could not get to the winner but bested the rest comfortably for the runners up share. SPEEDY RIVER had a good spot three deep watching the front duo, moved in three wide a quarter mile from the prize to loom boldly in the five path straightening out for the drive but could only finish up mildly between rivals late to just save for the show money at the finish line. LULU'S LULLABY was ahead of only one foe along the backside, offered no rally two wide throughout the turn, angled three wide turning for home lengthening stride, shifted out more to be in the five path at the furlong pole and just missed closing in for the third-place share at the wire. SILVER BULLET LADY broke inwards on the start, chased between horses along the backside, moved in to bid outside with five sixteenths from home, assumed the lead in hand at the quarter pole, maintained a slim advantage when roused with a furlong remaining but could not find another gear late and faded to be on the losing end of a three-way photo for the show award. CRUMLIN BIRD settled on the rail watching the front three down the back straight, kept pace inside foes on the turn, shifted to the two path for the stretch run and kept on

coming, gradually gaining on the fence in deep stretch to be involved at the wire for a minor placing. PRINCESSOFTHENORTH was bumped outside to trail in the early going, caught up to rivals inside at the three eighths marker, made little impact on the fence through the turn and managed to pass weary foes in the stretch. LOADED SECRET had a stalking trip near the rear on the outside, travelled three wide outside foes making no movement around the bend, angled out to the five path for the drive but failed to menace in the stretch running. GIZMO'S B F F emerged from the early scramble to have the lead down the backstretch, was collared outside by midturn, offered no resistance by upper stretch and wilted on the rail at the furlong marker.

ZODIAC BEACH was unhurried stalking close to the back in the early going, still remained at the rear heading into the turn, began to pick up horses three wide on the outside at the quarter pole, gathered more momentum swinging out widest having clear run in the eight path at the top of the lane and with a strong late kick got up late under a well timed stretch rally. LEGALLY CHARITABLE travelled inside horses in mid-pack, kept pace while between foes in the second flight through the turn, found her best stride late in the four path turning for home and just missed at the wire for the win. SMILES FOR DAVID settled inside horses in mid-division, dropped back to last on the fence around the turn at the quarter pole and had a sharp late surge on the rail with a furlong from the finish line to be a clear third when crossing the wire. MRS. HOT SHOT had a tracking position on the rail, waited in hand on the turn behind

the contesting trio, shifted out off a tiring rival midway around the turn, angled back inside to the fence in upper stretch to be in the hunt, took over control for a brief moment with an eighth left to run but could not fend off the closing runners in deep stretch and faded for a minor share in the end. BEAUMONT DRIVE was allowed to settle at the rear in the beginning, made a big swooping move five wide at the quarter pole passing foes, loomed a menacing presence seven wide for the stretch drive, could not sustain the rally and stalled with a furlong left to go. HYPER AWAKENING was rank while pressing the issue three wide battling up top down the back straight, continued to force the pace three wide around the bend, shifted out five wide in the mix with others in upper stretch but could not quicken with runners late and gave way at the sixteenth pole. NOW YOU SEE ME stalked in the third flight three deep, closed the gap travelling three wide outside horses on the turn to be in with a chance for a share six wide at the top of the stretch but lacked a rally the final furlong and could not pose a threat late. FOREST VIXEN was fractious in the stall prior to the start, vied between runners at the half, assumed the lead in the two path between horses three furlongs from the finish line, dug in stubbornly clinging onto the lead in the three path in upper stretch, had little left to offer late and tired in deep stretch. GOLD FORESTER seized the lead at the start taking this field along the backside, was roused when collared outside with three furlongs to go offering no response, backed through the field on the fence around the turn and emptied out on the rail in upper stretch.

VICTORIA'S CHIEF broke out at the start, travelled in the five path between foes heading into the first of two turns, stalked three deep close to the back

down the backstretch, rallied five wide around the last turn circling rivals at the quarter pole, was running on end in the six path down the stretch and got up in the last few jumps for the stretch running victory. JACK THE CAT was squeezed on the break to co-trail on the inside, started to mount a rally between foes two wide with a quarter mile from home, gathered speed widest in the eight-path straightening out for the drive, stayed on the wrong lead to the wire and got up late to be second best. YORKVILLE tracked on the outside in the second flight, edged closer three wide through the far turn, was encouraged left-handed having his sights set on the leaders at the quarter pole, loomed boldly five wide at the top of the stretch, drifted outside dueling for the lead at the sixteenth pole and faded late to settle for third in the end. JAY BIRD settled into stride ahead of only a couple of rivals after the start, narrowed the margin advancing on the fence down the backside by the half, started to rally weaving between horses picking up the bit with five sixteenths from home, shifted four wide quite in the thick of things at the top of the lane, lacked running room losing its lane at the eighth pole, angled outside once more at the sixteenth pole surging late, again was stymied having to be checked in tight quarters in deep stretch and could not recover in time to threaten at the finish. MIGHT BEE SPEEDY pressed just outside in the beginning, hounded the frontrunner outside down the backstretch, closed in around the final turn to have a short-lived lead in the three path between horses in mid-stretch, could not continue on in the late stages and yielded inside runners at the seventy-yard pole. stretch, drew clear when asked. H C HOLIDAY tucked in stalking in behind close up but off the leaders racing in the two path, shifted five wide leaving the second turn, was no match for the winner but second best. FRANK'S ART was forced out at the start, chased from outside about three wide, struck the lead outside the three-eighths, was overtaken at the top of the stretch, could not kick on with the top pair but fought on inside to hold show. SPRING MOUNTAIN tracked in behind racing up close early, was off the rail two to three wide and in contention coming past the quarter pole, had no extra for the drive and was outfinished for third. SUGAR IT'S ELI tracked four wide on the outside into the first turn, had an ideal spot on the outside of a rival watching the engaged pair at the half, moved in outside seizing control at the quarter pole, opened up at the furlong marker and held safe for the win. ZAKHARI was in front under a tight hold on the rail in the early going, lost the lead to hound the new frontrunner inside down the backstretch, chased the pace on the fence throughout the turn, kept on coming four wide down the stretch and came back on late to hold for the runners up share at the wire. MODDASSAH was away a step slow to begin having one foe beaten in the early stages, was roused starting a rally when bursting between runners at the five sixteenths pole, skimmed the fence turning for home and kept inching closer down the stretch on the rail but just missed out on the nod for the second place share in a tight photo. TRINITY PARK nestled on the rail in mid-pack, narrowed the margin between rivals in the two path stalking in the third flight, edged closer two wide around the far turn, shifted out for the drive in the three path, kept on grinding outside in the final furlong but had to settle for a minor role when on the losing end of a three way finish for the second money. PHANTOM JEWEL was off slowly on the break, stalked close to the back of the pack three wide in the first bend, improved four deep outside foes down the backside, kept pace three wide through the final turn, shifted out six wide straightening out for the drive and finished up evenly to the finish line. HATMAKER GIZMO stalked between runners in the third tier, moved in closer inside to be in the second flight at the half, found more when nudged three wide at the quarter pole to be in range in the five path in upper stretch, could not sustain the run and stalled in deep stretch. LONHRO'S GAMBLE travelled between horses in midfield, was shuffled back some positions along the backside, made little impression three wide around the final turn and in the four path showed little down the lane. STAR SCHOLAR was unhurried to trail in the early parts of the race, passed a stopping foe outside at the quarter pole, angled out six wide at the top of the lane and managed to go by another struggling runner in mid-stretch. STRETCH PASS pressed the pace on the outside, took over the front between rivals at the five eighths pole, had no answer when collared outside by the winner at the quarter pole and while on the wrong lead shortened stride stopping at the furlong marker on the fence. ## **Footnotes**

COMPUTER HACKER travelled on the rail when the field was quite bunched up at the half in the middle of the pack, edged closer in the two path with a quarter mile left to run, shifted out to be in the mix four wide at the top of the stretch and came on late to just get his nose in front right at the wire. WHISKEY ROW tracked the front two while between horses along the backside, kept a close eye just behind the contesting leaders throughout the turn, angled for clear running room in the three path in upper stretch, was closing in smartly late with runners on either side but lost the nod in a tight photo at the finish line. DELIRIO broke in at the start, dueled inside a rival down the backside, edged away for the lead in upper stretch, opened up with a furlong left to run putting away the other early speed foes and just got caught nearing the wire to settle for third money in the end. FAST AND READY prompted the pace outside along the backstretch, had a slim advantage between horses with three eighths remaining, battled up top in the four path turning for home, stayed on the wrong lead getting leg weary at the furlong pole and held on well enough to settle on the fringes at the finish line. TREBUCHET stalked in the five path between horses in the early stages, made little impact close to the back of the pack three wide through the turn, began to pick up the bit five wide with a quarter mile from the wire, angled out to the seven path in mid-stretch and was gaining gradually on the outside late. BENLION had a stalking role in the beginning six deep on the outside, made an early move sharply passing many rivals outside down the backside, kept on coming prompting the pace three wide outside horses around the bend, angled to the five path at the top of the stretch, could not sustain the long rally but still did finish up willingly in the last furlong. HARPER CITY was bumped on the start, settled in midfield in the two path, was shuffled back a few positions by the three-furlong pole, angled five wide turning for home, shifted inwards to be on the rail at the furlong pole and finished with good intent closing the gap in deep stretch. CANADIAN DADDY was situated in mid-pack between horses going three wide early on, made a brief run on the outside four wide in midturn, shifted to the seven path at the top of the lane but levelled off in the final sixteenth of a mile. PANYARD TAP tracked three deep down the backstretch watching the top two runners, could not maintain forward position conceding to the outside foe making a move at the three furlong pole, was under a ride being passed on both sides at the quarter pole in the three path and ran on evenly down the lane while going in the five path. DIXIE'S FLATTER was unhurried at the rear leaving the chute, took the short way around the bend picking up a rival on the inside with a quarter mile left to run and finished up mildly down the lane passing a couple more challengers to the wire. SING DIXIE tossed his head on the break, travelled four deep in mid-division down the backside taking closer order by the half, backed away five wide with five sixteenths from the line outside, angled out six wide for the drive to the wire but had little to offer in the late stages outside. TAX INCLUDED settled near the rear ahead of only one runner down the backside, could not offer a rally around the turn seeing the field at the quarter pole and passed a straggler outside in deep stretch. IMPERIAL STAR tracked the lead duo on the rail early on, travelled on the fence through the turn starting to retreat inside foes at the quarter pole, was checked briefly on the rail just before entering the stretch and weakened by the furlong marker.
