GAMBLE ON LOVE broke just a bit awkwardly and was immediately urged forward, gained position stalking the leaders from outside, went four wide on the turn beginning to advance, had aim in upper stretch, struck the lead about the eighth pole, drew clear. SERIOUS GREEN exchanged a bump at the start then was bumped into a rival, moved forward under some coaxing to make the lead from between runners, set the pace, was overtaken past the quarter pole, could not kick on with the winner but fought back for place. KEE'S FLATTER bumped a rival just after the start, was in tight soon after and shuffled a bit, moved up chasing mid-pack off the rail, went mostly two to three wide on the turn and encouraged along from the five-sixteenths, came out a bit wider past mid-stretch and finished well to get up for show. IMPERIAL TRICK had a brief early lead but was outsprinted, stalked that runner three wide, moved closer late on the turn taking the lead outside the three-sixteenths, was outkicked. PATRIOTIC WAR broke out on the start, had good early foot clearing from the outside post to get the lead on the rail by the half, moved well in hand loose on the lead through the turn, repelled the mild challenge while in the three path in upper stretch when asked for more and was comfortably in control for the win when crossing the finish line. GOLDEN SUNSET watched the lead duo three wide down the backstretch, took closer order moving in at the three eighths pole, posed the only threat to the winner four wide at the top of the stretch, kept on fighting on but chased the winner in vain to the wire. BEACH CRICKET travelled between horses in midfield early on, was relegated to last at the three furlong pole, had a quick turn of foot when roused with five sixteenths from home, was held up for a moment behind a wall of runners in the three path turning for home, angled four out wide in upper stretch and finished up strongly late to almost close in to capture the runners up share. EARENDEL settled in midfield three deep on the outside, made a sharp move three wide splitting foes at the quarter pole, angled in from the four path in upper stretch to the rail closing the gap by the eighth pole, could not continue the stretch rally and stalled in deep stretch to settle on the fringes. SULTRY SOPHIE co-trailed on the outside five deep down the back straight, tried to circle around horses five wide through the turn but with little impact, shifted out to the six-path turning for home but could only finish up one paced down the stretch. BEDTIME broke in on the start, chased the frontrunner down the backside, was roused to go after the pacesetter at the quarter pole but to no avail, could not keep pace with outside runners while in the two path straightening out for the drive and staying on the wrong lead down the lane began to shorten stride weakening in the final furlong. SHE'S SO CROATIAN was away slowly to co-trail inside a rival in the four path down the backside, was losing position when scrubbed four wide at the midpoint around the turn, angled out five wide for the drive to the wire but had little left for the stretch running. MOMANDA stalked near the rear on the rail, advanced sharply inside foes at the half, could not continue on when unable to quicken on the fence with the outside flow of runners at the three furlong marker, regressed around the turn and emptied out in upper stretch.

HOT CARGO was content to track the pacesetter three wide between horses down the backside, edged closer with five sixteenths from the wire with a slight move from the rider's hands, pounced confidently outside taking control turning for home and held safe quite comfortably when crossing the finish line. PEACH COBBLER sat behind the pacesetter on the rail, patiently waited to move on the fence watching the embattled duo midturn, shifted out for a clear run three wide in upper stretch posing the only danger, was gaining some late but in the end it was not enough to threaten the winner. OL' BLONDIE was situated in midfield in the two path between foes, started to make a move when coaxed midway around the bend, angled four wide reaching for more ground straightening out for home and closed in belatedly to be a non-threatening third. ECHO SEVEN had a rail position near the rear in the early stages, could see the field around the turn saving ground, shifted out four wide at the top of the lane, found another gear by mid-stretch and with a late kick passed many

rivals to settle on the fringes in the end. IMA BEAST had rivals on either side close to the back of the pack down the backstretch, made little progression taking the short way around the turn, shifted three wide for the drive to the wire but failed to fire in deep stretch. SUMMER SNOW was hustled early on, emerging from the group to have a clear lead with a half mile left to run, was under a ride maintaining a narrow advantage ahead of the waiting winner outside through the turn, had no answer when collared by the three sixteenths pole and folded on the fence by the sixteenth pole. MAXIMUM FIFTY kept a close eye on the frontrunner four deep down the backstretch, retreated when getting out midway around the turn, shifted out five wide at the top of the stretch but failed to menace in the stretch running. RETAIL THERAPIST settled in the rear group three deep on the outside in the beginning, offered a brief move three wide from the three eighths marker until the quarter pole closing the gap on the leaders, angled out seven wide for the drive but could not factor outside down the lane.

DANCIN IN DA'NILE was ahead of a couple of runners travelling in the two path, loped along finding a good rhythm down the backstretch, began to lengthen stride three wide at the half, made a sharp move progressing when asked with five sixteenths from the finish, closed in to have a slim advantage four wide at the top of the stretch and with a tap right handed at the eighth pole drew off late for the convincing win. STONE AGE (IRE) tracked the pacesetter outside, moved in to bid two wide on the outside three eighths from the wire, determinedly vied between rivals up top at the guarter pole having his head in front for a moment, was no match for the winner a furlong from the line but did dig in late saving the place share in a photo at the wire. ENGLISH CONQUEROR stalked at the rear on the fence, shifted out three wide midway around the final turn commencing a late run, had a sharp turn of foot four wide at the quarter pole to loom six wide for the stretch drive, could not gain on the winner who something left late and still battled on in deep stretch just missing for the second money share at the finish line outside. GREYSTONE travelled in mid-pack outside a fellow runner, could not quicken having the eventual winner on his outside at the three furlong marker, was hard ridden making little headway through the last turn, angled five wide for the drive and finished up willingly between horses for a minor placing. RON'S GIZMO was nestled on the fence behind the leader in the early stages, lacked running room looking for a seam in the two path behind the contesting trio at the top of the lane, found a clear path at the furlong pole but could only finish up evenly in deep stretch. BREAKING ALONE was steadied in tight quarters two wide going into the first turn co-trailing between runners, settled near the rear outside down the backstretch, was going the wrong way three to four wide around the last bend, shifted out widest in the seven path turning for home and passed a straggler late. SPINZAR assumed command under a snug hold, set an even split under the wire for the first time up top, slowed the pace down still in control down the backside, was collared outside with three eighths from home, fought on stubbornly on the rail until the furlong marker but wilted inside in deep stretch. FIRECRACKER FIONA travelled three deep on the outside keeping a close eye on the contesting duo down the backside, edged up midturn measuring the embattled pair, swung out looming boldly in the three path in upper stretch, swept right on by with only mild urging just inside the eighth pole and drew away with authority for the win in deep stretch. SAUCY NAME had a slim lead between rivals early on, dueled with company inside at the half, put away the inside speed foe to open up at the quarter pole, braced for the challenge by the outside runner in mid-stretch, had no answer when the winner swept past at the sixteenth pole but did easily best the rest for the runners up share at the finish line. WORLD SHOWCASE stalked on the rail close to the back of the pack, had little movement two wide throughout the turn, started to rally two wide at the top of the lane, shifted out to the five path briefly in upper stretch and closed in for third money in the final furlong while coming on three wide in the final sixteenth. LILLZ STAR was slow into stride ahead of only the other poor starter down the backside, mounted a rally darting between rivals smartly coming up to the quarter pole, gathered momentum five wide turning for home and finished up with intent to settle on the fringes at the wire. TENTOMIDNIGHT dueled on the fence up front down the back straight, battled stubbornly fighting on lead until the quarter pole when relinquishing the top spot inside, tried to find more holding for the show money in mid-stretch but weakened in the late stages. MIGHT BEE TROUBLE bore out badly on the break to trail by many down the backside, closed in three wide catching up, then passing horses at the quarter pole, shifted out five wide finding her stride at the top of the lane, could not continue the rally and levelled out laying on the wrong lead in the final furlong. EDEY'S VILLAGE had a slow start stalking near the rear outside rivals, offered a mild advance three wide around the bend, angled to the four path turning for home, drifted inwards tiring on the rail by the eighth pole and had to little to show in deep stretch. SENSATIONAL SARAH settled in the two path watching the top three runners down the backstretch, kept pace with the front threesome around the bend, angled out four wide straightening out for the stretch run but yielded between horses in the final furlong. TOUCARI BAY travelled on the fence in midfield down the back straight, could not go on backing away on the rail at the quarter pole, had nothing left for the stretch run and was not persevered with in the final furlong.
